- BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles continue their eight-game homestand against the Blue Jays (1-1), Guardians (0-1, 2 to play), and Reds (3 to play) tonight at Oriole Park at Camden Yards.
 - $artheta_{\!\scriptscriptstyle N}\,$ The Orioles have drawn at least one walk in 94 straight games dating to July 2, 2024, the longest active streak in MLB and the longest by Baltimore since a 116-game run from June 3, 1995–April 5, 1996.
 - Baltimore has homered in a season-best three straight games...They last homered in four straight (single season only) from August 29-September 2, 2024 (5 G).
 - The Birds have struck out 12+ times in back-to-back games for the first time since September 19-20, 2024...They have not done so in three straight games since September
 - 14-16, 2021 (3 G).

TIME FOR A TURN: Orioles starters own an MLB-worst 5.54 ERA (49 ER/79.2 IP) with the next closest clubs being the Rockies (5.05) and Yankees (4.98).

- the Nationals (5.17), Rockies (5.09), Athletics (4.80), and Angels (4.79). The Birds have allowed 10+ hits in four straight games for the first time since a five-
- game stretch from July 26-29 (G2), 2024.
- O's pitching has posted 7.19 strikeouts per 9.0 innings, the third-lowest mark in MLB ahead of only the Rockies (6.77) and Marlins (7.09)...Baltimore starters have averaged an MLB-low 6.44 strikeouts per 9.0 innings, with the next closest teams being the Rockies (6.60) and White Sox (7.00).

TOP GUN: After opening the season 4-for-29 (.138), Gunnar Henderson is 5-for-9 (.556) with one double, one triple, and three runs over his past two games

- θ_{*} He has as recorded an exit velocity of 102.5+ mph on 15 of his 24 batted balls (62.5%), posting a 98.6 mph average exit velocity and 66.7 percent hard-hit rate.
- since June 26, 2024, going 13-for-25 (.520) with three doubles, two home runs, and six RBI...His career 1.085 OPS against the Guardians is the highest among all active players (min. 70 PA) ahead of DET's Andy Ibáñez (1.075), BOS' Rafael Devers (1.032), LAA's Anthony Rendon (1.024), and WSH's Nathaniel Lowe (.998).

<u>'PEN PALS</u>: Seranthony Domínguez has thrown 7.0 scoreless innings across seven appearances to open the season, scattering one hit and six walks while striking out eight batters...He has not allowed a hit in six straight appearances, tied for the second-longest streak of his career (also 4/7-19/18), trailing his career-best seven-appearance run from May 29-June 16, 2024... The current six-game run is tied with AZ's Shelby Miller for the longest active streak in MLB.

- Best Homestand 𝔥 Matt Bowman owns a 1.08 ERA (1 ER/8.1 IP) with three strikeouts across seven Worst Homestand appearances...He has not issued a walk in a career-best 13 straight appearances since September 24, 2024...The 13-outing run is tied with STL's Phil Maton for the secondlongest active streak in MLB behind TB's Manuel Rodríguez (16 G).
- ϑ_{λ} Overall, O's relievers have allowed 0.46 home runs per 9.0 innings, the third-lowest mark in the majors behind only the Cardinals (0.42) and Mets (0.43).

THE MAGIC NUMBER: The O's are 6-2 when scoring four or more runs this year and winless when scoring three or fewer.

- ϑ The Birds have lost 18 straight games when scoring three runs or fewer dating to September 7, 2024, with their last such victory coming on September 6, 2024 vs. Tampa
- Since 2024, Baltimore is 86-21 (.804) when scoring four or more runs, the fourth best winning percentage in MLB during that stretch behind San Diego (88-14, .863), Cleveland (84-15, .848), and Houston (80-19, .808).

NO RISP, NO REWARD: Over the last six games since April 7, the Birds have gone 6-for-42 (.143) with runners in scoring position, the third-lowest mark in the majors during that time ahead of the Rockies (.115, 6-for-52) and Red Sox (.147, 11-for-75)...The O's own a .113 (6-for-53) RISP average with one extra-base hit in 10 losses, compared to 21-for-58 (.362) with three doubles, one triple, and two home runs in six wins.

 ϑ O's pitching has limited the opposition to a .218 (34-for-156) RISP average, the fourthlowest mark in the AL and eighth lowest in MLB.

FIRST-INNING INTEL: Baltimore has tallied five home runs in the opening frame, tied for the third-highest mark in MLB behind New York-AL (7 HR) and Los Angeles-AL (6 HR)...The O's .912 OPS in the first inning ranks fifth in the AL and seventh in MLB.

 ϑ Oriole starters have posted a 5.63 ERA (10 ER/16.0 IP) in the opening frame, the thirdhighest clip in the AL ahead of the Athletics (9.00) and White Sox (6.19).

THE FOREST CITY: The O's and Guardians continue their seven-game season series tonight in Baltimore...Cleveland took the 2024 season set, 4-3, taking two of three at Camden Yards from June 24-26... Baltimore has dropped four of its last five home games and six of eight to Cleveland

- Orioles Broadcaster and Major League Baseball Hall of Famer Jim Palmer recorded a 0, 2.12 ERA in 52 career appearances (48 GS) against Cleveland, his lowest ERA against any single opponent ahead of California (2.57)...His 29 career wins opposite Cleveland were his second most against any club, trailing only New York-AL (30).
- A. Cleveland Special Assignment Scout Dave Miller was drafted in the first round of the 1986 First-Year Player Draft by Baltimore after playing collegiately at Camden County College in New Jersey, where he was an All American right-handed pitcher.
- (b) On April 6, 1992, Baltimore hosted Cleveland in the first ever game played at Oriole Park

AGAINST CLEVELAND: Owns an 0-3 record with a 6.50 ERA (13 ER/18.0 IP), a 1.50 WHIP, and 10 strikeouts in four career starts against the Guardians...Last faced the club on August 2, 2024 in Cleveland, allowing four earned runs on six hits with two Observe against any opponent (min. 3 G)
 In 13 career starts against AL Central foes, owns a 2-8 record with a 5.81 ERA (40 ER/60.2 IP), a 1.53 WHIP and 46 strikeouts against 19 walks.

QUALITY AND QUANITY: Kremer has recorded 31 quality starts since the beginning of the 2022 season, leading all Orioles starters during that time frame...Last season, Orioles starters recorded 68 quality starts, tied with the Blue Jays for the sixth most in MLB.

STRONG FINISH: In his final eight starts of the 2024 season dating to August 14, Kremer went 4-1 with a 2.98 ERA (15 ER/45.1 IP) on 37 hits (3 HR), 17 total runs, 15 walks. and one hit batter with 42 strikeouts.

During that stretch, he limited left-handed batters to a .205/.283/.313 (17-for-83) line with 23 strikeouts. 0.

FOUR IS NOT MORE: Last season. Kremer posted a 2.75 ERA (22 ER/72.0 IP) on 52 hits (6 HR), 29 total runs, 25 walks, and two hit batters with 65 strikeouts and a 1.07 WHIP from innings one through three...In the fourth inning, however, he owned an 8.87 ERA (23 ER/23.1 IP) on 31 hits (6 HR), 26 total runs, nine walks, and one hit batter with 24

Opponents slashed .170/.245/.258 (33-for-194) with four home runs against him 0 the first time through the lineup, compared to .271/.336/.432 (52-for-192) with seven home runs the second time around.

THE RUN AROUND: His 13 unearned runs allowed in 2024 were tied with teammate Corbin Burnes and Boston's Tanner Houck for the AL lead and tied four fourth most in the majors behind Washington's MacKenzie Gore (21), San Diego's Michael King, and St. Louis' Lance Lynn (both 14).

BANANA SPLIT: He utilized his splitter 18.5 percent of the time last season, holding opponents to a .139 (14-for-101) average...his 36.0 percent whiff rate on the offering was the highest of any of his pitches, while his 34 strikeouts were his second most behind his four-seam fastball (45 K).

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Kremer went 5-5 with a 3.78 ERA (29 ER/69.0 IP) on 50 hits (6 HR), 31 total runs, and 28 walks with 65 strikeouts across 13 road starts in 2024. A His .196 (50-for-255) opponent batting average on the road was fifth lowest in the AL and seventh lowest in MLB (min. 65.0 IP).
