MLB DRAFT STARTS TONIGHT: The 2025 2-day MLB Draft starts today from Atlanta...MLB Network and ESPN will provide live coverage today beginning at 3 p.m. AZ...**D-backs First 3 Picks:** No. 18 (first round), No. 29 (compensation pick), No. 92 (third round).

FUTURES GAME RECAP: In the NL’s 4-2 win on Saturday from Atlanta, INF **LuJames Groover** (No. 10) started at third base and went 2-for-2 (2 singles) with 1 run scored...OF **Slade Caldwell**, OF (No. 2/MLB No. 84) was a replacement in center field, which included a highlight-reel diving catch to end the seventh.

TRIO OF ALL-STARS: The D-backs will be represented by 2B **Ketel Marte** (starting 2B), 3B **Eugenio Suárez** (reserve) and OF **Corbin Carroll** (reserve) at the MLB All-Star Game on July 15 in Atlanta.

2B Ketel Marte - Fan-Elected Starter:

- Led NL players in Phase 2 voting.
- Second straight and third career start at second base (also: 2019, '24).
- First NL second baseman with consecutive fan-elected starts since Chase Utley with 5 straight from 2006-10.
- First D-back with 3 fan-elected starts, second with 3 starts (also: Paul Goldschmidt) and third with consecutive starts (also: Paul Goldschmidt in 2014-15 and Randy Johnson in 2000-01).

3B Eugenio Suárez - Player-Elected INF Reserve:

- 2-time All-Star (also: 2018 with the Reds, player-elected at 3B).

OF Corbin Carroll - Player-Elected OF Reserve:

- 2-time All-Star (also: 2023 as fan-elected starter in LF).

LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 10-5 @ Angels.

- **Eugenio Suárez** had his 20th career multi-homer game.
- **Randal Grichuk** reached safely in his third straight game...has reached base 5 times in his last 9 PA.
- **James McCann** had his third multi-hit effort and hit safely in his sixth game in 9 total with the club.
- **Andrew Saalfrank** made his first appearance since April 29, 2024 vs. Dodgers and second career multi-inning stint (also: Sept. 16, 2023 vs. Cubs).

GENO ECLIPSES 30 HOMERS AGAIN: Last night, **Eugenio Suárez** (31 HR in 94 G) became second D-back all-time with 30+ home runs before the All-Star Break, joining Luis Gonzalez in 2001 (35 HR in 87 G).

- Suárez is the sixth D-back with consecutive 30+-homer seasons along with: Christian Walker/2022-23, Paul Goldschmidt/2017-18, Mark Reynolds/2009-10, Luis Gonzalez/2000-01 and Steve Finley/1999-00.

LAST 162 FOR GENO: In the last year since July 12, 2024, has played in 162 games (160 starts) and hit .275 (167-for-607)/.330 OBP/.583 SLG/.913 OPS with 31 doubles, 52 home runs, 134 RBI, 40 walks (180 K) and 354 total bases...he ranks among all players since July 12, 2024 (min. 450 PA):

- Second with **134 RBI** (behind Aaron Judge-NYY/142)
- Fourth with **52 homers** (behind Judge/61, Shohei Ohtani-LAD/58 and Cal Raleigh-SEA/53)
- Fourth with **83 XBH** (behind Judge/100, Ohtani/97 and Bobby Witt Jr.-KC/88)
- Fourth with **.583 SLG** (behind Judge/.747, Ohtani/.635 and Ketel Marte-AZ/.614)
- Fourth with **354 TB** (behind Judge/427), Ohtani/410 and Witt Jr./355)

GENO COMBINES FOR MLB HISTORY: For the first time in MLB history, there are 5 players with 30+ homers at the All-Star break [h/t Bob Nightengale]:

- Cal Raleigh/SEA 38
- Aaron Judge/NYY.....35
- Shohei Ohtani/LAD32
- Eugenio Suarez/AZ31**
- Kyle Schwarber/PHI.....30

MERRILL THE MAINSTAY: **Merrill Kelly**, in games following a loss, is 4-1 with a 2.75 ERA (18 ER in 59.0 IP), opponent .198 AVG and 1.02 WHIP over 10 starts.

- In his last start on July 8 @ Padres, tossed 7.0 innings of 1-run, 4-hit ball with 0 walks and 4 strikeouts...took the loss in the 1-0 affair, surrendering a solo homer to Luis Arráez (Bot 7)...it was just the second time in the Majors this season a starting pitcher worked 7.0+ innings with 77 or fewer pitches (also: José Soriano/LAA on March 29 @ White Sox, 7.0 IP, 73 pitches).

SNAKEBITES: **Josh Naylor** has hit safely in 6 straight games vs. AL West and reached base safely in 12 of his last 13, hitting .383 (18-for-47)/.473 OBP/.702 SLG/1.175 OPS with 3 doubles, 4 homers, 13 RBI and 8 walks (6 K).

- **Corbin Carroll** has hit in 8 straight road games, since June 8, at a .300 clip (9-for-30)/1.039 OPS, 3 doubles, 2 triples, 1 homer, 4 RBI, 5 walks and 1 HBP.
- **Geraldo Perdomo**, since July 1, has reached base safely in 11 of his 12 games (.436 OBP) with 2 doubles, 1 homer, 7 RBI, 9 walks (8 K) and 2 hit-by-pitches.

GRICHUK AT THE BIG A: **Randal Grichuk**, as an opponent @ Angel Stadium, is a career .308 hitter (16-for-52)/.654 SLG/.999 OPS with 3 doubles, 5 homers, 11 RBI and 3 walks over 16 games.

- His .654 SLG and .999 OPS @ Angels ranks sixth and eighth respectively among all players since 2016 (min. 15 G).

HOMERS RECENTLY AND ON THE ROAD: The D-backs' 39 home runs (23 G) since June 19 are tied for third in the Majors with the Yankees, behind the Cubs (41) and Mariners (40).

- On the road, the D-backs' 72 home runs are third in the Majors, behind the Cubs (83) and Mariners (74).
- It is the fourth time in franchise history with 70+ road homers within the first 100 games of a season (also: franchise-high 93 HR in 2019, 70 HR in 2001 and 70 HR in 1999).

VS. ANGELS: **Randal Grichuk**, in his last 7 games, is hitting .417 (10-for-24)/.462 OBP/1.000 SLG/1.462 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 triple, 3 homers, 6 RBI and 2 walks.

- **Josh Naylor**, in his last 14 games, is hitting .313 (15-for-48)/1.122 OPS with 1 double, 6 homers, 15 RBI, 9 walks (8 K) and 2 stolen bases.
- **Corbin Carroll** has reached safely in 4 of his 5 career games (.850 OPS) with 2 doubles, 1 triple, 1 RBI, 2 walks (0 K) and 1 stolen base.

CALL TO THE 'PEN: D-backs relievers, in their last 9 games since July 4, boast a MLB-best 2.25 ERA (7 ER in 28.0 IP).

- Among all bullpens since June 30 (13 G), the D-backs are the only relief staff to surrender only 1 homer in the span.

ON DECK - ST. LOUIS CARDINALS: Following the All-Star break, the D-backs will take on the Cardinals for a 3-game home weekend series (July 18-20).

- In their first series @ Cardinals (May 23-25), the D-backs fell in 3 straight 1-run affairs.

- Ranks among primary third basemen in homers (1st, 31), OPS (1st, .886), SLG (1st, .568), RBI (1st, 77), XBH (1st, 48) and total bases (1st, 196).
- Since July 1, 2024, his 146 RBI lead MLB, ahead of Aaron Judge/NYY (143).
- Since 2017, his 269 homers are the fourth-most in MLB, behind only Aaron Judge (346), Kyle Schwarber (298) and Matt Olson (276).
- The D-backs are 7-4 in the last 11 games he hits a home run.
- Hit his 30th home run on July 12 @ Angels to become the second D-back with 30+ home runs before the All-Star Break, joining Luis Gonzalez in 2001 (35 HR in 87 G)...he joins Luis Gonzalez (2001) as the only D-backs with 30+ home runs in the team’s first 96 games.
- Had his 20th career multi-homer game on July 12 @ Angels.
- In his last 12 games vs. AL West opponents, is batting .404 (19-for-47)/1.312 OPS with 1 double, 7 homers, 11 RBI and 3 walks.
- Has homered 7 times in his last 9 games vs. AL West opponents (.444 AVG).
- In his last 10 road games, is batting .333 (12-for-36)/1.279 OPS with 2 doubles, 6 homers, 9 RBI, 2 walks and 2 hit-by-pitches.
- Recorded his 900th career RBI on June 30 vs. Giants (on solo homer).
- Hit his 250th career double on June 28 vs. Marlins
