**BIRDLAND BITES:** The Orioles defeated the Royals yesterday, 8-1, setting up their second rubber match of the season this afternoon...The Birds continue their six-game road trip this afternoon through Kansas City (1-1, 1 to play) and Arizona (3 to play) before enjoying their second off-day of the season on April 10.

⚾ After hitting third yesterday, **Cedric Mullins** became the first MLB player since at least 1901 to start in seven different spots in the batting order within a team's first nine games of a season (*OptaSTATS*)...He has yet to start in the two or eight hole entering play today.

⚾ The O's tallied two triples yesterday (Holliday/ O'Neill) for the first time since July 31, 2024 vs. Toronto (Henderson/ Mountcastle)...It marked the second straight season the O's have tallied two triples in a game at Kauffman Stadium, having done so on April 21, 2024 (Santander/ Westburg).

⚾ Baltimore's seven-run victory was its largest over Kansas City at Kauffman Stadium since a 14-2 win on August 30, 2019.

⚾ The Birds have registered one home run or fewer in six straight games (1 HR overall), marking their longest run since September 13-19, 2024 (also 6 G)...They last went seven straight games with one homer or fewer from September 20 to October 1, 2023 (11 G).

⚾ The Orioles have not recorded a save through the first nine games of the season for the first time since 2002 (12 G)...The Athletics are the only other club in the majors that have yet to tally a save (also 9 G).

⚾ With a win today, Baltimore would improve to 7-0-2 in its last nine series vs. Kansas City... The O's last series defeat against the Royals came from August 30 to September 1, 2019... The current streak of eight straight series without a loss vs. Kansas City is tied for the second-longest run in franchise history (since 1954) behind a 13-series run from 2004-10.

**KNOCK(S) ON WOOD:** The Birds have recorded 83 hits, ranking third in the majors behind the Cubs (98 H) and Yankees (84 H)...The 83 hits are the most by a Baltimore club through nine game since the 2016 O's (86 H).

⚾ **Tyler O'Neill** is one of eight players in the AL with two games of three or more hits...Of the eight, six reside in the AL East (BOS' Wilyer Abreu, NYY's Paul Goldschmidt/Aaron Judge, TB's Jake Mangum, and TOR's Bo Bichette).

**OFF AND RUNNING:** **Adley Rutschman** has reached base safely in each of his first eight games, the longest season-opening streak by an Oriole since **Anthony Santander** (18 G) from April 8-27, 2022...**Aaron Hicks** reached base safely in each of his first 12 games from May 31 to June 14, 2023, but did not sign with the club until May 30 that season.

⚾ He is 16-for-45 (.356) with five doubles, one home run, and six RBI in 11 career games at Kauffman Stadium.

**SOUTHPAW SUCCESS:** Since 2024, **Tyler O'Neill's** 1.149 OPS against left-handed pitching ranks third in MLB behind NYY's Aaron Judge (1.318) and SF's Heliot Ramos (1.170)...During the same time frame, **Adley Rutschman** (.324, 55-for-170), **Ryan Mountcastle** (.312, 44-for-141), and O'Neill (.311, 42-for-135), rank eighth, 11<sup>th</sup>, and 12<sup>th</sup> respectively in batting average against lefties among AL batters.

**ROYAL FLUSH:** **Ryan Mountcastle** has reached base safely in 15 of his last 18 games opposite Kansas City since May 8, 2022, batting .311 (23-for-74) with eight doubles, four home runs, and 17 RBI during that period.

⚾ **Ramón Urías** is a career .316 (18-for-57) hitter with five doubles and 16 RBI in 18 games against Kansas City, with 12 of the RBI coming at Kauffman Stadium.

**SHAKE AND BAKE:** **Bryan Baker** has tossed 5.1 scoreless innings to open the season, scattering three hits with no walks and seven strikeouts across five appearances.

⚾ **Gregory Soto** has thrown 4.0 scoreless innings over his first four appearances, allowing two hits, two walks, and one hit batter while fanning eight...In 24 appearances since August 8, 2024, Soto is 1-0 with a 0.89 ERA (2 ER/20.1 IP), 0.93 WHIP, and 28 strikeouts.

**FOLLOW THE LEADER:** In Baltimore's four wins this season, **Cedric Mullins** is 7-for-16 (.438) with one double, two home runs, 10 RBI, five runs, two walks, one steal, and one hit-by-pitch... In the O's five losses, he is 3-for-16 (.188) with one double and one home run.

**ON THE ROAD AGAIN:** Baltimore is an MLB-best 102-66 (.607) on the road since 2023, ahead of Los Angeles-NL (96-70, .578) and Houston (94-69, .577).

⚾ **Cedric Mullins** has reached base safely in 10 straight road games since September 25, 2024, going 14-for-36 (.389) with two doubles, two home runs, and six RBI in that time... It is tied for the third-longest streak of his career.

⚾ **Ryan O'Hearn** has reached base safely in eight straight road games since September 27, 2024, batting .393 (11-for-28) with two doubles, two home runs, and four RBI during that stretch.

**RISPY BUISNESS:** The O's are batting .362 (17-for-47) with runners in scoring position in their four wins, compared to .136 (3-for-22) in their five losses...**Cedric Mullins** paces the club with a .625 (5-for-8) RISP average.

⚾ O's pitching has limited the opposition to a .205 (16-for-78) clip with RISP, the second-lowest mark in the AL behind the Rangers (.197, 15-for-76) and sixth lowest in MLB.

**SMALL SAMPLE:** Oriole batters have a 11.7 percent barrel rate, the third-highest mark in the majors behind the Yankees (17.7%) and the Mets (12.4%)...Their 24.3 whiff rate is fifth lowest in MLB behind the Padres (21.5%), Royals (22.1%), Cardinals (23.2%), and Diamondbacks (24.2%).

⚾ O's pitching has produced a 30.8 percent chase rate, the fourth-highest mark in the majors behind Diamondbacks (32.9%), Rays (32.8%), and Phillies (32.5%)...Baltimore also owns a 63.5 percent first pitch strike rate, the fifth-best mark in the AL and eighth best in MLB.

**THE SKIPPER:** Manager **Brandon Hyde** moved into sole possession of fourth place in Orioles history with his 408<sup>th</sup> win on March 29 at Toronto...The victory broke a tie with **Hank Bauer**...The 2023 AL Manager of the Year trails **Earl Weaver** (1,480), **Buck Showalter** (669), and **Paul Richards** (517).

**CITY OF FOUNTAINS:** The Orioles and Royals conclude a three-game set this afternoon at Kaufman Stadium...The clubs will meet for a three-game series in Baltimore from May 2-4...The O's won the 2024 season set, 4-2, and have taken each of the last four series sets since 2021, going 18-10 (.643) during that stretch.

<b>April 6, 1992</b> - Oriole Park at Camden Yards opens to rave reviews, changing the face of baseball parks forever. Rick Sutcliffe tosses a five-hit shutout as the Orioles down the Cleveland Indians, 2-0, in two hours and two minutes. Chris Hoiles doubles home one run and Bill Ripken squeezes home the other run in front of 44,568 fans. The Orioles become the first team since the San Francisco Giants in 1958 to christen a new ballpark with a shutout.

**QUICK HITS:** Set to make his second start of the season and the 18<sup>th</sup> of his career... Became the first Oriole pitcher to make his major league in 2024 when he started on June 6 at Toronto...Became the first Oriole to throw at least 100 pitches in his MLB debut since Wei-Yin Chen on April 10, 2012 vs. New York-AL and the third MLB player to do so since the start of 2019, along with Chicago-AL's Dylan Cease on July 3, 2019 (G1) vs. Detroit (101) and Cincinnati's Andrew Abbott on June 5, 2023 vs. Milwaukee (105)...On June 12, 2024 vs. Atlanta, became the 11<sup>th</sup> Oriole in team history to throw at least 6.0 scoreless innings in his first career MLB home start and first since Mike Wright Jr. on May 17, 2015 vs. Los Angeles-AL (7.1 IP)...At 24 years, 61 days old, became the youngest O's left-hander to toss 6.0+ shutout frames since Zack Britton (23-249) on August 28, 2011 (G1) vs. New York-AL (7.0 IP)...On September 3 vs. Chicago-AL, he became the second-youngest Oriole (24-144) with 10 strikeouts and no walks in a game behind Dennis Martinez (24-081) on August 3, 1978 vs. Milwaukee and the youngest to do so in a nine-inning game...Acquired by the Orioles along with RHP Yennier Cano, LHP Juan Rojas, and RHP Juan Núñez from the Minnesota Twins in exchange for RHP Jorge López and cash considerations on August 2, 2022...Originally selected by the Minnesota Twins in the third round (No. 98 overall) of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Nebraska.

**AGAINST THE ROYALS:** Will be facing the Royals for the first time in his major league career...Marks the 13<sup>th</sup> different team he has faced in his career...After today's start, he will have faced all five teams in the AL Central.

**AGAINST THE AL CENTRAL:** He is 2-2 with a 2.20 ERA (7 ER/28.2 IP) in five career starts against the division...Last faced a divisional opponent on September 27, 2024 at Minnesota, allowing two hits and a walk with two strikeouts in 5.2 scoreless innings.

**DAY AND NIGHT:** Povich was 0-4 with a 9.15 ERA (21 ER/20.2 IP) with 17 walks (1 IBB) and 19 strikeouts in five day starts last season...He went 3-5 with a 3.81 ERA (25 ER/59.0 IP) with 17 walks and 50 strikeouts in 11 night starts in 2024.

**FOREVER YOUNG:** At 24 years, 359 days old, he is currently the youngest pitcher on the O's and the third-youngest player overall behind Jackson Holliday (21-123) and Gunnar Henderson (23-281).

**GRAPEFRUIT LEAGUE:** Povich went 2-1 with a 3.07 ERA (5 ER/14.2 IP) with nine hits (1 HR), four walks, and 15 strikeouts in four starts in Spring Training...In his last outing on March 18 vs. Toronto, working 5.0 no-hit innings with three walks and six strikeouts... Retired 15 of the final 16 batters faced after walking the first two batters of the game.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Made his first home start of the season on April 2 against Boston...Suffered the loss after allowing three runs on eight hits with five strikeouts in 6.0 innings... Recorded his second quality start of the season...No other Oriole has one entering today.

**VS. ARIZONA:** Is set to face the Diamondbacks for the sixth time (5 GS)...Has gone 0-2 with a 3.18 ERA (10 ER/28.1 IP) in the five previous outings...Last faced the club on June 28, 2023 at Chase Field as a member of the Tampa Bay Rays, allowing two earned runs on seven hits with seven strikeouts in 7.0 innings...Has only walked two batters in 28.1 IP against Arizona, and his 0.64 BB/9 against the club is the second lowest he's produced against any opponent in his career (min. 25.0 IP).
