ST. LOUIS CARDINALS (14-12) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (12-13)

May 1, 2021 at PNC Park, Pittsburgh, PA -- GAME #26/HOME #11

RHP JACK FLAHERTY (4-0, 3.18 ERA) vs. RHP TREVOR CAHILL (1-2, 7.11 ERA)

THE PIRATES... have lost back-to-back games after winning a season-high three in a row and four-of-five...Have won six of their last 10 games and nine of their last 15...Have gone 11-7 in their last 18 games after losing six in a row...Were 7-18 after 25 games in 2020 (7-19 after 26).

SAVING THE BEST FOR LAST: The Pirates were scored upon in the ninth inning last night for the first time this season - the last MLB team to give up a run in the final frame...The Bucco pitchers have combined to post a .078 (4-for-51) batting average against in the ninth inning and their 1.97 ERA (64.0ip/14er) in the seventh inning and later is the fourth-best in the Majors behind the Mets (1.71), Yankees (1.76) and Padres (1.95).

INHERITENCE: Among the 31 inherited runners for the Pittsburgh bullpen this season, only six have scored (19.4%)...That percentage rate is the second-best among National League pens behind the Padres (6-of-32, 18.8) and the fifth-best among all Major League teams behind the Yankees (14.8), Rangers (16.7), Padres and Royals (19.1)...**Sam Howard** is one of three National League pitchers who has inherited at least seven runners without having any score.

BUCS AT HOME: The Pirates have gone 1-2 on this five-game homestand against the Missouri teams after splitting two games with the Royals Tuesday and Wednesday and dropping the opener of this series with the Cardinals Friday night...The Bucs have gone 5-5 at home so far this season.

THOSE PESKY BIRDS: The Bucs have lost five straight games to the Cardinals at PNC Park since winning the first meeting last season on 9/17...Dating back to August 4, 2018, the Pirates have gone 2-15 against the Redbirds at PNC Park and are seeking their first winning series on their home turf since sweeping a three-game series in 2018 from April 27-29.

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The Pirates have gone 4-0-2 in their last six series after dropping their first two...This marks the first time since July 9-August 1, 2018, in which the Bucs have posted six straight non-losing series (also 4-0-2 in that stretch).

CAPTAIN REDBEARD: **Colin Moran** leads the team in RBI (17) and shares the team lead in home runs (4)...His 16 RBI from the fourth spot of the lineup rank second behind Arizona's David Peralta (19) for the most among all MLB players and his 16 RBI as a first baseman are tied for fourth among N.L. players at that position...In addition, Moran is hitting .348 (8-for-23) with runners in scoring position and .455 (5-for-11) with RISP and two outs.

HISTORY MAKER: **Richard Rodríguez** has made six straight hitless outings (7.0ip) and has surrendered just one hit overall in his first 10 appearances (10.1ip)...According to the Elias Sports Bureau, Rodríguez is the first pitcher in Pirates history to allow no more than one hit over his first 10 appearances of a season.

HOWARD THE BUC: Lefty **Sam Howard** has made nine consecutive scoreless appearances (7.0ip) while striking out nine batters in that time...He has limited left-handed batters to a .111 (2-for-18) average and has also stranded all seven of his inherited runners...In 35 career games with the Pirates, Howard has gone 4-4 with a 3.19 ERA (31.0ip/11er) and 41 strikeouts.

HOT ROD: Dating back to June 1, 2019, **Richard Rodríguez** has produced a 2.11 ERA (76.2ip/18er) in his 80 games - that is the lowest ERA in the Majors among all relief pitchers with at least 75 appearances...Rodríguez has allowed just two baserunners (one hit and one walk) in his first nine outings this season (32 at bats) and has made 21 consecutive scoreless appearances (21.0ip) dating back to August 30 of last season.

PINCH ME: The Pirates lead the Majors with 12 pinch-hits this season, having gone a collective 12-for-40 (.300) with a home run and four RBI...**Wilmer Difo** leads all big league players with five hits off the bench, going 5-for-13 as a pinch hitter while collecting three of Pittsburgh's four pinch-hit RBI.

PEN PALS: **David Bednar** has made eight straight scoreless appearances (6.2ip) and has been scored upon once in his first 11 outings...**Kyle Crick** has allowed one hit in his first nine games (25 at bats) and **Sam Howard** has made nine straight scoreless outings (7.0ip) while stranding all seven of his inherited runners this season.

HOME RUNS AT PNC PARK: **Gregory Polanco** is tied with **Craig Wilson** for fifth place on the all-time list with 47 regular season home runs hit at PNC Park...**Garrett Jones** is fourth with 51, **Jason Bay** is third with 61, **Pedro Alvarez** is second with 62 and **Andrew McCutchen** is the leader with 92.

SHELTY'S CREW: Manager **Derek Shelton** and his entire 2020 coaching staff have returned for a second season in 2021...**Christian Marrero** has joined the staff as Assistant Hitting Coach...Returning coaches include **Tarrik Brock** (First Base), **Joey Cora** (Third Base), **Rick Eckstein** (Hitting), **Don Kelly** (Bench), **Oscar Marin** (Pitching), **Justin Meccage** (Bullpen), **Mike Rabelo** (Field Coordinator) and **Glenn Sherlock**...Catching coaches **Herbie Andrade** and **Jordan Comadena** have returned.

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

May 1, 1994: The Pirates completed a three game sweep of the Braves as Paul Wagner defeated Atlanta's Tom Glavine for his second career complete game in front of 30,614 fans at Three Rivers Stadium. Wagner, who went 2-for-4 with two RBI at the plate in the 4-1 victory, allowed just three hits while losing his shutout bid in the ninth inning on a home run by David Justice.
