AT A GLANCE: The Yankees continue their seven-game homestand tonight with the first game of a three-game set vs. Tampa Bay (through Sun)...are 2-2 on the homestand after splitting a four-game series vs. Toronto...following this series, will embark on a six-game road trip, featuring three-game sets at Kansas City (Mon.-Wed.) and the Athletics (5/29-31).

- **Their 30-21 (.588) record is the second-best in the American League and the sixth-best record in the Majors.**
- **Are 20-12 in their last 32 games (since 4/17), 21-13 in their last 34 games (since 4/15) and 22-14 in their last 36 games (since 4/13).**
- Are in a stretch of playing 26 games in 27 days (5/1-27).
- Have won or split eight of their last 11 series and 11 of their 16 series this season.
- The Yankees' +67 run differential this season is the best in the AL and the fourth-best in the Majors.

YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Yankees fell to the Blue Jays, 2-0, in their series finale on Thursday at Yankee Stadium...**LHP Carlos Rodón** (5.0IP, 3H, 1R/ER, 3BB, 7K, OHR) started and suffered his second loss of the season despite allowing only 1R/ER in 5.0IP...**Yankees batters** were shut out for the fifth time this season...**3B Ryan McMahon** (1-for-3, 1 double) recorded the Yankees' only extra-base hit...**DH Ben Rice** (1-for-4) and **CF Spencer Jones** (1-for-3, 1SB) were the only other Yankees to record hits...**LF Cody Bellinger** (0-for-2, 2BB) was the only Yankee to reach base multiple times...**LHP Brent Headrick** (1.0IP, 1K) tossed a scoreless inning of relief and stranded his two inherited runners...**RHP Camilo Doval** (0.2IP, 1H, 1R/ER, 1HR) allowed a solo HR in the seventh inning...**RHP Paul Blackburn** (2.0IP, 2H, 2K) tossed 2.0 scoreless innings of relief.

CLOSE CALLS: Each of the Yankees' last five games (since 5/17) and eight of their last 12 games (since 5/9) have been decided by 2R-or-fewer...13 of the Yankees' 21 losses have been decided by 2R-or-fewer, with 11 of those losses being one-run games.

RICE RICE BABY: C/INF Ben Rice has hit .288/.385/.644 (47-for-163) with 36R, 10 doubles, 16HR, 33RBI, 25BB/21BB, 2HP, 2SF and 2SB in 46 games this season...has reached base safely in 35-of-42 starts.

- Has hit 3HR in his last seven games (since 5/15), 4HR in his last 10 games (since 5/11), 6HR in his last 16 games (since 5/1), 8HR in his last 22 games (since 4/24) and 12HR in his last 29 games (since 4/16).
- Seven of his 16HR this year have given the Yankees the lead, including four of his last 5HR and five of his last 7HR.
- 26 of his 47H this season have been extra-base hits (10 doubles, 16HR).
- Has hit 8HR in his last 19 games vs. AL East opponents (since 9/21/25).

DYNAMIC DUO: OF Aaron Judge (16HR) and C/INF Ben Rice (16HR) are only the third pair of Yankees teammates in franchise history to each hit at least 16HR in the club's first 51 games of a season, joining Yogi Berra (16HR) and Mickey Mantle (21HR) in 1956, and Lou Gehrig (17HR) and Babe Ruth (21HR) in 1930...**are only the third pair of Major League teammates in the last 25 seasons (since 2002) to accomplish the feat,** joining Boston's Mookie Betts (17HR) and J.D. Martinez (16HR) in 2018 and Philadelphia's Ryan Howard (16HR) and Raúl Ibañez (19HR) in 2009.

GOOD AS GOLD: INF Paul Goldschmidt has hit .333/.419/.648 (18-for-54) with 10R, 3 doubles, 1 triple, 4HR, 11RBI, 6BB and 2HP over his last 17 games (since 4/26).

- Has hit 3HR in his last six starts (since 5/9) and 4HR in his last nine starts (since 5/5).
- Has hit .500/.684/.917 (6-for-12) with 2 doubles, 1HR, 10RBI, 5BB and 2HP with RISP this season...as a Yankee (since 2025), has hit .331/.428/.446 (40-for-121) with 8 doubles, 2HR, 44RBI, 19BB/51BB, 3HP and 2SF with RISP.

HOME SWEET HOME: The Yankees have gone 11-3 in their last 14 home games (since 4/17)...have gone 16-8 (.667) at home this season, tied with Atlanta (16-8, .667) for the third-best home record in the Majors, trailing only Tampa Bay (19-5, .792) and Chicago-NL (18-8, .692)...have lost back-to-back home games for only the second time this season (also 4/8-9).

PEN PAL: LHP Brent Headrick tossed a scoreless inning of relief and stranded his two inherited runners on Thursday vs. Toronto...**has stranded 17 of his 20 inherited runners this season.**

- Has not allowed a run in 19 of his 25 appearances this year, posting a 2.10 ERA (25.2IP, 6ER) and 29K over that span.

COLE TRAIN: RHP Gerrit Cole will make his season debut in tonight's series opener vs. Tampa Bay and his first Major League start since 2024 World Series Game 5 vs. the Dodgers...missed the first 51 games of this season and the entire 2025 season recovering from "Tommy John" surgery...made only one spring training start in 2025 before undergoing "Tommy John" surgery on 3/11/25...the procedure was performed by Dr. Neal ElAttrache at Cedars-Sinai Kerlan-Jobe Institute in Los Angeles, Calif.

- Made six combined rehab starts with High-A Hudson Valley, Double-A Somerset and Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, going 0-2 with a 4.66 ERA (29.0IP, 28H, 17R/15ER, 3BB, 28K, 6HR)...made his final rehab start with Scranton/WB on 5/16 vs. Syracuse and allowed only 1R/ER in 5.1IP (ND, 6H, 1BB, 6K, OHR).
- In 317 starts across 12 Major League seasons with the Pittsburgh Pirates (2013-17), Houston Astros (2018-19) and New York Yankees (2020-24), is 153-80 with a 3.18 ERA (1,954.0IP, 1,627H, 740R/690ER, 500BB, 2,251K, 217HR)...the six-time All-Star (2015, '18-19, '21-23) was unanimously named the 2023 American League Cy Young Award winner and has finished in the top-five of Cy Young Award voting six times (first in 2023, second in 2019 and 2021, fourth in 2015 and 2020, and fifth in 2018).
- Since 2018, is tied for first in the Majors in shutouts (five), ranks second in strikeouts (1,517), winning percentage (.712, min. 70 decisions), WHIP (1.00) and opponents' OBP (.260), third in wins (94), ERA (2.97), opponents' OPS (.615), complete games (seven) and WAR among pitchers (30.5 - FanGraphs), fourth in K/9.0IP (11.65) and opponents' BA (.205), fifth in K/BB (5.11) and ninth in opponents' SLG (.355).
- In 125 starts with the Yankees, is 59-28 with a 3.12 ERA (759.0IP, 263ER) and 915K...has allowed 3ER-or-fewer in 98-of-125 starts, the ninth-most in the AL in that span...has allowed 2ER-or-fewer in 86 starts as a Yankee, the seventh-most in the AL...has recorded 24 scoreless starts as a Yankee, tied for the seventh-most scoreless starts by any AL pitcher in that span.

ALL THAT JAZZ: INF Jazz Chisholm Jr. has recorded multiple hits in five of his last seven games (since 5/15)...is batting .433/.500/.633 (13-for-30) with 5R, 3 doubles, 1HR, 4RBI, 4BB and 1SB over his last eight games (since 5/13).

ALL RISE: OF Aaron Judge has reached base safely in each of his last 23 games vs. Tampa Bay (since 4/21/24)...his 23-game on-base streak marks his fifth-longest vs. a single opponent in his career, trailing only a 32-game streak vs. Baltimore from 9/3/16-9/22/18, his 28-game streak vs. Baltimore from 5/2/24-5/12/26, a 24-game streak vs. Minnesota from 9/18/17-9/8/22 and a 24-game streak vs. Tampa Bay from 7/27/17-9/26/18.

- 24 of his 46H this season have been XBH (8 doubles, 16HR).
- Has hit .321/.525/.750 (9-for-28) with 4HR, 15RBI, 11BB/51BB and 1HP with RISP this season.

SAVED BY THE BELL: INF/OF Cody Bellinger walked twice on Thursday vs. Toronto and was the only Yankee to reach base multiple times...had his 16-game home hitting streak snapped on Thursday...was the longest home hitting streak by a Yankee since Gleyber Torres' 16-game home hitting streak from 8/16-9/19/18...batted .441/.521/.915 (26-for-59) with 14R, 9 doubles, 2 triples, 5HR, 20RBI, 11BB, 15B and 15F over that span.

- Has hit safely in 20-of-23 home games this year, batting .366/.471/.756 (30-for-82) with 18R, 10 doubles, 2 triples, 6HR, 24RBI, 18BB, 2SF and 1SB.
- Has hit .341/.412/.537 (14-for-41) with 4 doubles, 2 triples, 20RBI, 7BB and 3SF with RISP this season.
- According to FanGraphs and Sports Info Solutions, leads all Major League LF in DRS (nine)...is tied for eighth in the Majors in go-ahead RBI (nine, tied for fourth in AL) and tied for 10th in walks (34, seventh in AL).

FOR STARTERS: Yankees starters have posted a 3.22 ERA (276.2IP, 99ER) and 280K in 51 starts this season...**have allowed 3R-or-fewer in 43 of their 51 starts this season, tied with Milwaukee for the most in the Majors...also marks their second-most in franchise history through their first 51 games of a season,** trailing only their 46 starts in 2022.

► **Lead the Majors in opponents' SLG (.323), opponents' OPS (.607) and HR/9.0IP (0.75),** rank third in strikeouts (280, second in AL), strikeout rate (24.8%, second in AL) and opponents' OBP (.285, second in AL), fifth in ERA (3.22, second in AL), WHIP (1.12, second in AL), opponents' BA (.214, second in AL), K/9.0IP (9.11, second in AL) and innings pitched (276.2, third in AL), sixth in K/BB (3.08, third in AL) and eighth in BB/9.0IP (2.96, fourth in AL).

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER: RHP GERRIT COLE (SEASON DEBUT)

RHP Gerrit Cole will make his season debut in tonight's series opener vs. Tampa Bay...the 35-year-old will pitch on extended five days' rest after making his final rehab appearance with Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre on Saturday vs. Syracuse (ND, 5.1IP, 6H, 1R/ER, 1BB, 6K, 0HR)...missed the entire 2025 season and the first 51 games of this season recovering from "Tommy John" surgery...will mark his first Major League game since 2024 World Series Game 5 vs. the Dodgers...the six-time All-Star (2015, '18-19, '21-23) was unanimously named the 2023 American League Cy Young Award winner and has finished in the top-five of Cy Young Award voting six times (first in 2023, second in 2019 and 2021, fourth in 2015 and 2020, and fifth in 2018)...his career 10.37 K/9.0IP ratio (2,251K/1,954.0IP) is the 10th-highest in Major League history (min. 1,000.0IP)...in 125 starts with the Yankees, is 59-28 with a 3.12 ERA (759.0IP, 263ER) and 915K...since 2018, is tied for first in the Majors in shutouts (five), ranks second in strikeouts (1,517), winning percentage (.712, min. 70 decisions), WHIP (1.00) and opponents' OBP (.260), third in wins (94), ERA (2.97), opponents' OPS (.615), complete games (seven) and WAR among pitchers (30.5 – FanGraphs), fourth in K/9.0IP (11.65) and opponents' BA (.205), fifth in K/BB (5.11) and ninth in opponents' SLG (.355)...is the first Yankee in franchise history to record at least 200K in three different seasons...owns two of the Yankees' top three single-season strikeout records and three of the top-eight records (his 257K in 2022 are the most in franchise history, his 243K in 2021 are the third-most in franchise history and his 222K in 2023 are tied for the seventh-most in Yankees history)...was originally selected by the Yankees in the first round (28th overall) of the 2008 First-Year Player Draft but did not sign and went on to play at UCLA for three seasons (2009-11)...was the first overall pick of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft, the 15th pitcher (and 11th right-hander) to be chosen first...is the fifth player selected first overall to play for the Yankees, joining Alex Rodriguez, Darryl Strawberry, Tim Lincecum and Ron Blomberg...signed a nine-year contract extending through the 2028 season with a player opt-out following the 2024 season on 12/18/19.

ROAD TO RECOVERY: Will make his first Major League start since 2024 World Series Game 5 vs. the Dodgers...missed the first 51 games of this season and the entire 2025 season recovering from "Tommy John" surgery...made only one spring training start in 2025 before undergoing "Tommy John" surgery on 3/11/25...the procedure was performed by Dr. Neal ElAttrache at Cedars-Sinai Kerlan-Jobe Institute in Los Angeles, Calif.

- ✦ Made six combined rehab starts with High-A Hudson Valley, Double-A Somerset and Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, going 0-2 with a 4.66 ERA (29.0IP, 28H, 17R/15ER, 3BB, 28K, 6HR)...made his final rehab start with Scranton/WB on 5/16 vs. Syracuse and allowed only 1R/ER in 5.1IP (ND, 6H, 1BB, 6K, 0HR).

2024: Went 8-5 with a 3.41 ERA (95.0IP, 36ER) in 17 starts with the Yankees in 2024...missed the first 75 games of the season on the 60-day injured list with right elbow inflammation...allowed 2R-or-fewer in 12 of his 17 starts, including 10 of his final 13 starts (7/12-9/26) and 11 of his final 15 starts (6/30-9/26)...allowed 1ER-or-fewer in seven of his final nine starts (8/10-G2-9/26), nine of his final 13 starts (7/12-9/26) and 10 of his final 15 starts (6/30-9/26).

- ✦ Went 7-4 with a 2.67 ERA (77.2IP, 23ER) and 80K in his final 13 starts from 7/12-9/26...was 5-3 with a 2.25 ERA (60.0IP, 15ER) and 61K over his final 10 starts of the season from 8/4-9/26.
- ✦ Allowed 19 of his 38R and seven of his 11HR in three of his starts: 6R/4HR on 6/25 at the Mets, 6R/3HR on 7/24 vs. the Mets and 7R/0HR on 9/14 vs. Boston...in his 14 other starts, went 8-2 with a 1.89 ERA (81.0IP, 17ER) and 93K.
- ✦ Went 1-0 with a 2.17 ERA (29.0IP, 27H, 13R/7ER, 10BB, 22K, 1HR) in five postseason starts...allowed 3ER-or-fewer in each of those five starts and 2ER-or-fewer in four of those starts.

IN PINSTRIPE: In 125 starts with the Yankees, is 59-28 with a 3.12 ERA (759.0IP, 263ER) and 915K...has allowed 3ER-or-fewer in 98-of-125 starts, the ninth-most in the AL in that span...has allowed 2ER-or-fewer in 86 starts as a Yankee, the seventh-most in the AL...has recorded 24 scoreless starts as a Yankee, tied for the seventh-most scoreless starts by any AL pitcher in that span.

- ✦ Since 2020, leads the Majors in opponents' OBP (.264), ranks third in WHIP (1.03, second in AL), third in K/9.0IP (10.85, first in AL), fourth in opponents' BA (.212, first in AL) and K/BB (4.95, third in AL), fifth in winning percentage (.678, first in AL, min. 60 decisions) and ERA (3.12, second in AL, min. 700.0IP), and sixth in opponents' OPS (.629, second in AL).
