RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals continue their seven-game road trip with the finale of a three-game series with the Miami Marlins...St. Louis won 2-of-3 at Wrigley Field last weekend and is 3-2 after splitting the first two games of this series, both one-run extra inning affairs...St. Louis is 1-1 on Juneteenth since 2021 when this day was first recognized as an official federal holiday...The Cardinals won 8-6 over Washington at Nationals Park in 2023, lost 6-4 to the Red Sox at Fenway Park in 2022, and were rained out in Atlanta in 2021.

MLB AT RICKWOOD FIELD: Tomorrow night, Baseball will honor and celebrate the rich and often-overlooked history of the Negro Leagues at America's oldest professional ballpark, and honor the great **Willie Mays** who sadly passed away yesterday at age 93...the Cardinals will take on the San Francisco Giants at historic Rickwood Field in Birmingham, Alabama in a game that will conclude a seven-game, three-city road trip through Chicago (2-1), Miami (1-1), and Birmingham as the Cardinals visit two of the three oldest active professional ballparks in America with games at Wrigley Field (1914) and Rickwood Field (1910)...**PLAYERS IN RICKWOOD FIELD HISTORY:** Nearly 30% of the 346 players inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame have played a game at Rickwood, including 17 notable Cardinals...Cardinals Coach **Willie McGee** played at Rickwood for the Nashville Sounds (AA-Yankees) in the early 1980s, while RHP **Riley O'Brien** (I.L.) pitched in the 2019 Rickwood Classic as a member of the Montgomery Biscuits (AA-Rays)...**Tom Alston** (Cardinals first Black player) played in a 1954 exhibition against the White Sox ... **Bill Greason** (Cardinals first black pitcher) was teammates with **Willie Mays** on the 1948 Birmingham Black Barons (NAL) that played home games at Rickwood Field...**Greason** (99 years) is the oldest living former Cardinals player.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals enter today in 2nd place in the National League Central, 6.5 games behind Milwaukee, and in position for the 2nd spot in NL Wild Card race ... Since Mother's Day (May 12), St. Louis owns MLB's 4th-best winning pct. (.636, 21-12) and they have won five of their last seven.

STAYING AFLOAT: The Cardinals moved to a game over .500 (36-35) with Monday night's win, matching their season-high water mark of one game over .500 (5-4 after play on April 6)...their low-water mark this year came after play on May 11 when they fell to 9 games under .500 at 15-24...the Cardinals have not been more than one game over .500 since concluding the 2022 season at 93-69.

BEACH BIRDS: Since the Marlins joined MLB as an expansion team in 1993, the Cardinals own the Majors' best win pct. (69-41, .627) of any team to visit Miami, while their .632 win pct. (24-14) at loan Depot park since it opened in 2012 trails Tampa Bay (24-7, .774) and Atlanta (69-36, .657) among annual visitors ... St. Louis also owned the best winning percentage at Sun Life Stadium (.625, 45-27) for teams who played in Miami every season from 1993-2011.

FISH FRY: The Cardinals all-time .605 win pct. (135-88) vs. the Marlins (1993-present) is their 2nd-highest against any opponent behind only the Diamondbacks (.612, 109-69), and is the best of any National League team since Florida/Miami joined MLB as an expansion team in 1993.

DEEP SEA FISHING: Monday night's win in 12 innings was the Cardinals longest of the season in both innings and time of game (3:38)...it matched the Cardinals 2nd longest extra inning game since MLB instituted the new extra inning rules in 2020...last night was the 2nd longest game by the Cardinals while playing on the road against the Marlins, but still far from matching the 20-inning game the two teams staged on 4/27/03 at Sun Life Stadium...the Cardinals are 5-2 all-time in extra inning road games against the Marlins. **EXTRA EXTRA:** The Cardinals have played extra innings on consecutive days for the first time since April 15-16, 2023 vs. PIT...they last played extras over three consecutive days May 1-3, 2015 vs. PIT.

Miles Mikolas was born in nearby Jupiter, Fla... graduated from Jupiter (Fla.) HS and Nova Southeastern University...made MLB debut vs. the Marlins on May 5, 2012 at Petco Park (as a Padre).

Paul Goldschmidt (Jupiter), **Miles Mikolas** (Jupiter), **Jordan Walker** (Jupiter), and **Nolan Gorman** (Pompano Beach) reside in the South Florida area.

Iván Herrera caught his first MLB shutout against the Marlins, June 27, 2022 at Busch Stadium from **Adam Wainwright** (7 IP), **James Naile** (1 IP) and **Jake Woodford** (1 IP) in a 9-0 win.

Nolan Gorman won the 2017 High School Home Run Derby at Marlins Park during All-Star Week.

Josh Bell's sister, Joy, is a communications professor at Webster University in St. Louis.

Sandy Alcántara pitched in eight games for St. Louis in 2017...Originally signed with the Cardinals as an International free agent on July 2, 2013 (signed by **Moises Rodriguez**)...traded to Miami with **Daniel Castano**, **Zac Gallen**, and **Magneuris Sierra** for **Marcell Ozuna** (Dec. 14, 2017).

Skip Schumaker played eight years in St. Louis (2005-12) and was the 2022 Cardinals bench coach...member of 2011 World Series Champion Cardinals...selected by St. Louis in the 5th round of the 2001 MLB Draft...traded by St. Louis to the Dodgers for **Jake Lemmerman** (Dec 12, 2012).

Jake Burger was born in St. Louis...was a 2014 graduate of Christian Brothers College High School in St. Louis...played college baseball at Missouri State University (2015-17).

Marlins Bench Coach **Luis Urueta** played in 24 games in the 2003 Cards minor league organization.

Marlins Asst. Hitting Coach **Bill Mueller** was a Cardinals coach for parts of four seasons (2015-18)...was born in Maryland Heights, MO...graduated from De Smet Jesuit High School...attended Southwest Missouri State University in Springfield.

Marlins Asst. Hitting Coach **John Mabry** served as a Cardinals hitting coach for six seasons (2013-18) and Asst. Hitting Coach in 2012...selected in the 6th round of the 1991 MLB Draft and played parts of eight seasons in St. Louis (1994-98, 2001).

Pedro Pagés resides in Doral, Fla...graduated from Gulliver Prep High School in Miami...played college baseball at Florida Atlantic University.

Miami First Base Coach **Jon Jay** played parts of six seasons with St. Louis (2010-15), where he was a member of the 2011 World Champions with Schumaker...originally selected by the Cardinals in the 2nd round of the 2006 MLB Draft.

Father of Marlins Pitching Coach **Mel Stottlemyre Jr.**, **Mel Stottlemyre**, previously served as a Cardinals pitching coach from 1996-98...Mel Jr.'s brother, **Todd Stottlemyre**, pitched parts of three seasons with St. Louis (1996-98).

Cardinals Communications Game Day Associates Supervisor **Jacob Mayer** was a 2016 Communications Intern for the Marlins.

Since 2003, the Cardinals and Marlins have shared the Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium Complex in Jupiter, Fla. as their Spring Training site...RDCS is also the home to the Palm Beach Cardinals and Jupiter Hammerheads of the Single-A Florida State League.

- Returns from the Bereavement List (6/16-18) after his last start on June 14 at Chicago.
- Making his 15th start of the season and as a member of the Cardinals (309th career).
- Today marks his 10th career start vs. the Marlins and 5th at loanDepot Park. His two career wins vs. Miami have been in Miami. Was hit for a season-high seven runs in his first outing earlier this season on April 7 in St. Louis, but is 4-1 with a 2.93 ERA since.
- Dropped his career ERA (4.49) below 4.50 for the first time since June 17, 2023, with 7.0 scoreless innings at Wrigley Field vs. CHI (6/14) in his last start. Was his first career win against the Cubs and at Wrigley Field.
- Has not suffered a losing decision since April 13 at ARI. Tied with **Luis Gil** (NYY) and **Trevor Williams** (WSH) for active consecutive starts in MLB without a loss at 11.
- Ranks T-3rd among National League pitchers in active win streak with four, trailing only **Hunter Greene** (CIN) and **Trevor Williams** (WSH) with five.
- Held his opposition to three runs or less over his last five starts dating back to May 22, posting a 2-0 record with 2.28 ERA over 28.2 innings pitched with 30 strikeouts. ERA is 9th-best among National League pitchers since May 22.
- Held his opposition to two earned runs or less in 9-or-14 starts, tied for the most by a Cardinals starting pitcher with Sonny Gray.
- Logged 6.0+ innings pitched in each of his first seven starts to begin the season (April 1-May 6), longest by a Cardinal to begin a season since 2017 (**Mike Leake** - 11 & **Michael Wacha** - 7). Streak was snapped in his 5/22 start vs. BAL (4.0 IP).
- Since 2013, leads active Major League Baseball pitchers in grounded into double plays (215). Has allowed 213 career home runs over that period for comparison.
- Posted career-highs for innings pitched (38.0) and strikeouts (29) in the month of April. Tied his most starts with six (also 2021 w/TEX). The 38.0 innings were the 3rd-most for Gibson in any calendar month, most recently tossing 39.1 with the Twins in 2018.
- St. Louis area resident and University of Missouri Baseball alum signed with the Cardinals as a free agent last November. Is one of three free-agent starters (**Sonny Gray** & **Lance Lynn**) that the Cardinals signed last off-season.
- Pitching for his fifth Major League team: Twins (2013-19), Rangers (2020-21), Phillies (2021-22), Orioles (2023) and Cardinals (2024).

- Fired 7.0 scoreless innings of two-hit ball for a 3-0 shutout win over the Cubs at Wrigley Field. Was his first career win against the Cubs and at Wrigley Field.

- Durable starting pitcher has made 29 or more starts in eight of the last 10 seasons, the most by any MLB pitcher.
- Has worked 150+ IP (minors/majors combined) in 10-straight (2013-23) professional seasons, excluding the COVID shortened 2020 season.
- Has not allowed an earned run with **Pedro Pagés** catching behind the plate in his two starts (11.0 IP). Also has a 3.24 ERA (25.0 IP) with **Willson Contreras** behind the plate, the 5th-lowest ERA of any of the 25 catchers he has pitched with in his career. **Pagés** was the 25th catcher of his career in the game at Cincinnati on May 28.
