BIRDLAND BITES: Baltimore wraps up a seven-game homestand this weekend with a three-game series against the San Diego Padres beginning tonight...The Orioles split a four-gamer with the Seattle Mariners earlier this week after dropping the first two games Monday and Tuesday before salvaging the series with wins on Wednesday and Thursday...A stretch of 13 games in 13 days will complete on Sunday before an off day on Monday...After falling a season-high eight games under .500 on May 21, the Orioles have gone 12-8 (.600) since.

♫ **Tyler Wells** tossed 3.0 scoreless innings last night to earn his first win of the year.

♫ **Andrew Kittredge** secured his first save as an Oriole.

♫ **Pete Alonso** has homered in consecutive games for the third time this season (last: 2 G, 5/20-22)...The 439-foot two-run shot in the third inning on Thursday was his longest home run of the season.

♫ **Adley Rutschman**, who missed the first three games of this homestand, returned to the lineup by going 2-for-3 with a double, a walk, a run scored, and three RBI...He has 10 RBI in seven games this month.

♫ The O's have gone 7-for-17 with runners in scoring position over the last two games after batting .129 (4-for-31) during the four-game losing streak from June 6-9.

IN THE FIGHT: Last night, the Orioles improved to 18-16 (.529) in games decided by two runs or less...The 34 such games are tied for the seventh most in the majors...The Guardians and Royals are tied for the MLB lead this season with 39 games...Over the last 14 games since May 28, the club has gone 3-5 in games decided by two or one run.

ALEXANDER THE GREAT: **Blaze Alexander** is slashing .366/.411/.549 (30-for-82) with seven doubles, one triple, two home runs, 10 runs, 18 RBI, five walks (1 IBB), four stolen bases, and two hit-by-pitches in 34 games since May 1 after slashing .137/.228/.176 (7-for-51) in April.

♫ His batting average since May 1 is third highest in the majors (min. 75 AB) behind MIL's Andrew Vaughn (.375) and SF's Jung Hoo Lee (.374).

♫ Over his last 14 games (10 starts) at Camden Yards since May 13, he is batting .447/.500/.632 (17-for-38) with four doubles, one homer, seven runs, and 12 RBI.

HOMER HAPPY: The Birds have hit 38 home runs since May 16, tied for the MLB lead during that time with the Giants.

♫ Baltimore has hit 48 homers at Oriole Park this season, third most in the AL and tied for the fifth most in MLB at home.

PITCHING PROWESS: Oriole starters have posted a 3.27 ERA (44 ER/121.0 IP) in 22 games since May 19, the fifth-lowest mark in the majors behind the Dodgers (2.59), Nationals (2.98), Yankees (3.08), and Mariners (3.11)...The club's rotation has surrendered two runs or fewer in 13 of those games...Prior to this stretch, Baltimore starters owned a 5.24 ERA, the second-highest clip in the majors ahead of the Rockies (5.62).

CAN'T WARD HIM OFF: **Taylor Ward** ranks among MLB leaders in walks (3rd, 61), times on base (3rd, 130), and on-base percentage (4th, .410).

♫ His 15 multi-walk games are second most in the majors behind LAA's Mike Trout (18)... Last season, **Jackson Holliday** led the Orioles with nine multi-walk efforts.

♫ Over his last nine games since June 3, is slashing .394/.524/.515 (13-for-33) with one double, one home run, seven walks, and two hit-by-pitches against seven strikeouts.

♫ Ward has seen 1,363 total pitches this season, second most in the majors behind WSH's James Wood (1,369)...He has seen 466 of those pitches in a 3-2 count, second in MLB behind LAA's Mike Trout (485).

LEFTY MASHER: **Coby Mayo** is slashing .314/.364/.745 (16-for-51) with four doubles, six home runs, and 12 RBI off left-handed pitching this season.

♫ Since May 11, he is 10-for-18 (.556) with two doubles, four home runs, and seven RBI off southpaws.

♫ Overall, his .745 slugging percentage against left-handed pitching is second highest in MLB (min. 50 PA) behind NYY's Paul Goldschmidt (.776), while his 1.109 OPS is sixth highest behind Goldschmidt (1.276), CWS' Miguel Vargas (1.177), AZ's Corbin Carroll (1.152), MIA's Otto Lopez (1.142), and ATH's Shea Langeliers (1.118).

MOOOVING ALONG: **Colton Cowser** is slashing .297/.361/.641 (19-for-64) with one double, seven home runs, 14 runs, 16 RBI, and seven walks in 24 games since May 17.

♫ Over that period, he is hitting .316 (12-for-38) with one double, three home runs, and a 30.0 percent strikeout rate on breaking and off-speed pitches...Prior to that period, he was 4-for-48 (.083) with zero extra-base hits and a 47.1 percent strikeout rate on such offerings.

♫ His seven home runs this season have traveled an average distance of 418 ft., the third-furthest average home run distance in MLB (min. 5 HR) behind COL's Ezequiel Tovar (422 ft.) and MIL's William Contreras (420 ft.).

CAMDEN CONFINES: The Orioles' .751 OPS at home ranks eighth in the majors, while their .691 OPS on the road ranks 18th in MLB.

♫ Birds pitching owns a 3.83 ERA at Camden Yards, compared to a 5.52 mark on the road... The home ERA ranks 14th in MLB, while the road ERA is second highest in the majors ahead of the Twins (5.63).

♫ **Adley Rutschman** has reached base safely in 11 straight home games since May 13, going 9-for-37 (.243) with 11 walks against five strikeouts during that time.

FACING THE FRIARS: Baltimore and San Diego are meeting this weekend for the only games between the clubs this season...The O's have won four consecutive games against the Padres for the first time since the teams first met in 2002, including a three-game sweep from September 1-3, 2025 at Petco Park.

♫ Padres first baseman/outfielder **Gavin Sheets'** father, Larry, played 606 career games with the Orioles from 1984-1989...Gavin was born in Lutherville, MD and attended Gilman School in Baltimore, where Larry has been the head varsity baseball coach since 2010.

♫ Padres outfielder **Jackson Merrill** was born in Baltimore and attended Severna Park High School before San Diego selected him in the first round (No. 27 overall) in 2021.

♫ Orioles Assistant Athletic Trainer **Ben Fraser** spent the previous six years in the same role with San Diego from 2020-25...He also worked in the Padres' minor league system from 2018-19.

QUICK HITS: Baz is scheduled to make his 14th start as an Oriole after being acquired from the Tampa Bay Rays in exchange for four minor leaguers and a 2026 Competitive Balance Round A pick on December 19, 2025...The O's and Baz agreed to terms on a five-year contract extension on March 27 that covers the 2026-30 seasons.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered the loss on June 7 at Toronto after allowing five runs (1 ER) on seven hits (1 HR) and one walk with three strikeouts over 5.2 innings...Threw 81 pitches, 56 strikes.

- Was scoreless through 5.0 innings before allowing a leadoff homer to Yohendrick Piñango to open the sixth.
- Jesús Sánchez tallied a one-out double and was followed by Ernie Clement, who reached via a fielding error by **Gunnar Henderson**.
- Brandon Valenzuela followed Clement and bounced a ball to Henderson at short in what could have been an inning-ending double play, but Clement was ruled to have stayed in the base path and reached second base with Valenzuela thrown out at first.
- An RBI-single by Kazuma Okamoto and an RBI-double by Andrés Giménez followed, chasing Baz from the game.

FRIAR'S FLY EAST: Baz is set to make his third career start opposite San Diego, having gone 2-0 with a 1.50 ERA (2 ER/12.0 IP), .150 opponent average (6-for-40), and 0.83 WHIP.

Last faced the Padres on April 25, 2025 at Petco Park and earned the victory after tossing 7.0 scoreless innings on four hits, one walk, and one hit batter with six strikeouts.

ROUNDING INTO FORM: Over his last five starts since May 15, Baz is 2-2 with a 2.20 ERA (8 ER/32.2 IP)...Among all MLB hurlers who have thrown at least 30.0 innings during that period, Baz's 2.20 ERA is seventh lowest in MLB...Teammate **Brandon Young's** 2.08 ERA (7 ER/30.1 IP) is tied for fifth-lowest in the majors during that same time.

CONTROLLING THE LONG BALL: In 19 starts since August 26, 2025, Baz has permitted eight home runs over 105.1 innings (0.68 HR/9.0 IP)...Over his first 25 starts of the 2025 campaign, he allowed 26 homers over 138.0 innings (1.70 HR/9.0 IP).

He has allowed one or zero home runs in each of the 19 outings, the fifth-longest active streak among all MLB starters behind KC's Kris Bubic (29 G), STL's Andre Pallante (26 G), NYY's Cam Schlichtler (24 G), and AZ's Michael Soroka (21 G).

INSIDE THE ARSENAL: Over his last five starts since May 15, during which Baz owns a 2.20 ERA (8 ER/32.2 IP), he has limited the opposition to a .207 (12-for-58) mark on his knuckle curve.

Prior to this stretch, the opposition hit .328 (21-for-64) off his knuckle curve.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Entering play today, Baz has allowed an MLB-high 25 doubles, ahead of COL's Tomoyuki Sugano (22)...On April 21 at Kansas City, Baz permitted a career-high five doubles.

He has given up 4+ doubles in three of his 13 starts in 2026, having allowed four doubles in three of his 54 career starts entering this season.

Only four O's starters (five occurrences) have allowed 4+ doubles four times in a season: Brad Bergesen (2010), Mike Mussina (2000, 1996), Pat Rapp (2000), and Scott Erickson (1996).

TEERING OFF EARLY: Opponents are slashing .391/.404/.696 (18-for-46) with eight doubles and two home runs off Baz on the first pitch of an at-bat...His 1.100 opponent OPS on the first pitch is third highest in MLB (min. 45 BF), ahead of AZ's Ryne Nelson (1.179) and TEX's Nathan Eovaldi (1.105).

GOING THE DISTANCE: Baz was one of three Rays starters in 2025 to remain active all season, along with Ryan Pepiot and Drew Rasmussen...Five of his 31 starts last year went 7.0+ innings, tying Zack Littell for the club lead...That included a start on June 26 at Kansas City, when he tossed a career-high 8.0 scoreless innings, scattering three hits and one walk with nine strikeouts in a winning effort...Marked the first start of 8.0 scoreless innings or more by a Rays pitcher since Tyler Glasnow on May 26, 2021 vs. Kansas City.
