BIRD WATCHING: The St. Louis Cardinals conclude their three-game weekend series against the Arizona Diamondbacks this afternoon in the series rubber game after the clubs split 5-4 and 5-3 decisions on Friday and Saturday...the team's six-day roadtrip out of the All-Star break will continue tomorrow night in Anaheim, CA when the Cardinals open a three-game series against the Los Angeles Angels (Mon.-Wed.) in their first visit to the Big A since 2024...with a make-up game slated for this Thu. (July 23) at Busch Stadium vs. Arizona, the Cardinals are scheduled to play 20-straight days before their next open date on August 6.

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis entered play today in 3rd place in the National League Central, 9.5 games behind 1st place Milwaukee, and 3.5 games behind 2nd place Chicago. The Cardinals are currently tied for the final NL Wild Card spot with Miami and are 1.5 games in front of Arizona.

GAME TIME IS ON TIME: Beginning with today's series finale in Arizona at 1:10 MT, the Cardinals will not repeat game times over their next nine games, playing at 7:10 PT, 6:38 PT and 1:07 PT in Anaheim, followed by 4:15 CT, 7:15 CT, 6:15 CT, 1:15 CT and 6:45 CT starts when they return home this week. Tomorrow night's series opener at the LA Angels will be televised by ESPN.

IT'S WHACKING DAY: The Cardinals .603 win pct. (114-75) against the Diamondbacks is their best against any opponent (min. 25 games) and the highest in MLB vs. the Snakes among National League and common interleague opponents. **RAZING ARIZONA:** St. Louis is 54-41 (.568) all-time at Chase Field, the best win pct. by any annual visitor and the club's 3rd-best winning pct. in any road city.

THE ROAD AHEAD: The Cardinals are scheduled to play 38 games on the road following the All-Star break, their most since playing 39 post-ASG road games in 2007. **HOME BODIES:** The team's 52 Home games before the ASG break this season matched the 1973 season for their most in a full season.

WE MEET AGAIN: After **Jordan Walker** edged out hometown hero **Kyle Schwarber** to win the T-Mobile MLB Home Run Derby on Monday at Citizens Bank Park in Philadelphia he now finds himself again matched up with **Schwarbs** as they both own the longest active on-base steraks in MLB at 20 games...**Walker** has also hit safely in 9-straight games, the longest active hit streak among Cardinals batters.

CENTURY CLUB: **Alec Burleson** collected a pair of hits yesterday to push his season total to 101, six back of **Jordan Walker's** team-high 107 safeties. Walker and Burleson are the first pair of Cardinals to each amass 100 hits before Team Game 100 since **Allen Craig & Matt Carpenter** did so in 2013.

MASYN AT CHASE: **Masyn Winn's** single in the 2nd inning yesterday pushed his hitting streak at Chase Field to 7 games, passing **Willie McGee** (6, 1998-99) for the Cardinals 2nd longest at this ballpark, trailing **Yadier Molina's** 15-game run here from 2016-22.

HAPPY BIRTHDAY JIMMY CROOKS: Cardinals catcher **Jimmy Crooks** who belted a 443 ft. HR yesterday is celebrating his 25th birthday today.

ARIZONA CONNECTIONS

Nolan Arenado played five seasons in St. Louis (2021-25), where he was a three-time NL All-Star and the winner of one Silver Slugger Award and a pair of Platinum Gold Gloves Awards...traded to Arizona with cash considerations for RHP Jack Martinez (Jan. 13, 2026).

Matthew Liberatore was born in Peoria, Ariz.... graduated from Mountain Ridge High School in Glendale...signed his letter of intent to the University of Arizona before being drafted by the Rays.

JoJo Romero played college baseball at Yavapai College in Prescott, Ari...committed to transfer to the University of Arizona, but first spent a season at Yavapai due to transfer restrictions, and was subsequently drafted before transferring.

George Soriano made his MLB debut vs. Arizona (April 16, 2023), tossing 3.0 scoreless innings of one-hit ball with a pair of strikeouts...fanned Corbin Carroll for his first career strikeout.

Jon Jay played 84 games for Arizona in 2018.

Kyle Driscoll previously worked two seasons (2024-25) as Pitching Coordinator with Arizona.

Dbacks Hitting Coach **Joe Mather** was selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2001 MLB Draft... played parts of two years in St. Louis (2008, '10).

Dbacks 1B Coach **Dave McKay** served in the same position for St. Louis for 16 seasons (1996-2011).

Casey Chenoweth served as a Diamondbacks hitting coordinator from 2020-22 in Scottsdale prior to joining the Cardinals organization.

Daniel Descalso played two seasons for the Diamondbacks (2017-18)...served as a Special Assistant to Baseball Operations for Arizona in 2023.

Brandon Allen played parts of three seasons (2009-11) with the D-Backs...made his MLB debut with Arizona (Aug. 22, 2009 at Minute Maid)... singled off **Brian Moehler** for first career hit.

Ildemaro Vargas was signed by St. Louis as an international free agent (June 26, 2008) and played seven seasons in the Cardinals minor league system (2008-14).

Zac Gallen was selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2016 MLB Draft...pitched two seasons in Cardinals minor league system before being traded to Miami as part of the package to acquire **Marcell Ozuna** (Dec. 14, 2017).

Hall of Fame Manager **Tony La Russa** was a Dbacks Baseball Operations Executive for parts of four seasons (2014-17).

D-Backs Player & Media Relations Coordinator **Kat Ritter** previously worked as a Cardinals Communications Gameday Associate in 2019.

Arizona VP of Latin American Scouting **César Gerónimo** previously worked six seasons (2011-16) as a Cardinals international crosschecker.

TODAY'S START:

- Making his 19th start of the 2026 season today and his 80th career start (188th career appearance).
- Won his last two road day games, an 8-1 win in Game 1 at CIN (5/23) and a 17-1 blasting of the Cubs on a Friday afternoon matinee at Wrigley Field (7/3). Allowed a total of one run over 11.2 IP.
- Pallante's 10 wins were the most by a Cardinal through their first 17 starts in a season since **Carlos Martinez** (10 in 2015).
- Is 10-15 with a 4.67 ERA in 27 career starts (78 app.) Post All-Star Break.
- **Owns an 11.17 Run Support Average on the road (highest in MLB)** but just a 2.93 at home ... He's received 3 runs or fewer in 10 of his 11 Home starts, yet 5 runs or more in 6 of his 7 Road starts.
- Making his his 188th career appearance today, passing **Fernando Salas** and **Jordan Hicks** for 64th all-time among Cardinals pitchers. He has joined **Adam Wainwright** (478 starts), **Carlos Martinez** (274), **Lance Lynn** (206), **Miles Mikolas** (204) and **Chris Carpenter** (198) since 2000 to reach both 188 career games pitched for St. Louis while also making 79 or more starts.
- **Is 6-0 in six Road starts (St. Louis is 6-1) and he's 4-6 in Home games with the Cardinals going 5-6 in his Home starts after starting out 1-4 in his 1st five Home starts.**
- **Leads all current Cardinals pitchers in career starts (79), wins (35), and innings pitched (560.0).**
- Began the season with 10 consecutive starts of 5.0+ IP (March 31-May 23), first Cardinal to do so since RHP **Sonny Gray** ran off 10 straight such starts to begin 2024.
- Alternated Home & Road starts in first 11 starts to begin the season, but that trend ended on May 29-June 7 homestand after consecutive Home starts. Now is alternating again through his last four.
- Allowed 2 runs or fewer in five of six starts from May 17 to June 22 (2.88 ERA) and led the Cardinals starting staff with his 3.16 ERA in June.
- Made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster for the 5th time (2022-26), tied with **Lars Nootbaar** for most among active Cardinals.

LAST TIME OUT (Thursday, July 9 vs. Milwaukee): L, 3-2; 5.0 IP, 8 H, 6 R, 6 ER, 2 BB, 2 SO, 1 HR, 97 pitches.

- Was hit for six runs over the first three innings en route to an 8-4 Cardinals loss vs. MIL. Tied his season-high in earned runs.
- Surrendered a three-run home run to Jake Bauers in the 3rd inning.

2026 NOTES:

SLIDE ON IN: Is holding opposing batters to a .185 BA (22-119) with his slider, and 36 of his 72 strikeouts this season have come via the slider ... Boasts a 10 Run Value on his slider, 6th best slider in MLB according to *Baseball Savant* this season.

COUNT ON ME: Has worked at least 5.0 IP in 17 of his 18 starts this season, allowing 2 runs or fewer in 10 of those games.

IF AT FIRST: Has had issues with 1st inning, allowing a .833 OPS, 14 runs and 4 HRs in 1st inning ... Batters are hitting .306 (15-49) when contacting the 1st pitch of an at-bat.

SIX & THIRTY: Snapped a 4-game losing skid in games pitched at Busch Stadium as he matched his season total from 2025 with his 6th win of the season vs. TEX (6/3); also marked his 30th career win.

THE STATE OF WINNING: With a win in Sacramento (May 12), earned his first MLB in his home state of California.

BITTER BREW: Allowed four 1st inning runs, including 3-run HR, in 6-2 loss to MIL (5/6), losing his 3rd straight decision at Busch Stadium.

AHOY MATEY: Pitched then season-best 6.0 IP while allowing 1 run in Cards 5-4 win at PNC Park (4/29) in G3 of a 4-game series sweep of Pittsburgh.

TRI-DENT: Fanned 8 Mariners on 4/24 in 5.1 IP, but took the 3-2 loss after Josh Naylor's solo HR in the 6th snapped a 2-2 tie.

SPACE TRAVELER: Earned his 1st road win since 5/16/25 (at KC) in a 7-5 Space City win over the Astros on 4/18 in Houston.

MARCH MADNESS: Made his 2026 season debut vs. NYM (3/31) and gained a 3-0 win as he worked 5.0 scoreless IP, allowing just 3 hits.

CAREER:

- Has made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster for five consecutive seasons (2022-26) after arriving at 2022 Spring Training as a non-roster invitee, his first official invite to Major League Spring Training.
- ***Since his 2022 MLB debut, boasts the highest ground ball pct. (62.3%) in Major League Baseball among pitchers with 500.0+ IP.*** As a starting pitcher (428.1 IP), Pallante's 59.2 career groundball pct. currently is the 9th-best in MLB since the stat has been tracked since 1987 (min. 400.0 IP as starter).
- Started vs. San Francisco (June 20, 2024) at Rickwood Field in Birmingham, Ala., tossing 5.1 innings in the 6-5 Cardinals win. Was the first Cardinals starting pitcher to earn a win at a neutral site since Alan Benes vs. San Diego on April 19, 1997 at Aloha Stadium in Honolulu, Hawaii.
