THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY

AUG. 14

2020 - The Astros explode for nine runs in the 1st in an 11-1 win over the Mariners in Houston...in his first at-bat of the 2020 season, **DH Yordan Alvarez** hits a three-run homer in the opening frame, which ended up as his only homer on the season...**1B Yuli Gurriel** also homers in the inning, going back-to-back with Alvarez.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The first-place Astros will open a huge nine-game homestand tonight as they welcome in their division rival, the Mariners, for a three-game weekend series at Daikin Park...**RHP Peter Lambert** (8-6), the Astros most consistent starter this season, will start the series opener for Houston opposite Astros nemesis **RHP George Kirby** (8-9) and the Mariners.

HALL OF FAME WEEKEND: The Astros are celebrating **Hall of Fame Weekend** beginning tonight at Daikin Park...Astros legends **Alan Ashby** and the late **Phil Garner** will be inducted into the Astros Hall of Fame in a pregame ceremony tomorrow, scheduled for 5:35 p.m...Ashby and members of the Garner family will be available to the media in the press conference room at 4:30 p.m. tomorrow.

THE TURNAROUND: After a slow start to the season, the Astros are 42-29 since May 22, which is the second-best record in the AL in that span...on that date, the Astros were 20-31, 11 games under, which is their low water mark for the season.

THE LAMBO: Today's Astros starter **RHP Peter Lambert** leads the club in wins (8), starts (20), innings (113.2) and strikeouts (111)...among AL pitchers with at least 110 IP, Lambert ranks seventh in opponent average (.208) and 10th in ERA...a minor league signing by Houston this offseason, Lambert pitched last year for the Tokyo Yakult Swallows in the NPB, posting a 3.98 ERA (55ER/124.1IP) with 111 strikeouts in 23 starts.

FAMILIAR FOE: **RHP George Kirby** has been at his best against the Astros in his career, going 6-1 with a 2.14 ERA (15ER/63IP) in 11 regular season starts opposite Houston, numbers that do not include his 7.0 shutout innings in the 2022 NLDS...the Astros with the most career success vs. Kirby: **3B Isaac Paredes** (.438, 7x16, 3RBI), **SS Jeremy Peña** (.300, 6x20, 4RBI) and **C Yainer Diaz** (.273, 6x22, RBI).

VS. THE MARINERS: It's been three months since the Astros last played the Mariners, as they last saw them in a four-game series in Houston from May 11-14...the Astros have gone 1-7 against the Mariners this season with five games left to play.

WINSDAY IN SAN FRAN: The Astros won the rubber game of their three-game series against the Giants on Wednesday with a 2-1 victory in San Francisco...trailing 1-0 after the 6th, the Astros scored runs in the 7th and 8th on sac flies to take the lead and eventually the ballgame...the Astros went with a bullpen game on Wednesday, with **RHP Tatsuya Imai** (0ER/3IP) picking up the bulk work.

ROAD WARRIORS: The Astros closed out their six-game road trip on Wednesday with a win, giving them a 3-3 trip thru San Diego (1-2) and San Francisco (2-1)...Houston has gone 25-16 (.610) on their last five road trips and are 31-22 (.585) on the road since going 1-9 on their first road trip of the season...Houston is 32-31 overall on the road in 2026.

ON THE MEND: The Astros have four players on the Major League Injured List...updates on three:

- **RHP Mike Burrows** (rt. elbow neuritis) is scheduled to pitch for Triple A Sugar Land tonight in what will be his first affiliate rehab start since the injury.
- **IF Carlos Correa** (lt. ankle tendon injury) has begun a hitting progression while also participating in light on-field baseball activity and a running progression.
- **OF Brice Matthews** (lt. knee sprain) is participating in on-field baseball activity and a running progression.

THAT'S OFFENSIVE: The Astros lead the AL in SLG (.411), while ranking second in OPS (.730 and home runs (162)...in the Majors, the Astros rank fourth in homers, trailing only the Nationals (177), Yankees (169), and Braves (164).

MVP-CALIBER: **Yordan Alvarez** holds at least a share of the lead in all AL Triple Crown categories, ranking first in average (.322), first in RBI (87) and tied for first in HR (35)...additionally, he leads MLB in OPS (1.057), OBP (.436), SLG (.621), and TB (270)...in the AL, he ranks first in hits (140), XBH (60) and runs (80), and is second in BB (84)...AL leaders:

CHIPPING IN: A couple Astros are on mini hot streaks, including **OF Taylor Trammell**, who's posted a .991 OPS (.400 OBP/.591 SLG) with 11 runs, one double, one triple, four home runs, eight RBI and nine walks in his last 14 games (since July 26)...**RF Cam Smith** is batting .386 (17x44) with three home runs, eight RBI and a 1.095 OPS in his last 12 games dating back to July 29.

PEÑA'S PALS: **SS Jeremy Peña** will host kids from **Hidalgo Little League** tonight for August's Peña's Pals...in its fourth year, Peña's Pals is a program developed by Peña in partnership with the Astros Foundation...the program celebrates kids and their development in academics, character building and making healthy choices.

HADERADE: **LHP Josh Hader** has been stellar since returning from injury in early June, going 4-1 with a 0.96 ERA (3ER/28IP), 38 strikeouts, a .106 opponent batting average (10x94) and a 0.71 WHIP, while also converting all 17 of his save opportunities, through 29 appearances.

GREAT RUN FOR THE AYA: The Astros Nike RBI Softball Team lost in the championship game of the 2026 Nike RBI Softball World Series yesterday...this loss ends the season for the Astros Nike RBI Softball Team as they finished one win short of a sixth title...pregame Sunday, both the Astros Nike RBI Junior Baseball and Softball Teams will be recognized for advancing to the Nike RBI World Series.

LAST START, AUG. 8 at SD: Allowed 3 runs (2 ER) on 5 hits and 3 walks with 3 strikeouts in 5.0 innings...suffered the loss after the Astros were defeated by Padres, 2-3.

THE LAMBO: A minor league free-agent signing this offseason, Lambert has established himself as one of the top pitchers in the AL this season despite beginning the year at the Triple A level...among AL pitchers with at least 100.0 innings this season, he ranks 7th in opponent batting average (.208), 7th in H/9 (6.89), 7th in opponent OPS (.619) and 9th in ERA (3.09).

VS. THE MARINERS: In his only start vs. the Mariners this season, he allowed 3 runs on 6 hits with 1 walk and 6 strikeouts in 7.0 innings on May 11 at Daikin Park...suffered the loss after the Mariners defeated the Astros, 1-3.

THE STABILIZER: Leads Astros pitchers with 8 quality starts this season and has been scoreless in 3 of his starts (July 5 vs. TB; May 5 vs. LAD; April 22 at CLE)...has also pitched 6.0+ innings in 9 of his 20 starts and 5.0+ innings in 18 of his 20 starts this season...leads the Astros 113.2 innings pitched.

SLIDER COMBO: Is having his greatest MLB success with his slider, holding opponents to a .176 average on the pitch (9x51)...opponents had combined to hit .313 (50x160) vs. his slider through his first 4 MLB seasons...in 2024, his last season in the Majors prior to this year, opponents batted .340 (18x53) vs. his slider.

SUMMER FUN: Went 2-0 with a 1.88 ERA (6ER/28.2IP) in 5 starts in July...among AL pitchers in July, he ranked 5th in ERA (1.88) 7th in opponent OPS (.537), 11th in opponent batting average (.204), 13th in H/9 (6.91) and 13th in WHIP (1.05).

DOUBLE DIGITS: Got the Astros' first start coming out of the All-Star Break on July 17 vs. BAL and struck out a career-high 10 batters...prior to this start, Lambert's single-game career high was a 9-strikeout effort on June 6, 2019 at CHC, while with the Rockies.

STREAKER: Had a career-long 4-game winning streak from May 24-June 23, which spanned 6 starts...within the streak, he posted a 2.97 ERA (11ER/33.1IP)...the streak ties as the longest by an Astro this season, also reached by **RHP Spencer Arrighetti** (April 15-May 2).

WITH THE SPACE COWBOYS: Did not make the Major League team out of Spring Training and was granted his release on March 24...re-signed to a minor league deal on March 27 and began the year at Triple A Sugar Land...made 3 appearances, including 2 starts for Sugar Land to begin the 2026 season...in those 3 appearances, he recorded a 1.84 ERA (3ER/14.2IP) with 12 strikeouts, a 0.95 WHIP and a .208 opponent batting average...added to the Major League roster on April 17.

2025 SEASON: Spent the 2025 season with the Tokyo Yakult Swallows in the Nippon Professional Baseball League...made 23 appearances for the Swallows, recording a 3.98 ERA (55ER/124.1IP) with 111 strikeouts, 54 walks and a 1.44 WHIP.

LAST APPEARANCE (8/12 at SF): Struck out 2 in 1.0 scoreless inning on Wednesday at SF.

SCORELESS STREAK: Is on an active 12-game scoreless streak (12.0 IP), recording a 0.00 ERA (0ER/12IP) with 17 strikeouts, 4 walks, a 0.58 WHIP and a .077 opponent batting average (since July 18)...it is the second-longest streak by an Astros pitcher this season, behind only LHP Steven Okert 14-game scoreless streak from May 23-June 24.

TURNING THE PAGE: Since May 3, he has gone 4-1-6 with a 1.87 ERA (7ER/33.2IP)...has also recorded 41 strikeouts, a 0.98 WHIP and a .161 opponent batting average during the stretch...prior to May 3, Abreu had a 12.54 ERA in his first 11 apps. of the season.
