... St. Louis opened its homestand by being swept by the division-rival Milwaukee Brewers over the weekend ... St. Louis plays 19 of their first 28 games against teams who made the 2023 Postseason.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals open today in 5th place in the National League Central, 6.0 games behind first place Milwaukee (14-6) and 2.0 games behind Pittsburgh (11-11) for 4th place ... St. Louis has lost four in a row, marking their season high losing streak and longest losing stretch since Sept. 19-22, 2023 (4 games) The last time the Cardinals lost four straight home games was a six-game skid from June 10-24, 2023 (2 vs. Reds, 3 vs. Giants, 1 vs. Cubs).

IT'S WHACKING DAY: Since Arizona joined MLB as an expansion team in 1998, the Cardinals .611 win percentage (107-68) against the Diamondbacks is their best against any opponent, the highest in MLB vs. the Snakes among National League and common interleague opponents, and the highest by any team against the last four expansion teams (Rockies, Marlins, Rays, Diamondbacks).
