RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals continue a six-game homestand with the opener of a three-game series against the defending National League Champion Arizona Diamondbacks tonight at Busch Stadium ... St. Louis opened its homestand by being swept by the division-rival Milwaukee Brewers over the weekend ... St. Louis plays 19 of their first 28 games against teams who made the 2023 Postseason.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals open today in 5th place in the National League Central, 6.0 games behind first place Milwaukee (14-6) and 2.0 games behind Pittsburgh (11-11) for 4th place ... St. Louis has lost four in a row, marking their season high losing streak and longest losing stretch since Sept. 19-22, 2023 (4 games) ... The last time the Cardinals lost four straight home games was a six-game skid from June 10-24, 2023 (2 vs. Reds, 3 vs. Giants, 1 vs. Cubs).

IT'S WHACKING DAY: Since Arizona joined MLB as an expansion team in 1998, the Cardinals .611 win percentage (107-68) against the Diamondbacks is their best against any opponent, the highest in MLB vs. the Snakes among National League and common interleague opponents, and the highest by any team against the last four expansion teams (Rockies, Marlins, Rays, Diamondbacks). **RAZING ARIZONA:** St. Louis' .642 home winning pct. (36-21) vs. the Diamondbacks is tied for its 4th-best at Busch Stadium III (2006-present).

BRONCO: With his first strikeout tonight, Lance Lynn will reach 939 for his Cardinals career (2011-17, '24) and pass Bill Doak (1913-24, '29) for sole possession for 9th place in Cardinals history ... Lynn is current 13 strikeouts shy of tying Steve Carlton (951) for 8th and 39 strikeouts behind Jesse Haines (979) for 7th in franchise history.

GIVES ME THE WILLIES: Willson Contreras has reached base safely in a career-high 26 straight games dating back to Sept. 6, 2023 ... Contreras is also riding a career-best 14-game hitting streak since April 1 (.347/.467/.592, 17-49), currently MLB's longest active and the 2nd-longest this season to Marcell Ozuna (17).

THE MAN WITH THE GOLDEN GUN: Since joining St. Louis in 2019, Paul Goldschmidt has gone yard nine times against his former team, tying the Mets and Giants for his most against any non-NL Central opponent over that timespan ... Goldy is the all-time Chase Field home run leader (105) and ranks 3rd in Busch Stadium III history with 74 blasts.

READY FOR TAKEOFF: The Cardinals have not homered in their last eight games (April 13-present), MLB's longest active homerless streak and the Redbirds longest draught since eight games from April 21-28, 2022 ... The last time St. Louis homered was April 12 at Arizona, with Nolan Arenado and Lars Nootbaar going yard off tonight's starter, Brandon Pfaadt.

THE NEW GUYS: Since April 9, free agent acquisitions Sonny Gray, Lance Lynn, and Kyle Gibson have combined for a 1.74 ERA (8 ER/41.1 IP) in their seven starts.

BASES TAKEN: St. Louis leads Major League Baseball with 44 bases taken (extra bases advanced on fly balls, passed balls, wild pitches, balks, and defensive indifference), while the Diamondbacks are 2nd with 36.

PRODUCTIVE OUTS: The Cardinals lead MLB in both productive outs (33) and productive out pct. (38.8%), while Arizona is 2nd in productive outs (32) and 5th in productive out pct. (33.3%) (fly balls, grounders, or bunts to advance runners) ... St. Louis leads MLB in bunt hits (5) and sacrifice flies (12), and co-leads MLB in sacrifice bunts (6) with the White Sox.

ARIZONA CONNECTIONS

Paul Goldschmidt was selected by Arizona in the 8th round of the 2009 MLB Draft...played eight seasons with the Dbacks (2011-18), hitting .297/.398/.532 with 209 home runs and 710 RBI...selected to six All-Star squads (2013-18)...won four Silver Sluggers (2013, '15, '17-18) and three Gold Gloves (2013, '15, '17)...acquired by St. Louis from Arizona for Carson Kelly, Luke Weaver, Andrew Young, and the 2019 Cardinals Compensation Round B selection (Dec. 5, 2018).

Nolan Arenado made his MLB debut vs. the Dbacks (April 28, 2013 at Chase Field)...Signed his letter of intent to play college baseball at Arizona State University before drafted by the Rockies.

Nolan Gorman was born in Phoenix...graduated from Sandra Day O'Connor High School in Glendale...signed his letter of intent to the University of Arizona before drafted by the Cardinals.

Dbacks First Base Coach Dave McKay served in the same position for the Cardinals for 16 seasons (1996-2011).

Dbacks Hitting Coach Joe Mather was selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2001 MLB Draft...played parts of two years in St. Louis (2008, '10).

Keynan Middleton pitched in 18 games for the Diamondbacks in 2022.

Daniel Descalso played two seasons for the Diamondbacks (2017-18)...served as a Special Assistant to Baseball Operations for Arizona in 2023.

Brandon Crawford resides in Scottsdale, Ari.

JoJo Romero played college baseball at Yavapai College in Prescott, Arizona.

Jordan Montgomery pitched parts of two seasons with St. Louis (2022-23).

Matthew Liberatore was born in Peoria, Ari...graduated from Mountain Ridge High School in Glendale...signed his letter of intent to the University of Arizona before drafted by the Rays.

Randal Grichuk played parts of his first four MLB seasons in St. Louis (2014-17)...originally joined the Cardinals via trade with the Angels, packaged with Peter Bourjos in exchange for David Freese and Fernando Salas (Nov. 22, 2013).

Turner Ward played two seasons (1999-2000) and spent eight years coaching in the Dbacks organization, serving as AA-Mobile Hitting Coach (2008-10) and Manager (2011-12), and Arizona Asst. Hitting Coach (2013) & Hitting Coach (2014-15)...Turner's son, Tucker Ward, was selected by Arizona in the 40th round of the 2015 MLB Draft and pitched three seasons in the Arizona organization (2015-17).

Brandon Allen played parts of three seasons (2009-11) with the Dbacks...made his MLB debut with Arizona (Aug. 22, 2009 at Minute Made)...singled off Brian Moehler for first career hit.

Zac Gallen was selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2016 MLB Draft...pitched two seasons in Cardinals minor league organization before traded to Miami as part of the package to acquire Marcell Ozuna (Dec. 14, 2017).

Dbacks Pitching Coach Brent Strom spent six seasons (2008-13) with the Cardinals organization as minor league pitching instructor (2008-11) and pitching coordinator (2012-13).

John Mozeliak attended the Univ. of Arizona before graduating from the Univ. of Colorado at Boulder.

Athletic reporter Katie Woo graduated from Arizona State University.

Dbacks Player & Media Relations Coordinator Kat Ritter previously worked as a Cardinals Communications Gameday Associate in 2019.

Dbacks Pitching Strategist Dan Haren was selected by St. Louis in the 2nd rd. of the 2001 MLB Draft...pitched two seasons with the Cardinals (2003-04).

TONIGHT'S GAME

- Makes his 5th start of the season and the 322nd of his career (346th appearance).
- Making his 15th career appearance (13th start) against Arizona and his first appearance vs. the D-Backs as a member of the Cardinals since posting a 3-2 win here at Busch Stadium on 7/30/17.
- Needs one strikeout to pass **Bill Doak** (938) for 9th place all-time in Cardinals history with 939 strikeouts. He's 13 strikeouts back of **Steve Carlton** (951) for 8th place.
- Has a team-leading 2.18 ERA, which would rank 8th in the NL in he had enough qualifying innings pitched.
- Is coming off 3-2 win at Oakland last Tue. (4/16) when he worked a season-high 7.0 IP with 101 pitches. It was his first win in Cardinals uniform since 9/12/17 vs. CIN and first road win with the Redbirds since 8/5/17 at CIN.
- Was the Cardinals home opening starting pitcher for the first time in his career (4/4 vs. MIA).
- Is 75 strikeouts shy of 2,000 for his career and 90.1 innings for 2,000.
- Returns to his original drafting team in 2024 for the first time since 2017 after pitching for the Twins (2018), Yankees (2018), Rangers (2019-20), White Sox (2021-23) and Dodgers (2023).
- Was teammates with current Cardinals manager **Oliver Marmol** in Quad Cities (2008) and Palm Beach (2009).
- Ranks 2nd behind only **Adam Wainwright** (29) with 24 postseason pitching appearances among Cardinals.
- Has five postseason wins as a member of the Cardinals, T-3rd in franchise history behind **Chris Carpenter** (10) and **Bob Gibson** (7).
- Won a career-high 18 games with St. Louis in 2012, his first full season as a starting pitcher.

LAST TIME OUT

- Gained his 1st win in a Cardinals uniform since 9/12/17 last Tue. (4/16) in a 3-2 win at Oakland. Worked a season-high 7.0 IP, totaling 101 pitches.
- The win improved the Cardinals record to 3-1 in his games started.
- Was his first career start of 7.0+ IP with one or fewer strikeouts. Dakota Hudson (9/1/23) was last Cardinal to match that.

BUSCH STADIUM III (2006-PRESENT)

- Has never pitched at Busch Stadium as a visitor. Before the Home Opener (4/4/23), his previous appearance in St. Louis was Sept. 28, 2017 vs. the Cubs (ND, 5.0 IP, 1 R, 5 K).
- His start tonight marks the 80th of his career at Busch Stadium III, 2nd-most in stadium history (2006-present) behind only **Adam Wainwright** (214).
- Is seeking his 1st win at Busch III since 9/12/17 vs. CIN (13-4).

CAREER

- Member of the 2011 Cardinals World Series Championship team and the 2013 National League Champions.
- Two-time All-Star with the National League (2012, did not pitch) and the American League (2021). Pitched a scoreless inning at Coors Field (7/12/21) in relief of starting pitcher **Shohei Ohtani**. Current teammates **Kyle Gibson** and **Andrew Kittredge** also pitched for the A.L. in that game.
- Placed in the Top 10 in the American League Cy Young Award voting in 2019 (5th), 2020 (6th) and 2021 (3rd).
- Recorded 26 double-digit strikeout games, 19th among pitchers since 2012, when he became a starting pitcher.
- Is one of five Cardinals pitchers with five seasons of 150 or more strikeouts joining **Bob Gibson** (11), **Adam Wainwright** (8), **Chris Carpenter** (5), **Steve Carlton** (5) and **Dizzy Dean** (5).
