BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles lost to the Reds, 8-3, last night at Oriole Park...Baltimore is 3-3 in the first six games of this homestand against Toronto (1-1), Cleveland (2-1), and Cincinnati (0-1)...Following an off day on Monday, the Birds travel to the nation's capital to play the Nationals from Tuesday-Thursday before heading to Detroit for a three-game set next weekend.

🦅 Last night's crowd of 42,587 was the largest non-Home Opener April crowd at Camden Yards since April 26, 2015 vs. Boston (43,802)...Marked the second sellout of the year, joining March 31 vs. Boston (45,002).

🦅 **Cedric Mullins** opened the scoring with his team-leading fifth home run of the year, a solo shot in the second inning...Marked his second homer and fourth RBI in his 14th plate appearance against a lefty of the season, surpassing his home run and RBI totals against left-handed pitching from 2024 (101 PA)...Mullins hit three home runs off lefties in 2023 (119 PA), four in 2022 (197 PA), nine in 2021 (247 PA), and one in 2020 (38 PA).

🦅 **Heston Kjerstad** has homered in back-to-back games for the second time in his career (also 6/27-29/24)...He's second on the club with 12 RBI behind Mullins (18) and is tied for second on the club with three home runs with **Ryan O'Hearn**, **Adley Rutschman**, and **Jordan Westburg** behind Mullins (5).

ROSTER MOVES: The Orioles today recalled right-handed pitcher **Brandon Young** from High-A Aberdeen...Young will be making his MLB debut, the second O's pitcher to debut this season along with **Tomoyuki Sugano** (3/30 at TOR)...To make room on the active roster, right-hander **Scott Blewett** was designated for assignment.

CED AND DONE: **Cedric Mullins** is one of four MLB players leading their team in hits (16), homers (5), RBI (18), and walks (13), along with CHC's Kyle Tucker and NYY's Aaron Judge, per *Stats Perform*.

🦅 He ranks among AL leaders in on-base percentage (3rd, .432), RBI (T-3rd, 18), OPS (4th, 1.059), and slugging percentage (5th, .627), and walks (T-5th, 13).

THE MAGIC NUMBER: The O's are 8-2 when scoring four or more runs this year and winless (0-9) when scoring three or fewer.

🦅 Since 2024, Baltimore is 88-21 (.807) when scoring four or more runs, the fourth-best winning percentage in MLB during that stretch behind San Diego (89-15, .856), Cleveland (85-15, .850), and Houston (81-19, .810)...During that same period, the Birds are 11-61 (.153) when scoring three runs or fewer, the fourth-worst mark in the majors ahead of the White Sox (12-107, .101), Rockies (14-79, .151), and Diamondbacks (9-50, .153).

🦅 The O's have lost 19 straight games when scoring three runs or fewer dating to September 7, 2024, with their last such victory coming on September 6, 2024 vs. Tampa Bay (2-0).

LONG BALL LIVING: The Birds have hit 13 homers during the six games on this homestand, tallying multi-homer performances in five of the six contests...This follows a 10-game stretch from March 30-April 9 in which they hit an MLB-low two homers.

🦅 The O's have hit at least two home runs in five of nine home games this season, including three straight since Thursday...The club has eight total homers in the last three games, the most in a three-game home stretch since June 26-28, 2024 (also 8).

🦅 Baltimore has homered in six straight games in a single season for the first time since doing so in 16 straight from August 4-21, 2024...The team set a club record by going deep in 22 consecutive games from June 1-23, 2024.

🦅 The O's have received 11 long balls from their 6-9 hole hitters, tied for the most in MLB with the Angels and Yankees (both 11 HR).

'PEN PALS: The O's bullpen has posted a 2.93 ERA (23 ER/70.2 IP) this season, tops in the AL and fourth in MLB behind the Padres (1.58), Giants (1.83), and Mets (2.10)...Orioles relievers have allowed 0.38 home runs per 9.0 innings, the lowest mark in the majors.

🦅 **Seranthony Dominguez** has thrown 7.1 scoreless innings across eight appearances to open the season, allowing one hit and six walks with nine strikeouts...He has not allowed a hit in a career-high-tying seven straight appearances (also 5/29-6/16/24)...His seven-game run is tied for the longest active streak in MLB with AZ's Shelby Miller and Adam Ottavino, who last pitched for the Yankees on April 7.

🦅 **Matt Bowman** owns a 0.96 ERA (1 ER/9.1 IP) with three strikeouts across eight appearances.

🦅 **Yennier Cano** has yet to allow a run across 7.1 innings, scattering four hits and one walk while fanning seven...**Bryan Baker** owns a 1.04 ERA (1 ER/8.2 IP) over nine outings.

ADVANCED TALK: O's batters have produced a collective 45.1 percent hard-hit rate, ranking fourth in the majors behind the Red Sox (47.3%), Yankees (47.1%) and Mets (46.1%).

🦅 On Wednesday, Baltimore collected a season-high 17 hard-hit balls (95+ mph exit velocity), its most since September 25, 2024 at New York-AL (18).

🦅 **Gunnar Henderson** has recorded a 64.5 percent hard-hit rate, third best among batters (min. 25 batted balls) behind ATL's Drake Baldwin (71.4%) and NYY's Ben Rice (66.0%)...**Ryan Mountcastle** (55.3%), **Ryan O'Hearn** (52.5%), and **Heston Kjerstad** (51.4%) are all above 50 percent.

NO RISP, NO REWARD: In their eight wins, the O's are batting .365 (23-for-63) with three doubles, one triple, and four home runs with runners in scoring position...In their 10 losses, they own a .111 (6-for-54) RISP average with one extra-base hit.

SEEING RED: The Orioles and Reds meet for their only series of the season this weekend at Camden Yards...Baltimore swept a three-game set at Great American Ball Park last year from May 3-5...Entering this series, the O's and Redlegs have only squared off in the regular season 21 times, tied with the Cardinals and Dodgers for the fewest against a single opponent by Baltimore in team history...The clubs first met in the 1970 World Series, with the Orioles defeating the Big Red Machine, 4-1, to win their second title...The teams met in the regular season for the first time in 2005.

🦅 Orioles Director of Pitching Development **Forrest Herrmann** worked in the Reds organization as the Pitching Coach with Single-A Daytona (2021) and as a Minor League Pitching Coach (2020).

🦅 Baltimore Director of Latin American Scouting **Gerardo Cabrera** signed with the Reds and made his professional debut with the GCL Reds in 2005.

WELCOME TO THE SHOW: Young is set to make his major league debut this afternoon, becoming the second Oriole to do so this season, joining **Tomoyuki Sugano** on March 30 at Toronto...He was added to the active roster prior to this afternoon's game after being added to the taxi squad yesterday.

NUMBER NEWS: Young will wear No. 63, keeping his number from Spring Training... The last O's player to wear No. 63 was Nick Maton in 2024.

LAST TIME OUT: Was dealt the loss on April 12 vs. Gwinnett after allowing five runs on six hits (1 HR) with six strikeouts in 5.0 innings...Did not walk a batter for the first time this season...Threw 80 pitches, 54 strikes.

OFF AND RUNNING: In his first two starts of the 2025 campaign with Triple-A Norfolk, Young allowed just two unearned runs across 11.1 innings on seven hits and two walks with 11 strikeouts...In his April 5 start at Charlotte, he threw 5.1 hitless innings, conceding one walk while fanning eight.

ODDS AND ENDS: Through three starts this season, he limited lefties to a .182 (6-for-33) average compared to a .241 (7-for-29) mark against right-handed hitters...Young held opponents to a .174 (4-for-23) clip on his changeup, while the opposition hit .238 (5-for-21) on his fastball...He produced a 46.2 percent whiff rate on his curveball and 40.0 whiff rate on his cutter.

QUICK HITS: Young made three relief appearances during 2025 Grapefruit League play, allowing four earned runs across 6.1 innings while striking out five...Was added to the Orioles 40-man roster on November 19, 2024...Signed with Baltimore as a non-drafted free agent out of the University of Louisiana-Lafayette on June 14, 2020.

BEST OF THE BEST: He was named Baltimore's 2024 Jim Palmer Minor League Pitcher of the Year, going 5-6 with a 3.57 ERA (44 ER/111.0 IP) and 102 hits (8 HR), 49 total runs, two hit batters, 37 walks, and 132 strikeouts in 27 appearances (24 GS) between Double-A Bowie and Norfolk...Young finished third among O's minor leaguers in strikeouts, fourth in starts, and fifth in innings.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: In 2023, began the season on Bowie's 60-day Injured List recovering from right elbow surgery...Started a rehab assignment on July 15 and pitched in five rehab outings with the FCL Orioles, Single-A Delmarva, and High-A Aberdeen before his reinstatement with Bowie on August 15...Made six appearances, all starts, for the Baysox to finish the season.

🏪 In 2022, made three appearances for the Baysox before his April 28 placement on the 7-day Injured List...Was transferred to the 60-day Injured List on May 28 and Underwent right elbow ulnar collateral ligament reconstruction on June 1, missing the remainder of the season.

🏪 In 2021, made his professional debut between Delmarva and Aberdeen, going a combined 4-3 with a 3.52 ERA (33 ER, 84.1 IP) across 23 appearances (20 GS).
