SNAKEBITES

THE NL CHAMPS: The 2023 National League Champion D-backs captured their second NL pennant and made their second trip to the World Series, first since winning it all in 2001, in their seventh Postseason berth ('99, '01, '02, '07, '11, '17, '23) last season.

LAST GAME: The D-backs shutout the Braves, 1-0, to win the series-finale.

◆ **Eugenio Suárez's** fifth-inning solo homer proved to be the game-winner...homered in consecutive games for the first time since July 17-19, 2023.

◆ **Brandon Pfaadt's** 6.0 shutout frames (3 H, 0 BB, 4 K) were the second-most in his career (7.0 scoreless on Aug. 18, 2023 @ Padres).

◆ **Kevin Ginkel** (1.0 IP), **Ryan Thompson** (1.0) and **Paul Sewald** (1.0) combined for 3 scoreless frames.

WIN THE SERIES: The D-backs have won or split their last 4 series (3-0-1) and 10 of their last 12 series overall since May 30, going 7-2-3.

HOMER HAPPY: The D-backs' 18 home runs in July are fourth in the Majors behind the Pirates (19), Tigers (19) and Reds (19) and ahead of the Red Sox (15), Braves (15) and Twins (15).

VS. BLUE JAYS: The D-backs host the Blue Jays for just the fifth time ever (also: 2002, '10, '13, '16) and first time since July 19-20, 2016.

◆ Are 5-1 in their last 6 home games vs. Blue Jays (4-7 all-time).

◆ Were swept last July 14-16 @ Blue Jays and prior to that swept the Blue Jays in Toronto June 7-9, 2019.

INTERLEAGUE: The D-backs in their last 12 games vs. AL are hitting .274 AVG/.811 OPS with 70 runs (5.83 R/G).

◆ Among NL teams in Interleague play since June 11, rank first in runs (70), tied for first in hits (107) and walks (42), second in AVG (.274), OBP (.354), OPS (.811) and extra-base hits (42), and third in SLG (.456).

• **Ketel Marte** has hit safely in 8 of his last 11 Interleague games, batting .385 (15-for-39)/1.186 OPS with 4 doubles, 3 homers, 10 RBI and 7 walks...has hit safely in 14 of 18 home games vs. AL at a .354 clip (23-for-65)/1.099 OPS with 6 doubles, 1 triple, 4 homers, 14 RBI and 12 walks.

• **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** has hit in 4 of his last 5 games vs. AL, all home games, at a .389 clip (7-for-18)/1.151 OPS with 1 double, 1 triple, 1 homer, 5 RBI, 1 walk and 1 hit by pitch.

• **Christian Walker** has hit safely in 5 of his last 7 Interleague games at a .370 clip (10-for-27)/1.022 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 homer, 6 RBI and 1 walk.

• **Kevin Newman** has hit safely in 8 of his last 10 Interleague matchups this season (.333, 12-for-36, .831 OPS, 3 2B, 1 3B, 4 RBI, 4 BB).

ALL-STAR STARTER: **Ketel Marte** is now a 2-time All-Star as the fan-elected NL starting second baseman (besting Luis Arraez/Padres 55% to 45%)...second career All-Star selection/start (also: 2019)...second D-back with multiple fan elections (also: Paul Goldschmidt)...D-backs' eighth fan-elected start for a position player.

GOOD VIBES GENO: **Eugenio Suárez** has hit safely in 7 of his last 10 games at a .333 clip (11-for-33)/1.163 OPS with 4 doubles, 3 homers, 12 RBI and 6 walks.

GABI THRIVING IN JULY: **Gabriel Moreno**, since being reinstated from the injured list on July 2, has hit safely in 7 of his last 9 games at a .387 clip (12-for-31)/1.053 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 home runs, 5 RBI and 5 walks.

LG2: **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** has hit safely in 7 of 8 games (.257 AVG/.749 OPS), including 7 straight from July 2-9.

◆ Has reached base safely in 17 of his last 19 games, hitting safely in 16 games, with a .333 average (26-for-78)/.897 OPS, 3 doubles, 1 triple, 4 homers, 13 RBI, 2 walks and 1 hit by pitch.

◆ Has hit safely in 6 of his last 8 home games at a .310 clip (9-for-29)/.870 OPS with 1 double, 1 triple, 1 homer, 6 RBI, 2 walks and 1 hit by pitch.

EL PIKE: **Ketel Marte** has reached base in 16 straight home games since June 11, batting .351 (20-for-57)/.449 OBP/1.081 OPS with 11 walks.

◆ Has not struck out in 25 consecutive plate appearances, since July 4, tied for the team's eighth-longest streak since 2023 [source: Elias Sports Bureau].

◆ His 5 strikeouts since June 24 are third fewest in NL, behind Miguel Rojas/LAD (4) and Luis Arraez/SD (4).

THE WALK SHOW: **Christian Walker** has reached base safely in 9 of his last 11 home games (.268, 11-for-41, 5 2B, 1 HR, 8 RBI, 4 BB).

◆ Among D-backs before the All-Star Break...

• His 22 homers (94 G) are tied for sixth (also: 22 HR in 90 G) behind 23 by Matt Williams/1999/88 G...24 by Jay Bell/1999/85 G and Mark Reynolds/2009/87 G...25 by Steve Finley/2000/87 G...and 35 by Luis Gonzalez/2001/87 G.

• His 66 RBI (94 G) are 10th behind 67 by Luis Gonzalez/2003/93 G, Paul Goldschmidt/2017/88 G, Jake Lamb/2017/85 G, Eduardo Escobar/2019/89 G...70 by Steve Finley/2000/87 G and Paul Goldschmidt/2015/87 G...77 by Paul Goldschmidt/2013/94 G...82 by Matt Williams/1999/88 G...86 by Luis Gonzalez/2001/87 G.

GINKS LOCKED IN: **Kevin Ginkel** has a 10-game (10.1 IP) home scoreless streak, since June 4, with opponents batting .189 (7-for-37) with 0 walks and 13 strikeouts.

◆ Has not issued a walk in 9 straight games since June 25 (37 BF) and 21 of his last 22 games since May 18 (89 BF; 2 BB on June 21 @ Phillies).

MILESTONES: D-backs approaching career milestones:

• **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.:** 699 games are 1 game shy of 700 career games...391 RBI are 9 shy of 400 career RBI.

• **Christian Walker:** 796 games are 4 shy of 800 career games...693 hits are 7 shy of 700 career hits.

• **Joc Pederson:** 199 home runs are 1 shy of 200 career homers.

NEXT STARTER: RHP YILBER DIAZ (0-0, 1.50)

◆ Second career start...debuted on July 8 vs. Braves (6.0 IP, 1 R, 4 H, 1 BB, 5 K).

SNAKEBITES

AT A GLANCE: Third season with the D-backs.

- Last season, set career highs with 29 appearances, 27 starts, 144.0 innings and 96 strikeouts...in the Postseason, made 3 appearances (1 Wild Card, 1 NLCS, 1 World Series).
- Debuted in 2022 with 3 starts.
- D-backs' 2021 Minor League Pitcher of the Year.
- Second-round pick (No. 56 overall) in the 2019 draft.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW: 17th game and 15th start this season...eighth home start.

- In his last 5 outings (4 starts), has a 3.49 ERA (11 ER in 28.1 IP), opponent .255 AVG (28-for-110)/.284 OBP, 3 walks and 21 strikeouts.
- Has pitched 6.0+ innings in 5 of his last 7 starts (team is 4-3), including 4 quality starts.

LAST START: Earned his sixth win with his fifth quality start (1 ER in 6.2 IP) on July 7 @ Padres, retiring 18 of 23 batters faced, including 7 of the first 9.

- Lone run allowed came on a solo homer to his second batter faced, Jurickson Profar.

VS. BLUE JAYS: Posted a no-decision in his lone start, a 7-2 loss, @ Blue Jays on July 14, 2023 (2 R-1 ER in 5.2 IP, 9 H, 0 BB, 3 K).

IL REPORT: Was placed on the 15-day injured list (right elbow contusion) on April 19...reinstated on May 5.

- On April 18 @ Giants, exited after 2.0 scoreless innings when he was struck on the arm by a comebacker off the bat of Mike Yastrzemski.

FEW FREE PASSES: Among NL starters (min. 10 GS), his 16 walks are tied for fourth fewest and his 5.2 walk pct. (16 BB in 308 BF) is seventh lowest.

- In his last 5 starts, has issued 3 walks in 28.1 IP and 116 batters faced.
- Has 6 starts with 0 walks and 5 starts with 1 walk.
- In 7 home starts, has 2 outings with 0 walks and 4 outings with 1 walk.

FIRST INNING: Has allowed just 1 run in the first inning (1 ER in 14.2 IP) with an opponent .176 AVG (9-for-51)/.482 OPS, 0.75 WHIP, 2 walks and 13 strikeouts.

- Did not allow a first inning run in his first 15 games (13 starts)...last start, allowed a solo home run to Jurickson Profar.
- In the first inning in 7 home starts, opponents are scoreless while hitting .200 AVG (5-for-25)/.499 OPS with 2 walks and 8 strikeouts.

RISPY BUSINESS: In his last 9 games (7 starts) with runners in scoring position, holding opponents to a .167 AVG (7-for-42)/.607 OPS with 3 walks and 10 strikeouts.

- With runners in scoring position and 2 outs, opponents are hitting .129 AVG (4-for-31)/.454 OPS with 4 walks and 7 strikeouts.

VS. LEFTIES: In his last 9 games (7 starts), is holding lefties to a .228 AVG (23-for-101)/.278 OBP with 6 walks and 17 strikeouts.

3-4 IN THE LINEUP: Holding opponents to a .091 AVG (3-for-33)/.239 OPS with 1 walk and 8 strikeouts in his last 6 games (5 starts).

- In 16 games (14 starts), is holding hitters 3-4 to a .185 AVG (15-for-81)/.233 OBP with 5 walks and 14 strikeouts.
- In his last 3 home starts, hitters 3-4 are batting .056 (1-for-18)/.167 OPS with 0 walks and 5 strikeouts.

RUN SUPPORT: Is 2-1 with a 4.34 ERA (14 ER in 29.0 IP) when the D-backs score 3-5 runs and 3-0 with a 3.06 ERA (6 ER in 17.2 IP) when they score 6+ runs in a game.

2023 RECAP: Made his first Opening Day roster and went on to make 29 appearances (27 starts).

- In 27 starts, was 7-8 with a 5.53 ERA (85 ER in 138.1 IP)...in 2 relief outings, was 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA (0 ER in 5.2 IP).
- Tossed 5.1 scoreless innings with a career-low 1 hit allowed on May 17 @ Athletics.
- On June 25 @ Giants, tossed a career-high-tying 7.0 innings...after a first-inning, 2-out walk to J.D. Davis, retired 15 consecutive batters until a sixth-inning, 2-out walk to Michael Conforto).

2023 POSTSEASON: Made 3 relief appearances (5.68 ERA, 4 ER in 6.1 IP).

2022 DEBUT: Debuted in 2022 with 3 starts.

- Made his Major League debut on Sept. 5, 2022 @ Padres with 7.0 shutout innings, 4 hits, 0 walks and 7 strikeouts...after allowing a leadoff double, retired 17 straight batters (5 strikeouts) until the sixth inning with 2 outs (Jurickson Profar double)

2021 MILB PITCHER OF THE YEAR: Named D-backs' 2021 Minor League Pitcher of the Year...in 22 starts at High-A Hillsboro and Double-A Amarillo, went 7-4 with a 3.17 ERA (41 ER in 116.1 IP), opponent .206 AVG, 40 walks and 163 strikeouts...tied for fourth among all Minor Leaguers in strikeouts.

HOW HE STARTED: D-backs' second-round pick (No. 56) in the 2019 draft.

- Attended the University of Oregon...as a junior in 2019, was First-Team All-Pac-12, led the conference with 104 strikeouts and finished fourth in the nation with a 14.40 K/9 IP.
