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BIRDLAND BITES: Baltimore swept the Astros in a three-game set in Houston coming out of the All-Star break over the weekend to extend its winning streak to a season-high seven games...The club has won 10 of 13 to move within two games of .500, the closest the team has been to .500 since June 5 (31-33)...The Orioles open a three-game series in Boston tonight before an off day on Thursday...The O's return home on Friday for a three-game set against Atlanta...The Birds are 8.0 games behind Tampa Bay in the AL East and 2.0 games back in the Wild Card.

⚾ After opening the year 13-23 (.361) on the road through June 19, the Orioles are 8-3 away from Camden Yards.

⚾ Baltimore was hit by four pitches yesterday, matching a franchise record for the fifth time, joining June 28 (G2), 2006 vs. Philadelphia, May 10, 2001 at Tampa Bay, August 17, 2000 vs. Chicago-AL, and August 9, 1968 vs. California.

⚾ The Birds swiped a season-high four bases on Sunday.

⚾ **Brandon Young** allowed one run in 7.0 innings to improve to 8-2 and lower his ERA to 3.25...The Orioles are now 13-3 in his 16 starts this year.

⚾ **Gunnar Henderson** stole home on a double steal in the third inning yesterday, the first steal of home by an Oriole since **Ryan Mountcastle** on August 14, 2025 vs. Seattle.

WE'RE GOING STREAKING: The current seven-game winning streak is the longest by the Orioles since 2023 when the team had three separate streaks of 7+ wins in a row: September 2-9 (7 G), July 5-16 (8 G), and April 16-24 (7 G).

⚾ The Orioles have won at least seven games in a row when starting the streak at least nine games under .500 for the first time since winning 10 in a row from July 3-13, 2022 (35-44 when streak began).

⚾ Boston has won 13 games in a row, marking the fourth time Baltimore will face a team with a 13+ game winning streak, joining April 25, 2021 vs. Oakland (13 G), September 8-10, 2017 at Cleveland (15, 16, & 17 G), and June 17, 1991 vs. Minnesota (15 G).

⚾ The Red Sox and Orioles both enter this series with winning streaks of at least seven games...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, this will be the fifth time in the expansion era (since 1961) that two teams will play each other while riding winning streaks of 7+ games, joining June 23, 2023: Cincinnati (11) beat Atlanta (8), August 23, 2021: New York-AL beat Atlanta (9), September 19, 2008: Miami (8) beat Philadelphia (7), and June 30, 1975: Chicago-AL beat Oakland (both 8)

BRAD TO THE BONE: The O's agreed to terms on a five-year contract with right-handed pitcher Kyle Bradish on Saturday, extending him through 2031...He finished fourth in the AL Cy Young voting in 2023 before undergoing right elbow reconstruction with internal brace on June 19, 2024...Among pitchers with at least 60 starts since the start of 2023, Bradish's 3.03 ERA ranks 10th in the majors.

MAKING THEIR PITCH: The O's have posted a 3.46 ERA in 49 games since May 24, the third-best ERA in the majors during that time behind the Tigers (3.16) and Red Sox (3.35)...Entering that day, the Orioles had a 4.95 ERA in the first 51 games of the year, second worst in MLB ahead of the Astros (5.16).

⚾ The rotation has posted a 3.54 ERA since May 24, the fourth-best starter ERA in the AL and sixth best in the majors...Entering that day, O's starters had a 5.13 ERA, second worst in MLB ahead of the Rockies (5.55).

⚾ Orioles relievers have a 2.71 ERA since June 16, the second best in the majors behind the Yankees (2.61)...Entering that day, the team's bullpen ERA was 4.53, ranked ninth in the AL and 21st in MLB.

WALKING IT OUT: Baltimore has drawn at least one walk in 91 straight games since April 6, the longest active streak in the majors ahead of the Mets (32 G)...The Orioles have drawn multiple walks in a season-high 20 straight games, their longest run since a 21-game stretch from July 20-August 10, 2024.

⚾ **Taylor Ward** has drawn a free pass in career-high-tying nine straight games, the longest active streak in MLB...He also drew a walk in nine straight earlier this season from April 20-30, which trails only ATH's Nick Kurtz (20 G) for the longest such streak in the majors this year.

⚾ Ward has 79 walks this season, 17 more than an Oriole had in 2025 and one more than the team leader had in 2024...The last O's player with more than 78 walks in a season was **Adley Rutschman** (92 BB) in 2023...An Oriole has not reached 100 free passes in a season since Albert Belle (101) in 1999.

⚾ The Birds have been held without a free pass only once this season (4/5 at PIT).

⚾ Overall, the O's lead the AL and rank fourth in MLB with 388 walks.

FOR PETE'S SAKE: **Pete Alonso** is tied for third in the AL and is tied for ninth in the majors with 66 RBI...He is batting .268/.365/.508 (68-for-254) with 10 doubles, 17 homers, 44 runs, 53 RBI, 37 walks, and four hit-by-pitches in 69 games since May 1.

⚾ Alonso became the 21st player (28th occurrence) in Orioles history to hit at least 20 homers before the All-Star break and the first since **Gunnar Henderson** (28) and Anthony Santander (24) in 2024.

⚾ He also became the 24th player (31st occurrence) in O's history to drive in 60 runs before the All-Star break and the first since **Gunnar Henderson** (63) in 2024...His 65 RBI pre-break were the most by an Oriole since Manny Machado (65) in 2018.

⚾ Alonso played in his 500th consecutive game on June 27 vs. Washington and he has played 516 straight games, trailing ATL's Matt Olson (880 G) among active players...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, he is one of 39 players since 1900 to play in at least 500 consecutive games.

PHILLY PHILLY: **Adley Rutschman** was named to the 2026 All-Star Game, earning his third career selection (2023 & 2024)...He entered in the seventh inning as a defensive replacement, grounding out in the eighth inning in his only at-bat.

⚾ Rutschman is the fourth catcher in Orioles history (since 1954) to earn multiple All-Star Game selections, joining Matt Wieters (4), Gus Triandos (3), and Andy Etchebarren (2).

⚾ According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, Rutschman is one of six catchers in MLB to earn at least three All-Star Game selections in their first five full seasons since 1990, joining Brian McCann (4), Mike Piazza (4), Ivan Rodriguez (4), Jason Kendall (3), and Salvador Perez (3).

AROUND BIRDLAND: Catcher **Luis Dias** and infielder **Maicor Degollado** both participated in the Dominican Summer League All-Star Game on Sunday, leading the AL to a 7-6 victory...Dias started at first base and went 1-for-2 with a single, while Degollado earned MVP honors after hitting a pinch-hit go-ahead solo home run in the eighth inning...The Orioles have now had three of the last four players to win DSL All-Star Game MVP, along with Laurens Sosa (2025) and Luis Vicioso (2023).

QUICK HITS: Baz is scheduled to make his 20th start as an Oriole after being acquired from the Tampa Bay Rays in exchange for four minor leaguers and a 2026 Competitive Balance Round A pick on December 19, 2025...The O's and Baz agreed to terms on a five-year contract extension on March 27 that covers the 2026-30 seasons.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision on July 12 vs. Kansas City after throwing a season-low-tying 4.2 innings (also 5/9 vs. ATH), allowing two runs on eight hits with zero walks and a season-high-tying nine strikeouts (3x, last: 6/18 at SEA)...Threw 104 pitches, 70 strikes.
⚡ Snapped a streak of 17 straight starts with 1+ walk.
⚡ Produced a season-high 19 whiffs, his most since July 1, 2025 vs. the Athletics (20).

SHIPPING UP TO BOSTON: Baz is set to make his seventh career start against Boston, having gone 4-1 with a 2.63 ERA (11 ER/37.2 IP).
⚡ In four starts at Fenway Park, he is 2-1 with a 2.92 ERA (8 ER/24.2 IP), including a win earlier this season on June 2 (7.0 IP, 4 H, 2 ER, 2 BB, 6 K).

CONTROLLING THE LONG BALL: In 25 starts since August 26, 2025, Baz has permitted nine home runs over 140.0 innings (0.58 HR/9.0 IP)...Over his first 26 starts of the 2025 campaign, he allowed 26 homers over 138.0 innings (1.70 HR/9.0 IP).
⚡ He has allowed one or zero home runs in each of the 25 outings, the third-longest active streak among all MLB starters behind KC's Kris Bubic (35 G) and STL's Andre Pallante (32 G).
⚡ The only other Oriole in franchise history (since 1954) to pitch at least 4.0 innings without allowing more than one home run in each of their first 19 starts with the team is Jim Hardin (19 GS, 1967-68).

ROUNDING INTO FORM: Over his last 10 starts since May 20, Baz has posted a 3.28 ERA (22 ER/60.1 IP) and a 1.28 WHIP after recording a 5.26 ERA (30 ER/51.1 IP) and a 1.52 WHIP across his first nine outings.
⚡ Baz has 32 strikeouts over his last five starts after fanning 10 hitters in his previous three outings from June 2-12.

FASTBALL FOCUS: In his last start against the Royals, opponents went 3-for-6 with two doubles off his four-seam fastball...In his prior outing on July 7 vs. Chicago-NL, he limited the Cubs to an 0-for-8 clip on the offering.
⚡ Over six June starts, Baz limited the opposition to a .158 (6-for-38) clip with three doubles on his four-seam fastball after they hit .241 (7-for-29) with two doubles and one home run against the offering in five May starts.
⚡ Overall, he is holding right-handed hitters to a .200 (7-for-35) mark on his four-seamer, while lefties are batting .253 (21-for-83).

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Entering play today, Baz has allowed an MLB-high 35 doubles, ahead of COL's Tomoyuki Sugano (30)...On April 21 at Kansas City, Baz permitted a career-high five doubles.
⚡ He has given up 4+ doubles in three of his 19 starts in 2026, having allowed four doubles in three of his 54 career starts entering this season.
⚡ Only four O's starters (five occurrences) have allowed 4+ doubles four times in a season: Brad Bergesen (2010), Mike Mussina (2000, 1996), Pat Rapp (2000), and Scott Erickson (1996).
⚡ His 35 doubles were the most allowed by an Oriole pitcher in the first half of the season in club history (since 1954), ahead of Rodrigo López (34, 2006).

FIRST INNING STRUGGLES: Baz owns a 5.68 ERA (12 ER/19.0 IP) in the first inning while allowing nine walks and an .890 opponent OPS.
⚡ He has, however, been scoreless in each of his last three first innings after allowing two runs on June 23 at Los Angeles-AL and three runs on June 18 at Seattle.
⚡ From innings 2-4, he has posted a 3.16 ERA (20 ER/57.0 IP) with 15 walks and a .658 opponent OPS.

TEEING OFF EARLY: Opponents are slashing .365/.375/.635 (23-for-63) with 11 doubles and two home runs off Baz on the first pitch of an at-bat...His 1.010 opponent OPS on the first pitch is fifth highest in MLB (min. 60 BF), ahead of KC's Seth Lugo (1.269), TEX's Nathan Eovaldi (1.253), SEA's Logan Gilbert (1.095), and CHC's Colin Rea (1.075).
