**LAST GAME:** The D-backs lost 7-2 @ Tigers on Wednesday.

- Geraldo Perdomo** had his fourth 3-hit game since the All-Star break (July 18), the most by an NL short-stop...his 10 games with 3+ hits overall in 2025 ranked tied for fourth among NL shortstops (also: Xander Bogaerts/SD)...was also his 20th multi-RBI game, the most by a NL shortstop this season.
- Corbin Carroll** hit safely (double) in his third straight game...was his 54th extra-base hit (T-6th in MLB)...over the 3 games @ Tigers, hit .364 (4-for-11)/1.053 OPS with 1 double, 1 triple and 1 walk.
- Ryne Nelson** (L; 4 R-1 ER in 5.1 IP, 0 BB, 8 K) has allowed 2 earned runs or fewer in 8 of his last 9 starts (1 or 0 ER in 7 of them)...since June 13, is 4-1 with a 1.95 ERA (11 ER in 50.2 IP), opponent .192 AVG (25-for-182), 0.95 WHIP, 13 walks and 43 strikeouts...since June 13, his 1.95 ERA ranks sixth lowest among NL starters.

**TODAY'S ROSTER MOVES:** The D-backs reinstated LHP **Jalen Beeks** from the 15-day injured list (lower back inflammation), selected LHP **Kyle Nelson** (No. 24) and INF **Connor Kaiser** (No. 65) to the Major League roster, activated/reported INF **Tyler Locklear** (No. 28) to the roster, and optioned LHP **Brandyn Garcia** and INF **Tristin English** to Triple-A Reno.

**TRADE DEADLINE RECAP:** The D-backs made the following transactions before the 2025 MLB trade deadline:

- July 24: Acquired LHP **Brandyn Garcia** and RHP **Ashton Izzi** from the Mariners for INF **Josh Naylor**.
- July 26: Acquired RHP **Andrew Hoffmann** (optioned to Triple-A Reno) from the Royals for OF **Randal Grichuk**.
- July 31: Acquired INF **Tyler Locklear**, RHP **Juan Burgos** and RHP **Hunter Cranton** from the Mariners for INF **Eugenio Suárez**.
- July 31: Acquired LHP **Kohl Drake**, LHP **Mitch Bratt** and RHP **David Hagaman** from the Rangers for RHP **Merrill Kelly**.
- July 31: Traded RHP **Shelby Miller** and LHP **Jordan Montgomery** to the Brewers for a player to be named or cash considerations.

**JULY RECAP:** The D-backs led the Majors in the month of July with 8 triples, ahead of the Red Sox (7) and Athletics (5)...Arizona has now recorded 8+ triples over 3 consecutive July's (also: 10 in 2024, 9 in 2023).

- Geraldo Perdomo** led the D-backs' offense in July, batting .322 (29-for-90)/.431 OBP/.456 SLG/.887 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 triple, 2 homers, 17 RBI, 15 walks (10 K), 3 hit-by-pitches and 2 stolen bases...among NL shortstops in July, Perdomo ranked in OBP (1st, .431), pitches seen (1st, 447), walks (1st, 15), hit-by-pitches (1st, 3), singles (T-1st, 22), RBI (2nd, 17), OPS (2nd, .887), AVG (3rd, .322), SLG (3rd, .456) and hits (3rd, 29).
- Ryne Nelson** (5 GS, 2-1, 2.22 ERA; 7 ER in 28.1 IP, 7 BB, 22 K) led the D-backs' starting pitching in July...was ninth in ERA among NL starting pitchers in July.
- Relievers **Anthony DeSclafani** (4 G, 1-0, 1 SV, 0.75 ERA; 1 ER in 12.0 IP, .171 AVG, 3 XBH, 4 BB, 11 K) and **Andrew Saalfrank** (6 G, 0-0, 0.00 ERA; 0 ER in 7.1 IP, .214 AVG, 0 XBH, 3 BB, 7 K) highlighted the D-backs' bullpen during the month.

**VS. ATHLETICS:** The D-backs have won each of their last 2 series vs. Athletics (2-1 from June 28-30, 2024 @ home; 2-1 from May 15-17 on the road).

- During Spring Training, the D-backs played 2 games vs. Athletics in Las Vegas (March 8-9; 1-1 split).

**MCKAY AND THE A'S:** D-backs' first base coach **Dave McKay**, the longest active tenured coach in the Majors (41st season), was an infielder with the Athletics from 1980-82.

- Coached in the A's organization from 1984-95 and was Tony La Russa's first base coach for 7 seasons (1989-95), including the 1989 World Champion team.
- His son, Cody, was drafted by the Athletics in 1996.

**DANGEROUS FROM 1-2 SPOTS:** From the 1-2 lineup spots, the D-backs lead the Majors in OPS (.872), OBP (.358), SLG (.514), extra-base hits (105), RBI (131) and triples (15)...are second in homers (49, behind Dodgers/52).

**PERDOMO'S CAREER SEASON:** **Geraldo Perdomo** has already set career bests in various categories at just over 100 games into his campaign:

**CARROLL'S 40 CAREER TRIPLES & 5 IN JULY:** **Corbin Carroll** collected his 40th triple in his 436th career game on Tuesday @ Tigers...since the divisional era (1969), became the seventh player to reach 40+ triples in their first 436 career games, joining Dexter Fowler/COL (40, 2012), Curtis Granderson/DET (40, 2008), Jose Reyes/NYM (40, 2006), Carl Crawford/TB (40, 2005), Juan Samuel/PHI (43, 1986) and Garry Templeton/STL (42, 1979).

- Since he entered the Majors in 2022, his 40 triples lead the Majors, trailed by Jarren Duran/BOS (31) and Bobby Witt Jr./KC (31).
- In July, he became the fifth D-back all-time to collect 5+ triples in a month, joining Chris Owings (5 in Aug. 2016), David Peralta (franchise-high 6 in July 2015), Stephen Drew (5 in July 2009) and Eric Byrnes (5 in May 2007).
- Carroll and Zach McKinstry/DET (June 2025) are the only players to hit 5+ triples in a month this season.

**LEADOFF TRIPLES & HOMERS:** Since 1901, **Corbin Carroll** is the only player to collect 5+ leadoff triples and 5+ lead-off homers within their first 100 games of a season...he is 1 of 3 players all-time to do so in an entire season:

**ON-BASE MACHINE:** Since July 1, **Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base in 22 of his 25 games, hitting .322 (29-for-90)/.431 OBP/.456 SLG/.887 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 triple, 2 homers, 17 RBI and 15 walks (10 K)...his 47 times on base in the span rank second in the NL, behind Fernando Tatis Jr./SD (49), and tied for seventh in the Majors.

**TRENDING BATS:** **Corbin Carroll** has hit safely in 6 straight interleague matchups (July 21-23 vs. Astros and July 28-30 @ Tigers)...batting .292 with 3 doubles, 1 triple, 2 RBI, 1 walk, 1 stolen base and only 4 strikeouts...since 2023, Carroll's 12 triples in interleague matchups are second in the Majors, behind Jarren Duran/BOS (13).

- Ketel Marte**, since June 1, has reached in 22 of his last 26 road games, hitting .354 (35-for-99)/.443 OBP/.636 SLG/1.080 OPS with 7 doubles, 7 homers, 18 RBI and 16 walks (13 K).

NEXT STARTER: RHP ZAC GALLEN (7-12, 5.60)

- In 3 career starts vs. Athletics, is 1-0 with a 1.06 ERA (2 ER in 17.0 IP), opponent .121 AVG (7-for-58), 0.65 WHIP, 4 walks and 23 strikeouts.

**AT A GLANCE:** First season with the D-backs...signed as a Major League free agent on June 15.

- 12th season in the Majors along with Marlins (2014), Reds (2015-20, did not pitch in 2017), Giants (2021-23), Twins (2024, did not pitch in 2024).
- In 2024, acquired by the Twins on January 29, 2024, from the Mariners, but missed the entire season after suffering a right elbow strain in Spring Training that require forearm flexor tendon surgery.
- In 2021 with the Giants, set career bests with 13 wins, 3.17 ERA, .225 OPP AVG, .634 OPP AVG.

**SNAKEBITES:** Second start for the D-backs.

- Made his first Major League start since July 18, 2023 on July 6 vs. Royals...in 4.0 innings, allowed 4 runs on 4 hits with 0 walks and 6 strikeouts.
- First road start since July 18, 2023 @ Reds (4 ER in 2.0 IP).
- His last Major League season was 2023 with the Giants...in 19 games (18 starts), went 3-8 with a 4.88 ERA (59 R-54 ER), opponent .271 AVG (105-for-388)/.767 OPS, 20 walks and 79 strikeouts.
- In 2022, made 2 rehab starts with Triple-A Sacramento...made 1 start @ Sutter Health Park on June 11, 2022 vs. Reno (0 ER in 3.0 IP).

**2025 OVERVIEW:** Signed by the D-backs on June 15...released by the Yankees on June 12...signed by the Yankees on May 13.

- In 5 starts for Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (NYY) from May 17-June 10, went 1-1 with a 4.50 ERA (11 R-10 ER in 20.0 IP), an opponent .300 AVG (24-for-80)/.796 OPS, 9 walks and 20 strikeouts.

**AS A STARTER:** Has worked primarily as a starting pitcher with 169 starts and 11 relief appearances in 180 career games.

- In 170 career starts, is 53-57 with a 4.20 ERA (474 R-434 ER in 929.2 IP), opponent .260 AVG (927-for-3,566)/.742 OPS, 248 walks and 823 strikeouts.
- Had a career-best 31 starts in 2015 (Reds), 2019 (Reds) and 2021 (Giants).
- Debut in 2014 with the Marlins with 5 starts from May 14-June 27 then was recalled and made 8 relief appearances the remainder of the season.
