**THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY**  
**JUNE 29**  
**2005** - **Craig Biggio** is hit by a pitch for the 268th time to set a modern Major League record, surpassing **Don Baylor**...Biggio homers his next time up in what ends up as a 7-1 win vs. Colorado...Biggio would end his career with 285 hit by pitches, a record that will likely never be surpassed...the active leader in HBP is **Starling Marte**, who's been hit by a pitch 168 times in his career.

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Astros will wear their City Connect uniforms tonight as they open a week-long, six-game homestand with the first of three games against the visiting Twins...**RHP Peter Lambert** (6-4), who's won four straight decisions, will open the homestand for Houston opposite **RHP Zebby Matthews** (3-5) and the Twins.

**RIDING THE LAMBO:** Tonight's Astros starter **RHP Peter Lambert** has posted a 4-0 record in his last six starts with a 2.97 ERA (11ER/33.1IP)...Lambert's four wins since May 24 are tied for tops in the AL in that span, along with six other pitchers, including teammate **RHP Tatsuya Imai**...Lambert pitched last year for the Tokyo Yakult Swallows in the NPB, posting a 3.98 ERA (55ER/124.1IP) with 111 strikeouts in 23 appearances in Japan...he began this season at Triple A Sugar Land (1.84 ERA in three appearances) before being called up April 17.

**THE SLOW TURNAROUND:** After a slow start to the season, the Astros are 22-13 since May 21, which is the best record in the AL in that span...on that date, the Astros were 20-31, 11 games under, which is their low water mark for the season.

**RECENT 'STROS:** The Astros have won five of six, six of eight, and nine of their last 12 games...the Astros 15-10 record in June is tops in the AL.

**SERIES-LY SPEAKING:** The Astros have won five consecutive series dating back to June 12, posting a 11-5 record in those games...the last time the Astros won five straight series was from June 20-July 6 of last season (went 12-3 in that stretch).

**WINNING THE CLOSE CALLS:** The Astros are 9-4 in one-run games and 18-10 in two-run games...each of the Astros last six wins and 11 of their last 12 victories have come by two-or-fewer runs.

**PEN PALS:** The Astros bullpen continued to roll yesterday, allowing just one earned run in 4.0 innings in the 7-5, comeback win...since May 15, the Astros bullpen has been the best in the AL, posting a 2.62 ERA (44ER/151.1P) in that span...the Astros are 25-16 since May 15.

**YESTERDAY IN DETROIT:** The Astros picked up another comeback victory yesterday in Detroit, as they rallied back from a 3-0 deficit in the 7th for a 7-5 win in 10 innings...the three biggest swings were produced by **2B Raynel Delgado** (1x4, HR, RBI), **3B Isaac Paredes** (3x5, HR, 2RBI) and **1B Christian Walker** (1x4, HR, 3RBI), who all hit decisive home runs in the contest...**RHP Hunter Brown** (2ER/6IP) picked up a quality start, while **LHP Josh Hader** (0ER/1IP) earned the win in relief.

**ROAD TRIPPIN':** With their win yesterday in Detroit, the Astros completed a seven-game road trip, in which they went 5-2 with stops in Toronto (2-1) and Detroit (3-1)...the Astros are 15-8 in their last three road trips combined and are 21-14 on the road since going 1-9 on their first road trip of the 2026 season.

**TODAY'S ROSTER MOVE:** The Astros have reinstated **IF Nick Allen** from the 10-day IL and have optioned **IF Raynel Delgado** to Triple A Sugar Land...Allen is returning from a left hamstring strain, which sidelined him since June 8.

**FROM THE TRAINER'S ROOM:** The Astros have nine players on the Injured List...updates on a few:

- **RHP Ronel Blanco** (rt. elbow surgery) has made two rehab starts this month, last pitching on Thursday for Double A Corpus Christi (0ER/3.1IP)...he tossed 50 pitches (31 strikes) in the outing.
- **RHP Cristian Javier** (rt. shoulder strain) made his fifth rehab start on Saturday for Triple A Sugar Land, working 6.0 shutout innings on 85 pitches.
- **RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** (rt. shoulder inflammation) began his rehab assignment on Thursday at Triple A, tossing 3.0 scoreless innings and 42 pitches.
- **LHP Bennett Sousa** (lt. elbow inflammation) continues his bullpen progression.
- **LHP Brandon Walter** (lt. elbow surgery) continues his throwing progression in West Palm Beach.
- **RHP Hayden Wesneski** (rt. elbow surgery) is scheduled to begin a rehab assignment with the FCL Astros later this week.
- **OF LaMonte Wade Jr.** (rt. hamstring strain) is set to begin a rehab assignment at Triple A this week.
- **IF Braden Shewmake** (rt. adductor strain) has played in two games for the FCL Astros on his rehab assignment, including a start at third base earlier today (2x3, 2B, BB).

**MVP-CALIBER:** **DH Yordan Alvarez** has had a torrid first half to his season, currently leading all of baseball in OPS (1.039), OBP (.426), SLG (.613) and total bases (185)...additionally, he ranks tied for first in the AL in homers (25) and extra-base hits (41), while ranking second in batting average (.311), second in hits (94), second in runs (58), fourth in walks (57), and tied for fifth in RBI.

**MINOR LEAGUE HONORS:** **LHP Colton Gordon** has been named the Triple A Pacific Coast League Pitcher of the Week (June 22-28)...Gordon made one start last week for Sugar Land, which came yesterday vs. El Paso, in which he tossed 6.0 shutout innings, allowing just one hit and one walk.

**WELCOME BACK VIC!:** The Astros are happy to welcome back Twins **C Victor Caratini**, who spent the last two seasons (2024-25) in Houston...Caratini appeared in 201 games as an Astro, in which he hit 22 doubles, 20 home runs and 76 RBI.

**WHOSE HOUSE? COOGS HOUSE!:** In honor of City Connect Monday, newly introduced **University of Houston** baseball coach **Will Davis** and second-year University of Houston women's basketball coach **Matthew Mitchell** will both throw out ceremonial first pitches...Davis will coach the Cougars next season in the 2027 BRUCE BOLT College Classic, which will feature UH, **Texas A&M, Louisiana, Louisville, UConn** and **Utah**.

**ON THE RADIO:** The Astros English radio broadcast on KBME SportsTalk 790 for this series will feature **Steve Sparks** and **Garrett Greene**, who's subbing for **Robert Ford**...Green currently serves as the Triple A Sugar Land Space Cowboys Media Relations Manager and Radio Broadcaster.

**LAST START, JUNE 23 at TOR:** Allowed 2 runs on 6 hits and 3 walks with 6 strikeouts in 4.2 innings...didn't factor into the decision, but the Astros defeated the Blue Jays, 9-7 in 11 innings.

**THE LAMBO:** A minor league free-agent signing this offseason, Lambert has become a stabilizing force in the Astros rotation since making his season debut in mid-April...has recorded a quality start in 5 of his 12 outings, including 2 scoreless outings...has also pitched 6.0+ innings in 6 of his 12 starts...among AL pitchers with 60.0+ innings pitched this season, Lambert ranks 9th in H/9IP (6.82) and 9th in opponent batting average (.207)...began the year at Triple A Sugar Land before being added to the Major League roster on April 17.

**STREAKING:** Enters tonight's start carrying a career-long, 4-game winning streak, which span his last 6 starts...within the streak, he's posted a 2.97 ERA (11ER/33.1IP)...the streak ties as the longest by an Astro this season, also reached by **RHP Spencer Arrighetti** (April 15-May 2).

**HIGH FIVE:** Prior to his last start, worked 5.0+ innings in a career-best 8 consecutive starts (May 5-June 17), surpassing a 6-game streak from Aug. 12-Sept. 10, 2023...has worked 5.0+ innings in all but 2 of his 11 starts this season (4.1 IP on April 30 at BAL-Gm 1 and 4.2 IP on June 23 at TOR).

**SLIDER COMBO:** Is having his greatest MLB success with his slider, holding opponents to a .167 average on the pitch (6x36)...opponents had combined to hit .313 (50x160) vs. his slider through his first 4 MLB seasons...in 2024, his last season in the Majors prior to this year, opponents batted .340 (18x53) vs. his slider.

**TOE-TO-TOE WITH 'SHO':** Logged the best start of his career on May 5 vs. LAD, outdueling **Shohei Ohtani** by allowing just 3 hits over 7.0 innings with 4 walks and 4 strikeouts...received the winning decision in the Astros 2-1 victory...matched his career-high with 7.0 innings, which he's now accomplished 5 times (last on June 17 vs. DET).

**WITH THE SPACE COWBOYS:** Did not make the Major League team out of Spring Training and was granted his release on March 24...re-signed to a minor league deal on March 27 and began the year at Triple A Sugar Land...made 3 appearances, including 2 starts for Sugar Land to begin the 2026 season...in those 3 appearances, he recorded a 1.84 ERA (3ER/14.2IP) with 12 strikeouts, a 0.95 WHIP and a .208 opponent batting average...added to the Major League roster on April 17.

**2025 SEASON:** Spent the 2025 season with the Tokyo Yakult Swallows in the Nippon Professional Baseball League...made 23 appearances for the Swallows, recording a 3.98 ERA (55ER/124.1IP) with 111 strikeouts, 54 walks and a 1.44 WHIP.

**ABOUT LAMBERT:** Right-handed pitcher joined the Astros on a minor league deal this offseason...prior to this year, had appeared at the Major League level in 4 seasons with the Colorado Rockies (2019, 2021, 2023-24)...in 74 Major League appearances with the Rockies, including 35 starts, he recorded a 6.28 ERA (170ER/243.2IP) with 181 strikeouts...was selected by the Rockies in the 2nd round of the 2015 MLB Draft out of San Dimas High School.

**FAMILY TIES:** Has an older brother, **RHP Jimmy Lambert**, who pitched in parts of four seasons (2020-23) in the Majors with the Chicago White Sox...in 83 career appearances, he recorded a 4.33 ERA (48ER/99.2IP) with 98 strikeouts.

LAST APPEARANCE (6/28 at DET): Allowed 1 hit and 1 walk in 0.2 of a scoreless inning yesterday at DET.

TURNING THE PAGE: Has gone 2-1 with 4 saves and a 2.55 ERA (5ER/17.2IP) in his last 20 apps., dating back to May 3...within these apps., he logged 9 consecutive scoreless outings (8.2 IP) from May 3-28...his 9-game scoreless streak is the 2nd-longest by an Astro this season, behind LHP Steven Okert (14-game streak).

ALL-TIME ASTRO RANKINGS: Made his 348 career appearances yesterday at DET, tying LHP Joe Sambito for the 5th-most relied appearances in Astros franchise history...also ranks 4th all-time among Astros relievers in strikeouts (482) and 10th in innings pitched (356.2).

CAREER: In 348 career games with the Astros, he's recorded a 2.90 ERA (115ER/356.2IP) with 482 strikeouts, a 1.22 WHIP, a 12.16 K/9 and a 0.78 HR/9...since 2019, he ranks 1st in strikeouts and 2nd in appearances among active AL relievers.
