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BIRDLAND BITES: Baltimore opens a six-game road trip tonight through Toronto (3 to play) and New York-NL (3 to play)...The Birds are coming off a 2-5 homestand, having been swept in a four-game set by the Red Sox before taking two of three from the Guardains...Baltimore is 3.0 games behind Cleveland for the final Wild Card spot with Toronto (1.0 GB) and Texas (2.0 GB) also in the mix.

👉 The O's earned a rubber-match victory on Wednesday behind an eight-run third inning... The eighth runs matched a season high for an inning, joining August 25 at St. Louis (5th inn.)...The Birds tallied a season-high eight hits in the frame, their most since July 26, 2025 vs. Colorado in the seventh inning.

👉 Baltimore had 14 plate appearances in the third frame, its most since July 22, 2006 at Tampa Bay.

👉 The Birds went 6-for-9 (.667) with runners in scoring position after going 5-for-39 (.128) over the first six games of the homestand.

👉 Oriole relievers own an MLB-best 2.11 ERA since August 21, ahead of the Guardians (2.13) and Padres (2.21)...Their eight saves during that period are tied for the most in the majors along with the Astros and Pirates.

BIRDS OF A FEATHER: The O's have hit multiple home runs in four straight games against the Blue Jays on the road since September 14, 2025...It is one game shy of the team-record five-game streak from September 6, 2015-June 12, 2016.

👉 **Colton Cowser** has hit safely in each of his last six games against Toronto, including an RBI in each of the last four contests, batting .474 (9-for-19) with one double, three home runs, five runs, and seven RBI...Cowser is 2-for-6 with two home runs in his career off Max Scherzer.

👉 **Chris Bassitt** is 23-13 with a 3.45 ERA (121 ER/315.2 IP) in 53 career starts at Rogers Centre...The 23 wins are the third most among all active pitchers at the venue behind TOR's José Berrios (32) and CHC's Kevin Gausman (26).

POLAR VORTEX: **Pete Alonso** ranks among AL leaders in RBI (1st, 97), total bases (3rd, 273), home runs (4th, 34), slugging percentage (5th, .498), OPS (5th, .861), extra-base hits (T-6th, 58), runs (8th, 88), and hits (9th, 147).

👉 Alonso has started all 147 O's games this year, tied for the most starts in MLB along with PHI's Bryce Harper and ATL's Matt Olson...The last Oriole to start every team game in a season was Jonathan Schoop in 2016.

👉 He's played in 563 consecutive games, the second-longest active streak in the majors behind ATL's Matt Olson (929 G).

👉 Alonso leads HOU's Yordan Alvarez (96) for the most RBI in the AL...He looks to become the eighth player in franchise history (since 1954) to lead the AL in RBI, joining Chris Davis (138 RBI, 2013), Miguel Tejada (150 RBI, 2004), Eddie Murray (78 RBI, 1981), Lee May (109 RBI, 1976), Frank Robinson (122 RBI, 1966), Brooks Robinson (118 RBI, 1964), and Jim Gentile (141 RBI, 1961).

👉 According to *STATS Perform*, since RBI became official in 1920, the only players to lead the AL in RBI in their first year playing in the Junior Circuit (including ties) are TEX's Josh Hamilton (130 RBI, 2008), CWS' Dick Allen (113 RBI, 1972), BAL's Frank Robinson (122 RBI, 1966), BOS' Dick Stuart (118 RBI, 1963), and BOS' Ted Williams (145 RBI, 1939).

COBY BEEF: **Coby Mayo** has reached base safely in a career-best 14 straight games, slashing .298/.377/.638 (14-for-47) with one double, five home runs, 12 runs, 12 RBI, and five walks.

👉 It is tied for the seventh-longest active streak in MLB, including tied for second longest in the AL behind HOU's Isaac Paredes (17 G).

👉 Mayo is batting .319/.383/.741 (43-for-135) with nine doubles, 16 home runs, and 33 RBI this year against left-handed pitching...He leads the majors in home runs, slugging percentage, and OPS (1.123) against lefties...The 16 homers are the second most in a season off lefties by an Oriole since Gary Roenicke hit 18 in 1983.

PLAYING THE LONG GAME: The Birds have hit 42 homers since August 9, tied with the Reds for second most in MLB during that time behind the Cubs (57).

👉 During its most recent road series in Colorado, Baltimore hit only one homer during the three-game set...Prior to that, the Orioles had homered in 13 of their last 15 road games, totaling 27 long balls from August 8-30.

PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE: The O's lead the AL and rank fourth in the majors with 544 walks this season behind the Cubs (620 BB), Brewers (609 BB), and Dodgers (557 BB)...The Yankees are second in the AL with 527 free passes.

👉 The team's 31 games with 6+ walks are the most by a Baltimore club since 1999 (35).

👉 The Birds are averaging 3.97 pitches per plate appearance, ranking second in MLB behind the Brewers (3.99).

'PEN PALS: **Josh Walker** hasn't allowed a run in 15 games (12.1 IP) since August 6...It's the longest scoreless streak, by games, by an Oriole since **Yennier Cano** (17 G) from April 14-May 17, 2023.

👉 **Alex Hoppe** has yet to allow an earned run in 14 appearances (11.0 IP) since making his Orioles debut on August 5.

👉 Eleven Baltimore pitchers have recorded at least one save this season, breaking the franchise record since saves became an official statistic in 1969...The Birds are one of seven teams in MLB to have at least 11 players tally at least one save this year, led by the Cubs (14).

NIP AND TUCK: The Orioles are 47-51 in games decided by three runs or fewer, tied for the most such games in the majors this year with the Guardians (51-47)...The .480 winning percentage in those games ranks 19th in the majors.

👉 Baltimore is 16-22 in one-run games this year...The .421 winning percentage ranks 25th in the majors.

KEYS TO VICTORY: Last night, Baltimore's High-A affiliate, the Frederick Keys, dropped Game 2 of the South Atlantic League North Division Championship series to the Greensboro Grasshoppers (PIT), 5-3.

👉 Tonight's Game 3 winner at Nymeo Field will advance to the 2026 SAL Championship series beginning Sunday against the Winston-Salem Dash (CWS)...RHP Christian Rodriguez is scheduled to start for the Keys.

QUICK HITS: Bassitt is scheduled to make his 16th start (18th appearance) of the season...Signed a one-year major league contract with Baltimore on February 13, 2026, to mark his fifth MLB team, following Toronto (2023-25), New York-NL (2022), Oakland (2015-21), and Chicago-AL (2014)...Was selected by Chicago-AL in the 16th round (No. 501 overall) of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft.
⚡ Was placed on the 15-day Injured List (low back discomfort) on June 8, retroactive to June 5, and transferred to the 60-day IL on July 17...Reinstated from the 60-day IL on August 14.
⚡ Reached 10 years of major-league service time in May.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered the loss on September 5 vs. Boston after allowing three runs on five hits and four walks with six strikeouts in 5.2 innings...All three runs scored in the sixth inning, and one came after he left the game...Threw 91 pitches, 54 strikes.
⚡ Tied a season high in walks (also 4/17 at CLE & 3/30 vs. TEX).

BLUE JAY WAY: Has made four career starts against Toronto, going 0-1 with a 3.60 ERA (10 ER/25.0 IP)...In his lone start vs. them this season on May 28 at Camden Yards, Bassitt tossed 6.0 innings of one-run ball on four hits (1 HR), one walk, and one hit batter with two strikeouts in a 2-1 Orioles loss.
⚡ Is 23-13 with a 3.45 ERA (121 ER/315.2 IP) over 53 career starts at Rogers Centre, 51 of which came as a member of the Blue Jays from 2023-25.

A TALE OF TWO PITCH TYPES: Hitters are slashing .202/.302/.294 (22-for-109) with four doubles, two homers, 10 walks, and 27 strikeouts off Bassitt's breaking balls (curve, sweeper, slider) compared to .342/.404/.495 (76-for-222) with 13 doubles, seven homers, 22 walks, and 34 strikeouts on his fastballs (sinker, cutter, four seamer).
⚡ However, his .234 opponent average (18-for-77) on his curveball this season is the second-highest mark of his career ahead of 2015 (.255)...In 2025, his .172 opponent average (17-for-99) on the pitch was fourth lowest in MLB among 20 pitchers that threw 400 or more curveballs.

TO THE LEFT: Bassitt has allowed 21 of his 27 extra-base hits (18 2B, 9 HR) this season to lefties, who are slugging .505 against him compared to a .321 mark for right-handed batters...In 2025, he allowed 38 extra-base hits (22 2B, 3 3B, 13 HR) to left-handed batters, more than double his 18 extra-base hits (9 2B, 9 HR) given up to righties.
⚡ Didn't allow an extra-base hit in his last start on September 5 vs. Boston for the first time since May 5 at Miami.

WEAK CONTACT: Only 14 of Bassitt's 285 batted balls (4.9%) have been barreled this season...The 4.9 percent barrel rate is the second-lowest mark of his career (4.7%, 2015) and ranks in the 88th percentile of MLB.
⚡ His 87.7 mph average exit velocity and his 35.4 percent hard-hit rate both rank in the 72nd percentile of MLB.

U TURN: Over three road starts since returning from the Injured List, Bassitt is 2-0 with a 4.08 ERA (8 ER/17.2 IP).
⚡ He posted an 8.14 ERA (22 ER/24.1 IP) across his first six road starts of the season, allowing opponents to slash .353/.451/.569 (36-for-103) with seven doubles and five home runs.

MAKING THE ADJUSTMENT: The first time through the lineup, opponents are batting .336 (44-for-131) with eight doubles, five home runs, 16 walks, and a .930 OPS.
⚡ Those figures drop to .284 (38-for-134) with eight doubles, three home runs, 10 walks, and a .748 OPS the second time through, and .260 (20-for-77) with two doubles, one home run, seven walks, and a .670 OPS the third time around.

TIME OF THE SEASON: Bassitt is 29-20 with a 3.23 ERA (166 ER/463.0 IP) over 86 career appearances (78 GS) in the months of August and September compared to 60-49 with a 3.95 ERA (392 ER/892.1 IP) in 161 career games (153 GS) from March-July...He holds a 4.34 ERA (14 ER/29.0 IP) in five starts since August 14 after pitching to a 5.27 ERA (33 ER/56.1 IP) over his first 12 games (10 GS) of the year.
⚡ Held a 4.24 ERA (58 ER/123.0 IP) with a .274 opponent average (135-for-492) in his first 23 games (22 GS) last season from March-July...Recorded a 3.23 ERA (17 ER/47.1 IP) and .223 opponent average (39-for-175) in nine starts from August-September.

WORK HORSE: Bassitt is one of 28 active MLB pitchers to have reached 1,300 career innings, which he did on April 22 at Kansas City... Entering the 2026 campaign, he was one of seven MLB pitchers to have made at least 30 starts in each of the past four seasons, joining Toronto's José Berrios, Dylan Cease, and Patrick Corbin, Chicago-NL's Kevin Gausman, Miles Mikolas, and SF's Logan Webb.
