AT A GLANCE: The Yankees continue their season-long 10-game homestand today with the second game of a three-game set vs. Toronto (1-0 thus far)...will also play a three-game series vs. Houston (Tues.-Thurs.) and a four-game set vs. Boston (8/28-30)...went 4-2 on their recent six-game road trip after going 1-2 at Toronto and sweeping a three-game set at Baltimore.

- **Their 73-55 (.570) record is the second-best in the American League and the sixth-best in the Majors**, trailing only Milwaukee (80-49, .620), Los Angeles-NL (78-51, .605), Tampa Bay (76-52, .594), Atlanta (75-54, .581) and Chicago-NL (74-55, .574).
- **Have won each of their last five games (since 8/16), seven of their last 10 games (since 8/11) and nine of their last 13 games (since 8/7)...are 19-11 in their last 30 games (since 7/19) and 23-13 in their last 36 games (since 7/9).**
- **The Yankees' five-game winning streak matches their second-longest of the season**, trailing only an eight-game streak from 4/17-25 (also 5G from 5/24-29 and 5/1-5).
- Have had 25 of their last 35 games decided by 2R-or-fewer (since 7/10), going 17-8 in those games...are 37-28 (.569) in games decided by 2R-or-fewer this season...their 37 wins in games decided by 2R-or-fewer are the most in the AL and tied for the second-most in the Majors.
- **Have won four of their last six completed series (since 7/31) and have won or split nine of their last 12 completed series since 7/6 (are 7-3-2 in those series).**
- **Are a season-high-tying 18G over .500** (also 45-27 on 6/17 and 46-28 on 6/19).

YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Yankees defeated the Blue Jays, 3-1, in their series opener on Friday at Yankee Stadium...**RHP Cam Schlittler** (6.OIP, 6H, 1R/ER, 3BB, 4K, OHR) started and earned his 11th win of the year after allowing only 1R/ER over 6.OIP...**RF/LF Spencer Jones** (1-for-3, 1R, 1HR, 2RBI) hit his seventh HR of the season with a go-ahead two-run shot in the second inning...**2B/3B José Caballero** (0-for-2, 1RBI, 1SF) drove in a run in the fourth inning with a sac fly...**LHP Brent Headrick** (1.OIP, 1H, 2K) tossed a scoreless seventh inning...**RHP Paul Blackburn** (1.OIP, 1H, 1K) tossed a scoreless eighth inning...**RHP David Bednar** (1.OIP, 1H, 1K) tossed a scoreless ninth inning to earn his 30th save of the season.

KEEPING UP WITH THE JONESES: OF **Spencer Jones** hit his seventh HR of the season on Friday vs. Toronto with a go-ahead two-run shot in the second inning...four of his 7HR this year have either tied the game (one) or given the Yankees the lead (three).

- Has homered in back-to-back games for the second time this season (also 2G from 7/31-8/1).
- Has hit safely in seven of his last nine games (since 8/12), batting .303/.324/.576 (10-for-33) with 6R, 3 doubles, 2HR, 6RBI, 1HP and 3SB over that span.

NEW YORK 'PEN STATION: Yankees relievers tossed 3.0 scoreless innings on Friday vs. Toronto (3H, 4K)...**have allowed just 1ER over their last 18.2 innings** (since the eighth inning on 8/16 at Toronto)...**have posted a Major League-best 2.43 ERA (255.1IP, 69ER) over their last 68 games (since 6/3)**, holding opponents to a .198 (182-for-920) BA during that stretch.

- **Own the best inherited runners scored percentage in the Majors this season (21.5%) and the second-best bullpen ERA (2.98, second in AL)**...also rank second in the Majors in opponents' OBP (.299, second in AL), opponents' OPS (.646, second in AL) and WHIP (1.19, second in AL), third in opponents' BA (.220, first in AL) and opponents' SLG (.347, second in AL), fifth in HR/9.OIP (0.91, second in AL) and ninth in K/BB (2.53, fifth in AL).

ON A ROLL: RHP **Paul Blackburn** tossed a scoreless eighth inning on Friday at Toronto (1H, 1K)...**has not allowed an earned run in 26 of his last 28 appearances (one start) since 6/21, going 2-1 with one save, a 0.70 ERA (38.1IP, 3ER) and 35K during that stretch**...has held opponents to a .120/.214/.208 (15-for-125) slash line during that span.

- Has not allowed an ER in each of his last 11G (12.1IP) since 7/31.
- Has gone 4-2 with one save, a 1.77 ERA (71.OIP, 14ER) and 58K in 49 games (two starts) this season, holding opponents to a .192/.273/.288 (48-for-250) slash line.

MERRY GRISHMAS: OF **Trent Grisham** reached base twice on Friday vs. Toronto...has reached base multiple times in each of his last four games and eight of his last 11 games (since 8/9).

- Is batting .326/.392/.739 (15-for-46) with 8R, 4 doubles, 5HR, 11RBI, 5BB and 1SB over his last 12 games (since 8/8).

PUT TO BED: RHP **David Bednar** tossed a scoreless ninth inning on Friday vs. Toronto to earn his 30th save of the season (1.OIP, 1H, 1K)...has reached the 30-save mark for the second time in his career (also 39 saves in 2023 with Pittsburgh)...his 30 saves are the fifth-most in the Majors this season (third in AL) and match the most by a Yankee in the last seven seasons since 2020 (also Clay Holmes in 2024 and Aroldis Chapman in 2021).

- **Has not allowed a run in 29 of his last 32 appearances (since 5/22), going 5-0 with 19 saves, a 0.74 ERA (36.1IP, 3ER) and 40K during that span**...opponents are batting .115/.180/.156 (14-for-122) over that stretch.

FOR STARTERS: Yankees starting pitchers have allowed 2R-or-fewer in 19 of their last 22 starts (since 7/28), including 1R-or-fewer in 16 of those starts, posting a 2.02 ERA (125.OIP, 28ER) during that span...marks only the 10th time in franchise history Yankees starters have allowed 29R-or-fewer in a 22-start span (also did so nine times in 2024)...have allowed 2R-or-fewer in 22 of their last 27 starts and 1R-or-fewer in 19 of those starts (since 7/22-G2), posting a 2.30 ERA (149.OIP, 38ER) with 165K during that span.

- **Have allowed 2R-or-fewer in a season-high-tying eight straight starts (since 8/13), posting a 1.85 ERA (43.2IP, 9ER) over that span**...marks just the sixth time in the last seven years (since 2020) the Yankees have recorded as long of a streak in a *single season* (also a 16-start stretch from 5/12-29/24, a 10-start streak from 4/14-24/22 and eight-start streaks from 5/13-22/25, 4/17-25/26 and 5/20-29/26).
- **Have allowed 1ER-or-fewer in seven of their last eight starts (since 8/13) and nine of their last 11 starts (since 8/9).**
- **Have allowed 3R-or-fewer in 101 starts this season, their most such starts through their first 128 games of a season in franchise history** (previous: 99GS in 2021 and 2022)...have allowed 2R-or-fewer in 77 games this season, their second-most starts through their first 128 games of a season in franchise history, trailing only their 80 starts in 2022.
- Have allowed 3R-or-fewer in 33 of their last 37 starts (since 7/8), including 2R-or-fewer in 28 of those starts, posting a 2.67 ERA (199.OIP, 59ER) during that span.
- **Yankees starters own the best ERA in the Majors (3.35)**, rank third in strikeout rate (25.2%, first in AL), opponents' BA (.226, first in AL), K/9.OIP (9.35, first in AL) and opponents' OPS (.662, second in AL), fourth in strikeouts (715, second in AL), opponents' OBP (.291, second in AL), HR/9.OIP (1.05, second in AL) and opponents' SLG (.372, third in AL), fifth in WHIP (1.16, third in AL), sixth in K/BB (3.28, third in AL) and eighth in BB/9.OIP (2.85, fourth in AL).

WEATHERS REPORT: LHP **Ryan Weathers** will make his 25th start of the season today vs. Toronto...faced the Blue Jays in his last start on Sunday at Toronto and allowed only 1R/ER over 7.1IP in a no-decision (6H, 1BB, 4K, OHR)...has allowed 2ER-or-fewer in nine of his last 11 starts (since 6/18), posting a 2.56 ERA (59.2IP, 17ER) with 59K during that span.

- Has gone undefeated in each of his last seven starts (since 7/10), going 2-0 with a 1.94 ERA (41.2IP, 9ER) over that span...has allowed 1R-or-fewer in six of his last seven starts...the Yankees are 6-1 in those starts.
- **Has tossed at least 5.OIP and has allowed 1R-or-fewer in each of his last five starts (since 7/25), matching the fifth-longest streak by a Yankees pitcher in franchise history...has gone 2-0 with a 0.85 ERA (31.2IP, 3ER) during that stretch.**

GOOD SCHLITT: RHP **Cam Schlittler** started and earned his 11th win of the season on Friday vs. Toronto after allowing only 1R/ER over 6.0 innings (6H, 3BB, 4K, OHR)...has allowed 1ER-or-fewer in a Major League-best 19 starts this season, including 17 of his last 23 starts (since 4/17)...has gone 11-6 with a 2.16 ERA (158.OIP, 38ER) and 193K in 27 starts this season, holding opponents to a .199/.254/.321 (115-for-577) slash line.

- His 17 starts of 1R-or-fewer this season are tied with Luis Gil (17GS in 2024) for the fourth-most in franchise history, trailing only Ron Guidry (18GS in 1978), Whitey Ford (18GS in 1964) and Jack Chesbro (18GS in 1904).

PITCH PERFECT: Yankees pitchers have posted a **Major League-best 3.20 ERA (1,143.2IP, 407ER) this season**...have allowed 3R-or-fewer in 19 of their last 27 games (since 7/22-G2), including 2R-or-fewer in 15 of those games, posting a 2.41 ERA (246.OIP, 66ER) during that stretch.

- Have allowed 3R-or-fewer in 24 of their last 35 games (since 7/10), posting a 2.62 ERA (319.OIP, 93ER) with 343K during that span.
- Their 472R allowed this season are their second-fewest through their first 128 games of a season in the last 48 162-game seasons (since 1977), trailing only their 446R allowed in 2022 (excludes the 60-game season in 2020 and the strike-shortened 1981 season).

PEN PAL: LHP **Brent Headrick** tossed a scoreless seventh inning on Friday vs. Toronto (1H, 2K)...**has not allowed a run in 38 of his last 43 games (since 5/19), going 4-1 with a 1.08 ERA (41.2IP, 5ER) and 55K over that span.**

- Has gone 7-2 with a 1.52 ERA (65.OIP, 11ER) and 81K in 66 relief outings this season...**has not allowed a run in 55 of his 66 relief appearances, the most in the Majors this season and tied with Mariano Rivera (55G in 2004) for the most by a Yankees reliever through the club's first 128 games of a season in franchise history.**
- As a Yankee (since 2025), has not allowed a run in 68-of-83 games, going 7-2 with a 1.94 ERA (88.OIP, 19ER) and 111K.

GEORGE OF THE CONCRETE JUNGLE: INF **George Lombard Jr.** has hit safely in 11 of his first 15 career games, batting .288/.345/.423 (15-for-52) with 9R, 1 double, 2HR, 5RBI, 5BB, 1SF and 1SB.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: LHP RYAN WEATHERS (5-7, 3.56 ERA)

LHP Ryan Weathers will make his 25th start of the season today vs. Toronto...the 26 year-old will make the start on extended five days' rest due to Monday's team off day...made his 24th start of the season on Sunday at Toronto and allowed only 1R/ER over 7.1IP in a no-decision (6H, 1BB, 4K, 0HR)...has gone 5-7 with a 3.56 ERA (134.0IP, 122H, 59R/53ER, 38BB, 140K, 18HR) in 24 starts this season...has allowed 3ER-or-fewer in 17 of his 24 starts, 2ER-or-fewer in 16 of his starts and 1ER-or-fewer in 13 of his starts...has set career highs in strikeouts, innings pitched and starts this season...also tied his career high in wins (5W in 2024 with Miami)...**is 2-0 with a 1.94 ERA (41.2IP, 9ER) and 36K over his last seven starts (since 7/10)**...has allowed 1R-or-fewer in six of those starts...went 2-2 with a 3.99 ERA (38.1IP, 37H, 20R/17ER, 12BB, 37K, 7HR) in eight starts with the Miami Marlins in 2025...allowed 3ER-or-fewer in six of his eight starts and 1ER-or-fewer in four of his starts...missed the majority of the season due to two injured list stints (3/24-5/14, 6/9-9/11)...over the last three seasons (2024-26), has gone 12-15 with a 3.65 ERA (259.0IP, 237H, 118R/105ER, 74BB, 257K, 36HR) in 48 starts...during that stretch, has allowed 3ER-or-fewer in 36 of those 48 starts...since 2021, his 19 pickoffs are tied for fifth-most in the Majors...has pitched in over parts of six Major League seasons with the San Diego Padres (2021-23), Miami Marlins (2023-25) and the Yankees (2026)...has made four career Opening Day rosters (2021 and '23 with San Diego, '24 with Miami and '26 with the Yankees)...began the 2025 season on the injured list...is the son of David Weathers, who pitched in parts of 19 seasons in the Majors (1991-2009), including two seasons with the Yankees from 1996-97, where he won the World Series with the club in '96...became the fifth father/son duo in Yankees history to both play for the club, joining Clay Bellinger and Cody Bellinger, Mark Leiter and Mark Leiter Jr., Ron Davis and Ike Davis, and Yogi Berra and Dale Berra...was originally selected by the San Diego Padres in the first round (seventh overall) of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft...was acquired by Miami from San Diego in exchange for INF Garrett Cooper, RHP Sean Reynolds and cash considerations on 8/1/23...was acquired by the Yankees from Miami in exchange for OF Dillon Lewis, OF Brendan Jones, INF Dylan Jasso and INF Juan Matheus on 1/13/26.

LAST TIME OUT: Made his 24th start of the season on Sunday at Toronto and allowed only 1R/ER over 7.1IP in a no-decision (6H, 1BB, 4K, 0HR).

ON A ROLL: **Over his last seven starts (since 7/10), has gone 2-0 with a 1.94 ERA (41.2IP, 34H, 9R/ER, 11BB, 36K, 2HR)**...has allowed 1R-or-fewer in six of those seven starts.

- ★ Since 7/10, ranks first among Major League pitchers in groundball percentage (62.6%), fourth in ERA (fourth in AL) and sixth in HR/9.0IP (0.43, third in AL)...also ranks sixth in the AL in opponents' SLG (.316), ninth in opponents' OPS (.595) and 10th in BB/9.0IP (2.38).
- ★ The Yankees are 6-1 in those starts.
- ★ Has allowed 3BB-or-fewer in each of his last seven starts, including 2BB-or-fewer in five of those starts.
- ★ Is holding opposing batters to a .224/.279/.316 (34-for-152) slash line in his last 7GS...has allowed just 10 extra-base hits (8 doubles, 2HR) in that span.
- ★ **Has allowed 1R-or-fewer in each of his last five starts (since 7/25), going 2-0 with a 0.85 ERA (31.2IP, 3ER) and 25K** in that span...marks the longest such streak of his career.
- ★ **Is 1-0 with a 0.95 ERA (19.0IP, 2ER) and 14K over three starts in August.**

HOME SWEET HOME: In 14 starts at Yankee Stadium this season, has gone 3-5 with a 3.93 ERA (75.2IP, 73H, 38R/33ER, 22BB, 81K, 12HR)...has allowed 3ER-or-fewer in nine of his 14 starts.

- ★ Has posted a 3.31 ERA (16.1IP, 6ER) over his last three home starts (since 7/20).
- ★ Has recorded at least 7K in five of his 14 starts at home.
- ★ Over the last two seasons (2025-26), has gone 4-6 with a 3.73 ERA (91.2IP, 88H, 43R/38ER, 25BB, 96K, 14HR) in 17 home starts.

2026: Is 5-7 with a 3.56 ERA (134.0IP, 122H, 59R/53ER, 38BB, 140K, 18HR) in 24 starts this season...has allowed 3ER-or-fewer in 17 of his 24 starts, 2ER-or-fewer in 16 of his starts and 1ER-or-fewer in 13 of his starts...has set career highs in strikeouts, innings pitched and starts this season...also tied his career high in wins (5W in 2024 with Miami).

- ★ Among Major League pitchers this season, ranks ninth in groundball percentage (48.8%, fourth in AL)...also ranks ninth in K/9.0IP (9.40) among AL pitchers this season.
- ★ His 44 called strikeouts are tied for the sixth-most in the AL this season.
- ★ **Is just the fifth left-handed pitcher to record at least 140K through their first 24 starts with the Yankees**, joining Al Downing (174K from 1961-64), James Paxton (156K in 2019), Ron Guidry (153K from 1975-77) and Randy Johnson (152K in 2005). - confirmed by *Elias*.
- ★ Has allowed 2ER-or-fewer in 16 starts this season, including nine of his last 11 starts (since 6/18), posting a 2.56 ERA (59.2IP, 17ER) in that span...his 16 starts with 2ER-or-fewer is tied for ninth-most in the AL this season.
- ★ Has received 2R-or-fewer of support in 17 of his 24 starts this season, including 0R of support in nine starts...his 3.22 run support average this year is the second-lowest in the Majors.
- ★ Has allowed one-or-zero HR in 19 of his 24 starts, including 14 starts without allowing a HR...has surrendered one-or-zero HR in 16 of his last 20 starts (since 4/19)...has allowed just 7HR over his last 13 starts (since 6/5) after surrendering 11HR in his first 11 starts this season from 3/30-5/30.
- ★ **Posted a career-high 22.2 scoreless inning streak from 7/25-8/11...was the fourth-longest single-season scoreless streak by a Yankees starting pitcher in the last 25 years (since 2002)**, trailing only Clarke Schmidt's 28.1 inning streak from 6/4-28/25, Gerrit Cole's 25.2 inning streak from 4/11-27/23 and CC Sabathia's 23.2 inning streak from 6/30-7/10/11...also marks the 10th-longest scoreless streak in the Majors this season.
- ★ Has tossed at least 7.0 innings in five starts this season (8.0IP on 4/9 vs. the Athletics, 7.1IP on 8/16 at Toronto and 4/19 vs. Kansas City, 7.0IP on 7/30 at Chicago-AL and 5/24 vs. Tampa Bay)...prior to this year, had tossed at least 7.0IP only twice in his first 55 career starts over his first five seasons (2021-25).
- ★ Did not allow a home run in four consecutive starts from 6/24-7/10, marking his longest streak of consecutive starts without surrendering a home run.
- ★ Went 2-0 with a 2.48 ERA (36.1IP, 26H, 12R/10ER, 9BB, 37K, 4HR) over six starts from 4/19-5/24...allowed 2ER-or-fewer in five of those six starts...held opposing batters to a .198/.250/.313 (26-for-131) slash line in that stretch.
