THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
MARCH 30
2000 - The Astros play the first game at Daikin Park, then known as Enron Field, in an exhibition contest against the Yankees...Houston wins 6-5...1B Jeff Bagwell records the first hit in stadium history, singling off of Yankees starter RHP Roger Clemens...RHP Dwight Gooden throws the first pitch in stadium history in his start for the Astros.

CITY CONNECT MONDAY: The Astros will wear their City Connect uniforms tonight for the first time on the young season as they welcome in the Red Sox for the first game of a three-game series... RHP Lance McCullers Jr. will make his first start of the season tonight for the Astros opposite LHP Ranger Suarez, who's debuting for the Red Sox after signing with the club in the offseason.

ABOUT MCCULLERS: RHP Lance McCullers Jr. is making his season debut tonight in a start against the Red Sox, a team he has not faced since the 2018 season...McCullers last pitched in an exhibition game on March 24 vs. the Astros Triple A affiliate, the Sugar Land Space Cowboys, tossing 4.2 innings, allowing two runs, while striking out seven...he made his return to the mound in 2025 after missing the entire 2023-24 seasons due to a right flexor tendon injury that required surgery... he worked around four IL stints in 2025 to go 2-5 with a 6.51 ERA (40ER/55.1IP) and 9.92 SO/9IP in 16 games (13 starts).

ASTROS VS. SUAREZ: The Astros are facing LHP Ranger Suarez, who they last faced on June 24, 2025...that game was a memorable one, as Suarez dueled with LHP Framber Valdez through 7.0 innings...in a scoreless game in the 8th, LF Cooper Hummel took Suarez deep which eventually gave the Astros a 1-0 victory over the Phillies.

RIVALRY VS. THE RED SOX: The Astros and Red Sox have developed a nice rivalry over the last 10 years, as the two clubs have seen each other in three different postseason series since the 2017 season...the Astros won two of those three series, winning the 2017 ALDS and 2021 ALCS, while the Red Sox took the 2018 ALCS.

SUSTAINED SUCCESS: Dating back to the 2015 season, the Astros have made nine postseason appearances in 11 seasons, winning seven division titles, four AL pennants (2017, 2019, 2021, 2022) and two WS titles (2017, 2022)...in that span, the Astros became the only team in history to advance to seven consecutive ALCS (2017-23) and posted the second-most wins in the Majors (976), trailing only the Dodgers (1,036).

AT THE OPEN: The Texas Children's Houston Open completed play yesterday at Memorial Park Golf Course in Houston with Gary Woodland riding a record-setting performance to his first PGA TOUR title since 2019 and fifth overall...Woodland finished at 21-under 259 (64-63-65-67), recording the lowest 72-hole score in Texas Children's Houston Open history...2026 represents the seventh year the Astros Golf Foundation has hosted this premier PGA TOUR event and sixth at its permanent home, Memorial Park Golf Course in the heart of Houston.

SUNDAY FUNDAY: The Astros and Angels played a back-and-forth ballgame yesterday with Houston coming out on top with a 9-7 victory...2B Isaac Paredes (2x5, 2RBI) was the Astros hero, as he recorded the go-ahead hit in the 8th inning, a two-run double...RHP AJ Blubaugh (0ER/2IP) earned the win in relief, while LHP Bryan King (0ER/0.2IP) picked up the save.

ROSTER MOVES: After last night's game, the Astros optioned RHP Christian Roa to Triple A Sugar Land...in corresponding moves, the Astros selected RHP Cody Bolton (#67) to the Major League roster today and transferred RHP Hayden Wesneski to the 60-day IL.

OFFENSIVE EXPLOSION: The Astros combined for 20 runs over the last two games en route to back-to-back wins while scoring all their runs without hitting a homer, instead doing so with 11 singles, nine doubles, two HBPs and 14 walks...this marks the first time the Astros have scored 20+ runs without hitting a homer over a two-game span since they scored 27 runs from Aug. 2-3, 2010 at STL.

DOUBLE DOUBLE: The Astros lead the Majors with 12 doubles on the season, averaging three a game, which is also tops in the Majors...IF Isaac Paredes and 1B Christian Walker have three each and own a share for the Major League lead in that category.

YORDAN'S UPCOMING MILESTONES: LF Yordan Alvarez (495 RBI) is five RBI shy of reaching 500 career RBI, a mark only 14 players in franchise history have reached...Alvarez also checks in with 171 career homers, which makes him just three homers shy of matching franchise icon OF George Springer (174HR) for seventh on the Astros all-time list.

OPENING DAY CORNERSTONE: 2B Jose Altuve, who's under contract for the next four seasons (2026-29), made his 14th career Opening Day start on Thursday vs. LAA, which are the third-most in club history...only 2B Craig Biggio (19, 1989-2007) and 1B Jeff Bagwell (15, 1991-2005) have more.

NEW FACES: The Astros focused their offseason efforts on acquiring pitching, landing RHP Mike Burrows and RHP Kai-Wei Teng in trades and RHP Tatsuya Imai and RHP Ryan Weiss off the international free agent market...they also added a Rule 5 pick in RHP Roddery Muñoz, the Astros first Rule 5 selection since the 2017 Rule 5 Draft.

IMAI DEBUTS: By debuting yesterday, RHP Tatsuya Imai became the fourth notable Japanese-born player to play for the Astros, joining Kaz Matsui (2008-10), Norichika Aoki (2017) and Yusei Kikuchi (2024)...Imai signed with the Astros in January, signing a three-year deal after a stellar career in the NPB.

OUT ON REHAB: RHP Enyel De Los Santos made his second rehab appearance for Triple A Sugar Land yesterday, tossing 1.1 scoreless innings on 19 pitches en route to recording the win...De Los Santos is recovering from a right knee strain, which landed him on the 15-day IL to open the season.

EXHIBITION SEASON OVER: The Astros went 11-14-3 (.440) in Grapefruit League play, which does not include their three exhibition game victories, in which stats do not count...Astros starting pitchers were great, as their Opening Day rotation combined for a 1.95 ERA (12ER/55.1IP) in official games...OF Joey Loperfido (.317, 13x41, 6 RBI) and IF/OF Brice Matthews (10 RBI, 8 SB) had the best camps offensively with Loperfido leading the team in hits and Matthews leading the club in RBI and steals.

2025 RECAP: Made his return to the mound after missing the entire 2023-24 seasons due to a right flexor tendon injury that required surgery...worked around four IL stints to go 2-5 with a 6.51 ERA (40ER/55.1IP) and 9.92 SO/9IP through 16 games (13 starts)...made his season debut on May 4 at CWS, marking his first appearance on a Major League mound since Game 3 of the 2022 World Series in Philadelphia, a span of 915 days...logged his 50th career win on June 3 at PIT...became the 23rd pitcher in franchise history to reach the mark...ended the season with 51 wins, directly trailing **RHP Mark Portugal** for No. 22 on the franchise's all-time list.

EXHIBITION GAME vs. SUGAR LAND: Started the exhibition game against Triple A Sugar Land on Tuesday, March 24...allowed 2 runs on 6 hits and 2 walks with 7 strikeouts in 4.2 innings.

LAST SPRING TRAINING START - 3.17 at PIT: Made his last official Spring Training start on March 17 against the Pirates at LECOM Park in Bradenton, FL...in that outing, he allowed 1 run on 3 hits and 3 walks with 1 strikeout in 4.0 innings.

AGAINST THE RED SOX: Has made 5 career regular season starts vs. Boston...in those starts, he's recorded a 5.40 ERA (15ER/25IP) with 19 strikeouts...his last outing against the Red Sox was a quality start on May 31, 2018 at Daikin Park...allowed 2 runs on 4 hits and 2 walks with 4 strikeouts in 6.0 innings.

GROUNDING: is one of the game's elite groundball pitchers...his 55.4% ground-ball rate ranks 3rd in the Majors among active pitchers since 2015 (min. 700 IP)...trails only **LHP Framber Valdez** (62.4%) and **RHP Logan Webb** (57.9%).

ABOUT MCCULLERS JR.: the 2017 All-Star has made 146 apps. (140 starts) in eight Major League seasons with Houston (2015-18, 2020-22, 2025), posting a 51-37 record with a 3.70 ERA (318ER/774IP) and 861 strikeouts...missed the 2023-24 seasons due to injury.

ROAD WARRIOR: On the road in 2025, he recorded a 2.59 ERA (9ER/31.1IP) with 26 strikeouts, two quality starts and a .230 opponent batting average.
