PITTSBURGH PIRATES (0-1) AT MIAMI MARLINS (1-0)

March 28, 2025 - loanDepot park - Miami, FL - 7:10 EDT - Game #2/Road #2

RHP Mitch Keller (11-12, 4.25 ERA in 2024) vs. RHP Connor Gillispie (0-0, 2.25 ERA in 2024)

THE PIRATES: fell in Thursday's season opener, 5-4, against the Marlins here at loanDepot park after surrendering a 4-1 lead and allowing a ninth-inning, walkoff single to Kyle Stowers...The loss snapped Pittsburgh's eight-game winning streak against Miami dating back to 10/1/23 (the Pirates swept the seven-game season series against the Marlins in 2024)...Thursday also marked the first time that Pittsburgh was defeated in walkoff fashion in a season opener since losing 6-5 on 4/4/89 at Montreal's Olympic Stadium (Tim Lincecum drew a walkoff, bases-loaded walk against Jeff Robinson in the ninth inning).

ROSTER MOVES: The Pirates today recalled INF/OF Emmanuel Valdez (#48) from Triple-A Indianapolis...In a corresponding move, INF Nick Gonzales was placed on the 10-day injured list with a non-displaced fracture in his left ankle...The 26-year-old Valdez has 12 homers in 125 Major League games (all with Boston)...In 2024, Pittsburgh used 56 different players (tied for 11th-most in MLB).

WORTHY OF A STARGELL STAR: Bryan Reynolds delivered a two-run single in the fifth inning Thursday that gave the Pirates a 2-1 lead...Reynolds became the first Pirate to record an RBI on Opening Day in three straight seasons since Willie Stargell did so in five straight season openers from 1974-78...Reynolds has hit safely in each of the last five season openers dating back to 2021.

PIRATING: In Thursday's season opener at Miami, Pittsburgh swiped six bases, their most in a season opener since at least 1900 (according to the Elias Sports Bureau)...The previous high was four, set on 4/11/1907 at Cincinnati...Ke'Bryan Hayes swiped two bags, while Oneil Cruz, Isiah Kiner-Falefa, Tommy Pham and Bryan Reynolds each stole a base as well...The Pirates executed two double steals (Hayes/Kiner-Falefa in fifth inning & Pham/Reynolds in ninth inning)...Prior to Thursday, the last time Pittsburgh stole six bases in a game was on 4/26/23 vs. Los Angeles (NL)...In 2024, the Pirates ranked second in MLB with an 84.8 stolen base % (LAD, 85.5%, ranked first).

WELL-TRAVELED: Tommy Pham made his Pittsburgh debut in Thursday's season opener at Miami, going 1-for-3 with a double, a walk and a stolen base...The Pirates are the ninth different team Pham has played for since the start of the 2021 season (also: San Diego, Cincinnati, Boston, New York-NL, Arizona, Chicago-AL, St. Louis and Kansas City)...He joined right-handed pitcher Edwin Jackson (from 2015-19) as the only other player in Major League history to appear for nine different teams in a five-season span (courtesy of Stats Perform).

BEASTS OF THE EAST: In 2024, Pittsburgh went 20-14 against the National League East, which included a 9-8 mark in road games...Four of those wins came here in Miami against the Marlins.

GUIDING THE SHIP: This year is Derek Shelton's sixth as Pittsburgh's manager...He has 294 career victories, 13th-most all-time among Pirates managers (Gene Lamont is 12th with 295).

DOWN ON THE FARM: Tonight, Triple-A Indianapolis will open its season at St. Paul...Righty Braxton Ashcraft, one of the organization's top prospects (No. 4 per Baseball America / No. 6 per MLB Pipeline), is expected to start for the Indians...Indianapolis finished 2024 with a 77-70 record...The Pirates' three other full-season affiliates will kick off their seasons next Friday, 4/4.

THE ROAD AHEAD: The Bucs are opening the season on the road for the ninth straight year and the 10th time in 11 years...Prior to the last nine years, the last time the Pirates opened on the road more than nine straight years was from 1894 to 1953 (60 consecutive years).

CUTCH: Andrew McCutchen hit 20 home runs for the 10th time in his career in 2024...His eight seasons of 20-plus homers are the second-most in team history behind Willie Stargell (15)...McCutchen is currently ranked fourth in team history in home runs (235), fifth in extra-base hits (609), sixth in RBI (818), ninth in games played (1579), 10th in hits (1667) and 11th in runs scored (935).

ABOUT THE OPENING DAY ROSTER: Ten players who were on last season's Opening Day roster were also members of this year's active Opening Day roster...Of the 26 players who were included on the active Opening Day roster, 10 of them were not in the organization a year ago at this time (Bart, Ferguson, Frazier, Heaney, Kiner-Falefa, Lawrence, Mayza, Pham, Santana and Wentz).

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

March 28, 2024: The Pirates opened the season with a 12-inning, come-from-behind, last at-bat win on the road against the Marlins. Mitch Keller got the start before Josh Fleming, Hunter Stratton, Ryan Borucki, Aroldis Chapman, Luis Ortiz and Jose Hernandez combined to limit the Marlins to one hit over 6.1 scoreless innings. The Pirates went deep three times in the game. Luis Ortiz earned the win while Jose Hernandez worked a perfect 12th inning en route to the first save of his big-league career.

HOW ACQUIRED: Selected by the Pirates in the 2nd round of the 2014 Draft.

STARTING OFF: The 28-year-old Keller is entering his seventh Major League season... Keller signed a five-year contract extension through the 2028 season on 2/23/24...He earned Opening Day honors in both 2023 and 2024, which made him the first Pirate to do so since Francisco Liriano started three straight season openers from 2014-16... He was selected by the Pirates in the second round of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft.

LAST TIME OUT: Keller allowed only one hit in 3.0 scoreless innings while striking out five batters one week ago tonight against the Red Sox at JetBlue Park in Fort Myers.

THIS AND THAT: Keller will look to end a five-game losing streak that dates back to 8/26 of last season...It's tied for the longest losing streak of his career (also: once in 2023 and once in 2022)...Keller's last victory came on 8/20 of last season at Texas.

ON THE ROAD: Keller went 6-7 with a 5.46 ERA (87.1ip/53er) in 16 starts on the road last season...He has lost each of his last two starts on the road since scattering just three hits while striking out nine batters in a combined 4-0 shutout on 8/20 at Texas.

AS A STARTER: Keller has made 131 starts as a member of the Pirates since making his Major League debut in May of 2019 in Cincinnati...Keller's 131 starts are 39th-most in team history (Pink Hawley and Heinie Meine are tied for the 37th-most with 132).

AND THE WHIFF: In 2023, Keller set the club record by a right-handed pitcher with 210 strikeouts, surpassing the previous mark of 209 held by A.J. Burnett in 2013.

- Since the beginning of the 2023 season, Keller's 376 strikeouts are the fifth-most among all right-handed pitchers in the National League...The only four National League right-handed pitchers to punch out more batters during that time are Zack Wheeler (444), Freddy Peralta (418), Aaron Nola (399) and Zac Gallen (380).

KEEPING IT 100: Heading into the 2024 All-Star break, Keller was 10-5 with 105 strikeouts in 114.1 innings pitched...He became only the fourth pitcher in franchise history to have 10+ wins, 100+ strikeouts and 100.0+ innings pitched prior to the All-Star break, along with Gerrit Cole in 2015, Bob Veale in 1966 and Bob Friend in 1960.

AS A PIRATE: The Pirates selected Keller in the second round of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft out of Xavier High School in Cedar Rapids, Iowa...He was rated by Baseball America as Pittsburgh's No. 1 prospect in each season from 2018-20...He was also recognized by the same publication as a top-100 prospect in the game from 2017-20.

SIGN HERE PLEASE: The Pirates signed Keller to a five-year contract extension through 2028 last year on 2/23...He became the third member of the current team to sign a long-term contract extension, along with Ke'Bryan Hayes and Bryan Reynolds.
