



Arizona Fall League Alumni Spotlight

Chris Carpenter (Phoenix Desert Dogs, 1996) was selected with the 15th-overall pick in the 1993 MLB Draft. Originally committed to pitch at Creighton University, Carpenter instead began his professional career out of Trinity High School (NH) and would appear in the Fall League three years later, making 10 starts and posting a 2.33 ERA. In his 15-year MLB career, Carpenter collected 1,697 strikeouts in 2,219 1/3 innings, winning the National League Cy Young Award in 2005 (2.83 ERA, 241 2/3 IP). With a career postseason ERA of 3.00 (108 IP), Carpenter won World Series championships with the St. Louis Cardinals in 2006 and 2011.
