**HAPPY 60TH BIRTHDAY, TOREY!:** Happy 60th Birthday to D-backs manager, **Torey Lovullo!**

- For the occasion, his wife, Kristen, gifted him a custom pair of Nike shoes (by bstreetshoes), featuring "Happy 60th Birthday".
- The D-backs won their last 2 games on his birthday: 3-1 vs. Cardinals in 2023 and 7-0 vs. Giants in 2022.
- Shares his birthday with D-backs' current Triple-A Pitching Coach, former Pirate and 1990 Cy Young Award winner **Doug Drabek** (1962) as well as **Shoeless Joe Jackson** (1887)...was born (July 25, 1965) exactly 1 year before **Barry Bonds** (July 24, 1964).
- Was born in the pre-Divisional era when there were only 20 Major League teams (1965), pre-dating the Royals (founded in '69), Expos (69)/Nationals ('05), Padres (69), Brewers ('70), Mariners ('77), Blue Jays ('77), Rockies ('93), Marlins ('93), D-backs ('98) and Rays ('98).

**LAST GAME:** The D-backs lost 4-3 vs. Astros on Wednesday.

- Ketel Marte** hit his first leadoff home run since Aug. 5, 2024 @ Guardians...his 11 career are the second most by a D-back all-time, behind Chris Young (13).
- Geraldo Perdomo** had his second consecutive 3+-hit game and second with 4 hits (also: May 4 @ Phillies)... is 1 of 2 D-backs with multiple 4-hit games (also: Eugenio Suárez)...has 4 multi-hit games in his last 6.
- Corbin Carroll** hit safely in his fifth straight game at a .364 clip (8-for-22) with 3 doubles, 3 triples, 3 RBI and 2 stolen bases.
- Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** reached safely (BB) in his third straight game and has reached in 6 of his last 7 games.
- Brandon Pfaadt** allowed 2 runs over 5.1 innings on 5 hits with 2 walks and 5 strikeouts.

**TODAY'S ROSTER MOVES:** The D-backs recalled OF **Jorge Barrosa** from Triple-A Reno and placed OF **Alek Thomas** on the Bereavement List yesterday.

**D-BACKS ACQUIRE GARCIA, IZZI FROM MARINERS FOR NAYLOR:** Last night, the D-backs acquired LHP **Brandyn Garcia** (optioned to Triple-A Reno) and RHP **Ashton Izz**i (assigned to High-A Hillsboro/non-40 man) from the Seattle Mariners for INF Josh Naylor.

Brandyn Garcia (Age 25)

- Was rated as the Mariners No. 13 prospect by MLB.com.
- Made his Major League debut on July 21 vs. Brewers, working 1.0 inning with 2 runs (1 earned) on 4 hits and 1 walk.
- In 32 relief appearances between Double-A Arkansas (April 6-June 21) and Triple-A Tacoma (June 25-July 19), went 5-4 with 5 saves, a 3.96 ERA (17 R-13 ER in 33.1 IP), opponent .230 AVG (29-for-126)/.659 OPS, 1.38 WHIP, 17 walks and 42 strikeouts (11.34 K/9.0 IP).
- Played parts of 3 seasons (2023-25) in the Mariners system, making 68 career appearances (25 starts)...was the Mariners 11th-round pick in the 2023 Draft out of Texas A&M.

Ashton Izz

- Was rated as the Mariners' No. 4 pitching prospect (No. 13 overall) by *Baseball America* and No. 7 pitching prospect by MLB.com (No. 16 overall).
- In 12 starts for High-A Everett, was 2-4 with a 5.51 ERA (33 R-29 ER in 47.1 IP), an opponent .275 AVG (53-for-193)/.790 OPS, 21 walks and 54 strikeouts (10.27 K/9.0 IP).
- Made 47 starts in 3 seasons in the Mariners' Minor League system (2023-25)...was the Mariners' fourth-round pick (No. 126 overall) in the 2022 Draft out of Oswego East (IL) High School.

**1,000TH D-BACK GAME FOR KETEL:** Today, **Ketel Marte** will play his 1,000th game as a D-back to become the third D-back all-time to reach the feat, joining Paul Goldschmidt (1,092) and Luis Gonzalez (1,194).

**CARROLL IS 1 TRIPLE SHY:** **Corbin Carroll** is 1 triple shy of a career high...in the last 10 seasons, since 2016, is 1 of 3 players (also: Jarren Duran/BOS-14 in 2024 and Charlie Blackmon/COL-14 in 2017) with 13+ triples in a season but currently the only one to do so in consecutive seasons (also: 14 in 2024)...since 2010, the most triples in a season was 16 (Jose Reyes/NYM and Shane Victorino/PHI)...since 2008, the most triples in a season was 19 (Reyes/NYM).

**NO ONE HOTTER THAN PERDOMO:** Since the All-Star break, **Geraldo Perdomo** has reached safely in all 6 games (with hits in 5 of his 6 games), hitting a MLB-best .542 (13-for-24)/.560 OBP/.708 SLG/1.268 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 triple, 7 RBI, 1 walk and 2 stolen bases.

- Post-All-Star, is second in MLB with 13 hits, behind Nick Kurtz/ATH (14), ahead of Vladimir Guerrero Jr./TOR (12) and Angel Martínez/CLE (12).
- Has an 11-game on-base streak, since July 9, batting .405 (17-for-42)/.490 OBP/.619 SLG/1.109 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 triple, 1 homer, 12 RBI, 6 walks (3 K), 1 hit-by-pitch and 2 stolen bases.

**10-20-30-40 CLUB:** The D-backs (**Corbin Carroll** and **Ketel Marte**) are 1 of 3 teams with multiple players with respective seasons of 10+ doubles, 20+ homers, 30+ walks and 40+ RBI (also: Cubs/Michael Busch-Seiya Suzuki and Mets/Pete Alonso-Juan Soto)

- With 1 more walk, **Eugenio Suárez** would join making the D-backs the only team with 3+ players.

**VS. PIRATES:** Since 2022, the D-backs are 13-9 (.591) vs. Pirates, including 5-4 on the road.

- Ketel Marte**, in his last 7 games vs. Pirates, has an .808 SLG/1.141 OPS with 1 double, 4 homers and 10 RBI.
- Lourdes Gurriel Jr.**, in his last 9 games vs. Pirates, is hitting .367 (11-for-30)/.424 OBP/.500 SLG/.924 OPS with 1 double, 1 homer, 2 RBI and 2 walks.

**LAST SEASON'S HISTORICAL FIRST GAME @ PNC:** Last year, in the first game of their series @ PNC Park on Aug. 2, 2024, the D-backs became the first team in MLB history with 15 total bases from the first 4 batters of a game: **Corbin Carroll** leadoff triple followed by back-to-back-to-back homers in the top of the first by **Ketel Marte**, Joc Pederson and Josh Bell (eighth franchise occurrence).

- The D-backs tied a franchise high with 6 consecutive batters reaching (via H, BB or HBP) to start the game (second occurrence of 2024, seventh all-time)...the first-ever time also happened @ Pirates (Aug. 22, 2001).

**MEMORABLE STOP FOR GENO:** On Oct. 2, 2021 @ PNC Park while with the Reds, **Eugenio Suárez** played his 1,000th career game...punctuated the day with his 31st homer in his 144th game of that season.

**BANI BACK IN THE 'BURGH:** D-backs' bench coach **Jeff Banister** was the Pirates' Bench Coach from 2010-14 and Special Assistant from 2019-20.

- Pirates' 25th round pick in 1986...played in organization from 1986-93.
- Singled in his lone Major League plate appearance as a pinch hitter (for current D-backs Minor League Pitching Coach Doug Drabek) with the Pirates on July 23, 1992 vs. Braves...is 1 of 25 Major Leaguers in modern AL/NL history to finish their professional careers with just 1 hit in 1 career PA.

NEXT STARTER: RHP MERRILL KELLY (9-5, 3.32)

- On July 20 vs. Cardinals, had his third quality start in his last 4 starts and earned his second straight win...the D-backs are 8-5 in his 13 starts of 6.0+ innings.
- In 4 career starts (3 on road) vs. Pirates, is 3-0 with a 3.68 ERA (9 ER in 22.0 IP) and 17 strikeouts.

## Snakebites

**HOW HE STARTED:** D-backs' second-round pick (No. 56) in the 2019 draft.

- Named D-backs' 2021 Minor League Pitcher of the Year after going 7-4 with a 3.17 ERA (41 ER in 116.1 IP) with 163 strikeouts (T-4th in MiLB) over 22 starts between High-A Hillsboro and Double-A Amarillo.
- Attended the University of Oregon...as a junior in 2019, was First-Team All-Pac-12, led the conference with 104 strikeouts and finished fourth in the nation with a 14.40 K/9 IP.
- A Nevada native, attended Basic High School in Henderson where he was a shortstop and pitcher.

**WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:** Making his 12th start (sixth road).

- In his last 7 starts, is 4-0 (team is 6-1) with a 2.29 ERA (11 R-10 ER in 39.1 IP), opponent .200 AVG/.350 SLG, 0.99 WHIP and 31 strikeouts.
- In his last 3 road starts (team is 2-1), is 1-0 with a 3.68 ERA (6 ER in 14.2 IP), opponent .180 AVG and 12 strikeouts.
- Has allowed 2 runs or fewer in 9 of his 11 starts (5-2, 3.09 ERA).
- In 9 July starts (6 quality) dating back to July 31, 2023, has gone 5-0 with a 2.73 ERA (17 ER in 56.0 IP), opponent .212 AVG, 1.02 WHIP and 41 strikeouts...the D-backs are 8-1 in those starts and have outscored their opponents 70-24.
- Since 2022, his 17 starts of 6.0+ innings with 90 pitches or fewer are the most by a D-back starter, ahead of Zac Gallen (15).

**LAST START:** Earned his sixth win on July 19 vs. Cardinals after tossing his third quality start in his last 4 starts, allowing 1 run over 6.0 innings on 4 hits and 1 walk with 4 strikeouts.

**VS. PIRATES:** Third career start, second @ PNC Park.

- In his last start vs. Pirates on May 26 @ Chase Field, earned the win following 6.2 scoreless innings with 4 hits, 0 walks and 4 strikeouts.
- In 2 career starts (team is 2-0), is 1-0 with a 3.09 ERA (4 ER in 11.2 IP), opponent .227 AVG, 2 walks and 11 strikeouts.

**VS. NL CENTRAL:** In his last 6 starts (team is 5-1), is 4-1 with a 3.90 ERA (14 ER in 32.1 IP), opponent .226 AVG, 10 walks and 31 strikeouts.

- Has allowed 2 runs or fewer in 6 of his last 8 starts, including 5 starts with 1 run or fewer.

**FREE PASSES ARE LIMITED:** Has allowed 1 walk or fewer in 6 of his 11 starts.

- Has yielded 2 walks or fewer in 22 of his last 26 starts since June 14, 2024 (143.2 innings, 571 BF).

**LIMITING LEFTIES:** In his last 5 road starts, is holding left-handed hitters to a .122 AVG (5-for-41)/.265 OBP/.220 SLG/.485 OPS and 12 strikeouts.

- In his last 11 starts, is holding lefties to a .147 AVG (14-for-95)/.499 OPS with 22 strikeouts.

**GIVE 'EM THE HEATER:** Throwing his fastball 62.5% and holding hitters to a .187 AVG (38-for-203), his highest and lowest marks respectively since 2022.

**INNINGS INSIGHT:** From innings 2-5, has a 1.56 ERA (7 ER in 40.1 IP), and is holding opponents to a .171 AVG (24-for-140)/.537 OPS with 29 strikeouts.

**FROM THE SECOND TIME THRU:** Is holding opponents to a .186 AVG (22-for-118) with 23 strikeouts from the second time thru the order.

**NIGHT OWL:** In 7 night starts (team is 4-3), is 2-1 with a 2.45 ERA (11 R-10 ER in 36.2 IP) and 26 strikeouts.

**THE STOPPER:** In games following a loss, is 4-1 with a 3.40 ERA (19 ER in 50.1 IP) and 41 strikeouts.

**JUNE RECAP:** In 5 starts in June, went 2-1 with a 3.91 ERA (11 ER in 25.1 IP), opponent .189 AVG and 24 strikeouts.

**IN THE PEN:** Began the season in the bullpen and made 10 relief appearances.

- Pitched 2.0+ innings 8 of his 10 relief appearances.
- Tossed 4.0 scoreless innings twice (April 29 @ Mets and May 31 vs. Nationals)...has worked 4.0+ innings in relief five times in his career.
- In April, led D-back relievers in innings (15.1) and strikeouts (17).
- Recorded his third career win in relief on April 12 vs. Brewers (last: May 22, 2024 @ Dodgers).
- Tossed 3.0 perfect innings on April 7 vs. Orioles.

**HE CAN SWING IT:** Became the second D-back pitcher with a pinch-hit RBI on March 30 vs. Cubs (also: Micah Owings on April 30, 2008 vs. Astros).
