TAKE TWO: Yesterday's originally scheduled Orioles Home Opener against the Yankees was postponed due to the forecast of severe inclement weather...It is the first time the Orioles have had their Home Opener postponed since 1997 vs. Kansas City (the 1996 opener was also postponed)...The Orioles and Red Sox had their originally scheduled Opening Day at Fenway Park postponed in 2021.

HOMECOMING: The Orioles will celebrate their Home Opener this afternoon against the New York Yankees...The O's have gone 45-24 in Home Openers in club history (since 1954), including 21-10 at Oriole Park at Camden Yards...The Birds defeated the Brewers last year, 2-0, to snap a three-season losing streak in Home Openers since 2019...Baltimore has gone 4-4 in eight Home Openers against New York-AL (see chart at right); the last time the O's took on the Yankees in a Home Opener was 2020 (L, 9-3).
$\theta$. The game marks the beginning of a seven-game homestand for Baltimore, with three games against the Yankees and four against the Oakland Athletics.

ALL-TIME AT OPACY: The Orioles own a 1,199-1,222-2 (.495) all-time record in 2,423 game at Oriole Park since 1992...The Birds have mashed 3,012 home runs at Oriole Park since the ballpark opened, including 55 long balls that have landed on the iconic Eutaw Street promenade that separates the ballpark and the historic B\&O Warehouse.

WRAPPING UP THE ROAD TRIP: The Orioles went $3-3$ in their season-opening road trip against the Red Sox (1-2) and Rangers (2-1)...They defeated the Red Sox on Opening Day, 10-9, improving their record in season openers to 45-25 overall and 1312 on the road...The O's dropped the next two games against Boston before winning the first two against Texas...The two wins against the Rangers increased Baltimore's winning streak against Texas to eight games dating back to July 4, 2022, their longest winning streak against a single opponent since also winning eight in a row against the Mariners from July 3 to September 19, 2012...The O's fell to the Rangers in Wednesday's series finale, $5-2$, snapping their streak.

WELCOME TO THE SHOW!: Grayson Rodriguez was recalled from Triple-A Norfolk and made his Major League debut in Wednesday's series finale against the Rangers in Arlington...A native of Nacogdoches, Texas, Rodriguez grew up roughly 180 miles southeast of Arlington...Did not factor in the decision after allowing two runs on four hits with one walk and five strikeouts in 5.0 innings; struck out Ezequiel Durán swinging to end the second inning for his first career strikeout...Became the first Oriole to make his Major League debut this season; 13 players ( 7 pitchers) made their debut for the O's in 2022...Also became the first 0's pitcher to start his Major League debut since DL Hall on August 13, 2022, and the youngest O's pitcher (24-140) to start his debut since Kevin Gausman (22-137) on May 23, 2013...Rodriguez is currently ranked as the No. 6 overall prospect by MLB Pipeline, as well as the No. 2 pitching prospect...He is ranked as the No. 1 Orioles prospect following Gunnar Henderson's graduation from prospect status.

GRADUATION: Gunnar Henderson officially graduated from prospect status on April 5, according to MLB Pipeline...In his first 39 career games, he's slashed .242/.351/.424 (32-for-132) with seven doubles, one triple, five home runs, 14 runs scored, 19 RBI, 22 walks, and a .775 OPS...Entered the season as the No. 1 overall prospect by Baseball America, Baseball Prospectus, ESPN, FanGraphs, and MLB Pipeline.

STARTING WITH A BANG: The O's opened the 2023 season by hitting multiple home runs in each of their first five games, tied for the third-longest streak to start a season by a team since at least 1901 and tied with the 1994 Orioles for the longest streak in club history; the O's were the only MLB team to start the 2023 campaign with five consecutive multi-homer games...Marked the fifth time in club history that the Orioles homered in each of their first five games to start a season, and first since 2012 (also 5).

UPON FURTHER REVIEW: In the bottom of the eighth inning on April 2 at Boston, Masataka Yoshida advanced to third base on what was originally scored a throwing error by third baseman Ramón Urias...After review, this is being changed to a missed catch error (with no assumed out) by second baseman Adam Frazier.

THE SKIPPER: Manager Brandon Hyde returns for his fifth season...In 2022, he led the 0's to an 83-79 record, his first winning season as manager and the club's first winning campaign since 2016...He was named the Baseball America MLB Manager of the Year and was voted the Sporting News American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers... He finished second in voting for the Baseball Writers' Association of America (BBWAA) American League Manager of the Year award... Hyde was named the $20^{\text {th }}$ manager in Orioles history on December 14, 2018.

COACHING STAFF: The Orioles announced their 2023 Major League Coaching Staff on November 8, 2022...The club named Cody Asche (ASH-ee) Offensive Strategy Coach...Ryan Klimek (KLIM-ick) enters his first full season on the Major League Staff as Pitching Strategy Coach...All other coaches remain in their same positions: Matt Borgschulte (BORG-shult-ee) and Ryan Fuller as Co-Hitting Coaches, Tim Cossins (cousins) as Major League Field Coordinator/Catching Instructor, Fredi González as Bench Coach, José Hernández as Major League Coach, Darren Holmes as Assistant Pitching Coach, Chris Holt as Pitching Coach/Director of Pitching, Tony Mansolino as Third Base Coach, and Anthony Sanders as First Base Coach

RISING TIDE: The Orioles are ranked as the No. 1 farm system by MLB Pipeline...Marks the fourth consecutive time between the preseason and midseason lists that the O's are in the top spot....Since Pipeline began ranking systems in 2015, only one other organization has claimed the top spot four times in a row, and that was the Padres (2018 pre/mid, 2019 pre/mid)...Baltimore is also ranked as the No. 1 farm system by ESPN's Kiley McDaniel, as well as in Baseball America's preseason rankings for the first time since the publication began their Organizational Talent Rankings in 1984.

QUICK HITS: Slated to make his second start of the 2023 season in today's Home Opener against the New York Yankees...Made a career-high 22 appearances (21 GS) in 2022, 11 appearances at home ( 10 GS ), and 11 on the road...Made six starts of 5.0-or-more scoreless innings, tied for seventh-most in the AL...Acquired by the Orioles along with 2B Breyvic Valera, RF Yusniel Díaz, RHP Zach Pop and 3B Rylan Bannon in exchange for SS Manny Machado on July 18, 2018...Originally selected by the Dodgers in the $14^{\text {th }}$ round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of UNLV.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision on April 1 at Boston...Allowed five runs on six hits ( 2 HR ) with one walk and three strikeouts in 3.0 innings; threw 56 pitches, 36 strikes...Marked his shortest start since June 24, 2021, at Toronto (0.1 IP).

AGAINST NEW YORK-AL: Making his seventh career start against the Yankees... Dealt the loss in his last outing vs. New York-AL on July 24, 2022, at Oriole Park, allowing four runs on five hits (1 HR) with six punchouts to one walk and a hit batter in 5.1 innings...ls winless in his last five outings against the Yankees; earned his lone win vs. New York-AL in his MLB debut on September 6, 2020 at Oriole Park...Is $1-3$ with a 5.34 ERA ( 17 ER/28.2 IP) against the division rival in his career.

AGAINST THE ALEAST: Making his $23^{\text {rd }}$ career start ( $24^{\text {th }}$ appearance) against the AL East...Did not earn a decision in his last start against the division on April 1 vs . Boston...Owns a $2-11$ record with a $5.85 \mathrm{ERA}(70 \mathrm{ER} / 107.2 \mathrm{IP})$ and five quality starts through his first 23 appearances against division foes... Went $1-5$ with a 3.90 ERA ( $24 \mathrm{ER} / 55.1 \mathrm{IP}$ ) in 10 appearances ( 9 GS ) against the division in 2022.

HOME SWEET HOME: Went $3-4$ with a 2.95 ERA ( 19 ER/58.0 IP) in 10 games ( 9 GS) with 46 strikeouts to 14 walks at Oriole Park in 2022...The Orioles owned a 6-4 record in those games..Allowed three earned runs-or-fewer in eight of his 10 home starts...Opposing batters slashed .236/.288/.311 (50-for-212) with just four home runs against Kremer at OPACY in 2022.
'KREM' OF THE CROP: Had his career-high scoreless streak snapped at 22.2 innings on July 4 vs. Texas; according to Elias Sports Bureau and STATS, he does not get credit for the two outs he recorded in the fifth inning...Marks the longest scoreless streak by an Orioles starter since Mike Mussina pitched 27.0 scoreless innings from September 21, 1995 to April 2, 1996...The last Orioles pitcher with a scoreless streak of at least 22.2 innings was Steve Johnson, who tossed 25.1 scoreless frames across eight games (three starts) from August 25 to September 29, 2012.

WORLD BASEBALL CLASSIC: Pitched for Team Israel in the 2023 World Baseball Classic...Made the start in Team Israel's 3-1 win over Team Nicaraqua in Pool Play on $3 / 12$ at loanDepot park in Miami ( 4.0 IP, $3 \mathrm{H}, \mathrm{BB}, \mathrm{K}$ )...Was the youngest player (20) on Team Israel's 2017 WBC roster....Kremer has dual Israeli-American citizenship and became the first Israeli drafted by an MLB team in 2016.
$\mathbf{2 0 2 2}$ HIGHLIGHTS: Kremer made 22 appearances (21GS) last season, finishing the year with an $8-7$ record...Pitched to a 3.23 ERA ( 45 ER/125.1 IP) with 87 strikeouts. Tossed his first career shutout and complete game on September 23 vs. Houston, allowing four hits and two walks with six strikeouts over a career-high 9.0 innings; marked the first shutout by an O's pitcher since LHP John Means threw a nohitter on May 5, 2021 at Seattle; was one of 16 players in MLB to throw a shutout in 2022 and joined RHP Jordan Lyles (9/21 vs. DET) as the only O's pitchers with a complete game during the season....Made the start for the 0 's in their $5-3$ win at the Little League Classic on August 21 vs. Boston; did not factor in the decision after allowing one run on five hits with two walks and four strikeouts over 5.1 innings...Allowed 11 home runs in 125.1 innings for a 0.79 HR/9, the ninthlowest in the AL (min. 125.0 IP ), compared to 17 home runs in 53.2 innings in 2021 for a $2.85 \mathrm{HR} / 9$, the highest in the majors (min. 50.0 IP).
