RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals continue their Steel Corridor homestand with tonight's finale of a four-game series with the division-rival Pittsburgh Pirates at Busch Stadium ... For the first time since 2021 when they were previously branded as the Indians, the Cleveland Guardians visit St. Louis for three games this weekend ... Last night's Cardinals win clinched a winning record at Busch Stadium (41-35, .539) for the 17th time in 19 seasons since the stadium was opened in 2006 ... The Cardinals have won five straight at home since Sept. 11, one shy of their season-best six in a row here from June 12-24.

FLIGHT PATTERN: Winners of three in a row, St. Louis enters today tied with the Cubs in 2nd place in the National League Central and 7.0 games out of the 3rd and final Wild Card spot ... The Cardinals are eliminated from the NL Central Division, while their postseason elimination number is three ... St. Louis owns tiebreakers over the Padres, Braves, and Cubs.

WALKING THE PLANK: A win tonight would give the Cardinals a series sweep of the Pirates for the first time since May 20-22, 2022 at Pittsburgh's PNC Park (3 games).

- Last 4-game series sweep of Pittsburgh: July 22-25, 2019 at PNC Park.
- Last 4-game series sweep of the Pirates in St. Louis: May 7-10, 2001 at Busch Stadium II (before **Thomas Saggese, Masyn Winn, & Jordan Walker** were born).
- St. Louis has won the season series over Pittsburgh for the 21st time in the last 25 years since 2000 (excluding 2008, 2012, 2013, 2023).
- The Redbirds have swept the Orioles (May 20-22 at Busch), Cubs (May 25-26 at Busch) & Giants (June 20-23 at Rickwood/Busch) this season.

AN ERA OF EXCELLENCE: It has been 65 years since the Cardinals last experienced back-to-back losing campaigns in **full seasons** from 1958-59 (excluding seasons shortened by war, work stoppages, or COVID), the 2nd-longest all-time timespan by any franchise of the four major North American sports leagues (MLB, NBA, NFL, & NHL).

- The NHL's **Montreal Canadiens** hold the record of 80 years between consecutive full losing seasons occurring from 1938-39 to 1941-42 (4 seasons), and then again during the 2021-22 and 2022-23 seasons.
- The Los Angeles Dodgers have the 2nd-longest active streak, last experiencing losing seasons 37 years ago from 1986-87.
- After St. Louis suffered its first losing season since 2007 with a 71-91 record last year, the Cardinals need to win four of their remaining 10 games to end at .500 and finish at least 5-5 for a winning record (82-80).

PLUS-MINUS: The Cardinals (-56) are the only MLB team this season with a winning record but a negative run differential ... Only four Cardinals teams in franchise history have finished at or above .500 with a negative run differential: 1911, 1917, 1966, and 1975 (*chart left*) ... St. Louis sports an MLB-low +2.75 run differential per game in wins ... Last night's four-run win was their largest win at home since a 10-1 victory vs. Texas on July 31 (also won by **Michael McGreevy**).

DONNY, YOU'RE OUT OF YOUR ELEMENT: **Brendan Donovan** has hit safely in all 17 home games against the Pirates to begin his career, tied for 3rd-longest home hit streak vs. Pittsburgh to begin any MLB career behind **Rafael Furcal's** (2000-05) and **Kiddo Davis's** (1932-33) MLB record of hits in their first 18 home games vs. the Buccos ... In his career, Donovan is batting .321/.395/.504 (42-131) in 34 games vs. Pittsburgh, including a .433/.506/.672 (29-67) slashline in 17 home games.

PALM BEACH WINS FLORIDA STATE LEAGUE; SPRINGFIELD VIES FOR CHAMPIONSHIP BERTH: The Single-A Palm Beach Cardinals won the Florida State League Championship last night with a 6-4 win vs. Lakeland (Tigers) in the deciding Game 3 at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium, marking their 3rd FSL title in franchise history and the 'Beach Birds first since being declared co-champs in 2017 ... The Springfield Cardinals (AA) will look to advance to their first Texas League championship series since 2012 when it continues its best-of-three series vs. Arkansas (Mariners) tonight at 6:35 PM at Hammons Field ... Springfield won Game 1 in North Little Rock 4-1 on Tuesday and would play Game 3 (if necessary) tomorrow evening at home at 6:35 PM.

PITTSBURGH CONNECTIONS

Oliver Marmol was originally selected by Pittsburgh in the 31st Rd. of the 2004 MLB draft, but did not sign.

Miles Mikolas spent one month as a Pirate during the 2013 offseason...traded by San Diego with **Jaff Decker** to Pittsburgh for **Alex Dickerson** (Nov. 25, 2013), then traded by Pittsburgh to the Rangers for **Chris McGuiness** (Dec. 30, 2013).

Cardinals 2024 first round pick **JJ Wetherholt** graduated from Mars Area (Pa.) High School...coached by **Andy Bednar**, father of **David Bednar**.

Turner Ward played parts of three seasons (1997-99) with Pittsburgh...managed two seasons in the Pirates minor league organization for the 2006 GCL Pirates and 2007 State College Spikes (SS).

Nolan Arenado (2009) and **Paul Skenes** (2020) are graduates of El Toro High School in Lake Forest, Calif.

Willson Contreras (June 17, 2016 at Wrigley Field), **Sonny Gray** (July 10, 2013 at PNC), **Andre Pallante** (April 10, 2022 at Busch), **Nolan Gorman** (May 20, 2022 at PNC), **Matthew Liberatore** (May 21, 2022 at PNC), and **Drew Rom** (Aug. 21, 2023 at PNC) made their MLB debuts vs. the Pirates.

Michael Siani's younger brother, **Sammy Siani**, was selected by Pittsburgh with the 37th overall pick in the 2019 MLB Draft...is an outfielder for Altoona (AA) in the Pirates organization.

David Bednar was teammates of **Miles Mikolas**, **Paul Goldschmidt**, and **Nolan Arenado** on Team USA in the 2023 World Baseball Classic.

Riley O'Brien's great uncle, **Eddie O'Brien** played for Pittsburgh as an infielder and also made five pitching appearances (1953, 1955-58)...his grandfather **Johnny O'Brien**, played part of four seasons with the Pirates (1953, 1955-57).

Jake Woodford was selected by the Cardinals in the 1st round (#39) of the 2015 MLB Draft...pitched parts of four seasons with St. Louis (2020-24).

2024 Cardinals Hall of Famer **Matt Morris** pitched two seasons in Pittsburgh (2007-08).

Derek Shelton was born in Carbondale, Ill...caught four seasons (1989-92) at Southern Illinois Univ.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Julián Javier** signed with Pittsburgh as a free agent and played parts of five seasons in the Pirates minor league organization (1956-60).

TONIGHT'S GAME

- Makes his career-high 30th start of the season and his 9th since joining the Cardinals.
- Is making his 1st start against the Pittsburgh Pirates since 2022 while pitching for the Washington Nationals.
- Has established single-season highs in starts (29), wins (8), innings pitched (164.1) and strikeouts (141).
- Pitched 180.1 innings and 30 starts for the NC Dinos in the KBO in 2023, which were professional career highs.
- His 141 strikeouts this season are the most in his Major League career. He had 209 K's for the NC Dinos in the KBO last season.
- Needs 7 strikeouts for 500 in his MLB career.
- Is looking to snap a career-high four-game losing skid (Aug. 13-present). The Cardinals are 2-6 in his games started.
- Has made eight starts with St. Louis, going 1-5 with a 4.43 ERA (42.2 IP) and 33 strikeouts. Is 1-2 with a 2.35 ERA at Busch Stadium in his three home starts with the Cardinals and 0-3 with a 5.60 ERA in five road starts with St. Louis.
- Has received 2 runs or fewer in 7 of his 8 starts with St. Louis, and zero runs twice.
- Ranks in the Top-25 in MLB in both ERA (3.45, 19th) and opponent's BA (.233, 23rd).
- His only win with the Cardinals was Aug. 7 vs. Tampa Bay at Busch, limiting the Rays to one run over 5.0 innings with four hits, while throwing 93 pitches.
- Has held his opposition to one run or fewer in 12 starts this season. Lance Lynn has seven such starts this season for 2nd-most on the Cardinals staff this season.
- Has received one run of support or fewer in 11 of his 29 starts. Is 6-1 in starts during which he receives three runs of support or more this season.
- Pitched 6.0 or more innings in 13 starts, including 10 quality starts for White Sox.
- Struck out a career-high 11 batters over 6.0 innings at Minnesota on April 23.
- Ran off four straight winning decisions to start the year, establishing a new career-best winning streak from April 17-May 14, including consecutive scoreless starts vs. CLE (5/9) and vs. WSH (5/14) covering a season-high 14.0 inning scoreless streak.
- Had a positive home/road split after going 5-2 with a 1.87 ERA at Chicago's Guaranteed Rate Field, ranking 4th in Major League Baseball in home ERA.

LAST TIME OUT

- Allowed 3 runs, all in the 4th inning, and came away with a no-decision in the Cardinals 4-3 loss in 11 innings last Fri. (9/13) at Toronto.
