✦	Tallied his seventh game of the season with three hits or more last night vs. SEA...marked the second time in his career he has tallied three hits or more back-to-back games (also: May 3-4, 2026)...his seven such games this season are tied for fifth most in the AL.					
✦	Paces the team with 29 multi-hit games...has collected multiple hits in four consecutive games since July 8, tying for the longest streak in his career (4x, last: May 25-29)...is the third time he's turned the trick this season, and the fourth instance by a Ray this year (also: Yandy Díaz , June 17-21).					
✦	Has reached base safely in 11 of 18 PA over the last four games (6 1B, 4 2B, BB) on the heels of a 2-for-20 (.100) skid in his previous five games (July 3-7).					
✦	Is batting .422 (19-for-45) with 7 2B, 1 HR, 10 RBI, 5 BB, 7 R, and a 1.125 OPS over his last 12 games at Tropicana Field.					
✦	Is 5th in the AL in RISP AVG (.353)...is 9-for-16 (.563) with RISP in his last 18G (June 23-pres.)...overall, leads the AL in total hits (26-for-69) in that span.					
✦	Has multiple hits in 13 of his last 28G (June 12-pres.), the most multi-hit efforts in the majors over that span.					
✦	Ranks among AL leaders in AVG (4th, .297), multi-hit games (T4th, 29), hits (5th, 100), OBP (5th, .393), RBI (T5th, 62), BB (T8th, 51), and multi-RBI games (T8th, 16).					
✦	Of his 62 RBI, 52 have come vs. RHP, second in the AL and fifth in MLB...is batting .397 (29-for-73) vs. RHP over his last 26G (June 14-pres.).					
✦	His 62 RBI are seventh most by a Ray through 93 team games, most since Austin Meadows (63) in 2021...is T3rd-most RBI by a Rays hitter before the All-Star break, trailing José Canseco (69) in 1999 and Evan Longoria (66) in 2009.					
✦	His 158 times on base are the most in team history before the All-Star break, ahead of teammate Yandy Díaz (155) this year.					
✦	In May, he led the majors in average (.374/34-for-91) and on-base pct. (.464)...he also ranked highly in OPS (2nd, 1.025) and hits (T2nd)...was the first Ray to lead MLB in average over a month since Yandy Díaz in June 2024 (.400)...his 43 RBI were second most in team history through May (Evan Longoria - 2019, 55RBI).

★	Has a 10-game hitting streak vs. SEA (Aug. 27, 2024–pres.)...is 18-for-39 (.462) with 5 2B, 1 3B, 4 HR, 14 RBI, and a 1.449 OPS during the streak...min. 35 PA, his 1.348 career OPS against the Mariners is the highest among active players, ahead of PHI Bryce Harper (1.342).					
★	Launched his 28th HR of the season in the 7th inning on Fri. vs. SEA...was his MLB-leading 10th HR on a pitch outside the strike zone—no other hitter has more than five (Jonathan Aranda /COL Hunter Goodman)...marks the most such HR by a Ray during the pitch-tracking era (since 2008), surpassing Carlos Peña (8) in 2010...DET Miguel Cabrera (13, 2012) holds the MLB record.					
★	Friday's homer off SEA José A. Ferrer marked his fourth opposite-field homer of 2026, joining July 9 vs. NYY (Paul Blackburn), May 18 vs. BAL (Cameron Foster) and April 22 vs. CIN (Brandon Williamson)...is T7th most among AL hitters.					
★	Has homered 13 times in his last 18 games (June 23–pres.), most in club history over such a span and MLB's most since NYY Aaron Judge in July–Aug. 2022 (13)...during that stretch, leads the majors in HR and total bases (62) while pacing the AL in SLG (.899), OPS (1.291), RBI (25), XBH (15), and R (17).					
★	Is slated to become the first player in franchise history to start multiple All-Star Games...would become the first third baseman and 14th player in the modern era (since 1900) to start back-to-back All-Star Games in age-22-or-younger seasons (age as of June 30).					
★	Clubbed 11 HR in 11 games (June 23–July 4), becoming MLB's youngest player and 12th overall to turn the trick, first since WSH Kyle Schwarber (June 19 [G2]-30, 2021)...from June 24–July 1, tied a club record with a HR in six straight games, becoming the youngest player in modern era (since 1900) to accomplish the feat...had 22 RBI during the 11G span, the 3rd player since 1957 to have 22 RBI in an 11G stretch before turning 23, joining SD Fernando Tatis Jr. (2021) and WSH Bryce Harper (2015).					
★	His 78 HR before turning 23 last Sunday were 20th most in the modern era (since 1900)...currently has 73 HR between his age 21-22 seasons (2025-26; age as of June 30), third most in the modern era (since 1900) behind the Milwaukee Braves Eddie Mathews (87HR) and NYY Joe DiMaggio (75HR).					
★	Is one of two MLB hitters to log 25 HR or more with fewer strikeouts (75) than games played (93) alongside HOU Yordan Alvarez (31HR/72SO/95G).					
★	Min. 100 AB, his .360 (62-for-172) average vs. fastballs leads the AL...has 25 of his 42 XBH vs. fastballs (9 2B, 16HR).					
★	Paces MLB with an average bat speed of 79.9 mph...leads the majors with 119 batted balls hit at 100 mph or faster.					
★	With his homer July 3 at HOU, became the third primary third baseman (6x) in the modern era (since 1900) to record multiple 25-HR seasons in age-22-or-younger campaigns (2025, 45HR), joining ATL Bob Horner (2x, 1979-80) and BSN/MLN Eddie Mathews (3x, 1952-54)...he also joined Evan Longoria (5x) as the only primary third basemen in Rays history to have multiple 25-home run seasons.					
★	Was named the Defensive Player of the Month for June by Sports Info Solutions...during the month, he led MLB third basemen with 8 defensive runs saved...has committed three errors in 36 games since June 1...entered the month with 10 errors in his first 55 games.

★	His 109 hits are tied with HOU Yordan Alvarez for most in the AL and are tied with Carl Crawford (2009), Rocco Baldelli (2003), and Aubrey Huff (2003) for second most by a Ray before the All-Star break...is only one shy of Crawford (110) in 2004 for the club record.					
★	Leads the AL in AVG (.320) and ranks highly in OBP (3rd, .397), multi-hit games (T5th, 28), hard-hit balls (6th, 138), OPS (7th, .887), and SLG (8th, .490).					
★	Ten of his 13 HR have come at Tropicana Field...has the second-best home average (.367/.62-for-169) in the majors and is T2nd in home hits behind MIA Otto Lopez (66)...has reached base safely in 43 of 46 home games this season and 53 of his last 56 overall (Sept. 5, 2025–pres.)...includes a 26-game home on-base streak from May 5–June 28, the longest in the majors this season and the second longest of his career behind July 21, 2019–April 28, 2021 (29G).					
★	Leads MLB in average from the 7th inning on (.419/39-for-93), average vs. relievers (.410/50-for-122), and RISP average (.441/30-for-68).					
★	With 112 HR, is two shy of tying Ben Zobrist (114) for sixth in club history...has 305 XBH with the Rays (6th in TB history), four shy of fifth-ranked Aubrey Huff (309).					
★	Has reached base safely 155 times, fourth most through the Rays first 93G behind Evan Longoria (160) in 2010, Jonathan Aranda (158) this season, and Fred McGriff (158) in 1999...has reached base in 52 of his last 59G (May 1–pres.), including a 27G on-base streak (May 12–June 15; T2nd longest of his career).					
★	Joins Corey Dickerson (2017) and José Canseco (1999) as the only primary DHs in team history to be named to the All-Star Game...Díaz (34), Greg Vaughn (2001, 35), Fred McGriff (2000, 36), and Canseco (1999, 34) are the only Rays position players to be named All-Stars in an age-34-or-older season...is one of six Rays position players to earn multiple All-Star selections, joining Carl Crawford (4x), Evan Longoria (3x), Brandon Lowe (2x), Ben Zobrist (2x), and Junior Caminero (2x).					
★	His 14.6 pct. whiff rate is third lowest in the AL behind CLE Steven Kwan (8.7%) and teammate Chandler Simpson (10.5%)...his 10.8 pct. whiff rate vs. breaking balls is the lowest in the AL and second in MLB to SF Luis Arraez 's 10.5 pct. (min. 300 breaking pitches).
