FLIGHT PATTERN: The St. Louis Cardinals and San Francisco Giants play the second game of a season-ending three-game series today at Oracle Park ... St. Louis began its six-game road trip by taking two-of-three from the Rockies at Coors Field ... For only the second time in franchise history and first time since **1960**, the Redbirds will start and finish their regular season on the West Coast. - *Elias*

- The Cardinals started 1960 at San Francisco and the 1964, 1984, & 2024 seasons at the LA Dodgers ... St. Louis ended regular seasons in San Francisco twice (1958 & 1960), and once in Los Angeles (1962).

COMEBACK CARDS: St. Louis enters today tied with Chicago for 2nd place in the NL Central Division ... The Cardinals have finished with a winning season for the 23rd time since 2000 and the 84th in franchise history.

- Since 1913, St. Louis has experienced six 90+ loss seasons (1913, 1916, 1976, 1978, 1990, 2023), and then finished above .500 every year following: 81-72 in 1914; 82-70 in 1917; 83-79 in 1977; 86-76 in 1979; 84-78 in 1991; and 82-78 in 2024. - *Elias*

- After ending with a 71-91 record last season, St. Louis has improved by double-digit wins for the 33rd time in franchise history since 1892 (excluding 1981-82 and 2020-21). - *Elias*

- Through 161 games, their 13-win gain from last season is MLB's 5th-best improvement.

WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE: St. Louis (-51) is the only MLB team with a winning record but a negative run differential ... The 2024 Cardinals became the 5th in franchise history to have finished above .500 with a negative run differential, joining 1911, 1917, 1966, and 1975.

"...DO I FEEL LUCKY?" WELL, DO YA, PUNK?: Based on run differential, St. Louis (82-78) has outperformed its Expected Record (75-85) by an MLB-leading 7 wins this season, 5th-largest gain in franchise history behind 1902, 1911, 1917, and 1936.

HEL'S BELLS: Ryan Helsley converted his Major League-leading 49th save last night, passing Trevor Rosenthal (2015) to become the Cardinals single-season saves leader ... The last Cardinal to lead all of Major League Baseball in saves was **Lee Smith** (47 in 1991).

- 17 pitchers in MLB history have logged 50+ saves, last accomplished by Seattle's **Edwin Diaz** (57 in 2018).
- Helsley has combined to win or save a Cardinals-record 56 games this season, the 9th-highest total in MLB history and the highest total in MLB since Seattle Edwin Diaz converted 58 saves (0 wins) in a 2018.
- Helsley has combined to share in 68.3% of the team's 82 victories with his 49 saves & 7 wins (5 in extras), 5th-highest in MLB since 1969 (when saves became official) (*chart left*).

MASYN MILESTONES: Masyn Winn plays in his 148th game at shortstop today, passing **Ed Holly** (1907) for the Cardinals rookie record at shortstop ... 1978 Padre **Ozzie Smith** holds the Major League rookie record with 159 games at shortstop.

SEEK AND DESTROY: Paul Goldschmidt hit his team-leading 22nd homer and the 362nd of his career on Wednesday, passing **Joe DiMaggio** (1936-51) for 86th all-time in MLB history ... At age 37, Goldy would become the oldest to lead St. Louis in homers since **Roger Connor** did it in back-to-back seasons during the 19th century in 1895 (8 HR at age 38) and again in 1896 (11 HR at age 39) ... No visiting player in Oracle Park history has gone yard here more than Goldy (15). - *Elias*

LAND OF THE GIANTS: According to *Baseball Reference*, RHP **Chris Roycroft**, LHP **Lee Guetterman** (1993), and RHP **Mike Naimick** (1944) are listed as the tallest pitchers in franchise history at 6 feet, 8 inches tall ... In addition, the Cardinals currently have 6-ft, 6-inch RHP **Kyle Gibson** and OF **Jordan Walker** on the team... Giants RHP **Sean Hjelle** (*pronounced "JELL-ee"*) is the tallest Major Leaguer in 2024, listed as 6-foot-11 ... Former STL pitchers **Adam Wainwright** and **Andrew Miller** were both 6-foot-7.

THE CITY BY THE BAY: St. Louis leads San Francisco by a 363-361 margin in the all-time series since the Giants moved from New York in 1958 ... The Cardinals have won the season series over the Giants for the 9th time since 2013 ... St. Louis has won the first four games of the season series for the first time in franchise history, and never swept the season series.

SAN FRANCISCO CONNECTIONS

Paul Goldschmidt made his MLB debut at San Francisco (Aug. 1, 2011)...singled in first career PA off **Matt Cain** (Aug. 1, 2011)...homered off **Tim Lincecum** for first MLB home run (Aug. 2, 2011).

Jordan Hicks was selected by St. Louis in the 3rd Round of the 2015 MLB Draft...played parts of six seasons in St. Louis (2018-23).

Nolan Arenado's brother, **Jonah Arenado**, was selected by San Francisco in the 16th round of 2013 MLB Draft...played seven minor league seasons (2013-19) in the Giants organization.

Willie McGee played four seasons (1991-95) with the Giants...was born in San Francisco...graduated from Harry Ells High School in Richmond...played college baseball at Diablo Valley College in Pleasant Hill...resides in Hercules...worked as an asst. coach for Contra Costa College in San Pablo, CA.

Hayden Birdsong was born in Mattoon, Ill...pitched at Eastern Illinois University in Charleston, Ill.

Nolan Arenado and **Matt Chapman** were high school teammates at El Toro High School in Lake Forest, CA...In 2009 as a senior shortstop, Arenado's backup was Chapman, who only played shortstop when Arenado pitched.

Cardinals Bullpen Coach **Julio Rangel** was the Giants Minor League Pitching Coordinator in 2018.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Keith Hernandez** was born in San Francisco, CA...graduated from Capuchino High School in San Bruno, CA.

Late Hall of Famer **Orlando Cepeda** played parts of three seasons with St. Louis (1966-68)...in 1967, was NL All-Star, NL MVP and won the World Series...traded by the Cardinals to Atlanta for **Joe Torre** (March 17, 1969).

Daniel Descalso was born in Redwood City and resides in Danville, Calif...graduated from Saint Francis High School in Mountain View in 2004...played college baseball at UC-Davis (2005-07).

Giants Special Asst. **Will Clark** played in 51 games in his final season (2000) with St. Louis...slashed .345/.441/.621 in eight Postseason games.

Duane Kuiper is a graduate of Southern Illinois University in Carbondale, Ill.

Cardinals broadcaster **Ricky Horton** made his MLB debut at San Francisco (April 7, 1984).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Matt Morris** pitched two seasons in San Francisco (2006-07).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Tommy Herr** played 32 games for the Giants during his final season (1991).

Cardinals broadcaster **Bengie Molina** played parts of four seasons with the Giants (2007-10).

Cardinals Video Coordinator **Chad Blair** is a native of Santa Rosa, Calif. who also worked for Oakland.

Athletic writer **Katie Woo** is a native of Vacaville, Calif...previously covered the Giants, 49ers, & Warriors for NBC Sports Bay Area & California.

TODAY'S GAME

- Making his 20th start of the season today and his 30th career.
- Established single-season highs in wins (8), games started (19), innings pitched (116.1), strikeouts (90) and quality starts (7).
- Started against the Giants earlier this season, tossing 5.1 innings at Rickwood Field on June 20 in Birmingham, Ala., in a 6-5 Cardinals win. Was the first Cardinals starting pitcher to earn a win at a neutral site since **Alan Benes** vs. SD on April 19, 1997 at Aloha Stadium (Honolulu, HI).
- Was recalled on May 26 and has made 19 starts since, posting the lowest ERA (3.47) among Cardinals starters since **Paul Skenes** (1.96) has the lowest ERA in MLB during that period.
- His four wins since August 17 are the most among Cardinals pitchers and T-6th in MLB.
- Has not allowed a home run over his last three starts and has the 4th-lowest HR/9 IP in MLB since the All-Star Break (0.42) trailing **Blake Snell** (0.26), **Chris Sale** (0.27) and **Dylan Cease** (0.39).
- Held opposition without a hit through the first five innings in his last start vs. CLE (9/22) allowing one hit (**Myles Straw**) and one run on a safety squeeze through 7.0 innings as the Cardinals rallied to a 2-1 win. Ran his scoreless inning streak to a season-high 12.0 innings in the game. Pitched back-to-back 7.0 inning starts for the second time this season (8/17 vs. LAD & 8/23 at MIN).
- Established new single-season highs in wins (7) and innings pitched (109.1) in his start vs. PIT (9/16). Out-dued rookie **Paul Skenes** by throwing 7.0 scoreless innings of four hit balls with a career-high nine strikeouts in a 4-0 victory.
- Ran his strikeout total to 77 establishing a new career-high in his start vs. CIN (9/10).
- Posted back-to-back starts of 7.0 innings or more against the Dodgers (8/17) and at the Twins (8/23).
- Began the season in the bullpen and was 0-1 with a 6.30 ERA in nine relief appearances, getting optioned to Memphis (AAA) on April 21.
- Is 11-10, 3.64 ERA in 29 career starts (160.2 IP/65 ER) and 7-4 with a 3.90 ERA in 108 career relief appearances (131.2 IP/57 ER).
- Since May 26, leads all MLB starting pitchers with his 61.2 groundball pct.; has 189 ground balls and 61 fly balls allowed.
- Won his first three home starts (3-0, 2.87 ERA, 15.2 IP) this season, then lost three (0-3, 6.75 ERA, 16.0 IP) before he won again on 8/17 vs. LAD.
- Despite being winless in his four July starts, owned the Cardinals top starter's ERA (3.33) for the month and his .220 opponent's BA in July ranked 9th among N.L. starters.
- Has received three runs of support or less in 15-of-19 starts this season including 7 straight from June 28 to Aug. 10. Is 5-2 in his seven starts when receiving 3+ runs.
- Was involved in the decision in his first six starts and in 15 of 19 starts overall (8-7).
- His career reverse splits have continued this season, as he's held LHB to .209 BA & .558 OPS, while RHB are batting .260 with .724 OPS, hitting 6 of 8 HR's he's allowed in 2024.
- Was recalled on May 26 from Memphis (AAA), and made first start in Major League Baseball since July 31, 2022 at Washington at Great American Ball Park vs. CIN (5/29).
- Only pitched with human umpires calling balls/strikes in Memphis. Did not pitch to the ABS system while in Triple-A this season.
- Top pitch total in Memphis was 84 pitches vs. Gwinnett in his 5/17 start. Highest pitch total in his MLB career is 104 at KC on (8/10/24).
