### VS. HOUSTON

The Mariners and Astros meet today for their final matchup of the 2024 regular season...with a win today, Seattle would secure it's 4th consecutive series win at Minute Maid Park dating back to the start of the 2023 season.

**TODAY'S TILT**...the Mariners conclude the final road trip of the 2024 regular season today with the finale of 3 games against the Houston Astros (1-1)...Seattle is coming off a 3-game series victory at the Texas Rangers (2-1) to begin the trip...Seattle has the day off tomorrow and will welcome the Oakland Athletics to T-Mobile Park for a 3-game set (Sept. 27-29) to cap off the 2024 season...today's game against Houston will be televised live on **ROOT SPORTS** with **Aaron Goldsmith** and **Angie Mentink** on the call, and broadcast live on **Seattle Sports (710 AM)** with **Rick Rizzs** and **Dave Sims** on the call.

**ODDS AND ENDS**...the Mariners fell to the Astros by a 4-3 score in last night's series middle game...Seattle is 4-2 over its last 6 games and 12-7 over its last 19 games (9/4-c)...with 4 regular season games remaining, Seattle is 2.5 games back of Detroit and Kansas City for the 3rd and final AL Wild Card spot.

- **Another Odyssey** - The Mariners will fly back to Seattle following today's game in Houston, wrapping up their 2024 road slate with approximately 47,438 miles of total travel, 3rd-most in MLB behind only the Padres (~51,690) and Dodgers (~49,131) who both opened the season in South Korea...Seattle's 2025 schedule projects for ~44,649 miles of travel, 4th-most in MLB...it will be the first time since 2004 that Seattle is ranked outside of the Top 3 in MLB for most miles traveled in a season.
- **Rubber Games** - The Mariners are 9-10 in Rubber Games this season, having won their last Rubber Game on Sept. 8 at St. Louis.
- **Last 30 Games** - Seattle is 17-13 over its last 30 games (8/23-c) since **Dan Wilson** took over as manager and **Edgar Martinez** as hitting coach...Seattle owns a 5-2-2 series record during that span.
- **AL Player of the Week** - **Julio Rodríguez** on Monday was named **AL Player of the Week (Sept. 16-22)** for the 4th time in his career after batting .433 (13x30) with 5 runs, 1 doubles, 3 home runs, 9 RBI and a 1.218 OPS, tallying two 4-hit games and a multi-homer game during the week.

**JUST RUN WITH IT**...over the last 19 games (9/4-c), Seattle's offense **leads the Majors** in batting average (.285), on-base percentage (.367) and wRC+ (140), while ranking 2nd in OPS (.820), 4th in slugging percentage (.453), 2nd in hits (189) and 3rd in runs (103)...during that span, the Mariners offense has recorded 10+ hits in 11 of 19 games and 4+ walks in 14 of 19 games, while striking out 10+ times in only 6 of those 19 contests.

**FIRST 3 SEASONS OF THE J-ROD SHOW**...center fielder **Julio Rodríguez** is batting .275 (151x550) with 72 runs, 17 doubles, 19 home runs, 65 RBI, 25 stolen bases and 38 walks in 139 games this season, toting a .327 on-base percentage, .409 slugging percentage and .736 OPS (117 OPS+)...with 1 more home run this season, Julio would join Bobby Witt Jr.-KC as the **only 2 players in MLB history** to record 20 HR and 20 SB in each of their first 3 MLB seasons.

- **75 HR / 75 SB** - With 79 career home runs and 86 career stolen bases, Rodríguez is **1 of 2 players in MLB history** with 75+ homers and 75+ steals through a player's first 3 career seasons (other: Bobby Witt Jr.-KC, also 2022-24).
- **Winning Player** - Julio has accumulated 15.7 Wins Above Replacement (*Baseball-Reference*), **4th most WAR by a center fielder** through a player's first 3 career seasons trailing only Mike Trout (2011-13), Joe DiMaggio (1936-38) and Oscar Charleston (1920-22).
- **Last 25 Games** - Over his last 25 contests (8/28-c), Julio is batting .366 (41x112) with 24 runs, 5 doubles, 8 homers, 25 RBI, 9 walks and 6 stolen bases, getting on base at a .407 clip and slugging .625 with a 1.032 OPS...Julio has hit safely in 21 of those 25 games, including an active 6-game hitting streak (9/19-c).

**CAL RALEIGH: DOING IT ALL**...catcher **Cal Raleigh** has solidified himself as one of the best catchers in the Majors over several seasons...his 88 home runs over the last 3 seasons (2022-c) **lead MLB catchers**, while his 13.6 Wins Above Replacement (*FanGraphs*) since 2022 rank 2nd in the Majors to only Adley Rutschman-BAL (14.2)...Raleigh has firmly placed himself as the frontrunner for both the American League Silver Slugger and Gold Glove Awards this season:

- **Silver Slugger Candidate** - Cal **leads MLB catchers** with a career-high 31 home runs...after pacing the Majors with 27 home runs in 2022 and 30 in 2023, he is set to become the **first catcher to lead the Majors in homers in 3+ consecutive seasons** since Mike Piazza did it in 4 consecutive seasons (1999-2002)...Shea Langeliers-OAK (28 HR) and Salvador Perez-KC (27) rank closest to Cal in home runs.
- **Gold Glove Candidate** - Cal leads the Majors in catcher caught stealing (26), ranking ahead of Alejandro Kirk-TOR (25) and Will Smith-LAD (24)...after leading the Majors in CCS last season, Raleigh **could become the 3rd catcher to lead the Majors in CCS in consecutive seasons**, joining Jim Sundberg in 1975-76 (Sundberg tied for the Major League lead in '75) and Hall of Famer Gary Carter in 1982-83.

**PITCH PERFECT**...Seattle's overall pitching staff is tied for the Major League lead in ERA (3.51), while leading the Majors in opponent batting average (.219), WHIP (1.08), strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.81), fewest walks-per-9 innings (2.32), fewest hits-per-9 innings (7.40), opponent OBP (.276), opponent OPS (.652) and quality starts (91) this season...Seattle's **starting rotation** leads MLB in ERA (3.42), opponent batting average (.224), WHIP (1.03), strikeout-to-walk ratio (4.83), fewest walks-per-9 innings (1.75), fewest hits-per-9 innings (7.55) and opponent OPS (.645).

**VETERAN MOVES**...**Justin Turner** has reached base safely (via hit, walk or HBP) in 19 consecutive games, the longest active streak in the Majors...during the streak (9/4-c), Turner is batting .303 (20x66) with 13 runs, 5 doubles, 2 home runs, 5 RBI and 13 walks with a .402 on-base percentage, .470 slugging percentage and .872 OPS...Turner's 19-game on-base streak is also the longest on-base streak by a Mariners player this season, surpassing **Randy Arozarena's** 14-game streak (Aug. 24-Sept. 8)...Turner's career-high on-base streak is 39 games, spanning from Aug. 4, 2020-April 10, 2021 with the Dodgers.

**AS YOU KNOW**...Mariners starter **George Kirby** is making his career-high 33rd start of the season today, having already set career-highs in strikeouts (173) and starts (32)...George has also tied his career-high with 13 wins this season and is 4.1 innings shy of his career-high 190.2 IP set in 2023, and...**AS YOU MAY KNOW**...George leads MLB with a 7.86 strikeout-to-walk ratio this season after also leading MLB with a 9.05 SO/BB ratio in 2023, but...**DID YOU KNOW?**...George is on track to finish this season as the **first pitcher in MLB history** to post a SO/BB ratio of 6.00+ in each of his first 3 MLB seasons?...only 10 other pitchers in MLB history have made 25+ starts with a 6.00+ SO/BB ratio in 3 separate seasons at any point during their career, with Greg Maddux (1986-2008) and Tommy Bond (1874-1884) being the only pitchers to have 4 such seasons in their career.

ABOUT GEORGE KIRBY...

- 26-year-old right-hander is making his 33rd start of the season and his 4th against Houston...he is also making his 89th career start and 7th against the Astros.
• Is in his third season with Seattle; selected by the Mariners in the first round (20th overall) of the 2019 MLB First-Year Player Draft; signed by Mariners scout Ty Holub.
• Named to his 1st All-Star team in 2023.
• Named AL Rookie of the Month in August 2022 after posting a 2.15 ERA and 5-0 record with 7 earned runs, 3 walks, 34 strikeouts and .263 opponent batting average in 5 games started.
• Named Colonial Athletic Pitcher of the Year in 2019 for Elon University after posting a 2.75 ERA and 19-8 record in 88.1 innings pitched across 14 games started.

LAST TIME OUT...W#13 on 9/20 at TEX...he pitched 6.0 innings pitched and allowed 5 hits with 0 walks and 4 strikeouts...it was his 19th quality start of the season.

CAREER-HIGHS...he is 5.2 away from his career-high in innings pitched (190.2) that he set last season.

MESSIN' WITH TEXAS...he has made 6 starts in his career against the Astros and posted a 2-0 record with a 1.56 ERA (6 ER, 34.2 IP) and 31 strikeouts to 3 walks...he has thrown at least 6.0 innings and allowed 1-or-fewer runs in each of the last 5 starts (7/6/23-c)...George also posted 7.0 IP of no-run ball in the 2022 divisional game against the Astros.

NO FREE RIDES...is the only pitcher since 1900 (min. 50 GS) to have more games started than walks allowed (88 starts, 63 walks).

TOP RANKS...in 2024, ranks 1st in SO/BB (7.86) and 2nd in BB/9 (1.07) in the Majors...since his debut in 2022, he ranks 1st in MLB with 1.12 BB/9 (min. 400.0 IP)...Miles Mikolas-STL ranks 2nd during that span with a 1.60 BB/9 mark.

WALK THE WALK...among pitchers with at least 150.0 innings pitched this season, Kirby has the 2nd-fewest walks in the Majors with 22 (Zach Eflin-BAL/TB, 19)...his BB% is 2.9%, tied with Eflin (2.9%) for the best in MLB and ranks in the 99th percentile of all Major League pitchers.

UNDER CONTROL...has not allowed more than 3 walks in any of his first 88 career starts, the 3rd-longest streak in MLB history to start a career by a starting pitcher...he is 8 starts behind Chris Bosio for 2nd-best...has a 62-start streak with 2-or-less walks, the longest active streak in the Majors and the T-4th-longest streak ever by a starting pitcher.

BEST IN THE WEST...holds a 18-4 record with a career 2.58 ERA against AL West opponents over 31 starts...over these starts has struck out 172 batters while only walking 22 batters...he holds a 0.99 WHIP with opponents slashing .232/.262/.331 with a .592 OPS against him.

LEADING BY EXAMPLE...since his MLB debut on 5/8/22, he ranks among the top pitchers in the American League in various categories (min. 350 IP), including SO/BB (1st, 7.59), innings pitched (4th, 505.2), wins (t-3rd, 34), ERA (5th, 3.45), WHIP (5th, 1.10) and strikeouts (7th, 478).

END THE INNING...this season, opposing hitters are batting .197 (43x218) with 7 doubles, 2 triples and 7 home runs and 53 strikeouts with 2 outs in an inning...with 2 outs and runners in scoring position, hitters are batting .211 (15x71) with 14 strikeouts.

NO JUNE GLOOM...in his 5 starts in June, he held a 3-0 record with a 1.74 ERA (6 ER, 31.0 IP) and 31 strikeouts to 3 walks...the 1.74 ERA in June is his lowest in a month during his career...his ERA was the 2nd lowest on the Mariners (min. 20 IP), trailing Logan Gilbert with a 1.51 ERA.

QUALITY MATERIAL...recorded his 19th quality start of the season in his last start at Texas on 9/20...in 2023, had 20 starts of at least 6.0 innings while allowing 3 earned runs or fewer, which ranked T-5th in the Majors and T-3rd among AL pitchers.

MISSION CRITICAL...the Mariners own a 36-19 record in games that Kirby tosses at least 6.0 innings in his career...in games Kirby goes 5.2 innings or less, the Mariners are 12-21.

LUCKY 88...Kirby has made 88 starts in his career and is topping many Mariners pitching stats...he owns the 2nd lowest ERA (3.45), fewest walks (63), fewest baserunners allowed (585), 5th fewest hits (491), 6th most strikeouts (526) of any starters first 88 games with the Mariners.

A LOT OF 0s...did not allow a run in 17.0-consecutive innings from his start on 4/15 vs. CIN to allowing 1 run in the 4th inning against the Astros on 5/3.

FAST AND FURIOUS...of starting pitchers with at least 250 PA Kirby's 4-seam fastball has the 4th highest Whiff % (29.4) in the Major Leagues and 3rd amongst AL Starters...his 31.2 K% also ranks 4th amongst all Major League starters (min. 250 PA) ...his fastball holds the 2nd lowest hard hit % of any 4-seamer thrown by a Major League starter this season (min. 250 PA) and is the lowest of any AL pitcher with 37.5%.

STRIKE 24...began his outing on 8/24/22 vs. Washington by throwing 24 consecutive strikes, the most to start a game since the pitch tracking era (1988-c), passing the 21 thrown by Joe Musgrove on 8/30/18 vs. STL with PIT.
