RECENT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals continue a six-game road trip to Kansas City and Cincinnati tonight playing the final of a two-game set and four-game season series with the Kansas City Royals...following tonight's game, the Cardinals depart to Cincinnati for a four-game series wrapping up their play in the Queen City for the 2019 season...the Cardinals entered play today in 2nd place in the National League Central, one game behind 1st place Chicago and hold the 2nd Wild Card position 1.0 game behind Washington...the Cardinals have won four straight games, the longest active streak in the National League, and are 18-11 since the All-Star Break, 3rd best winning pct. (.621) in the N.L.

JACK ATTACK: Cardinals pitcher **Jack Flaherty** ran his consecutive scoreless inning streak to 23.0 last night, currently the longest active in MLB and T-2nd longest all season (Hyun-Jin Ryu, LAD, 32.0)...Flaherty has the longest Cardinals streak since **Trevor Rosenthal** ran off 23.2 in 2015 and the longest by a Cardinals starting pitcher since **Adam Wainwright** went 25.0 scoreless in 2014...*Elias Sports Bureau* reports over his last seven starts, Flaherty's 0.79 ERA is the best over a seven-start span since **Chris Carpenter** posted an 0.45 in 2005 and the next lowest is by **Bob Gibson** in 1968 (0.43).

FOWLER PROWLER: **Dexter Fowler** has scored in the 1st inning in each of the last three games in which he has batted lead-off. Over Fowler's 12-year career, his teams have a .665 winning percentage when Fowler bats No. 1 and scores a run in the game...the Cardinals are 19-15 (.559) when Fowler bats lead-off and scores a run since 2017.

BUZZARD BAIT: 22 of the Cardinals next 28 games until September 12, including the next five in a row, are against opponents with records of .500 or below, sporting a combined .452 winning percentage (324-393). This season, St. Louis is 32-20 (.615) when facing teams with a losing record.

KANSAS CITY SHUFFLE: The Cardinals have won seven straight games at Kauffman Stadium dating back to their last loss, June 27, 2016, one shy of the club record of eight (5/21/11-6/4/14)...a win today would give the Cardinals three consecutive sweeps at Kauffman Stadium, something they have never pulled off before.

ROAD HOUSE: According to *Elias Sports Bureau*, the Cardinals' career .667 road win pct. (38-19) in Kansas City is tied for the highest between any two teams in MLB history (minimum 50 games) with the Houston Astros at the Seattle Mariners (44-22, .667), and Boston Braves at the Washington Senators (.667, 34-17, from 1892-99).

SOMETIMES THEY COME BACK: Since Interleague play began in 1997, the Cardinals .667 road win pct. at Kauffman Stadium is the tied for the highest among all Major League teams (min. 10 games), trailing only Arizona (.667, 12-6).

DESIGNATED TO HIT: Since Interleague play began in 1997, the St. Louis Cardinals lead all teams with a .299 BA from their designated hitters, soundly ahead of the Boston Red Sox (.272) in 2nd place...**Matt Holliday** (119 AB, .277 BA), **Jose Martinez** (78 AB, .295) and **Albert Pujols** (50 AB, .360) have the most at-bats among Cardinals in Interleague play.

30-FOR-30: With an RBI on a sacrifice fly last night, **Paul Goldschmidt** not only knocked in his 10th game-winning RBI of the season, but has now recorded an RBI against all 30 MLB teams. It was only the second career Interleague sac fly by Goldschmidt with a previous vs. Seattle on June 18, 2012 at Chase Field.

KANSAS CITY CONNECTIONS

José Martínez was signed by the Royals as a minor league free agent (Jan. 28, 2015) and played parts of two seasons in Omaha (AAA)...hit .384 to win the 2015 PCL batting title, setting a modern era PCL record that was the circuit's highest since **Gene Woodling's** .385 mark in 1948 for the San Francisco Seals (AAA)...acquired by the Cardinals in exchange for cash considerations (May 25, 2016).

Miles Mikolas pitched his first career complete-game shutout against the Royals on May 21, 2018 with a career-high 9 strikeouts.

Kolten Wong's first MLB home run was a grand slam vs. Kansas City (June 2, 2014).

Royals Hitting Coach **Terry Bradshaw** played in 34 games over two seasons for the Cardinals (1995-96)...selected by St. Louis in the 9th round of the 1990 MLB Draft and spent his first eight seasons in the Cardinals organization.

Cardinals Hall of Fame manager **Whitey Herzog** managed the Royals for three seasons (1976-78)...piloted the club to three straight American League Western Division titles.

Royals Pitching Coach **Cal Eldred** pitched for St. Louis for three seasons (2003-05)...served as Cardinals Special Asst. to the GM (2013-15).

Royals Assistant Pitching Coordinator **Jason Simontacchi** pitched for St. Louis in parts of three seasons (2002-04)...was a minor league pitching coach in the Cardinals organization for parts of six seasons (2012-17).

Cardinals Asst. Athletic Trainer **Jeremy Clipperton** worked one season (2001) with the Rookie-level Northwest League Spokane Indians of the Royals organization.

Royals Special Asst. to the GM **Tim Conroy** worked as an area scout and an East Coast regional supervisor with St. Louis (1994-2000)...pitched for St. Louis for two seasons (1986-87).

Royals Northwest Arkansas (AA) Hitting Coach **Abraham Nuñez** was a member of the Cardinals 2005 N.L. Central championship team.

Cardinals broadcaster and former pitcher **Al Hrabosky** pitched in 116 games over two seasons (1978-79) with Kansas City...traded to Kansas City for pitcher **Mark Littell** and catcher **Buck Martinez** (Dec. 8, 1977).

Royals Senior Advisor to the GM/Scouting & Player and Development **Mike Arbuckle** was selected by the Cardinals in the 1969 MLB Draft.

Royals Special Advisor-Player Development **Mike Matheny** was Cardinals Manager from 2012-2018 and played five seasons (2000-04) as an All-Star catcher for the Cardinals. His 591 managerial wins rank 5th all-time for Cardinals.

Royals Special Assistant to the GM **Jim Fregosi Jr.** was originally selected by the Cardinals in the 2nd round of the 1985 MLB Draft.

Royals Asst. Dir. of Scouting **Dan Ontiveros** worked in the Cardinals Scouting Department from 1998-2004.

Royals Pitching Coordinator **Larry Carter** was originally selected by St. Louis in the 10th round of the 1986 MLB Draft.

Royals Roving Pitching Coordinator **Jeff Suppan** pitched parts of four seasons with St. Louis (2004-06, '10)...named 2006 NLCS MVP...member of 2006 World Series Champions.

Cardinals broadcaster **Brad Thompson** pitched part of the 2010 season with Kansas city.

FOX Sports Kansas City reporter **Joel Goldberg** covered the Cardinals for FOX Sports Midwest for three seasons (2005-07)...worked parts of six years for KTVI FOX 2 in St. Louis.

Royals broadcaster **Steve Stewart** is a St. Louis native...called Cardinals games on KMOX in 2002.

TONIGHT'S GAME

- Rookie right-hander makes his 24th career start (51st appearance) and 5th Interleague start this season.
- Resident of nearby Leawood, Kan., is making his first start and second appearance at Kauffman Stadium.
- Is 6-4 on the road this season, his six road wins at T4th among N.L. pitchers.
- Has lost two straight decisions for the third time in his career, looking to avoid a career-high three tonight.
- Ranks T8th in the National League and tied for first among Major League rookies with 10 wins, matching Atlanta's Mike Soroka. His team-leading 10 victories makes him the first Cardinals rookie to lead the Cardinals in that category since Matt Morris (12, 1997).
- Is 8-3 over his last 15 starts since May 18, the 2nd-most wins among National League pitchers trailing only Washington's Stephen Strasburg (11).
- Since Ground Ball Pct. became a recorded stat in 1987, currently has the 10th-best single-season mark (57.1) in Cardinals history and lowest since Jaime Garcia (57.9) in 2016.

LAST TIME OUT

- Pitched 4.0 innings in a no decision allowing two runs on six hits before being removed for a pinch-hitter in a game the Cardinals rallied to win 6-2. Was his 3rd straight start throwing 4.0 innings or less and first career MLB start without striking out a batter.
