Cleveland Rocks!

The Brewers are 10-2 all time against Cleveland at American Family Field with a current 5-game winning streak.

They're Out of Our League

The Brewers are 123-69 (.641) since 2022 during Interleague Play, trailing only the Dodgers (118-66, .641) by percentage points for the best record in the majors....the team is 21-11 (.656) against AL opponents in 2026.

Hangin' with Mr. Cooper

Cooper Pratt last night recorded his first Major League hit with a single off Gavin Williams and also notched his first career run, RBI and stolen base.

Start with a Bang

Christian Yelich last night belted his 10th career leadoff homer and ninth as a Brewer (one with the Marlins)....it was the second leadoff homer in the last 3 games for Milwaukee after hitting none in the first 68 games of the season....Jackson Chourio hit the team's first leadoff homer of 2026 on Sunday vs. Philadelphia.

That's a Fact, Jack!

In his last 17 games, Jackson Chourio is batting .370 (27-for-73) with 9 HR and 23 RBI....during this stretch, he has a .420 OBP/.795 SLG/1.214 OPS.

Trevor Megill, who had a 14.40 ERA, over his first 6 appearances of the season (5ip, 8er), has a 1.71 ERA in his last 21 outings (21ip, 4er) while holding opponents to a .173 batting average (13-for-75, 4bb, 31k).

TODAY'S GAME: Is the sixth game [4-1] of a 6-game, 7-day homestand against Philadelphia [2-1] and Cleveland [2-0]....after this homestand, the team takes a 6-game trip to Atlanta [3g] and Cincinnati [3g]....the Brewers return to American Family Field for a 7-game homestand against Chicago-NL [3g] and Cincinnati [4g] from 6/26-7/2.

IN THE TRAINER'S ROOM: RHP Coleman Crow (right forearm), LHP Brian Fitzpatrick (left elbow), LHP DL Hall (left pectoral), RHP Logan Henderson (back), LHP Jared Koenig (left elbow), OF Brandon Lockridge (right knee), RHP Quinn Priester (right thoracic outlet), RHP Carlos Rodriguez (right shoulder), RHP Brandon Woodruff (right shoulder), LHP Rob Zastryzny (left trapezius) and LHP Angel Zerpa (left forearm) are on the injured list....Fitzpatrick, Priester and Zerpa are on the 60-day IL.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy (395g, 235-160, .595) is in his third season as Brewers manager....he was voted NL Manager of the Year in 2024 and 2025....he is one of four managers ever to win Manager of the Year in consecutive seasons, joining the Braves' Bobby Cox (2004-05), Rays' Kevin Cash (2020-21) and Guardians' Stephen Vogt (2024-25)....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell....he signed a multi-year contract extension on 2/20/26.

COACHES: Returning from the 2025 staff is offense & strategy coordinator Jason Lane (11th season/1st in current role), pitching coordinator Jim Henderson (5th season/1st in current role), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (4th season/3rd in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (8th season), bullpen coach Charlie Greene (3rd season), lead hitting coach Eric Theisen (2nd season/1st in current role) and third base coach Matt Erickson (3rd season/1st in current role)....assistant pitching coach Juan Sandoval, hitting coach Guillermo Martinez, hitting coach Daniel Vogelbach and first base coach Spencer Allen are all in their first seasons on the coaching staff.

IN THE STANDINGS (84 days): The team has spent the following number of days alone or tied at each spot in the NL Central standings: **FIRST:** 46, **SECOND:** 10, **THIRD:** 8, **FOURTH:** 13, **FIFTH:** 7....the Brewers are currently in first place, leading the second-place Cardinals by 5.5 games.

AT HOME: The Brewers are 25-14 at home, going 9-3-1 in series play....the team has a pair of season-high 5-game winning streaks coming from 4/30-5/12 and 5/25-6/2.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 20-12 on the road, going 7-3-1 in series play....the team is 12-4 in its last 16 road games and had a season-high 5-game winning streak from 5/31-6/8.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 22 replay challenges this season, going 16-6....their last challenge (lost) came on 6/8 at Athletics as an out call at first base involving Brice Turang was confirmed.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have qualified for the postseason seven times in the last eight seasons and three seasons in a row....the team was just two games away from making the postseason in nine straight seasons (2017-25), missing out in both 2017 and 2022 by a single game....Milwaukee has won the NL Central in four of the last five seasons and three seasons in a row.

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last eight full seasons (2017-25)....this does not include the shortened 2020 season....the Brewers have 808 wins since 2017, which ranks fourth in the majors behind the Dodgers (901), Astros (841) and Yankees (833).

DROHAN AT A GLANCE: Shane Drohan, 27, will be making his 15th appearance and fifth start of the season....Drohan last pitched last Saturday in a start vs. Philadelphia and took a 9-8 loss (5ip, 8h, 4r, 4er, 0bb, 7k, 1hr, 78 pitches)....he is 1-2 with a 6.00 ERA as a starter (18ip, 12er) and 2-0 with a 1.82 ERA as a reliever (24.2ip, 5er)....the team is 2-2 in his starts....he has 1 quality start....opponents are batting .238 (39-for-164, 3hr)....he made his Major League debut in a start on 4/8 at Boston and took a 5-0 loss (2.2ip, 3h, 3r, 3er, 4bb, 2k, 63 pitches)....he is also 1-1 with a 3.29 ERA in 3 games/ 2 starts this season at Triple-A Nashville (13.2ip, 14h, 6r, 5er, 7bb, 17k, 2hr)....Drohan was acquired from Boston with LHP Kyle Harrison and INF David Hamilton on February 9 in exchange for INF Caleb Durbin, INF Andruw Monasterio, INF/C Anthony Seigler and a 2026 Competitive Balance Round B selection....name is pronounced "DROH-ehn."

LAST SEASON: Drohan went 5-1 with a 2.27 ERA in 12 games/11 starts at Triple-A Worcester....he held International League opponents to a .185 AVG with 67 strikeouts in 47.2 innings while posting a 1.01 WHIP....he was on Worcester's injured list from 5/13-8/25 with left forearm inflammation.

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER: Is 32-22 with a 4.25 ERA in 107 games/91 starts (425.1ip, 387h, 226r, 201er, 212bb, 489k, 51hr) while pitching in the Boston (2021-25), Chicago-AL (2024) and Milwaukee (2026) organizations....he was originally selected by Philadelphia in the 23rd round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft but did not sign....he was then selected by Boston in the fifth round of the 2020 First-Year Player Draft....Drohan went from Boston to Chicago-AL in the 2023 Rule 5 Draft and returned to the Red Sox in June 2024....he underwent left shoulder surgery 2/22/24, performed by Dr. Nikhil Verma, and missed most of the 2024 season.

AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 1-1 with a 3.21 ERA in 10 games/2 starts (28ip, 10er).

ON THE ROAD: Is 2-1 with a 4.30 ERA in 4 games/2 starts (14.2ip, 7er).

vs. GUARDIANS: Drohan has not faced Cleveland.

ODDS & ENDS: Drohan graduated from Cardinal Newman (FL) High School, where he played three years of football [quarterback] in addition to baseball....he went on to attend Florida State University....his father, Bill, pitched in the Royals organization from 1987-90 at the Rookie and Class-A levels....Drohan enjoys watching football and basketball and playing video games....he is a fan of the Miami Dolphins and Miami Heat.

RHP Jacob Misiorowski will make his 15th start of the season.....Misiorowski last started last Friday vs. Philadelphia and picked up a 6-0 win as he threw the first complete game of his career (9ip, 1h, 0bb, 15k, 95 pitches).....he became the seventh pitcher in Major League history to have a game with 15+ strikeouts while allowing one or no hits and issuing no walks.....the team is 9-5 in his starts.....he has 9 quality starts (seven in a row)..... opponents are batting .140 (42-for-299, 4hr).....he has 131 strikeouts in 87.0 innings (13.55 K/9IP).....he is 7-0 with a 0.17 ERA in his last 8 starts (54.1ip, 19h, 2r, 1er, 9bb, 80k, 0hr).....he was named NL Player of the Week for 5/25-5/31 and 6/8-6/14 (co-winner).....he has never faced the Braves.
