TONIGHT'S TILT...the Mariners continue a 9-game homestand with the 2nd of 3 games against the Minnesota Twins (1-0)...the Mariners also welcome the Baltimore Orioles (3 G, July 2-4) and Toronto Blue Jays (3 G, July 5-7) to T-Mobile Park on the homestand...Seattle is coming off a 9-game road trip (3-6) at Cleveland (1-2), Miami (1-2) and Tampa Bay (1-2)...tonight's game will be televised live on **ROOT SPORTS** with **Aaron Goldsmith** and **Mike Blowers** on the call...the game will also be broadcast live on **Seattle Sports (710 AM)** with **Rick Rizzs** and **Dave Sims**.

ODDS AND ENDS...the Mariners earned their 6th walk-off win of the season in last night's game, beating the Twins 3-2 in 10 innings...the Mariners are 16-10 (.615) over their last 26 games (5/31-c) and 20-11 (.645) over their last 31 games (5/26-c).

- **In The Mix For Six** - Seattle is 40-15 (.727) when its starting pitchers go 6.0+ innings this season.
- **Greatest Hits** - Seattle is 35-3 (.921) when out-hitting its opponent this season.
- **Kings of Clutch** - The Mariners have 17 comeback wins this season, including 7 when trailing after the 7th inning.
- **Thievery** - The Mariners are 27-for-31 (87.1%) in stolen base attempts since May 27, the 3rd-best stolen base percentage in the Majors during that span.
- **'Stache Power - Mitch Garver** holds a .857 OPS over his last 21 games (6/2-c) with 5 doubles, 5 home runs, 17 RBI and 15 walks with a .349 OBP and a .508 slugging percentage during that span.
- **The Walking Man - J.P. Crawford** has drawn a walk in 5-consecutive games (6/23-c)...he tied the franchise record last season, walking in 10-consecutive games from July 25-Aug. 5, 2023.

THE WEST'S BEST...the Mariners (47-37) are in 1st place in the American League West Division by 5.5 games over the 2nd place Houston Astros (40-41) and 9.0 games over the 3rd place Texas Rangers (37-45)...the Mariners have held 1st place for 48 consecutive days (5/12-c).

THREE CONSECUTIVE...the Mariners have clinched a winning month of June, going 15-10 in the month so far with 2 games remaining...Seattle went 17-13 in March/April and 15-14 in May...Seattle has started the season with 3 consecutive winning months for the 5th time in franchise history (2001-03, '18, '24).

TERRIFIC AT T-MOBILE...Seattle is 28-12 (.700) at T-Mobile Park this season, 3rd-best home record in the Majors behind Cleveland (.743/26-9) and Philadelphia (.711/32-13)...the Mariners are 13-2 (.867) over their last 15 home games since May 27, best home record in the Majors during that span.

- **Series-ly Special** - The Mariners have won 9 consecutive series at home (4/15-c), 2nd-longest streak in team history and trailing only the 11 consecutive home series wins from July 27, 2001-April 3, 2002.
- **#TridentsUp** - The Mariners are 10-2 (.833) in front of home crowds of at least 35,000, the best record in MLB among the 15 teams who have drawn 35,000+ fans at least 10 times this season.
- **Lid Lifters** - The Mariners won their 12th-consecutive series opener at home (4/1-c) in yesterday's game, extending their franchise record.

FOUR SCORE...the Mariners are 36-6 (.857) this season when scoring 4+ runs in a game, as opposed to 11-31 (.262) when scoring 3-or-fewer runs...Seattle's .857 winning percentage when dialing up 4+ runs is **best in the Majors**...it is also on pace to be the 2nd-best record when scoring 4+ runs in franchise history, trailing only the 2001 Mariners (.886/101-13).

PITCHIN' IN THE HOME KITCHEN...Seattle's pitching staff has allowed 113 runs at T-Mobile Park this season, by far the fewest runs allowed at home in the Majors (next: Cleveland, 130 R allowed)...the Mariners lead the Majors in home ERA (2.52), opponent batting average (.194), WHIP (0.92), hits-per-9 innings (6.31), walks-per-9 innings (1.92), strikeout-to-walk ratio (4.82) and FIP (2.93), ranking 4th in strikeouts-per-9 innings (9.27)...Seattle's .194 opponent AVG would be the **lowest in MLB history**, a record currently held by the 1910 White Sox (.196 opponent AVG at home)...Seattle's 4.77 strikeout-to-walk ratio this year is currently the highest home SO/BB ratio in Major League history.

ALL-STAR(TERS)...the Mariners starting rotation has several All-Star candidates...**Logan Gilbert** leads **the American League** in WHIP (0.88) and quality starts (14), innings pitched (112.1), 3rd in opponent batting average (.195) and 7th in ERA (2.72)...**George Kirby** leads **the Majors** in strikeout-to-walk ratio (10.67) and ranks 2nd in MLB in fewest walks-per-9 innings (0.82)...**Luis Castillo**'s 100 strikeouts rank T-9th in the AL, while **Bryce Miller** ranks 6th in opponent batting average (.205) and 10th in WHIP (1.04).

ANDRÉS MUÑOZ: WORTHY OF BEING AN AL ALL-STAR...right-hander **Andrés Muñoz** has 13 saves and a 1.64 ERA (6 ER, 33.0 IP) with 43 strikeouts and 13 walks in 33 appearances this season...his next save will set a career-high, after he recorded 13 saves in 2023...this season, Muñoz has posted a 1.03 WHIP and limited opposing hitters to a .179 batting average...the 25-year-old is 1 of 3 American League pitchers with 13+ saves and a sub-2.00 ERA, along with Emmanuel Clase-CLE and Mason Miller-OAK...Muñoz is 1 of 2 MLB pitchers with 10+ saves and 5+ holds this season, along with José Alvarado-PHI.

THE RYNEOCEROS...**Ryne Stanek** has thrown 10 consecutive scoreless outings (6/10-c), going 2-0 with 3 saves and 2 holds during that span...the right-hander has 11 strikeouts and just 1 walk over 8.2 innings in those 10 appearances, limiting opponents to a .188 (6x32) batting average and .431 OPS.

R&R AT HOME...**Luke Raley** and **Josh Rojas** have the 2 highest OPS's at T-Mobile Park among Mariners this season...in 33 home games, Raley is batting .270 (24x89) with 15 runs, 5 doubles, 1 triple, 5 home runs, 15 RBI and 5 stolen bases with a .854 OPS...in 33 home games, Rojas is batting .281 (27x96) with 17 runs, 6 doubles, 4 homers, 11 RBI, 4 stolen bases and 14 walks with an .847 OPS.

ON THE HOMESTAND...the Mariners are home for a 9-game homestand through July 7, hosting the Minnesota Twins (3 G, June 28-30), Baltimore Orioles (3 G, July 2-4) and Toronto Blue Jays (3 G, July 5-7)...upcoming promotions on the homestand include **Aloha Shirt Night** tonight, Bark at the Park on July 2, **Patriotic Fireworks** on July 3 and **Patriotic Cap** on July 4.

AS YOU MAY KNOW...**Cal Raleigh** has been stellar behind the plate this season, leading Major League catchers in catcher caught stealing (15) and tied for the lead in defensive runs saved (10), but...**DID YOU KNOW?**...that Mariners pitchers have pitched to a 3.25 ERA while Raleigh has been behind the plate?...his 3.25 catcher ERA ranks 4th in the Majors, trailing only J.T. Realmuto (2.84 ERA), Adley Rutschman (3.20) and Freddy Fermin (3.21), and...**DID YOU ALSO KNOW?**...that Cal's 3.25 catcher ERA this season ranks 2nd in franchise history, trailing only Mike Zunino (3.18 in 2014)?...Cal also holds the 3rd-best catcher ERA in a season in franchise history, with Mariners pitchers combining for a 3.30 ERA when he was catching during the 2022 season.

ABOUT BRYCE MILLER...

- The 25-year-old right-handed pitcher is scheduled to make his 17th start of 2024 and his 1st against Minnesota...marks his 42nd career start and 2nd against the Twins.
- Selected by Seattle in the 4th round (113th overall) of the 2021 MLB First-Year Player Draft; signed by Mariners scout Derek Miller.
- Spent 3 seasons at Texas A&M from 2019-21...also spent 2 seasons playing for Brazos Valley Bombers of the Texas Collegiate League in 2018 and 2020, and 1 season with the Falmouth Commodores of the Cape Cod League in 2019.
- Was born in Mount Pleasant, Texas and attended New Braunfels High School in New Braunfels, Texas.

LAST TIME OUT...L#6 on 6/23 at Miami...pitched 4.0 innings and allowed 6 hits (2 home runs), 6 runs (6 earned), 1 walk with 3 strikeouts...his first time since 4/24 without pitching 5.0+ innings.

AMERICAN v NATIONAL...in 5 outings against the National League this year, he is 3-1 with a 2.37 ERA (8 ER, 30.1 IP), 31 strikeouts and 4 quality starts...has allowed 1-or-fewer runs 4 out of 5 starts...NL hitters are slashing .144/.198/.269 against Miller in 2024.

AGAINST THE TWINS...in his only career start against the Twins (7/26/23) he did not allow a walk...Minnesota is 1 of 2 teams to not earn a walk against Miller in his career (also: New York-AL).

KEEPIN' IT LOW...his .205 opponent average (69x337) against ranks 11th in the Majors and 5th in the AL...he is 10th in the AL in WHIP (1.04)...the only Mariners pitcher to go a single season with a Opp. AVG below .200 is Randy Johnson (1997, .194).

YOU GOTTA EARN IT...has given up 2 ER or fewer in 10 of 16 games this season and 1 ER or fewer in 6 games...**Luis Castillo** leads Mariner starters with 11 games of 2 or less ER allowed.

EVERYTHING IS ALL LEFT...left-handed batters are slashing .204/.273/.414 (38x186) with 18 walks, 39 strikeouts, 6 doubles and 11 home runs, in 2024.

HIT LIMITER...his start on 6/12 vs. Chicago-AL was his 12th career game with 6.0+ innings pitched and 3-or-fewer hits allowed...since his debut on May 2, 2023, he has the 6th-most in the Majors and 2nd-most in the AL, only trailing **Logan Gilbert (14)**...he has done so on 5 occasions this season, tied for the 2nd most in MLB while trailing Tyler Glasnow-LAD (8).

IT WORKS 80% OF THE TIME, EVERYTIME...hitters this season are batting .191 (55x290) against his 4-seam fastball, splitter and sinker combined...81.0% of his pitches thrown this year have been one of those three...77 of his 85 strikeouts this season have come via a 4-seam fastball (36), splitter (26) or sinker (15) and he has allowed just 8 doubles and 10 home runs on those pitches.

SOME QUALITY TIME...has tossed 17 quality starts (6.0+ IP, 3 ER or less) in 41 career outings...in games where he tosses a quality start the Mariners are 15-2.

NO APRIL SHOWERS...in his 5 starts in April, he held a 1.19 ERA (4 ER, 30.1 IP) with 3 wins, 4 quality starts and an opponent batting average of .127 (13x102)...this marks the lowest ERA and the lowest batting average against in a single calendar month during his career...it is also tied for the most wins in a month (May 2023, 3) and 2nd-most quality starts during a single month in his career (May 2023, 5).

YOU SHALL NOT SCORE...tossed 14.0 consecutive scoreless innings starting in the 5th inning of his start vs. Boston (3/31) and ending in his start vs. Chicago-NL (4/12) in the 7th.

200 AND COUNTING...recorded his 200th career strikeout in his last start against Cleveland on 6/18 after striking out Bo Naylor-CLE in the 2nd inning...his 204 strikeouts in his first 41 career games ranks 8th in franchise history.

AMONG THE BEST OF THEM...finished in the top 10 among rookies with a minimum of 100.0 innings pitched in various pitching categories in 2023, including BB/9 (1st, 1.78), SO/BB (1st, 4.58), WHIP (3rd, 1.14), GS (4th, 25), wins (T-6th, 8), IP (7th, 131.1) and ERA (9th, 4.32).

MAKING MORE HISTORY...became the 1st pitcher since at least 1901 to go 6.0+ innings pitched and allow 2-or-fewer hits in at least 4 of his first 10 career appearances.

MAKING IT LOOK EASY...he became the only pitcher in MLB history to have 6.0+ innings pitched and allow 3-or-fewer baserunners in his first 3 career starts...his 3-game streak of 6.0+ innings pitched and 3-or-fewer baserunners allowed is tied for the longest since 1901...Blake Snell-SDP and Corbin Burnes-MIL were the most recent pitchers to achieve this feat, both doing so in 2021.

AN ALMOST PERFECT BEGINNING...took a perfect game into the 6th inning in his first career Major League start at Oakland on 5/2/23 before a Tony Kemp 1-out single broke up the no-hit bid...the 16-consecutive batters retired in a pitcher's MLB debut are the most since 1961 (*h/t Elias Sports*).

WHAT A DEBUT...became just the 3rd pitcher in MLB history to strike out 10 batters without issuing a walk in their Major League debut, joining RHP Johnny Cueto-CIN (4/3/08) and Stephen Strasburg-WSH (6/8/10)...became the 30th pitcher in MLB history to strikeout 10+ in their MLB debut...also set a franchise record for most strikeouts in a debut moving ahead of Enrique Romo, who struck out 9 on 4/7/77.
