**THE WORD ON THE 'BIRDS:** The St. Louis Cardinals continue a seven-game road trip over eight days in the Golden State with the finale of four games with the San Diego Padres at Petco Park. The Cardinals have won 2-of-3, taking a 4-2 loss yesterday afternoon at Petco Park. Following today's game, the Cardinals will enjoy an open date in San Diego before flying to Sacramento to play a three-game series with the Athletics (May 12-14).

**FLIGHT PATTERN:** St. Louis enters play today at 23-16 and in 2nd place in the National League Central, 3.5 games behind first place Chicago. The Cardinals have tied for the 4th-best record in the National League at 23-16 with San Diego. The 2021 season was the last time the Cardinals were 23-16 or better through 39 games.

**WELCOME BACK:** For the first time since May 6, the Cardinals will be on Cardinals TV and not National TV as broadcasters Chip Caray, Mark Sweeney and field host Dani Wexelman will be entertaining Cardinals fans. The Cardinals were 2-1 during their stretch on ESPN, Apple and FOX.

**IT CAN BE A MOTHER:** Today's matchup marks the 115th game the Cardinals have played on Mother's Day since it became a National holiday in 1914. St. Louis is 55-67-2 overall and 28-32-2 on the road. The Cardinals have played their last four Mother's Days on the road and have played the Padres four times. The first was in the Padres inaugural 1969 season with San Diego earning the win. St. Louis has only beat the Padres on Mother's Day once, a 15-5 win at Busch Memorial Stadium in 2005. San Diego also won in 2018 (5-3) and 2007 (3-0).

**BIRTHDAY 'BIRDS:** Nolan Gorman (26) and Cesar Prieto (27) are both celebrating their birthday today. Gorman has played twice on his birthday previously and homered on his 24th birthday at Milwaukee with a home run in the 9th inning. Gorman was the first MLB player with a 2000 birth year to play in the Majors when he debuted in 2022.

**ROAD KILL:** The Cardinals enter with the best road record in Major League Baseball at 13-6 (.684). The last time the Cardinals lost two straight road games was April 4-5 at Detroit.

**CHiPs (Cardinals High in Preventing Steals):** Catcher Pedro Pagés has threw out runners giving him a Major League-leading nine catcher caught stealing for the season.

**LITTLE LEAGUE GRAND SLAM:** Friday night, with the bases loaded in the 5th inning, Cardinals rookie JJ Wetherholt hit a two-RBI single to right field which was misplayed by Fernando Tatis, Jr., into an inside-the-park-grand slam. It was the first instance the Cardinals scored all four runs on a hit aided by an error since July 3, 1967 vs. Cincinnati at Busch Memorial Stadium. Highlighting a 7-run 1st inning off Reds starter Milt Pappas, shortstop Dal Maxvill hit a double that would score Orlando Cepeda, Mike Shannon, Julian Javier and Maxvill, aided by a throwing error from Pete Rose. The Cardinals went on to win 7-3 scoring all their runs in one inning, similar to the Cardinals Friday night. -Elias Sports Bureau

**IVÁN THE CHEER-ABLE:** Iván Herrera caught his second shutout of the season (5th career) Friday night. He put a bow on it by rapping out a career-high four hits. It was the first time a Cardinals catcher had a four-hit game since Willson Contreras did against his former team, the Chicago Cubs, at London Stadium on June 25, 2023. The last time it happened stateside was Yadier Molina vs. Cincinnati (8/23/20) in front of zero fans at Busch Stadium during the COVID-19 restrictions. Herrera ran his career-high on-base streak to 25 games on Saturday, 3rd-longest active in MLB behind only Nic Kurtz (ATH, 32) and Ian Happ (CHI, 30).

**Fernando Tatis**, father of Padres outfielder, **Fernando Tatis Jr.**, played three seasons with St. Louis (1998-2000)...is famously remembered for hitting two grand slams in one inning (April 23, 1999 at Los Angeles), both off of **Chan Ho Park**.

Cardinals TV broadcaster **Mark Sweeney** played parts of four seasons in San Diego (1997-98, 2002, 2005) and appeared in the 1998 World Series...was a part of the Padres broadcasting team for 12 seasons (2012-23)...resides in San Diego.

**Thomas Saggese** was born in and resides in Carlsbad, CA...graduated from Carlsbad High School.

**Ramón Urías's** younger brother, **Luis Urías**, played parts of two seasons in San Diego (2018-19), where he made his MLB debut.

**Brant Brown** (June 15, 1996 at Wrigley), **Daniel Descalso** (Sept. 18, 2010 at Busch III), **Dustin May** (Aug. 8, 2019 at Dodger Std.), and **Brad Thompson** May 8, 2005 at Busch II) made MLB debuts vs. the Padres.

Cardinals President of Baseball Operations **Chaim Bloom** began his baseball career as a Baseball Operations Intern with the San Diego Padres.

#### SAN DIEGO CONNECTIONS

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** played 26 games for San Diego in 2008...traded by St. Louis to San Diego for **David Freese** (Dec. 14, 2007).

Hall of Famer **Ozzie Smith** was selected by San Diego in the 4th round of the 1977 MLB Draft...played four seasons with San Diego (1978-81)...traded by San Diego with Al Olmsted and Steve Mura to St. Louis for Luis DeLeon, Sixto Lezcano and Garry Templeton (Dec. 10, 1981).

**Yohel Pozo** was signed by San Diego as a minor league free agent in Nov. 2020, before the Texas Rangers re-acquired him by selecting him in the Triple-A phase Rule 5 Draft 23 days later.

Padres Asst. Hitting Coach **Mike McCoy** was selected by St. Louis in the 34th round of the 2002 MLB Draft...played six minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization.

Padres Baseball Operations Advisor **Allen Craig** played parts of five seasons (2010-14) with St. Louis, where he was a 2013 NL All-Star and member of 2011 World Series Champion Cardinals.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Mark McGwire** was the Padres bench coach for three seasons (2016-18).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Ray Lankford** played parts of two seasons for San Diego (2001-02)...traded by St. Louis with cash to the Padres for **Woody Williams** (Aug. 2, 2001).

**Jon Jay** played the 2016 season with San Diego...traded by St. Louis to the Padres for **Jedd Gyorko** and cash (Dec. 8, 2015).

Padres Coach **Peter Summerville's** brother, **Andrew**, was drafted by St. Louis in the 12th round in 2017...pitched two minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization.

Padres Coach **Nick Punto** played 63 games for St. Louis in 2011 and was a member of the 2011 World Series Champions.

Padres broadcaster **Carlos Hernandez** played 17 games for St. Louis in 2000...traded (July 31, 2000) to St. Louis with **Nate Tebbis** from the Padres for **Heathcliff Slocumb** and current Memphis (AAA) manager **Ben Johnson**.

St. Louis Post-Dispatch reporter **Daniel Guerrero** graduated from San Diego State Univ. in 2020...interned for NBC San Diego in 2019...also served as backup MLB.com reporter on-site at Petco Park.

## TODAY'S GAME:

- Today marks his 8th start of the season (9th career) and 106th career appearance.
- It will be his 4th career appearance vs. the Padres and his first career start. Is 0-0 with a 0.00 ERA (0 ER/5.1 IP) and three strikeouts in three relief outings.
- Looking to earn a win in three straight appearances for the first time in his career after winning both of his last two starts (4/28 at PIT & 5/4 vs. MIL).
- **Three of his team-leading four wins this season have come on the road: April 5 at Detroit, April 17 at Houston and April 28 at Pittsburgh. Is T-1st in the NL with three road wins and is one of five NL starters to win three of their first four road starts of the season.**
- Limiting right-handed batters to .246/.324/.393 (15-61) slash with a .717 OPS this season.
- His first 97 career appearances were as a relief pitcher beginning with his Major League debut on July 7, 2023; First career start came at Chicago's Wrigley Field on Sept. 28, 2025.
- Previously started 72-of-89 games over his first four professional seasons (2018-19, 2021-22).
- Kyle's 97 career relief appearances before his 1st career Major League start (Sept. 28, 2025 at CHI) were the most by a Cardinal since **Jordan Hicks** (April 21, 2022 at Miami) who made his 1st career start after having made 114 career relief appearances.

**LAST TIME OUT (Monday, May 4 vs. MIL at Busch Stadium):** W, 6-3: 5.1 IP, 6 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 2 BB, 5 SO, 0 HR, 1 HBP; 94 pitches.

- Matched his career high in innings pitched (5.1) for the 2nd straight start (Also: 4/28 at PIT).
- Allowed a season-low one run, his fewest as a starter since his 1st career start on 9/28/25 at CHC (3.0 IP).
- Earned his first home win of the season, and his first career home win as a starter (3rd overall).

## 2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

**PARK PLACE:** Is making his fifth road start of the season, and all five will have been at Parks (Petco Park, Comerica Park, Daikin Park, LoanDepot park, & PNC Park), with his next road start potentially at Cincinnati's Great American Ball Park.

**DEEP DRIVE DIVE:** Four of his six homers allowed have been solo shots, three of the six HR's have come in the 3rd inning.

**DECISIVE STARTS:** Has earned the decision in each of his seven starts; leads the team in wins (4) and is T-2nd in losses (3). Is tied for 4th in MLB in decisions (7). Has received winning decisions in consecutive outings for the first time in his career (4/28 at PIT & 5/4 vs. MIL).

**STRETCHING OUT:** Pitched a career-high 5.1 innings in each of his last two starts (4/28 at PIT & 5/4 vs. MIL), and has worked at least 5.0 innings in six of his seven starts on the year.

**CENTRAL FOCUS:** Earned a win in both of his starts against NL Central opponents this season (4/28 at PIT & 5/4 vs. MIL) to improve to 4-1 in his career against divisional opponents.

**BROOM RIDE:** Gained the win in the middle game of the Cardinals three-game series sweep at HOU in a 9-4 win on 4/17; Struck out a season high 6, but allowed 3 solo HR's.

**ALL EYES ON US:** Drew back-to-back starting assignments in nationally televised games on Easter Sunday on NBC/Peacock Sunday Night Baseball in Detroit and April 11 vs. Boston on FOX.

**EASTER DELIGHT:** Gained his 1st win of the season on April 5, allowing 2 runs over 5.0 IP in the Cardinals 5-3 Easter win over the Tigers. He threw a career-high 97 pitches as he earned the winning decision as a starter for the 1st time - all while helping to prevent a series sweep by Detroit.

**IT'S COLDER IN BOULDER:** The Colorado native worked in game time temps of 42 degrees on Easter Sunday in Detroit, his third career MLB appearance in temperatures 45 degrees and below, two shy of matching Cardinals announcer **Brad Thompson** (5) for T-3rd among Cardinals in the frosty temps.

**IF AT FIRST YOU DON'T SUCCEED...:** Took the loss in his first career home start vs. NYM (3/30), allowing four runs over a then career-high 5.0 innings and 79 pitches.

## CAREER:

- Graduated from Erie (Colo.) High School. Named Boulder County Player of the Year and was selected to play at the High School Futures Game at Coors Field.
- Played college baseball at Colorado Mesa University in Grand Junction, Colo., going 22-2 with a 3.13 ERA (204.1 IP), 188 strikeouts and six complete games.
- Allowed nine home runs to 852 total batters faced while pitching in high altitude (Grand Junction is 4,583 ft above sea level).
- Posted a 13-0 record with a 1.41 ERA during his sophomore season, earning First Team All-American, First Team Academic All-American, and was the South Central Regional Tournament MVP.
- Pitched two summers for the Waterloo Bucks of the collegiate summer Northwoods League (2016-17).
- His father, Tim Leahy, played college basketball at Kansas State University and his uncle, Thomas Leahy, pitched in the Braves organization (1991-93) advancing to Durham (High-A).

**LEAHY VS. SAN DIEGO:**

- Makes his first career start and 4th career appearance vs. the Padres and his first career start. Is 0-0 with a 0.00 ERA (0 ER/5.1 IP) and three strikeouts in three relief outings.
- Appears in a game at Petco Park for the 2nd time in his career after earning a hold with 1.2 perfect IP and one strikeout in a relief outing on 8/2/25 during an 8-5 victory.
- Pitched 2.2 scoreless innings of relief on 7/26/25 vs. SD that was his longest home relief outing of the season and the longest scoreless relief appearance by a Cardinals pitcher against the Padres since **Carlos Martinez** worked 2.2 scoreless innings on 6/30/19 during a 5-3, 11-inning win at Petco Park.
- Makes his first career start vs. the NL West. Has not allowed a run in seven of his last eight outings vs. NL West opponents (all in relief) since 7/26/25 vs. SD. His 0.93 WHIP against the NL West is the 4th lowest in franchise history (min. 25.0 IP), while his 6.75 strikeout-to-walk ratio (27 SO/4 BB) ranks 3rd.

**LAST APPEARANCE VS. PADRES (Aug. 2, 2025 at Petco Park):** ND, W, 8-5 in relief - 1.2 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 1 SO, 16 pitches

- Was one of his eight hitless relief appearances in 2025 that were longer than 1.0 inning, tying **Matt Svanson** for the most such outings on the team.
