RAY REPORT—The Rays continue a six-game, seven-day homestand against the Mariners (2-1) and Nationals (1-0, 2 to play) today at Tropicana Field...have won four of five, seven of nine, eight of 11, and 10 of their last 16 games...after traveling to Kansas City and Texas from July 2-7, the Rays will conclude their pre-All-Star break schedule by hosting two of the AL's top three teams in the Yankees and Guardians from July 9-14... the Rays are at the .500 mark for the 16th time this season...they have not been above .500 since entering play on May 21 (25-24).

Last night, Jose Siri's two-homer game powered a 3-1 series-opening win over the Nationals...the Rays did not allow an earned run for the sixth time this season.

Tampa Bay has won four of its last five games at Tropicana Field after posting an MLB-worst 5-14 mark at home from May 8-June 12.

The Rays have scored first in 12 of their last 13 games since June 14, with the exception being June 24 vs. SEA...they are 8-5 over that span...they allowed their opponent to score first in nine of their first 11 games to open June, going 5-6.

The Rays 16-8 (.667) mark in Interleague play is the best in the majors...they are 8-2 against NL clubs at home, winning seven of their last eight games.

Despite a -54 run differential on the season, third worst in the AL (LAA -64; OAK -101), the Rays have outscored opponents, 76-65 (+11), over their last 16 games.

With a win today or tomorrow, the Rays would record a fourth straight series victory, which would mark their longest streak since claiming six consecutive sets from Aug. 11-30, 2023...they would also improve to 7-2-0 in series play against NL opponents (4-0-0 at home).

A victory would also secure a winning record in June for the second straight year...after posting a 17-10 mark in June 2023, it would mark the second time the Tampa Bay has accomplished the feat in back-to-back seasons, joining 2008-09.

REWRITING RECORD BOOKS—Last night, Yandy Díaz extended his hitting streak to 20 games with a 3rd-inning single, surpassing Jason Bartlett (19G from May 15–June 25, 2009) for the longest streak in franchise history...since the streak began on June 7, Díaz is slashing .360/.374/.494 (32-for-89) with 3 2B, 3 HR and 11 RBI...he ranks among AL leaders over that span in mulit-hit games (T1st, 11), hits (2nd, 32) and average (5th)...in all of MLB, only MIN Carlos Correa (34) has more hits in that timeframe...it marks the second-longest active streak in the majors behind PIT Bryan Reynolds (24G) and is fourth longest in MLB this season, also trailing 21-game streaks by AZ Ketel Marte and NYY Anthony Volpe.

Díaz also has a career-high 29-game on-base streak, the second-longest active streak in MLB behind BAL Gunnar Henderson (35G)...it marks the ninth-longest streak in franchise history and is the longest since Wander Franco (43G) in 2021.

He saw his streak of eight consecutive games with an RBI come to an end last night...it tied the club record shared by Rocco Baldelli (2004), Carlos Peña (2008), Evan Longoria (2009) and Ben Zobrist (2009) and is tied with BOS Wilyer Abreu (April 18-27) for the second-longest streak in the majors this season behind LAD Shohei Ohtani (10G, June 16-26).

Díaz has collected 36 hits in June, tied with Delmon Young (2007) for fourth most in the month in Rays history...Randy Winn (2002) holds the club record with 42 hits, followed by Carl Crawford (40, 2009) and Julio Lugo (37, 2006)...it matches August 2023 for the most hits in any calendar month of Díaz's career

ARE YOU SIRI-OUS?—Last night, Jose Siri recorded his fifth career multi-homer game and second this season, joining May 30 vs. Oakland...he is one of four MLB outfielders with multiple 2+ HR games this season (games as OF only), along with HOU Kyle Tucker (4G), NYY Juan Soto (3G) and LAD Teoscar Hernández (2G)...over his last 15 games, Siri is slashing .327/407/.692 (17-for-52) with 42B, 5 HR and 7 RBI...in his last 26 games since May 26, he ranks among AL leaders in slugging pct. (4th, .624), home runs (5th, 8), extra-base hits (T5th, 15) and OPS (7th, .983)...that date represents when his current string of success began:

OPS 528 983 Detensive runs saved 3 6 **RED-HOT RAYS—Ben Rortvedt** is batting .359/.405/.692 (14-for-39) with 4 2B, 3 HR and 14 RBI over his last 12 games...the 14 RBI since June 13 are tied for third most in the AL behind NYY **Aaron Judge** (17RBI) and BAL **Anthony Santander** (16RBI)...he has hit safely in a career-high-tying five straight games (also April 3-10, 2024) and has a four-game RBI streak, the longest by a Rays catcher since **Mike Zunino** (5G) from Aug. 11-17, 2021. **Randy Arozarena** is batting .300/.431/.525 (12-for-40) with 3 2B, 2 HR, 7 RBI, 6 BB and 4 HBP during a 12-game on-base streak...his last longer streak was a career-best 20-game run from April 17-May 9, 2023. **Josh Lowe** is 11-for-33 (.333) with 5 XBH a 1.072 OPS over his last nine games...he entered that stretch batting .189 (14-for-74) with a .594 OPS in his first 23 contests.

TO LEAD. OR NOT TO LEAD—According to Elias, the Rays have held a lead at some point in 17 consecutive games, their longest streak since an 18-game run from May–June, 2021...there have been only two other streaks of 18+ games in Rays history: 26 games in April–May 2013 and 22 games in August 2020...from May 18–June 4, Tampa Bay trailed at some point in 15 consecutive games...the Rays rank among MLB leaders in both comeback wins (T2nd, 22) and blown lead losses (T3rd, 22).

PITCHING PROWESS—Rays pitching has turned in a 2.76 ERA (62.0IP, 19ER) and 0.89 WHIP over the last seven games, holding opponents to a .151/244/.297 (32-for-212) line...it marks the AL's second-best ERA over that span (since June 21) behind the Angels (2.57)...since posting a 10.13 ERA (16.0IP, 18ER) over four games from June 14-18, the Rays rotation has allowed 2 ER or fewer in eight of the last nine games, pitching to a 2.81 ERA (48.0IP, 15ER).

CLOSE SHAVES—The Rays own the majors' best record in one-run games (16-7/.696) and games decided by two runs or fewer (29-12/.707)...among AL clubs, only the Athletics (43G) have played in more games decided by two runs or fewer than the Rays (41G)... since April 29, they are 20-6 in such contests and 8-19 in games with a margin of 3+ runs... this includes a 12-4 record in one-run games over that timeframe...seven of their last nine wins have come by two runs or fewer.

The Rays and Nationals are tied with the Royals and Yankees for second in the majors with 22 comeback wins. trailing the Brewers (24)...Tampa Bay has come from behind in six of 10 and 12 of its last 17 victories.

Tampa Bay ranks among MLB leaders in last at-bat wins (T3rd, 12), wins after the opponent scores first (T4th, 17) and walk-off wins (T5th, 5)...the Rays have the most wins in the majors when trailing after six (10) and seven (8) frames.

D.C. DEALINGS—The Rays and Nationals meet for their lone series of 2024 this weekend, their first meeting at Tropicana Field since a two-game split from June 8-9, 2021...last season, the Rays recorded a three-game sweep at Nationals Park from April 3-5 as part of their modern era-record-tying 13-game season-opening winning streak...Tampa Bay posted a +13 (23-10) run differential in the series, plating 6+ runs in each contest...since the franchise moved to the nation's capital in 2005, the Rays are 9-3 against them at Tropicana Field.

The Rays can win their fifth straight game over the Nationals today, which would mark the longest streak in club history (prev. 4G from June 12, 2009–June 21, 2012).

Tampa Bay is 7-2 against NL East opponents, including 4-0 at home.

TODAY'S START—Civale will take the ball for his club-leading 17th start of the season, including his ninth at home...has turned in a 3.94 ERA (29.2IP, 13ER) over his last six starts...is seeking his first win since April 9 at LAA—has a career-high four-decision losing streak...has gone 4-8 with a 5.26 ERA (126.2IP, 74ER) in 26 starts since the Rays acquired him from the Guardians on July 31, 2023.

LAST TIME OUT-Did not factor into the decision on June 23 at Pittsburgh...tossed 5.0 innings of one-run ball, scattering a season-low three hits and one walk with three strikeouts...his 61 pitches marked his fewest in a start of 3.0 innings or more since April 24, 2022 at New York-AL (also 61)...his three strikeouts were tied for a season low (4x, last: May 31 at BAL)...the lone damage done to Civale was a Bryan Reynolds solo homer to lead off the 4th inning.

UNFAMILIAR FOE—Civale is set to make his first career start against the Nationals...he has made three career starts against the NL East, going 1-1 with a 6.46 ERA (15.1IP, 11ER)...following today's outing, he will have started against 24 of 30 major league clubs (0 GS: ATL, AZ, HOU, LAD, PHI, TB).

UPS AND DOWNS—In five starts since May 31, he has alternated allowing one earned run and four earned runs, with his most recent being a onerun outing across 5.0 innings on June 23 at PIT...he owns a 4.01 ERA (24.2IP, 11ER) during this stretch, striking out 26 batters against six walks while allowing opponents to hit .277 (28-for-101).

Prior to his last outing, the Rays had lost each of his last eight starts, the longest team losing streak in a Tampa Bay pitcher's starts since Matt Andriese (8GS, May 30, 2017-April 29, 2018).

Civale has limited opponents to 2-for-21 (.095) average with RISP over his last five starts dating to May 31...this, following a seven-start stretch from April 21-May 25 in which the opposition hit .433 (13-for-13) with RISP.

FRIENDLIER CONFINES—Civale owns a 4.40 ERA (43.0IP, 21ER) in eight home starts, including a 3.98 ERA (20.1IP, 9ER) over his last four starts at Tropicana Field...this, compared to 6.10 ERA (38.1IP, 26ER) in eight road starts...min. 35.0IP, his 6.10 road ERA is second highest in the majors, lower than only SEA Bryco Miller (6.28) than only SEA Bryce Miller (6.28).

CRUISING. THEN BRUISING—From innings 1-3, Civale has posted a 2.25 ERA (48.0IP, 12ER) and a .205 (36-for-176) opp. average...from the 4th inning on, he owns an 9.45 ERA (33.1IP, 35ER) with a .345 (51-for-148) opp. average...he has allowed a combined 33 runs (31ER) in the 4th and 5th innings compared to 16 runs (all earned) in all other frames.

He has allowed opponents to slash .292/375/472 (31-for-106) with two outs...the .292 two-out opp. average is 10th highest in the AL (min. 75AB)...Zach Eflin (.325) and Zack Littell (.322) own the thirdand fourth-highest averages, respectively.

Opponents are batting .222 (30-for-135) against him the first time through the order and .302 (57-for-189) thereafter.

WALKING IT OUT—He has walked 1+ batter in a season-high seven straight starts, the third-longest streak of his career behind runs of 13 starts (June 11, 2021–April 29, 2022) and nine starts (Oct. 5, 2022–July 2, 2023)...he has walked 1+ batter in 13 of his 16 starts, but has issued exactly one walk in eight of those starts.

BIT BY THE LONG BALL—Civale's 15 HR allowed are tied for sixth most in the AL/tied for seventh most in MLB...he has yielded at least 1 HR in 13 of his 16 starts and in 19 of his last 23 dating back to Aug. 23, 2023 vs. COL... entering that stretch, he had permitted just 1 HR in his previous 10 starts from June 25-Aug. 16, 2023... 23 of the 49 runs (46.9%) he has allowed this season have come on the 15 HR against him.

A LOOK AT THE ARSENAL—He utilizes his curveball 17.3 pct. of the time and has held opponents to a .241 average (13-for-54)...the offering has been more successful when deployed against lefties, as they are hitting .172 (5-for-29) on his curveball, compared to .320 (8-for-25) by righties.

Over his last 10 starts dating to May 3, left-handed hitters are batting .136 (3-for-22) with 14 strikeouts against Civale's curveball.

3 IS THE MAGIC NUMBER—For his career, Civale is 31-1 with a 3.48 ERA (320.1IP, 124ER) in games when he receives three or more runs of support... he has a 2-30 record with a 4.95 ERA (236.1IP, 130ER) in games receiving two or fewer runs of support.
