Five Straight

Tonight's starter LH Dallas Keuchel has won each of his last five starts, the longest streak of consecutive wins in his career...He has a 1.16 ERA (4 ER/31.0 IP) during the run.

Keuchel had won four straight starts on five different occasions, most recently last season.

No Braves starter has won six straight turns since Kris Medlen in 2012, and no Atlanta lefty has done so since Mike Hampton in 2003.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Phillies open a three-game set tonight with the 17th of 19 meetings between the teams this season...The two clubs will conclude the season series with the three-game set this week and have split the first 16 games this season, winning eight games apiece.

A The clubs concluded a four-game set in Philadelphia just five days ago, and are in the middle of an 11-day stretch in which they play each other seven times.

A After getting swept in a season-opening, three-game series in Philadelphia, the Braves have won eight of the last 13 games with the Phillies, outscoring their division rival 98-61 over the stretch.

A LHP Dallas Keuchel makes his fifth career start against the Phillies and his third this season, and is 2-1 with a 1.42 ERA (4 ER/25.1 IP)...In two starts this year, is 1-1 with a 2.08 ERA (3 ER/13.0 IP), including 6.0 one-run innings last Wednesday, September 11 at Philadelphia.

A RHP Vince Velasquez is 0-6 with a 5.36 ERA (29 ER/48.2 IP) in 11 career appearances against Atlanta, including 10 starts...In his only start against the Braves this season, June 16 here at SunTrust Park, allowed four hits and four runs in 2.1 innings.

HOME RUN RECORD: The Braves have failed to hit a home run in each of their last two games, after tying the franchise record for most home runs in a single season at 235 (also, 2003) last Friday.

A Atlanta has been held homerless in back-to-back games just five times this season, and has yet to go three consecutive games without going deep.

A The Braves rank third in the National League with their 235 home runs, trailing the Dodgers' total of 261 and Chicago's 243.

A The club already has the franchise record for most home runs at home, after they finished their last homestand with 123...The old record of 119 was set by the 1966 team.

A The Braves have hit 112 homers away from SunTrust Park this season, and are 12 shy of the franchise record for single-season road home runs, first set in 1957 and matched in 2003...Atlanta has five games remaining on the road this season.

PLAYOFF BOUND: The Braves clinched a postseason berth Saturday at Washington and enter tonight with a magic number of three to clinch the National League East, which would give the club their second consecutive division title.

A The Braves are looking for their 19th division title in franchise history, and they are currently tied with New York (AL) for the most in MLB history.

A Atlanta is one of just two teams in baseball to have already clinched a spot in the 2019 Postseason...The Dodgers have also done so.

ROSTER MOVE: The Braves today selected the contract of C John Ryan Murphy from Triple-A Gwinnett and placed INF/OF Charlie Culberson on the 60-day injured list with a fractured right cheekbone.

A Atlanta acquired Murphy, 28, from the Arizona Diamondbacks on July 31 and he batted .170/.220/.234 in 14 games with Gwinnett.

GOOD OPPONENTS: The Braves open a three-game set with Philadelphia tonight, and face a team above .500 for the 12th consecutive game.

A Atlanta is 51-38 (.573) against teams above .500 this season, the third-best record in the majors in such games...Only the Yankees (43-30, .589) and Dodgers (44-31, .587) have been better.

A No team in baseball has more wins against teams above .500 than Atlanta's 51.

A Since the club moved to Atlanta in 1966, just four Braves teams have more wins against opponents above .500 in a single season...The Braves last won more games in 2005, when that team went 57-51 against teams above .500.

A The 1969 club won an Atlanta-era most 66 games, while the 2003 Braves won 57 such games and the 1992 club won 52.

SERIES PLAY: The Braves took another set last weekend at Washington, and are now 31-10-8 in series play this season.

A The Braves have not lost a multi-game series since dropping both games to Kansas City, July 23-24, at SunTrust Park...They have gone 11-0-4 in multi-game series play since that sweep.

A The Braves' streak of 15 straight multi-game series without a loss is the longest such streak in the majors this season...The Astros went 13 straight from May 4-June 14.

A The 15-series streak is tied for the third longest by a Braves team with one fashioned by the 1916 Boston Braves from June to the middle of August.

A Only two Braves team in the modern era (since 1900) have had longer such streaks than this year's club: the 2002 club had a franchise-record 22-series streak, while the 1996 team went 17 without a loss.

40-40?: OF Ronald Acuña Jr. needs one home run and four steals to become the fifth player in baseball history to collect a 40-homer, 40-steal season.

A OF José Canseco was the first player to go 40-40, reaching 42 home runs and 40 steals in 1988...Barry Bonds then matched those numbers in 1996, while Alex Rodríguez had 42 homers and 46 steals in 1998...Alfonso Soriano then had 46 and 41 in 2006.

A Acuña Jr. is the 15th player in history to have 35 home runs and 35 stolen bases in a single season, and the youngest to accomplish the feat...The last player to reach those marks was Matt Kemp in 2011 with the Dodgers.

Tonight's Game

- A* Makes his 17th start of the season and the 200th of his career...Is his 209th career appearance.
- A* Becomes the 45th active player in the majors to make 200 career starts.
- A* Has won each of his last five starts, and Atlanta has won each of his last six turns.
- A* Allowed just four earned runs during the stretch, pitching to a 0.97 ERA (4 ER/37.0 IP)...Has struck out 35 in 37 innings.
- A* Has won five consecutive starts for the first time in his career...Had previously won four straight on five occasions, last in 2018...No Braves starter has won six straight turns since Kris Medlen in 2012, and no Atlanta lefty has done so since Mike Hampton in 2003.
- A* The six starts come after he allowed a season-most 10 hits and eight runs on August 8 at Miami.
- A* Makes his ninth start of the season at home, and is 4-1 with a 2.10 ERA in his first eight turns...Is 4-4 with a 4.76 ERA (24 ER/45.1 IP) in eight starts on the road.
- A* Among pitchers to make at least 15 starts this season, his 2.10 ERA at home is fifth lowest in the National League.
- A* All eight of his turns at SunTrust Park have been quality starts, and Atlanta is 6-2 as a team when he starts here.
- A* Set for his fifth career start against the Phillies and his third this season, and is 2-1 with a 1.42 ERA (4 ER/25.1 IP).
- A* In two starts this year, is 1-1 with a 2.08 ERA (3 ER/13.0 IP), including 6.0 one-run innings last Wednesday, September 11 at Philadelphia.
- A* Faces the same opponent in back-to-back starts for the fifth time in his career, and for the first time this season...Has almost identical numbers in the second start of back-to-backs as he does in the first, going 2-1 with a 2.25 ERA (6 ER/24.0 IP) in the first game and 0-1 with a 2.59 (7 ER/24.1 IP) in the second.
- A* Is allowing opponents to bat .257 (94-for-366) against him on the season, with a .330 on-base percentage and .404 slugging.
- A* With runners in scoring position, is holding opponents to a .177/.293/.316 line, with 14 hits in 79 at-bats...Opponents are batting .104 points lower with runners in scoring position than they are with no one on base (.281, 56-for-199).
- A* In 40 opponent at-bats with runners in scoring position and two outs, has allowed just seven hits (.175) and eight RBI.

2019 Recap

- A* Started, 8/20 vs. MIA, and allowed six hits and one run over 6.0 innings to earn his fourth win of the season.
- A* Struck out opposing pitcher Elieser Hernandez leading off the third inning for the 1,000th strikeout of his major league career.
- A* Became the 49th active pitcher to have 1,000 career strikeouts, and the second on the Braves staff (Julio Teheran).
- A* Pitched against the Mets, 8/14 at SunTrust Park, and tossed 6.0 scoreless innings.
- A* With that start, has pitched against 27 of the 30 major league clubs...Has never faced either Atlanta or Houston, the two teams he has played for, and the Los Angeles Dodgers.
- A* Started, 7/23 vs. KC, and logged his sixth career double-digit strikeout game...Fanned 12 Royals over 6.0 innings, one off his career high.
- A* The last Atlanta pitcher to fan more batters in a single start was Kris Medlen, who struck out 13 Nationals over 7.0 innings on September 14, 2012.
- A* Beat the Padres on 7/12, allowing just six hits and one run over 7.0 innings.
- A* Earned the win in Atlanta's final start before the All-Star break, 7/7 vs. MIA, and in Atlanta's first game after the break, 7/12 at SD...Became the third Braves pitcher to start and win consecutive regular season games for the Braves in the modern era (since 1900) and the first since Johnny Sain on September 6 and September 11 of 1948.
- A* Pitched at least 7.0 innings in each his three starts from 7/2-12, going 2-1 with a 2.11 ERA (5 ER/21.1 IP) in that span.
- A* Was the first Atlanta starter to pitch at least 7.0 innings in three consecutive turns since 2017, when Jaime García did so from 5/31 to 6/11.
- A* Signed by the Braves to a one-year major league contract on 6/7...Was recalled to Atlanta on 6/21.
- A* Became the first former Cy Young winner to join Atlanta midseason since the Braves acquired reliever Mark Davis from the Kansas City Royals in 1992.

Career Recap

- A* Selected by the Houston Astros in the seventh round of the 2009 First-Year Player Draft...Signed by Jim Stevenson.
- A* Is a four-time Rawlings Gold Glove Award winner (2014-16, 18), two-time American League All-Star (2015, 2017) and the 2015 AL Cy Young Award winner. Has pitched in parts of seven seasons in the Major Leagues (2012-18).

Saves/Opp: 1/1 **Holds:** 8 **1st Batter/Retired:** 40/32 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 21/6

- Is 1-0 with 3.68 ERA (12 ER/30.0 IP) in 40 games with Atlanta...Thirty-three of his 40 appearances have been scoreless, including 20 of his last 24.
- Converted his first save chance of the season, 8/14 vs. NYM...Was the seventh save of his career.
- Celebrated 10 years of major league service time on July 27.
- Has a 27.00 ERA (6 ER/2.0 IP) against LAD this season...Has a 1.93 ERA (6 ER/28.0 IP) against all other teams.
- Twenty-two of his 40 appearances have been less than 1.0 inning.
- Holding left-handed batters to a .167 (9-for-54) average with 19 strikeouts...Righties are 13-for-55 (.236).
- Atlanta acquired him from the Oakland A's on 4/28 in exchange for cash considerations...Was designated for assignemnt by Atlanta on 5/14 and re-signed to a major league contract on 5/18.

- Was returned from his major league rehabilitation assignment and reinstated from the 60-day injured list 9/12...Was placed on the IL, 7/11, and missed 56 games with a fractured right great toe
- Is 0-0 with 2.89 ERA (9.1 IP) in 11 appearances with ATL this season...Has struck out 12.
- Went 0-1 with a 3.04 ERA (9 ER/26.2 IP) in 22 games with the Strippers this season, and fanned 41 batters while walking just four...In seven games with the Strippers during his rehab assignment, allowed six runs.
- In 2017 made his first Opening Day roster and appeared in 29 games out of the bullpen for Los Angeles (NL) before suffering a full tear of the ulnar collateral ligament in his left elbow that ended his season in August.

Shane Greene • RHP • 6-4 • 200 • 30 yrs • #19

Saves/Opp: 1/3 **Holds:** 9 **1st Batter/Retired:** 22/15 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 4/4

- Is 0-1 with a 3.98 ERA (9 ER/20.1 IP) in 22 games with the Braves, and 0-3 with a 2.16 ERA (14 ER/58.1 IP) in 60 games on the season...He has converted 23 of 28 save opportunities.
- Snapped a streak of 13 consecutive scoreless appearances on 9/7 vs. Washington...Held opponents to just four hits while striking out 14 through 13.0 innings during the streak...Logged his first save with Atlanta, 9/6 vs. WSH.
- Allowed runs in four of his first six appearances with the Braves, and allowed all four inherited runners to score.
- Made his Braves debut on 8/3 vs. CIN, allowing a run in the ninth inning to blow a save.
- Acquired from Detroit on 7/31 in exchange for LHP Joey Wentz and OF Travis Demeritte...At the time ranked fourth in the AL with his 22 saves, while his 1.18 ERA was the second lowest in baseball among qualifying relievers.
- Was 0-2 with 22 saves and a 1.18 ERA (5 ER/38.0 IP) with 43 strikeouts and 12 walks in 38 games out of the bullpen for the Tigers this season.

Luke Jackson • RHP • 6-2 • 210 • 27 yrs • #77

Saves/Opp: 18/25 **Holds:** 8 **1st Batter/Retired:** 65/42 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 23/11

- Is 8-2 with a 3.86 ERA (29 ER/67.2 IP) in 64 games this season...Has converted 18 of his 25 save chances after logging just one career save prior to 2019...His seven blown saves are tied for third most in the majors.
- Has eight wins in relief this season, the most by a Braves reliever since Oscar Villarreal also had eight in 2006.
- Left-handers have just 16 hits in 99 at-bats (.161) against him...Righties are hitting .329 (55-for-167).
- Has fanned 95 batters in 67.2 innings for a career-best 12.56 SO/9.0 IP ratio.
- Earned his 18th save, 8/11 at Miami...Has four saves of at least 1.1 innings.
- Recorded his second consecutive two-inning save, 5/15 vs. STL, to become the first Braves closer with back-to-back two-inning saves since Hall of Famer John Smoltz in 2002

Chris Martin • RHP • 6-8 • 225 • 33 yrs • #51

- Is 1-3 with a 3.54 ERA (21 ER/53.1 IP) in 55 games on the season, including a 4.70 ERA (8 ER/15.1 IP) in 17 games with Atlanta...Has a 1.88 FIP with the Braves.
- Struck out the three hitters he faced on nine straight pitches for an immaculate inning on 9/11 vs. Philadelphia...The first for Atlanta since Buddy Carlisle on July 7, 2007.
- Acquired from Texas on 7/30 in exchange for LHP Kolby Allard...Made his Braves debut on 8/2 vs. CIN with a perfect eighth inning.
