### Pitching

With 2.1 scoreless innings from Didier Fuentes, Dylan Lee and James Karinchak last night, Atlanta's bullpen lowered its ERA to 2.93 – the best in Major League Baseball.

In the last 13 seasons, Braves relievers have only once pitched to a better mark through 68 games. The 2022 bullpen posted a 2.89 ERA through this point.

Atlanta's 3.20 ERA as a staff (starters included) constitutes its best 68-game start since the 2011 club had a 3.05 mark.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Braves and White Sox today conclude a three-game series with the last of three games between the clubs this season...This is the only scheduled meeting between the two teams this year.

*A* The Braves left 10 runners on-base last night in a loss to the White Sox, 2-1...Jorge Mateo registered the only multi-hit game and extra-base hit for Atlanta.

*A* With last night's loss to the White Sox, the Braves fell below .500 against the club all-time (14-15, .483)... Chicago became the 13th team to actively have a winning record against Atlanta.

*A* Atlanta has just one series win against Chicago-AL in the last seven seasons, dating to 2020...All-time, the Braves are 4-6-1 in series play against the White Sox.

*A* Since first facing the White Sox in 2002, the Braves have averaged 1.46 home runs per nine innings, their third-best mark against any single opponent behind the Minnesota Twins (1.75) and the Athletics (1.47).

*A* LH Anthony Kay tonight will make his first start and second overall appearance against Atlanta... The southpaw faced the Braves out of Toronto's bullpen on August 4, 2020, and pitched 2.0 scoreless innings with three strikeouts in a Braves win, 10-1...Kay has held opponents to two earned runs or fewer in 10 of his 13 outings this season... The Stony Brook, NY, native is 5-1 with a 4.40 ERA (30 ER/61.1 IP)...Among pitchers with as many starts, his .833 winning percentage is sixth-best in MLB.

**MARTÍN PÉREZ:** Is slated to face his former club as he makes his 10th start and 14th appearance of the season...The southpaw made 10 starts (11 games) for the White Sox last season, going 1-6 despite a 3.54 ERA (22 ER/56.0 IP).

*A* Pérez has faced the White Sox with four different clubs, and the Braves will be the fifth: Texas, Minnesota, Boston and San Diego...Across 10 starts, he's 5-3 against Chicago-AL with a 5.16 ERA (34 ER/59.1 IP).

*A* This year, he has completed at least 5.0 innings in all nine of his starting assignments...The native of Guanare, VZ, has limited opponents to two earned runs or fewer in six of those turns.

*A* Among the 16 active starting pitchers that are at least 35 years old (min. 9 starts), Pérez' ERA (3.02) is fourth-best in MLB behind Zack Wheeler (PHI, 2.22), Chris Sale (ATL, 2.30) and Nick Martinez (TB, 2.43).

*A* There are 49 pitchers that have made at least 10 appearances this season at age 35 or older...Among that group, five of the top 12 ERAs belong to Braves: Robert Suarez (2nd, 0.61), Raisel Iglesias (3rd, 1.21), Chris Sale (9th, 2.30), Pérez (11th, 3.02) and Tyler Kinley (T12th, 3.18).

**ON LOSING:** The Braves have lost back-to-back games for just the fifth time this season, and for the first time since dropping two straight to Washington from May 23-24.

*A* Atlanta is one of two teams in MLB that hasn't been swept this season, joining the Los Angeles Dodgers...The Braves were last swept at the hands of the Milwaukee Brewers from August 4-6, 2025, at Truist Park.

*A* The White Sox have swept the Braves in a three-game series just once, taking all three games from them in 2010.

*A* The Braves have lost three straight games just once this season, doing so on the road against the Arizona Diamondbacks (2) and the Los Angeles Angels from April 4-6.

*A* The only two teams in Major League Baseball that have yet to suffer a four-game losing streak are playing in this series – the Braves and White Sox... Each team's longest skid stands at three games.

**SCORING POSITION:** The Braves left 10 runners on-base last night and batted just 1-for-6 with runners in scoring position...Atlanta has left 10 men on-base in each of the first two games of this series.

*A* The Braves have hit .118 (2-for-17) with runners in scoring position during this set...Their only two knocks were both singles, coming off the bats of Mauricio Dubón (Tuesday) and Mike Yastrzemski (Wednesday).

*A* Despite the lull, Atlanta maintains the best batting average with RISP in Major League Baseball (.285), ahead of the Milwaukee Brewers (.283).

**FACING LEFTIES:** The Braves are set to face left-hander Anthony Kay this afternoon...The team enters play 20-9 (.690) against opposing left-handed starters this season...Those are the most wins in such games in the majors this year.

*A* Dating even further to 2019, no team in Major League Baseball has been better against lefties... The Braves have gone 186-108 (.633) versus left-handers in that span...The Dodgers rank second at .623 (205-124).

*A* Since the start of May, Atlanta has faced 19 left-handed starting pitchers...The club has played to a 13-6 record in those games.

*A* The Braves have alternated wins and losses in their last 10 games against left-handed starters, going 5-5 against southpaws since May 22...Atlanta lost Game 1 of this series when left-hander Brandon Eisert got the nod.

*A* Both the Braves and their opponent will field a left-handed starting pitcher for the ninth time this season...The team enters play 5-3 when both starters are left-handed.

#### Today's Game

Makes his 10th start of the season and the 289th of his career in the finale of a three-game series at Chicago (AL)...Faces the White Sox, the club he pitched for in 2025, for the first time since joining Atlanta...In his most recent turn June 5 against Pittsburgh, the 35-year-old Venezuelan earned the win, allowing three runs over 5.0 innings in Atlanta's 6-3 victory at Truist Park.

Owns a 5-3 record and a 5.16 ERA (34 ER/59.1 IP) in 10 career starts against the White Sox...Last defeated them on September 21, 2024 with San Diego, allowing one run on two hits over 5.1 innings with three walks and six strikeouts in a 6-2 win.

Has allowed five hits or fewer in 19 consecutive starts dating to March 31, 2025, the longest active streak of its kind by a left-handed starting pitcher...The run is the second-longest by a left-handed starter since 1901, trailing only Tony Cingrani's 22-game streak from 2013-14.

The 6-foot, 210-pound left-hander enters with a 4-3 record and a 3.02 ERA (19 ER/56.2 IP) over 13 total appearances - nine starts and four relief outings - with 47 strikeouts against 20 walks.

Owns a 3.02 ERA (19 ER/56.2 IP) through his first 13 games of the season, the second-lowest mark he has posted over a season-opening 13-game span in his career, trailing only the 2.10 ERA (19 ER/81.1 IP) he recorded to begin 2022 with Texas...His next-lowest such span was a 3.22 ERA over his first 13 games of 2016, also with the Rangers.

Right-handed batters are hitting .207 (29-for-140) with four homers off Pérez this season, while left-handers are batting .186 (11-for-59) with two homers.

#### 2026

Earned the win in his most recent start June 5 against Pittsburgh, allowing three runs on three hits over 5.0 innings with two walks and five strikeouts on 85 pitches in Atlanta's 6-3 victory at Truist Park...All three runs scored in the third inning.

Earned the win May 30 at Cincinnati, allowing two runs on four hits over 5.0 innings with three walks and two strikeouts on 81 pitches in Atlanta's 5-2 victory at Great American Ball Park...Bleday's two-run homer in the second was the only home run he surrendered

Took the loss in his most recent start May 24 against Washington, allowing one run on five hits over 5.2 innings with two walks and two strikeouts on 86 pitches in Atlanta's 2-1 defeat at Truist Park...Lile's double was the only extra-base hit he surrendered.

Logged his first career 10-strikeout game in his 285th start on May 19 at Miami, the second-most starts before a first career 10-or-more strikeout game among pitchers to debut since 1893, trailing only Doyle Alexander (321st start, July 23, 1985)...At 35 years, 45 days, Pérez is the 17th-oldest pitcher to record a first career 10-strikeout game dating to 1893, and the first to do so at age 35-or-older since Colin Rea (35 years, 79 days) on September 18, 2025 (per Elias).

Received a no-decision May 19 at Miami, working 5.0 innings with two walks, a career-high 10 strikeouts and a home run on 78 pitches in Atlanta's 8-4 win at loanDepot park...Set a career high in strikeouts and recorded his first career 10-strikeout game.

Tossed a perfect inning of relief on May 16 vs. Boston, striking out a pair on 14 pitches...Did not factor in the decision in the Braves' 3-2 loss at Truist Park.

Worked a perfect inning of relief on May 13 vs. the Cubs, striking out two on 12 pitches in Atlanta's 4-1 win at Truist Park.

Took the loss in his start on May 6 at Seattle, allowing two runs on five hits over 5.2 innings with one walk, five strikeouts and a home run on 84 pitches in a 3-1 defeat at T-Mobile Park...The home run was a solo shot by Julio Rodríguez in the sixth.

Earned his second win as a Brave on April 28 vs. Detroit, working 5.0 scoreless innings of two-hit ball with four walks and five strikeouts on 91 pitches in the 5-2 victory at Truist Park.

Tossed 3.0 innings of relief on April 22 at Washington, allowing a pair of solo home runs in a span of three batters in the sixth inning, but did not factor in the decision in the 8-6 win.

Earned his first win as a Brave on April 17 at Philadelphia, holding the Phillies to four hits over 6.0 scoreless innings with two walks and four strikeouts on 94 pitches in the 9-0 victory at Citizens Bank Park.

Took the loss in his second start with Atlanta on April 11 vs. Cleveland, allowing one run on two hits over 5.0 innings with three walks, two strikeouts and a home run on 86 pitches in a 6-0 defeat...The lone run came on a solo home run by José Ramírez in the fourth inning.

Allowed four earned runs on five hits over 5.0 innings in his first career start as a member of the Braves on April 5 at Arizona, walking one with one strikeout on 75 pitches...Did not factor in the decision in Atlanta's 6-5 loss in 10 innings.

Made his first appearance with the Braves on March 31 vs. the Athletics, tossing 4.1 scoreless innings of relief...Allowed just two hits with no walks and three strikeouts on 47 pitches (31 strikes) in the 5-2 loss.

Had his contract selected by Atlanta from Triple-A Gwinnett on April 17...Originally had his contract selected on March 30 before being designated for assignment on April 12, outrighted to Gwinnett on April 14, and re-signed to a minor league deal on April 15.

In his 15th major league season, Pérez has pitched for seven clubs: Texas (2012-18), Minnesota (2019), Boston (2020-21), Texas (2022-23), Pittsburgh (2024), San Diego (2024), Chicago (AL) (2025) and Atlanta (2026).

Enters play ranking fourth in starts (287) and fourth in innings pitched (1,683.1) among active left-handed pitchers, and is tied for sixth in wins (94).

Ranks fifth in starts among Venezuela-born pitchers (287), one ahead of teammate Carlos Carrasco (286).

Originally signed by Texas as an international free agent on July 2, 2007...Represented Venezuela in the World Baseball Classic in 2017 and 2023.

- Earned his first career save June 7 versus Pittsburgh, At 20 years and 355 days old, he's the youngest Brave to register a save since Mike McQueen on August 11, 1971, at St. Louis (20 years, 346 days)...The last major league pitcher as young to do so was Andrés Muñoz on August 29, 2019, at San Francisco, while with San Diego.
