RAY REPORT—The Rays open a nine-game, 10-day homestand against the Mets (3 to play), White Sox (3 to play) and Yankees (3 to play) tonight at Tropicana Field...they are coming off a 1-5 road trip through Chicago-AL (0-3) and Milwaukee (1-2) over which they were outscored, 36-17 (-19), and suffered three losses by 5+ runs...the Rays have lost two straight, five of six, eight of 10 and 12 of their last 18 games since an 8-6 start...they are a season-high four games below .500 and a season-high 6.5 GB in the AL East standings... they have been alone at the bottom of the AL East since April 28.

At 1-5 (.167), the Rays are coming off their worst road trip of 6+ games since going 1-7 (.125) from June 14-19, 2021 at CWS and SEA...they held a lead after only 11 of 55 innings during the trip, nine of which came in the lone win on April 29 at MIL...

Tampa Bay has faced multi-run deficits in eight of its last 10 games overall and has been outscored, 15-3 (-12), over its last two contests.

The Rays have gone winless in their last five series (0-4-1) following a 3-0-1 start... they have lost four consecutive series for the first time since also dropping four straight from June 10-22, 2022.

The Rays rotation has produced a 3.32 ERA (21.2IP, 8ER) in the last four games... however, the bullpen owns an 8.74 ERA (11.1IP, 11ER) in that span...this comes on the heels of the bullpen posting a 2.64 ERA (44.1IP, 13ER) from April 16-27.

Tampa Bay looks to win back-to-back series openers for the first time this season after falling in seven of its first eight...its 2-8 record in series-opening contests ranks 27th in the majors, better than only the D-backs, Marlins and White Sox (all 1-9).

Kevin Cash (753) can tie his predecessor, Joe Maddon (754), as the Rays all-time managerial wins leader with a victory tonight...a loss would send the Rays five games below .500 for the first time since entering play on June 23, 2018 at 35-40.

**GRIT** x **GLOW**—The Rays will debut their Nike City Connect uniforms tonight and throughout the weekend series against the Mets...the jerseys will be worn a total of 15 times this season, including this weekend, every Saturday night home game and a pair of road contests: June 15 at ATL and Aug. 7 at STL...the Rays will become the first club to wear their City Connects in a visiting ballpark...for more information on the jerseys' inspriation and design, visit www.RaysBaseball.com/CityConnect.

**RECENT TRANSACTIONS**—Earlier today, the Rays selected **C Alex Jackson** from Triple-A Durham and activated **OF Jonny DeLuca** (right fifth metacarpal fracture) from the 10-day IL...in a pair of corresponding moves, **C René Pinto** and **INF/OF Niko Goodrum** were optioned to Durham...**RHP Colby White** was designated for assignment to accomodate Jackson's selection.

TOUGH SLEDDING—The Rays have been outscored by 26 runs (57-31) during their 2-8 slump, their worst run differential over any 10-game span since July 20-29, 2018 (-26; 65-39)...they have been held to six total runs over their last four games (1.5 R/G) since April 28 and have plated two runs or fewer in four straight, their longest streak since another four-game run over the same calendar days in 2021 (April 28-May 1)...their last five-game streak came from Aug. 4-9, 2017.

The Rays are 1-for-21 (048) with RISP over their last four games, going 0-for-6, 0-for-3, 1-for-4 and 0-for-8...their .162 (21-for-130) RISP average since April 15 ranks 27th in the majors, ahead of the Pirates (.117), Athletics (.160) and Blue Jays (.161)... they entered that stretch batting .303 (36-for-119) with RISP in their first 16 games.

POWER SEARCH—The Rays 26 HR are their fewest through 32 games since 2005 (22HR) and rank 14th in the AL/25th in the majors...among AL clubs, only the White Sox (22) have fewer homers...Tampa Bay has 11 HR in its last 16 games since erupting for a season-high 4 HR on April 14 vs. SF...only 26.5 pct. of the Rays hits have gone for extra bases, the second-lowest mark in the majors (MIA - 26.6%)...they sit near the bottom of the majors in both slugging pct. (26th, .352) and extra-base hits (T27th, 68), but rank highly in infield hits (2nd, 40), singles (4th, 188) and total hits (T13th, 256)...the Rays are coming off a three-game set in Milwaukee in which 15 of their 16 hits were singles.

Rays hitters have also struggled to draw free passes, ranking 27th in the majors in walks (83) and 28th in walk rate (7.0%)...however, Mets pitching owns a MLB-high 11.3 pct. walk rate.

PLATOON PROBLEMS | REHAB UPDATES—According to Baseball Reference, Rays hitters have had a platoon advantage in only 43.7 pct. of their plate appearances, 26th in the majors...only the Rockies (43.4%), Angels (43.0%), Astros (42.6%) and Blue Jays (38.9%) have lower marks...last season, they held a platoon advantage in 52.9 pct. of their PA, in line with the major league average of 53.4 pct.

The Rays have nine RH batters and three LH hitters on their active roster...they have recorded the fewest left-handed at-bats vs. RHP in the majors (191), with the Blue Jays (220) being the next closest club...Rays LHH are slashing .272/.365/.403 (52-for-191) with 10 2B and 5 HR off RHP.

There are four switch-/left-handed-hitting Rays on the injured list: INF Jonathan Aranda (right 4th finger fracture), INF Brandon Lowe (right oblique strain), OF Josh Lowe (right oblique strain) and INF Taylor Walls (recovery from right hip surgery)...Aranda (5G) and Josh Lowe (7G) have both begun rehab assignments with Triple-A Durham...the latter resumed his assignment last night (0-for-5, RBI, 2SO) after a brief hiatus due to tightness in his right hamstring.

RHP Taj Bradley (right pectoral strain) is scheduled to make his second rehab start for Durham tonight...he tossed 5.0 hitless innings with 7 SO on April 28.

RAYS OF SUNSHINE—Isaac Paredes has recorded multiple hits in five of his last seven games, batting .367 (11-for-30) with 1 2B, 2 HR and 3 RBI...he entered that stretch with six multi-hit games in first 22 contests...Paredes is riding a pair of home streaks, hitting safely in seven straight at Tropicana Field and reaching base safely in 13 straight...it marks the longest home on-base streak by a Ray since Yandy Díaz's 21-game run from May 2-June 25, 2023.

Richie Palaries is 8-for-17 (471) with 1 HP and CREAT.

Richie Palacios is 8-for-17 (.471) with 1 HR and 3 RBI during a five-game on streak...he has reached base in 13 of 22 PA during that timeframe (.591 OBP).

**RUNNING WILD**—This series features the two clubs that have allowed the most stolen bases in the majors...opponents are 42/43 (97.7%) on SB attempts against Mets pitching compared to 35/40 (87.5%) vs. the Rays...Tampa Bay baserunners have swiped 32 bases, second most in the AL behind the Guardians (33SB), but have gone 1-for-5 (20.0%) over their last three games and 7/13 (53.8%) in their last nine...this, after posting an 83.3 pct. success rate (25/30) in their first 23 games.

**MEET THE METS**—The Rays and Mets meet for their 12th all-time series, including the sixth at Tropicana Field...the Rays are 6-4-0 in series play against the Mets (3-2-0 at home), winning four of the last five sets dating back to 2015...the Rays swept the Mets in three games the last time the clubs met in this venue from May 14-16, 2021...they have won a club-record five consecutive home games over the New York dating back to Aug. 8, 2015... overall, the Rays have won five of seven, eight of 11, and 10 of the last 14 matchups.

**TONIGHT'S START**—Civale will make his seventh start of the season, including his fourth at home...in eight home starts since being acquired by Tampa Bay last July, Civale is 1-2 with a 5.01 ERA (41.1IP, 23ER), including 1-1 with a 2.50 ERA (18.0IP, 5ER) in 2024.

LAST TIME OUT-Did not factor into the decision on April 27 at Chicago-AL...allowed a season-high six runs on a season-high-tying eight hits with no walks and three strikeouts...his 4.1 innings signaled the shortest start of the season

- Held the White Sox scoreless through 3.0 innings...allowed consecutive singles to **Eloy Jiménez** and **Andrew Vaughn** to open
- the 4th before allowing a three-run HR to **Andrew Benintendi**. Allowed consecutive singles to **Nicky Lopez** and **Tommy Pham** to open the 5th before an RBI-double from **Gavin Sheets**.

IT'S BEEN A WHILE—In his lone career start opposite the Mets, Civale took the loss on Aug. 22, 2019 at Citi Field...he worked 5.2 innings, allowing two runs on four hits and one hit batter with no walks and three strikeouts.

His only other career start against an NL East opponents came last season on Aug. 29 at Miami...he earned the win after tossing 5.0 innings of two-run ball, conceding seven hits with no walks and five strikeouts. five strikeouts.

ROUGH PATCH—Civale has allowed 5+ earned runs in back-to-back starts for only the second time in his career (also April 24-29, 2022)...during the current stretch, he has posted an 11.00 ERA (9.0IP, 11ER).

He has failed to reach the 5.0-inning mark in consecutive starts for the first time since a career-high-tying four-start stretch from Sept. 9-29, 2023

NEED TO LIMIT THE LONG BALL—Civale has surrendered at least 1 HR in five of six starts this season...he has allowed 1+ homer in in 11 of 13 starts overall dating back to Aug. 23, 2023.

Entering the current 13-start street, he allowed 1+ HR in only one of

10 starts from June 25-Aug. 16, 2023.

IT'S A MARATHON—From innings 1-3, Civale has posted a 2.00 ERA (18.0IP, 4ER) and a .217 (15-for-69) opponent average...from the 4th inning on, Civale owns a 9.00 ERA (14.0IP, 14ER) with a .300 (18-for-60) opponent

- average.

  When his pitch count sits between 1-45, he has limited the opposition to a 12-for-58 (.207) mark while allowing 3 XBH (2B, 2 HR).

  From pitches 46-60, opponents are hitting .423 (11-for-26) with 1 2B

  - From pitch 61 and on, the opposition is 10-for-45 (.222) with 2 XBH (2B, HR).

STRIKEOUT STUFE—Since joining Tampa Bay, Civale has made 16 starts and produced a 28.3 pct. strikeout rate (92SO/336BF)...in 76 starts for the Guardians, he posted a 21.1 pct. strikeout rate (37OSO/1750BF).

HITTING THE CENTURY MARK-Civale threw 100+ pitches in back-HILING THE CENTURY MARK—Civale threw 100+ pitches in back-to-back starts from April 16-21...it marked the fifth time in his career he accomplished the feat, including the first time since another two-start streak from June 5-11, 2021...he threw 100+ pitches in a career-best five straight starts from May 3-25, 2021.

He became the first Rays pitcher to throw 100+ pitches in consecutive starts since Ryan Yarbrough (2GS) from July 10-19, 2021.

He is one of 10 pitchers in MLB to throw 100+ pitches in consecutive starts this season.

3 IS THE MAGIC NUMBER—For his career, Civale is 31-1 with a 3.22 ERA (307.01P, 110ER) in games when he receives three or more runs of support... he has a 2-27 record with a 5.17 ERA (200.11P, 115ER) in games receiving two or fewer runs of support...since joining the Rays, Civale is 4-0 with a 3.61 ERA (42.11P, 17ER) with 3+ runs of support and 0-5 with a 6.46 ERA (30.21P, 22ER) when receiving two or fewer runs.

SINK AND SWEEP—He utilizes his sinker 22.2 pct. of the time and is holding opponents to a .200 (7-for-35) clip with 10 SO on the offering.

Civale throws his sweeper 16.8 pct. of the time, but deploys it almost exclusively against right-handed hitters...opponents are 6-for-30 (.200) vs. the sweeper, including a 5-for-26 (.192) clip from RHH.
