★	Joined Junior Caminero as the only Rays with 90 RBI or more this season...the two players with 90 RBI or more are tied with St. Louis (2, Alec Burleson and Jordan Walker) and Houston (2, Yordan Alvarez , Isaac Paredes) for the most by any team in 2026.					
★	Ranks among AL leaders in RBI (T75th, 92), hits (6th, 156), multi-RBI games (T7th, 24), and multi-hit games (T8th, 41).					
★	Has been thrown 1,658 fastballs, third in the AL behind CLE Steven Kwan (1,682) and LAA Mike Trout (1,677)...28 of 48 XBH (19 2B, 9HR) have come on fastballs.					
★	Produced a career-high-tying four-game multi-hit streak (4x, last: May 25-29) from July 8-11...was the third time he's turned the trick this season, and the only other Rays to do so this season are Yandy Díaz (June 17-21) and Chandler Simpson (Aug. 8-11).					
★	Notched his second career multi-homer game on Sept. 13 vs. HOU (also: April 24, 2026 vs. MIN)...he is the 11th Mexican-born player to have multiple multi-home-run games in a season, and the first since TOR Alejandro Kirk and HOU Isaac Paredes (both 2) in 2025.					
★	In May, he led the majors in average (.374/34-for-91) and on-base pct. (.464)...he also ranked highly in OPS (2nd, 1.025) and hits (T2nd)...was the first Ray to lead MLB in average over a month since Diaz in June 2024 (.400)...his 43 RBI were second most in team history through May (Evan Longoria - 2019, 55RBI).

★	Is 3 RBI shy of joining Carlos Peña (3), Aubrey Huff (2), Evan Longoria (2), and Fred McGriff (2) as the only Rays with multiple 100-RBI seasons.					
★	Ranks among AL leaders in home runs (1st, 41), total bases (2nd, 312), XBH (2nd, 66), RBI (3rd, 97), SLG (3rd, .531), hits (4th, 163), and runs (T6th, 95).					
★	Registered his second career walk-off home run on Wed., with both coming in a four-game span (Sept. 11-15)...he launched a postseason-clinching, walk-off, two-run home run in the 9th inning on Sept. 11 vs. HOU with his 40th homer and his first career walk-off plate appearance...is the first player in franchise history with multiple 40-homer seasons (also 2025)...became the second player in the modern era (since 1900) with multiple 40-HR seasons in age-22-or-younger seasons (also: MLN Eddie Mathews , 1953-54), and the first primary third baseman to have back-to-back 40-HR seasons since COL Nolan Arenado (2015-16)...is the 10th player in the modern era with 93 home runs or more before his age-23 season.					
★	Has reached the 90-RBI mark for the second straight season, becoming the sixth player since 2000 to reach 90 RBI or more multiple times in age-22-or-younger seasons, and is the first since Juan Soto (2019, 2021)...is 3 RBI shy of becoming the 15th player in major league history to tally multiple seasons of 100 RBI or more in age-22-or-younger seasons (last: Miguel Cabrera , 2004-05).					
★	He has an RBI in 16 of his last 29 games (Aug. 19–pres.) and 21 of his last 37 (Aug. 10–pres.)...has five home runs in his last 19 games after a career-high-tying 15-game drought (Aug. 12-28) without a long ball.					
★	Through 154 team games, Caminero is on pace to finish the season with 43 homers and 102 RBI...he would become the 15th player in the modern era (since 1900) to have triple-digit RBI in multiple age-22-or-younger seasons, the first since FLA Miguel Cabrera (2004-05)...he has started every game this season and could join Evan Longoria (2014) and Aubrey Huff (2003) as the only Rays to appear in each of the club's games during a single season.					
★	His 38 hits of 110 mph or faster this year are the most in the majors...also leads the majors with 188 batted balls hit at 100 mph or faster and paces MLB with an average bat speed of 79.6 mph.					
★	Min. 275 AB, his .321 (92-for-287) average vs. fastballs is third in the AL...has tallied 36 of his 64 XBH vs. fastballs (13 2B, 23HR).					
★	Is the first player in team history to have multiple walk-off home runs in a homestand and one of five Rays to have multiple walk-off home runs in a single season (also: Brandon Lowe - 2023; Evan Longoria - 2011; Johnny Damon - 2011; Carl Crawford - 2003).

★	His 14.9 pct. whiff rate is fourth lowest in the AL behind CLE Steven Kwan (8.4%), teammate Chandler Simpson (10.2%), and HOU Isaac Paredes (14.9%)...his 12.9 pct. whiff rate vs. breaking balls is the second lowest in the majors behind PHI Luis Arraez (9.6%) (min. 300 breaking pitches).					
★	His 38 opposite-field home runs with the Rays are tied with NYM Juan Soto for second most in MLB since he joined the club in 2019, behind NYY Aaron Judge (57)...he accounts for 10.5 pct. of all opposite-field long balls (38-of-362) in team history, according to Baseball-Reference.					
★	He had three hits or more in consecutive games for the seventh time in his career (last: June 5-6, 2026) with four hits on Aug. 9 at SEA and three hits Aug. 10 at ATH...his 13 games with three hits or more in 2026 are tied for third most in the AL.					
★	With a pair of walks on Fri. vs. BOS, he surpassed B.J. Upton (430) for fourth most in franchise history (431)...with his solo home run on Aug. 28 vs. SD, surpassed Upton (118) for fifth-most home runs in franchise history...is seven shy of tying Aubrey Huff (128) for fourth most...also surpassed Carlos Peña (468) for fourth most RBI in team history...is now 34 shy of tying Ben Zobrist (511) for third most.					
★	July 24 vs. CLE was his 915th game with the Rays, surpassing Kevin Kiermaier (914) for fifth most in franchise history...is now two games behind B.J.
