**RAY REPORT**—The Rays continue a season-long, 10-game, 10-day homestand against the Nationals (2-1), Royals (1-2, one to play), and Diamondbacks (three to play) today at Tropicana Field...are 3-3 on a stretch of 23 games in 24 days leading into the All-Star break (June 19–July 12), with the lone off day coming on June 29...they are an MLB-worst 10-18 since May 24 after producing an MLB-best 22-4 record between April 22–May 23...have lost 8.5 games on the AL East-leading Yankees during that timeframe, whom they now trail by 3.0 games for the division lead...had the best record in the AL for 35 straight days between May 9–June 12, which included eight consecutive days atop the majors from May 18–25...have spent 41 days in first place in the AL East, 37 in second, six in third, four in fourth, and three in fifth.

★ The Rays picked up a 5-3 win over the Royals last night...ended a run of nine straight games against the Royals where the visiting team won each contest (July 4, 2024–June 23, 2026).  
★ They snapped a six-game losing streak to the AL Central (April 29–June 23) that came on the heels of a 10-game winning streak against the division (April 4–28).  
★ The win marked their AL-leading 13th victory without the benefit of a home run.  
★ **Yandy Diaz** (447) surpassed **Brandon Lowe** (446) and tied **B.J. Upton** (447) for sixth-most RBI in team history (see more in "Aranda & Arañita" note below).

**RECENT TRANSACTIONS**—Today, the Rays placed **LHP Steven Matz** (left ankle sprain) on the 15-day IL (retro June 24) and recalled **RHP Michael Grove** from Triple-A Durham.  
★ Across stints with the Bulls (6G) and FCL Rays (2G), Grove was 0-1 with a 2.84 ERA (12.2IP, 4ER), 16 strikeouts, a 1.03 WHIP, and a .196 (9-for-46) opp. average...over parts of three seasons with the Dodgers (2022-24), Grove held a 5.48 ERA (149.1IP, 91ER) with 151 strikeouts in 64 appearances (20 starts)...his last major league appearance came on Oct. 6, 2024 vs. SD in game two of the NLDS.

**OPENING ACT**—Casey Legumina is scheduled to open for bulk reliever **Ian Seymour** today, the fifth time the Rays have used an opener this season, joining May 15 vs. MIA (Seymour for **Jesse Scholtens**), May 2 vs. SF (**Griffin Jax** for Scholtens), April 26 vs. MIN (Jax for Scholtens), and April 15 at CWS (**Cole Sulser** for Scholtens)...Rays openers have pitched to a 1.00 ERA (9.0IP, 1ER), holding opponents to a .219/.286/.313 (7-for-32) line with 7 SO and 3 BB...they are 4-0 when using openers this year and 112-72 (609) since first introducing the opener concept on May 19, 2018 at LAA, when **Sergio Romo** opened for **Ryan Yarbrough**...this, compared to a .555 (579-465) winning pct. in all other games over that span...the Rays used an opener only once last season, a 7-1 loss on Sept. 5 vs. CLE when Jax opened for Seymour, but produced a winning record in games with an opener each year from 2018-24.

★ This marks Legumina's second start of the year, joining a bullpen game on June 14 at LAA, and the third of his career...he was used as an opener by the Mariners on May 20, 2025 at CWS (1.0IP, H, BB, SO)...between his previous starts, he holds a 3.38 ERA (2.2IP, 1ER) with two strikeouts and one walk...he made 26 starts in his minor league career to a 2-8 record and a 4.73 ERA (93.1IP, 49ER) with 100 strikeouts to 34 walks.  
★ Seymour is 3-1 with a 4.98 ERA (43.1IP, 24ER) in 29 appearances (three starts) this season...the southpaw has 109 career strikeouts, 12th most by a Ray through his first two big-league seasons...with five strikeouts today, he would tie **David Price** (114) for 10th-most strikeouts by a Rays lefty within his first two major league seasons.

**JUNE GLOOM**—The Rays .381 (8-13) winning pct. in June is on pace to be their fifth-lowest in any month since 2008 and lowest since July 2025 (7-18/.280)...since the calendar flipped to June, their 15 homers are the fewest in the majors and their .361 slugging pct. is the fourth lowest in MLB, ahead of the Mariners (.356), Braves (.355), and Diamondbacks (.350)...they are on pace to launch 19 home runs in June, which would be their fewest in a month since March/April 2022 (19HR)...the Rays were second in the Junior Circuit with a .280 average with runners in scoring position across their first 56 games (Opening Day–May 31), compared to .258 (4th in AL) since June began...the bullpen's 4.29 ERA in June is the fourth highest in the AL (SEA, 4.85; ATH, 6.29; MIN, 6.72).

★ The club entered June with a 9-1 record in one-run games and has gone 2-8 in one-run affairs this month...the last time it dropped nine one-run contests or more in a month was May 2023 (9).

**ARANDA & ARAÑITA**—Through the team's first 77 games this season, **Yandy Diaz** has reached base safely 135 times and **Jonathan Aranda** has reached base 127 times...Diaz's 135 TOB are the most in team history through this point of the season, while Aranda's 127 TOB are tied for fifth most (see table on the right)...the duo have combined for 104 RBI (Aranda, 53 & Diaz, 51), the first Rays pairing to reach that mark through 77 team games since **Evan Longoria** (63) and **Carlos Peña** (55) in 2009...the only other pair to accomplish the feat was **Jose Canseco** (63) and **Fred McGriff** (50) in 1999.

★ Diaz (447) surpassed **Brandon Lowe** (446) last night and is tied with **B.J. Upton** (447) for sixth-most RBI in franchise history...he is two shy of tying **Aubrey Huff** (449) for fifth most.

★ After going 0-for-11 in the series against the Tigers between June 1-3, Aranda has recorded a hit in 14 of 17 games (June 5–pres.) with six multi-hit contests and has reached base safely in 16 of them.

**DOMESTIC SWEET DOME**—Despite going 6-6 in their last 12 at Tropicana Field, the Rays own the best home record (27-12/.692) in MLB...it is the third-best start at home in franchise history behind 2023 (31-8) and 2008 (28-11)...since May 13, the Rays are 13-8 at home (2nd in AL/4th in MLB) compared to 3-12 in road affairs (30th in MLB)...on the year, the 245-point discrepancy between their home (27-12/.692) and road (17-21/.447) winning percentages is the third largest in MLB behind the White Sox (292) and Tigers (250)...the Rays are in a stretch of 19 home games within a 28-game span from May 29–June 28, going 11-13 thus far (8-7 at home)...they have several notable active home streaks:

★ The Rays are 12-0 against the AL East at Tropicana Field, MLB's longest season-opening, home winning streak over division rivals since the 2009 Dodgers won their first 12 home games vs. the NL West...among AL clubs, only the 2003 Royals (13-0) have had a longer streak in the divisional era (since 1969)...they are 14-11 against all other opponents at home.

★ **Yandy Diaz** has reached base safely in 22 straight home games (May 5–pres.), tied with **SD Fernando Tatis Jr.** for the longest active streak in the majors...he is slashing .422/.495/.747 (35-for-83) with 6 2B, 7 HR, and 24 RBI at Tropicana Field during that stretch.

★ **Kevin Kelly** has recorded 18 scoreless outings (19.0IP) at Tropicana Field, the second-longest season-opening streak at home by a Rays reliever behind **Jake McGee** (19G) in 2012...per Stats Perform, the 19.0-IP streak at home is the second longest to begin the season in MLB this year, trailing **NY Yankees Headrick** (19.2, active) and is the longest to open a campaign in Rays history (see table on the right).

**TURNING ON THE JETS**—Rays baserunners have swiped 18 bases over their last 16 games (June 7–pres.) after stealing one in their 13 previous contests (May 22–June 6)...their 18 stolen bases over that span are the second most in the AL behind the Yankees (21) and are fourth most in the majors (SD, 25; WSH, 24)...they stole a season-high-tying 4 SB on June 20 vs. WSH, matching April 4 at MIN...on the season, their 72 stolen bases are tied for the second most in the AL (see table on the right).

★ **Chandler Simpson** swiped a pair of bases last night, his 10th career multi-steal game...he has 63 career stolen bases, one shy of tying **Carl Crawford** (64) for the most in franchise history through a player's first two major league seasons...his 63 stolen bases are six behind **Miguel Cairo** for 12th most in team history and 15 behind **José Caballero** and **Taylor Walls** (both 78) for 10th most.

★ Rays pinch runners have combined for 4 SB, tied for third in the majors behind the Royals (7) and Braves (5).

**THE GREAT TAMPA BAY BAKE OFF**—**Bryan Baker** picked up his 20th save of the season last night, becoming the seventh Ray in team history to reach the mark before the All-Star break and the first since **Alex Colomé** (25) in 2017...he has converted each of his last nine save opportunities (May 17–pres.), tied for the second-longest active run in the AL and tied for the fourth longest in the majors.

**REAL ROYALTY**—The Rays and Royals will complete a seven-game season series over the course of 11 days from June 22–July 2...this marks the Rays first four-game series this season—they were scheduled to play four at Fenway Park from May 7-10, but the third contest of the series was postponed due to inclement weather...the Rays and Royals have split their last two season sets (3-3 in 2024-25), but the Rays have not lost a season series to Kansas City since 2017 (4-3), going undefeated in the previous seven (5-0-2; clubs did not meet in 2020).

★ Last night's win snapped a franchise-record run of nine straight games between the Rays and Royals where the road team won between July 4, 2024–June 23, 2026...per Stats Perform, it surpassed eight-game streaks with the White Sox (Aug. 3, 2018–July 20, 2019) and Mariners (June 7, 2014–July 5, 2015).

**SNAKES ON A PLANE TO TAMPA BAY**—The Rays are set to host the Diamondbacks for a three-game set this weekend...the Rays lead the all-time series with a 20-11 record and have won seven of the last eight meetings and 11 of the last 14...the trip marks the sixth time the Diamondbacks have visited Tropicana Field and the first time since the Rays swept them between Aug. 16-18, 2024.

**TODAY'S OUTING**—Ian Seymour is scheduled to take the mound today for his 30th appearance of the season...marks his 49th career appearance...selected in the second round (57th overall) of the 2020 First-Year Player Draft out of Virginia Tech.

✦ Is 1-1 with a 5.48 ERA (21.1IP, 13ER) with 19 strikeouts during 13 day outings in 2026 compared to a 4.50 ERA (22.0IP, 11ER) and 26 strikeouts in 16 night appearances.

✦ Is scheduled to work bulk relief today...is 2-0 with a 3.43 ERA (21.0IP, 8ER) when going multiple innings as a reliever this season...has limited opponents to a .227 (17-for-75) AVG in those appearances.

✦ If he were to permit a home run today, would become the first Rays southpaw to surrender homers in five straight contests or more since **Tyler Alexander** (6G) in 2024.

**LAST TIME OUT**—Worked a season-high 5.0 innings, allowing three earned runs in his first loss of the season on June 20 vs. WSH (5.0IP, 7H, 3ER, 4SO, HR)...tossed a clean 1st inning, but allowed a **CJ Abrams** solo home run to lead off the 2nd...after allowing two more batters to reach base following the long ball, he yielded an RBI-double that gave Washington its first lead of the game...retired seven of his next nine batters faced before a pair of hits plated the third run in the 5th inning...threw a season-high 81 pitches, his most since throwing 81 on Sept. 18, 2025 at TOR.

✦ Following his 5th and final inning of work, he eclipsed the 100.0-IP mark for his career.

✦ Marked his most innings pitched as a starter since a career-high 7.0 innings on Sept. 17, 2025 vs. TOR.

**WE'LL NEVER BE ROYALS**—Seymour is set to make his first career appearance against Kansas City.

✦ Has logged a 1-2 career record with a 3.92 ERA (20.2IP, 9ER) and 23 strikeouts across eight appearances (two starts) against AL Central clubs...in four outings against the division in 2026, has pitched to an 11.57 ERA (4.2IP, 6ER).

**TROPS OF JUPITER**—Seymour is making his 17th appearance at Tropicana Field this year...is 1-1 with a 3.42 ERA (26.1IP, 10ER) and 24 strikeouts at home this season as opposed to a 2-0 mark with a 7.41 ERA (17.0IP, 14ER) and 21 strikeouts in 13 road outings...since making his major league debut in 2025, Seymour has posted a 3.33 ERA (46.0IP, 17ER) with a 1.09 WHIP and 42 strikeouts across 22 home outings (four starts).

✦ Has a 3.24 ERA across his last 25.0 innings pitched inside Tropicana Field (15 appearances) since April 10, logging a .172 (15-for-87) opp. average with 8.28 strikeouts per 9.0 innings during that stretch.

**IT'S NOT A SWORD**—He boasts a 29.3 pct. whiff rate this season, ranking second among AL southpaws (min. 700 pitches) behind only **DET Tarik Skubal** (30.0%)...his whiff rate ranks second among Rays arms (min. 700 pitches) behind **Griffin Jax's** 31.0 pct. clip...carries a 42.2 pct. whiff rate on his sweeper, the seventh-highest mark on the pitch among AL pitchers (min. 150 sweepers).

**MAJOR LEAGUE RECAP**—In his rookie season in 2025, made 19 appearances (five starts) over three stints with the Rays (June 8-10, July 8-30, & July 31—end of season)...began in a relief role before transitioning to the starting rotation, earning the starting nod in five of his final seven appearances after his first 12 came out of the bullpen.

✦ Made his first career start Aug. 25 at CLE, tossing 5.0 IP of one-hit ball with 8 SO and 1 BB, joining **Brendan McKay** (June 29, 2019 vs. TEX) as the only Rays to permit two baserunners or fewer across 5.0 IP or more in their first career start...was the first left-hander to start a game for the Rays since **Tyler Alexander** on Sept. 26, 2024, snapping a 133-game streak of right-handed starters that was second longest in team history, trailing Oct. 3, 1999—June 5, 2001 (234G)...his 8 SO tied **Taj Bradley** (April 12, 2023 vs. BOS) for third most by a Ray in his first career start, trailing **Matt Moore** (11) on Sept. 22, 2011 at NYY and **Wade Davis** (9) on Sept. 6, 2009 vs. DET.

✦ Made his major league debut on June 9, 2025 at BOS and earned the win after pitching the 10th and 11th innings...he allowed one run (OER) with two walks (1 IBB) and two strikeouts in the outing...he was the fourth Ray to earn the win in relief in his major league debut, joining **Seth McClung** (March 31, 2003 vs. BOS), **Doug Waechter** (Aug. 27, 2003 at SEA), and **Andrew Bellatti** (May 9, 2015 vs. TEX).

## TODAY'S OPENER: RHP CASEY LEGUMINA (2-1, 3.45)

✦ **RHP Casey Legumina** will serve as the Rays opener...marks his 25th appearance (second start) of the season.

✦ Will be making his third start of his career, his first since yielding 1 ER on 2 H and 1 HBP over 1.2 IP on June 14 at LAA...today's start will mark his first inside Tropicana Field and first at home in his career.

✦ In two career starts (both as an opener), he's pitched to a 3.38 ERA (2.2IP, 1ER) with 2 SO.

✦ Of his 16 games with the Rays (April 29—pres.), 11 have been scoreless...is 2-0 with a 2.75 ERA (19.2IP, 6ER) and 14 SO in those outings.
