THE TWWWWWWWINS: Have gone 5-0 through five games on their six-game roadtrip, sweeping the Angels in three in Anaheim over the weekend, followed by consecutive victories in Chicago over the White Sox the last two nights...today, the Twins will complete the trip with the three-game series finale on the South Side...after today's game, the Twins will travel to Minneapolis to enjoy an off-day tomorrow, then begin a seven-game homestand with three against the Red Sox over the weekend and four against the Mariners from Monday-Thursday. ☞ Over the last nine games, the Twins have a run differential of +35 (66-31)...prior to the current winning streak their run differential was at -25 (67-92).

HAPPY FLIGHT?: A win today would give the Twins an undefeated roadtrip of six-plus games for the first time in their history (since 1961)...additionally, 10 of Minnesota's 16 wins have come on the road, tied for the fifth-most road wins in baseball.

DID I CATCH A NINER IN THERE?: The Twins beat the White Sox last night at Guaranteed Rate Field by a score of 6-5, securing the series win...Simeon Woods Richardson was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs (1 earned) on seven hits in 3.2 innings pitched, with two walks and two strikeouts...Joan Duran made his return from the IL and earned his first save of the season with a scoreless ninth...the offense recorded nine hits, two from Trevor Larnach...Minnesota went 6-for-13 with runners in scoring position, making them 24-for-64 (.375) with RISP on the roadtrip.

PERFECT 10s: With a win today, the Twins winning streak will hit 10...it's MLB's longest winning streak in 2024...below are all the club's streaks of nine-plus consecutive victories:

OFFENSIVE COORDINATORS: Over the current nine-game winning streak, the Twins have hit .318 (102-for-321) with 29 doubles, 14 home runs, a .384 on-base percentage, a .545 slugging percentage and a .929 OPS...they have scored a total of 66 runs (7.3 runs-per-game) during the stretch...below are the Twins numbers through April 21 (first 20 games), compared to numbers since April 22 (9 games) and MLB ranks in parenthesis:

TWINS CALL TO BOUSHLEY: The Twins announced today that they have selected the contract of right-handed pitcher Caleb Boushley from Triple-A St. Paul...Boushley (BOZZ-lee) has gone 3-1 with a 4.00 ERA (27.0 IP, 12 ER), four walks, 30 strikeouts and a 1.15 WHIP in five starts for the Saints this season...to make room for Boushley on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned left-handed pitcher Kody Funderburk to St. Paul.

DEEP DISH: The Twins and White Sox are playing the seventh of 13 games this season...Minnesota has won seven straight and has gone 13-1 in their last 14 against the White Sox, dating back to May 4, 2023...one more win this season for the Twins over the Sox and they will have already secured the season series...the next meeting between these two will be for three games back here from July 8-10.

SWEEPS WEEK: Minnesota is seeking its third sweep of the season today...their other two sweeps were last week in four games against the White Sox at Target Field and this past weekend in three games at Anaheim (list of 2024 series results to the right).

☞ The Twins are looking to sweep at Guaranteed Rate Field for the first time since August 27-29, 2019 (3 games).

☞ The last time the Twins recorded three consecutive sweeps was June 23-July 2, 2006, when they swept the Cubs, Dodgers and Brewers, all in three games.

TWINS MiLB POMS: Double-A Wichita outfielder Emmanuel Rodriguez and High-A Cedar Rapids right-handed pitcher Zebby Matthews have been named Twins minor league Pitcher and Player of the Month for April.

☞ Rodriguez, 21, hit .294 (15-for-51) with six doubles, one triple, four home runs, 10 RBI, 19 runs scored, 22 walks, a .507 on-base percentage, a .686 slugging percentage and a 1.193 OPS in 16 games for the Wind Surge...the Santiago de los Caballeros, DR native was signed by the Twins in July of 2019...he is ranked as the third-best prospect in the Twins organization by MLB.com.

☞ Matthews, 23, made three starts for the Kernels, going 3-0, 2.30 ERA (15.2 IP, 4 ER) with no walks and 19 strikeouts...of his 14 hits allowed, just two went for extra bases (1 2B, 1 HR)...the Cullowhee, North Carolina native was selected by the Twins in the eighth round of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft out of Western Carolina University...he is ranked as the 20th-best prospect in the Twins system by MLB.com.

ANOTHER STELLAR START: Last pitched April 26 at Los Angeles-AL, earning his second-straight win...allowed two runs on three hits in a career-high-tying 7.1 innings, with three walks and eight strikeouts – both season highs...retired nine-straight batters before walking Mike Trout in the third...allowed first hit to Luis Rengifo in the sixth; Rengifo scored on Nolan Schanuel's groundout...was pulled after Zach Neto's eighth-inning double; Matt Bowman entered and allowed Neto to score.

- ✦ Generated 12 whiffs on 42 swings (28.6%)...now owns a 24.6 percent whiff rate this season, ranking in MLB's 43rd percentile.
- ✦ In four starts since eight-run season debut March 31 in Kansas City, has allowed four runs in 24.1 innings (1.48 ERA) with 11 total hits and no home runs.
- ✦ Second time Ober has gone four-or-more straight starts without allowing a home run (5 starts: 4/28-9/16, 2022).
- ✦ Is one of three pitchers (Luis Gil, Kutter Crawford) to allow three-or-fewer hits in four-straight starts this season.

TWO STARTS AGO: Started April 20 vs. Detroit, opposite Reese Olson...earned his first win of the season, allowing one run on two hits in 6.0 innings – his second-straight quality start against the Tigers – with one walk and six strikeouts...was perfect until Matt Vierling singled with one out in the fifth inning...walked Riley Greene and allowed RBI triple to Wenceel Pérez in the sixth.

SEASONED VS. THE SOX: Has made 10 career starts vs. Chicago-AL, going 3-1 with a 3.35 ERA (51.0 IP, 19 ER), 10 walks and 56 strikeouts...posted a 3.27 ERA (11.0 IP, 4 ER) in two 2023 starts vs. the White Sox...Chicago-AL hitters have hit .212 (41-for-193) with a .680 OPS and 27.5 percent strikeout rate vs. Ober.

- ✦ Before April 26 in Anaheim, Ober's only 7.1-inning start came September 27, 2022 vs. Chicago-AL; struck out 10 and allowed no runs on two hits.
- ✦ Made major league debut vs. White Sox on May 18, 2021 at Target Field...allowed four runs in 4.0-inning no-decision.

RED-HOT ON THE ROAD: Making his fourth road start of the season today...in previous three, has gone 1-1 with a 6.14 ERA (14.2 IP, 10 ER), four walks, 12 strikeouts, a 1.30 WHIP and .259 opponent batting average...eight of those 10 runs came in March 31 season debut at Kansas City; has allowed two total runs in 13.1 road innings since...compares to a 1-0 record in two home starts, with a 1.64 ERA (11.0 IP, 2 ER), three walks, 13 strikeouts, a 0.73 WHIP and .139 BAA.

- ✦ Career 7-9 with a 3.91 ERA (159.0 IP, 69 ER) in 31 road starts, compared to 8-4 with a 3.45 ERA (159.1 IP, 69 ER) in 31 home starts.

REVERSE SPLITS: April 26, Los Angeles-AL's left-handed hitters went 1-for-6 with a walk and two strikeouts against Ober, while righties went 2-for-18 with two doubles, two walks and six strikeouts...through five games against Ober, lefties have hit .195 (8-for-41) with a .651 OPS and 28.3 percent strikeout rate, while righties have hit .226 (12-for-53) with a .702 OPS and 21.4 percent strikeout rate.

- ✦ Lefties have a 29.9 percent whiff rate and 84.1 mph average exit velocity vs. Ober, righties a 20.8 percent whiff rate and 89.7 mph average exit velocity.
- ✦ Through April 30, Chicago-AL's left-handed hitters have hit .233 (94-for-404) with a .645 OPS vs. right-handed pitching, while its righties have hit .205 (81-for-395) with a .585 OPS.

THE ARSENAL: Has used a five-pitch mix thus far in 2024, per Baseball Savant...uses 4-seamer and cutter against both left- and right-handed hitters...predominantly throws changeup and curveball to lefties, slider to righties. Here's his pitch usage through five starts:

- ✦ April 26 at Los Angeles-AL, threw a season-high 25 changeups...hitters went 1-for-13 with six strikeouts against the pitch, whiffing 10 times in 19 swings (52.6%)...the pitch now has a career-best 42.6 percent whiff rate, up from 29.8 percent in 2023.
- ✦ His changeup has an MLB-best 36.4 percent putaway rate (min. 25 PA)...its .138 BAA ranks 11th in baseball.
- ✦ Changeup is averaging 18.0 inches of horizontal movement, tied with JP Sears for seventh best in baseball (min. 50 changeups thrown).
- ✦ Threw zero curveballs at Los Angeles-AL.

OBERWHELMING STUFF: Dating back to April 8 vs. Los Angeles-NL, Ober has posted one of the best four-start stretches of his career. Here's how Ober's numbers since April 8 stack up against his best four-start stretches:

- ✦ Was Triple-A St. Paul's Opening Day starter and pitched in four games for Saints to begin the season, posting a 2.55 ERA (17.2 IP, 5 ER) with six walks and 22 strikeouts.
- ✦ Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week on April 23 after throwing 5.0 scoreless innings.
- ✦ Recalled by Twins on April 23 and made season debut that day against Washington, allowing one run on three hits in 5.2 innings, earning the win.
- ✦ Posted a 1.82 ERA (24.2 IP, 5 ER) with four walks and 24 strikeouts over his next four starts with the Twins.
- ✦ Pitched 7.0 shutout innings twice: May 5 at Cleveland and July 1 at Baltimore.
- ✦ Allowed three earned runs or fewer in 15 of first 16 starts with Twins from April 23-July 23.
- ✦ Posted career-best four-start stretch (July 18-August 4) without issuing a walk.
- ✦ To limit innings, returned to Triple-A from August 28-September 15 and started once in that span.
- ✦ Set career highs in wins (8), innings pitched (144.1), starts (26) and strikeouts (146).
- ✦ Ranked fourth on Twins staff in starts, innings and strikeouts.
- ✦ Left off AL Wild Card Series roster vs. Toronto but added to ALDS roster vs. Houston.
- ✦ Made Postseason debut and started Game 1 at Houston, allowing three runs on four hits (2 HR) in 3.0 innings...was dealt the loss in a 6-4 Twins defeat.
- ✦ Made second appearance in relief in Game 3 vs. Houston, allowing three runs on four hits (2 HR) in 1.1 innings of Minnesota's 9-1 defeat.

FRIDAY'S STARTER - RHP CHRIS PADDACK (2024: 2-1, 5.88 ERA // CAREER: 24-22, 4.33 ERA)

Right-hander Chris Paddack is scheduled to start Friday night's series opener vs. Boston...last pitched April 27 at Los Angeles-AL, earning his second win of the season; allowed four runs on eight hits in 5.0 innings, with one walk and two strikeouts...has made two starts at Target Field this season, posting a 1.54 ERA (11.2 IP, 2 ER) with two walks and 15 strikeouts...has made one career start vs. Boston, on August 23, 2019 at Fenway Park; allowed six runs on seven hits (1 HR), with one walk and no strikeouts in 2.1 innings, and took the loss.
