**YESTERDAY'S NEWS:** The Orioles defeated the Angels, 4-2, in the first game of the three-game set in Anaheim...**Albert Suárez** earned his first win since June 23, 2016, a span of 2,860 days; he joins Travis Blackley as the only pitchers in the last 70 years to go that many days between wins, per the *Elias Sports Bureau*...**Colton Cowser** and **James McCann** each homered in the victory.

**WHAT'S TRENDING:** The O's have won four of their last five games, seven of their last 10, and 10 of their last 13...Eight of the Orioles' 15 wins this season have been in comeback fashion, the second-most in MLB behind the Braves (9).

**KIMBREL COUNT:** **Craig Kimbrel** recorded the 423<sup>rd</sup> save of his career last night, passing Billy Wagner for sole possession of seventh in MLB history; only Boston's Kenley Jansen (425) has more among active players...Kimbrel has 1,208 strikeouts, the fourth-most all-time as a reliever; he trails Hoyt Wilhelm (1,363), Goose Gossage (1,340), and Lee Smith (1,225).

**HOMER HAPPY:** Entering today's games, the Orioles lead MLB with 35 home runs, the most homers through the first 22 games in O's history; the total would also be tied with the 2005 and 2020 teams for the most through the first 23 games.

👉 **Colton Cowser** has homered in back-to-back games for the second time in his career, joining April 11-12 this season; the last O's rookie to homer in three straight games was **Gunnar Henderson** from June 10-13, 2023.

**THEY'VE GOT POP:** Entering today's games, the Orioles lead MLB with a 90.4 mph average exit velocity, per Statcast (see box at right)...The O's also lead MLB with 62 barrels and 270 hard-hit balls...**Gunnar Henderson** ranks second among all hitters with a 96.2 mph average exit velo (see box at right).

**RUN IT UP:** Entering today's games, the Orioles lead the AL and rank third in MLB with 126 runs scored...Their +31 run differential is third in the AL and fifth in MLB, while their 5.73 runs per game leads the AL and ranks second in MLB.

**DOWN BUT NOT OUT:** The Orioles are slashing .194/.247/.354 (75-for-387) in two-strike counts...Entering today's games, they lead MLB in slugging, OPS (.601), and extra-base hits (33) with two strikes, and are second in home runs (13)...**Jordan Westburg** has hit .368/.429/.737 (14-for-38) in two-strike counts, with three doubles, one triple, and three home runs...He leads MLB in two-strike average, slugging percentage, and OPS (1.165), and ranks tied for the lead in two-strike extra-base hits (7).

**AL PLAYER OF THE WEEK:** **Jordan Westburg** was selected as the AL Player of the Week for the period of April 15-21 after slashing .478/.500/.913 (11-for-23) with two doubles, one triple, two home runs, five runs scored, eight RBI, one walk, and one stolen base in six games...During that time, he led MLB in OPS (1.413) and average, and ranked tied for the lead in total bases (21)...He led the AL in total bases and ranked among the leaders in RBI (T-1<sup>st</sup>), slugging percentage (2<sup>nd</sup>), on-base percentage (T-3<sup>rd</sup>), hits (T-3<sup>rd</sup>), and extra-base hits (T-4<sup>th</sup>, 5)...Marks the first career honor for Westburg.

**YIN AND YANG:** **Colton Cowser** and **Jordan Westburg** have been named AL Player of the Week in back-to-back weeks, with Cowser winning for the period of April 8-14 and Westburg for the period of April 15-21...The O's are the first team to win consecutive Player of the Week honors since the Braves for the weeks of August 14 and 21, 2023 (Olson/Rosario), and the first AL team since the Astros for the weeks of August 7 and 14, 2023 (Valdez/Altuve)...The last time the Orioles earned back-to-back Player of the Week honors was 1981, when Orioles Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer **Eddie Murray** won two straight for the weeks of September 13 and 20...Overall, it is the third time Baltimore earned back-to-back weekly honors after **Don Baylor** won on August 10, 1975, followed by Orioles Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer **Jim Palmer** and **Ken Singleton** winning co-honors on August 17.

**ELECTRIC AVENUE:** **Cedric Mullins** earned his MLB-leading seventh career Electric Play of the Week award for his *diving catch* on April 15 vs. Minnesota...Mullins went full extension in center field to rob Kyle Farmer for the last out of the top of the first inning...The Orioles have an MLB-best 13 Play of the Week awards since 2019.

**CAROLINA LEAGUE PITCHER OF THE WEEK:** Single-A Delmarva's **Trey Gibson** was named the Carolina League Pitcher of the Week for April 15-21 after working 5.0 scoreless innings with one walk and eight strikeouts in his relief outing on April 17 at Down East.

**O THE PLACES YOU'LL GO:** The Birds are on a six-game road trip against the Royals (2-1) and Angels (1-0)...The Orioles have a scheduled off day after the trip on Thursday, April 25...The O's wrapped up their first road trip of the season with a 4-2 record against Pittsburgh (1-2) and Boston (3-0) from April 5-11.

**AGAINST THE ANGELS:** The O's and Angels are meeting for the second and final series of the regular season this week in Anaheim...The Orioles took two out of three against the Angels in Baltimore in the season-opening series from March 28-31...With a win tonight, the O's would clinch their third consecutive season series victory over Los Angeles-AL...The Birds went 5-2 against the Halos last year, splitting a four-game set in Baltimore from May 15-18 before completing a three-game sweep in Anaheim from September 4-6.

**SWEEPLESS IN BALTIMORE:** With tonight's game, the Orioles will have gone 99 consecutive regular-season series of at least two decisions (no ties) without being swept...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, that is the fourth-longest regular-season streak in MLB history, trailing the 1942-44 St. Louis Cardinals (124), 1906-09 Chicago Cubs (115), and 1903-05 New York Giants (105)...Baltimore's current streak is the longest in O's history, ahead of 46 such series from 1971-72...The Birds have not been swept in a regular-season series of at least two games since May 13-15, 2022 at Detroit (0-3), and not at home in a series of at least two games since August 27-29, 2021 vs. Tampa Bay (0-3).

👉 The 2023 Orioles (52 series) were the fourth MLB team since 2000 to go a full regular season without being swept in a series of at least two decisions, joining the Braves teams of 2022 (51 series), 2004 (52 series), and 2002 (52 series).

**ROSTER MOVES:** The Orioles today recalled outfielder **Heston Kjerstad** from Triple-A Norfolk...Kjerstad is ranked as the No. 4 O's prospect and No. 29 overall prospect by *MLB Pipeline*...In a corresponding move, catcher **David Bañuelos** has been optioned to the Tides.

**SCORING CHANGE:** In the bottom of the ninth inning on April 22 at Los Angeles-AL, Jo Adell advanced to third on what was originally scored a stolen base...This has been changed to defensive indifference as there was no attempt to retire Adell and the tying run did not advance on the play.

**THE SKIPPER:** Manager **Brandon Hyde** is in his sixth season in Baltimore...In 2023, he led the O's to an AL-best 101-61 record, their second straight winning campaign and the first time since 1997 that the Orioles claimed the top seed in the AL...He made his postseason managerial debut in the ALDS, and was named the Baseball Writers' Association of America (BBWAA) AL Manager of the Year, becoming the fourth Orioles manager to win the award...He was also voted the Sporting News American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers for the second consecutive year...Hyde was named the 20<sup>th</sup> manager in Orioles history on December 14, 2018...His 330 wins rank fifth all-time among Orioles managers, trailing **Hank Bauer** (407), **Paul Richards** (517), **Buck Showalter** (669), and Orioles Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer **Earl Weaver** (1,480).

**QUICK HITS:** Scheduled to make his fifth start of the season this afternoon against Los Angeles-AL...The O's have gone 4-0 in his first four starts...Posted a 7-4 record and 4.35 ERA (59 ER/122.0 IP) across 23 starts in his rookie campaign last year...Began last season with Triple-A Norfolk before being promoted and making his MLB debut on April 5 at Texas...Optioned to Norfolk on May 27...Recalled on July 17 for the remainder of the season...Originally selected by the Orioles in the first round (No. 11 overall) of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Earned the win on May 16 vs. Minnesota...Allowed two runs on four hits and three walks with six strikeouts across 6.0 innings...Extended his winning streak to a career-high five games, dating back to last season...Threw 87 pitches, 56 strikes.

**AGAINST THE ANGELS:** Making his fourth career start against the Angels...Secured the win in his season debut against the Halos on March 30 at Oriole Park after allowing one run on four hits (1 HR) and one walk with nine strikeouts and one wild pitch.

**AGAINST THE AL WEST:** Owns 2-2 record and a 7.41 ERA (28 ER/34.0 IP) in seven career starts against the AL West, his highest mark against any division; his second-highest ERA against a division is the NL West at 3.75 (5 ER/12.0 IP)...AL West opponents are slashing .302/.373/.496 (42-for-139) off him.

**ON THE ROAD AGAIN:** Owns a lifetime 4-2 record and a 3.89 ERA (30 ER/69.1 IP) across 13 road starts...Opponents are slashing .244/.304/.427 (64-for-262) against Rodriguez on the road.

**NIGHT OWL:** Posted a 7-3 record and a 4.18 ERA (41 ER/88.1 IP) in 16 starts at night last season...Has surrendered 10 home runs at night compared to nine home runs allowed during the day across 46.0 innings pitched in his career.

**GAME OF ADJUSTMENTS:** In Rodriguez's 10 starts in his initial stint with the club in 2023, he notched a 7.35 ERA (37 ER/45.1 IP)...After being optioned to Norfolk, he returned to Baltimore on July 17 and posted a 2.58 ERA (22 ER/76.2 IP) across his remaining 13 starts...Has posted nine quality starts in his last 13 outings, dating back to July 28, 2023; tied with eight others for the fifth most such starts in that span...Did not register a quality start in his first 12 outings to begin his career.

**GAS 'EM UP:** Punched out 129 batters for the O's last season, the most for an Orioles rookie since 2012 (Wei-Yin Chen, 154)...His mark ranks sixth among rookies in team history (since 1954)...He became the 20<sup>th</sup> rookie pitcher in Orioles history to strike out at least 100 batters.

**2023 HIGHLIGHTS:** Rodriguez opened last season with the Norfolk Tides, earning the nod as their Opening Day starter...Recalled by the Orioles on April 5, making his MLB debut in a start at Texas...Marked the first of six Orioles to make their big-league debut last year...Earned his first career win on April 29 (G2) at Detroit, throwing 5.0 shutout innings and striking out nine...Tossed a career-high 8.0 scoreless innings on September 16 vs. Tampa Bay, tied for the longest outing by an Oriole in 2023; at 23 years old, 304 days old, became the youngest O's starter to work 8.0 scoreless frames since Zack Britton (23-141) tossed a shutout on May 12, 2011 vs. Seattle, and the youngest rookie right-hander to do since Brad Bergesen (23-257) worked 8.0 scoreless on June 9, 2009 vs. Seattle.

**POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE:** Made his Postseason debut last season, taking the loss in Game 2 of the ALDS against the Rangers on October 8...Allowed five runs on six hits and four walks across 1.2 innings...Marked the most runs that Rodriguez had surrendered since May 26 when he allowed eight, also against the Rangers.
