CAREER

Tall, powerful right-hander was Washington's Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2021 and 2022...Made his Major League debut in 2022 and returned to the mound in 2025.

- 1,076 days passed between his debut on Aug. 26, 2022 vs. Cincinnati and his second career appearance on Aug. 6, 2025 vs. Athletics.
- Was ranked as high as the No. 53 prospect according to MLB Pipeline.com and the No. 61 prospect per *Baseball America* entering the 2023 season.
- Had the “Best Curveball” in Washington’s system, per *Baseball America*, for two consecutive seasons (2024-25)...Had the “Best Slider” in the system in 2021 and 2022.
- Led all of Minor League Baseball with 175 strikeouts in 2021.

LAST START

Cavalli struck out eight across 6.0 innings of work and allowed three earned runs on seven hits and two walks...He earned a win in the 5-3 victory over the Cincinnati Reds on August 7.

vs. CHICAGO

Cavalli is set to make his second career start against the Cubs...He allowed two earned runs on three hits and three walks with five strikeouts across 3.2 innings on March 26 against Chicago.

REGENCY BIAS

Cavalli is 5-1 with a 2.78 ERA (14 ER/45.1 IP) and a .226 opponents' average over his last eight starts...Right-handed batters are 17-for-70 (.243) with 27 strikeouts, four walks and three extra-base hits over this stretch.

CADE'S KS

Cavalli ranks eighth in the National League in strikeouts per 9.0 innings (9.86) and ninth in strikeouts (141)...He's 10th in strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.62).

- Cavalli has struck out 59 and walked just nine across nine games since June 25...He ranks among NL pitchers in strikeout-to-walk ratio (3rd, 5.36), strikeouts (T5th, 59) and strikeouts per 9.0 innings (5th, 10.34) since that date.

THE RIGHT STUFF

Opposing right-handed batters are 49-for-205 (.239) with 11 extra-base hits off Cavalli so far this season.
