NATIVE AMERICAN RECOGNITION DAY ON SUNDAY: On Sunday, June 1, the D-backs host their signature Native American Recognition Day to kick off the 25th annual D-backs Inter-Tribal Youth Baseball & Softball Tournament, both presented by Talking Stick Resort.

• Highlights include a pregame parade of more than 1,500 youth athletes representing over 20 tribes across 4 states, recognitions of Arizona's Tribal Royalty Contingent, community members throwing the ceremonial first pitch, performing the national anthem and handling the color guard, performances from various drum groups, dancers, vocalists, art displays and educational exhibits.

LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 4-3 @ Cardinals yesterday to mark their third straight 1-run loss and fifth consecutive by at most 2 runs.

- Brandon Pfaadt recorded a no-decision for the first time since July 21, 2024 @ Cubs, snapping a 20-game decision streak to tie the longest in franchise history with Wade Miley (2012).
- Ketel Marte has hit safely in 8 straight games.
- Eugenio Suárez had his second 3+-hit game with 1 double and 2 RBI...has hit safely in 4 straight games.
- Josh Naylor tied for the team lead with his 13th double and has hit safely in 4 straight games.

MAY-JORS LEADERS: In May among the Majors, the D-backs rank in extra-base hits (1st, 82), total bases (1st, 366), pitches seen (2nd, 3,434), SLG (3rd, .461), hits (T-3rd, 214), homers (T-3rd, 33) and times on base (4th, 298).

HOME COOKIN': Among active Major Leaguers in home games since 2017, Ketel Marte's 24 triples are the most while his .301 AVG ranks sixth, behind Bobby Witt Jr./KC (.322), Luis Arráez/SD (.319), Aaron Judge/NYY (.304), Freddie Freeman/LAD (.304) and Trea Turner/PHI (.302).

2 TEAMS, 10 1-RUN GAMES: The D-backs and Pirates enter today with 10 combined 1-run games over the last 7 days.

• Since May 18, the D-backs (1-4) and Pirates (3-2) have each been a part of 5 1-run contests.

VS. BUCCOS: The D-backs went 4-2 vs. Pirates last season to take each 3-game series and are 8-3 in their last 11 games since May 20, 2023, outscoring them 59-46.

- **Ketel Marte**'s 5 homers vs. Pirates since 2023 are tied for second among all players with Seiya Suzuki/CHC, behind Dansby Swanson/CHC (8)...has hit safely in 10 of his last 11 games and reached base safely in 32 of his 36 career games.
- Josh Naylor, in his last 9 games, is batting .419 (13-for-31) with 3 doubles, 3 homers and 15 RBI.

NO PLACE LIKE CHASE: Josh Naylor has reached base safely in 7 straight home games since May 8 vs. Dodgers and in 23 of his 26 home games, batting .319 (30-for-94) with 9 doubles, 1 homer and 17 RBI.

- Geraldo Perdomo has hit safely in his last 4 home games, batting .385 (5-for-13)/1.130 OPS with 4 doubles, 3 RBI and 2 walks.
- **Gabriel Moreno**, over his last 7 home games since May 5, is hitting .346 (9-for-26)/.947 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 homer, 5 RBI and 1 walk.

VS. LEFTY STARTERS: The D-backs' 15.6 strikeout pct. vs. lefty opponent starters is the lowest in the Majors, ahead of the Blue Jays (18.3) and Cubs (18.5), while their 9.9 walk pct. is fifth, behind the Yankees (11.1), Mets (11.0), Cubs (10.6) and Tigers (10.6).

• **Geraldo Perdomo**, in 14 games vs. lefty starters, is batting .391 (18-for-46)/1.023 OPS with 5 doubles, 1 homer and 16 RBI.

HUNTING THE FASTBALL: Against fastballs, the D-backs rank among the Majors in extra-base hits (1st, 105), doubles (1st, 60), triples (1st, 8), OPS (2nd, .898), fewest strikeouts (2nd, 143) and homers (T-5th, 37).

RECENT DEFENSE: Since May 1, the D-backs' .994 fielding pct. (5 E) is best in the Majors, ahead of the Cardinals (.993, 6 E) and Rangers (.993, 6 E).

Geraldo Perdomo's .988 fielding pct. ranks atop all shortstops and fifth in the NL (min. 50 G), behind Matt Olson/ATL (.996), Ozzie Albies/ATL (.995), Bryce Harper/PHI (.995) and Pete Alonso/NYM (.993).

EARLY SCORING: The D-backs' 19 games with 1+ runs scored in the first inning are tied for second in the Majors with the Mariners and Angels, behind the Phillies (20), Dodgers (20) and Yankees (20).

• The D-backs have scored first in 5 of their last 7 games (2-3 record in those games).

LIMITING THE CHASE: Geraldo Perdomo's 18.8 chase pct. is eighth lowest in the NL, behind Juan Soto/NYM (14.3), Kyle Tucker/CHC (17.0), Kyle Schwarber/PHI (17.7), Will Smith/LAD (18.2), T.J. Friedl/CIN (18.2), Matt Chapman/ SF (18.5) and Gavin Lux/CIN (18.6).

• Among MLB shortstops, his 4.14 average pitches per PA ranks third, behind Masyn Winn/STL (4.38) and J.P. Crawford/SEA (4.33).

MAY MASHER: Ketel Marte has hit a career-high 8 homers in May, also his most for any career month (prev: 7 in May 2019; 7 in June 2019, 2023, 2024; 7 in July 2024).

 Is tied for third in May homers in the NL (also: Pete Crow-Armstrong/CHC and Matt Olson/ATL), behind Shohei Ohtani/LAD (11) and Kyle Schwarber/PHI (9).

NEXT STARTER: RHP CORBIN BURNES (3-2, 2.73)

Won 3 of his last 4 starts and his last 2 home starts. Has 6 quality starts in his last 7. Made last start vs. Pirates on Sept. 4, 2023 (L; 4 ER in

6.0 IP, 0 BB, 7 K) on the road while with the Brewers. In his last start on May 21 @ Dodgers, allowed only 1 hit thru 5.0 innings before surrendering 3 hits in the sixth, including a 2-out, go-ahead, 3-run homer to Teoscar Hernández.
