ORIOLES NOTES

- The Orioles fell to the Guardians, 5-0, dropping their third straight series opener and fourth in their last five series after beginning the season 13-0 in the first game of a series...Shut out for the fourth time this year and for the first time since May 14 vs. PIT; all shutouts have come since May 3...Have lost four of the last five games at Oriole Park after starting the season 15-7 at home.
- **RHP Tyler Wells** was dealt his second loss of the season after allowing one run on four hits with seven strikeouts and a balk in 6.0 innings of work...Issued no walks in a start for the third time this season (3x, last: 4/9 vs. NYY)...Has tossed at least 5.0 innings in each of his 11 appearances (10 starts) this season; entered 2023 with 12 such games (all in 2022)...Leads MLB in WHIP (0.83) and opponent on-base percentage (.220) as of the end of today's game; also ranks among qualified pitchers in H/9 (2nd, 5.71), opponent batting average (2nd, .176), and BB/9 (7th, 1.71)...Threw 101 pitches, 65 strikes.
- RHP Mike Baumann has been perfect in his last four appearances (4.1 IP) since May 21; has four strikeouts in that time.
- **DH Anthony Santander** tallied his second three-hit game of the season (last: 5/25 at NYY)...Recorded his 10th multi-hit game in May and 14th of the year (last: 5/25 at NYY)...Is slashing .326/.421/.576 (30-for-92) with five doubles, six home runs, 15 runs scored, 17 RBI, 13 walks, and one stolen base in 25 games this month.
- CF Cedric Mullins drew two walks in the same game for the sixth time this season (last: 5/2 at KC).
- **C James McCann** doubled in the fourth inning for the third time this month (last: 5/27 vs. TEX); marked his sixth extra-base hit of the season (4-2B, 2 HR).
- Adley Rutschman did not appear in a game for the first time this season.

GUARDIANS NOTES

- The Guardians defeated the Orioles, 5-0, in the series opener...Won a series opener away from Progressive Field for the first time since May 1 at New York-AL...Shut out an opponent for the fifth time this season and first since May 22 vs. Chicago-AL...Their last team shutout on the road was on April 1 at Seattle...Snapped a three-game road losing streak.
- **LHP Logan Allen** earned his second career win after working a career-high 7.0 scoreless innings on three hits with two walks and a career-high 10 strikeouts...Became the second pitcher in franchise history to record eight-or-more strikeouts in three of his first seven career games, joining Herb Score, who accomplished the feat in five of his first seven career games in 1955...Becomes the first Guardians pitcher this season to record 10 or more strikeouts in a game this season...Is the eighth pitcher in franchise history to toss 10+ strikeouts in one of his first seven career games and the first since Triston McKenzie in 2020...Also becomes the 10th player in club history to allow three earned-runs-or-fewer in each of his first seven career starts and first since **Aaron Civale** accomplished the feat in each of his first nine career starts in 2019...Threw 103 pitches, 68 strikes.
- RHP Enyel De Los Santos has tossed five perfect appearances (4.2 IP) since May 19; has four strikeouts in that period.
- **LF Steven Kwan** tallied his team-leading 13th multi-hit game of the season...Also leads the team in hits (54) and runs (31); tied for the team lead with 29 walks (Bell)...Has scored a run in a season-high-tying four straight games since May 26 (4x, last: 5/6-9).
- **RF Will Brennan** recorded his first career three-hit game...Also set a career high with two doubles...His double in the second inning was his first since April 16 at Washington...Also scored a season-high-tying two runs (4x, last: 4/28 at BOS).
- **DH José Ramírez** recorded his 536th career extra-base hit with a double in the second inning, surpassing Nap Lajoie (535) for sixth on the club's all-time extra-base hit list.
- C Cam Gallagher notched his second multi-hit game of the season (also 5/19 at NYM).
