THE WORD ON THE 'BIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals continue a seven-game road trip over eight days in the Golden State with the middle game of a three-game series against the A.L. West division-leading Athletics in West Sacramento. The Cardinals split a four-game series at San Diego (2-2) to begin the road trip before an open date on Monday.

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis enters play today at 24-17 and in 3rd place in the National League Central, 2.5 games behind first place Chicago and percentage points behind 2nd place Milwaukee. This is the closest the Cardinals have been to first place since May 4 (2.0 GB). The high watermark of the season was eight games over .500 at 23-15 on May 8.

OPENING ACT: With the Cardinals earning a 6-4 win last night at Sutter Health Ballpark, they have now won their first game at domestic (inside the United States of America) stadiums for the 6th time in seven games. Winning last night in West Sacramento; at Steinbrenner Field vs. Tampa Bay (Aug. 21, 2025); Rickwood Field vs. San Francisco (June 20, 2024); at Truist Park vs. Atlanta (May 5, 2017); at Target Field vs. Minnesota (June 15, 2015); and at loanDepot Park vs. Miami (April 4, 2012). Their only loss was a 4-3 decision at Globe Life Park vs. Texas (June 5, 2023).

RESCUE RILEY: With his 12th save last night, tying **Mason Miller** (SD) for the National League lead, **Riley O'Brien** has matched **Ryan Helsley's** mark for save in the first 41 games of a schedule from 2024 when Helsley set the franchise record with 49. **Lee Smith** (14 in 1992) and **Jason Isringhausen** (13 in 2006) hold the mark for the most Cardinals saves through 41 games.

HOLD THE LINE: Cardinals lefty reliever **JoJo Romero** achieved his 14th Hold of the season, tying **Steve Kline** (2001-04) for 3rd place all-time in Cardinals history with his 71st Hold. Only southpaw **Kevin Siegrist** (78) and RHP **Giovanny Gallegos** (78) stand above.

MAKING A FIRST IMPRESSION: The Cardinals scored four runs in the 1st inning last night, marking the first time since July 13, 2024 (G1) vs. Chicago (NL) at Busch Stadium, when the 'Birds blasted the Cubbies for nine runs in the opening frame en route to an 11-3 victory in the opener of a doubleheader sweep. They were the first 1st inning runs the Cardinals had scored since May 1 when they plated three in the Opening Frame against the Dodgers at Busch Stadium.

CHiPs (Cardinals High in Preventing Steals): Catcher **Pedro Pagés** caught two runners stealing in the Padres series and has a Major League-leading nine catcher caught stealings for the season.

DIBS ON LIB: Tonight's starting pitcher **Matthew Liberatore** is attempting to win three straight starts for the second time in his career (June 17-29, 2025). The Cardinals southpaw enters on a 7.0-inning scoreless streak against the Athletics dating back to a relief appearance at the Coliseum on April 17, 2024. Liberatore and **Michael McGreevy** have both won their first two starts in the month of May.

STARTING TO REV IT UP: Cardinals starting pitchers have posted a 2.68 ERA in 10 starts in the month of May ranking 3rd behind only the Rays (2.06) and Pirates (2.07). They are tied for the most wins among starters with the Pirates (6) and Phillies (6) and have induced the most ground into double plays with 12. Since this road trip started on May 7, the Cardinals have the lowest ERA in MLB (2.03) and 2nd-lowest WHIP (0.88) to the Atlanta Braves (0.80).

ROAD KILL: The Cardinals have the best road record in Major League Baseball at 14-7 (.667). The Cardinals have not lost more than two straight road games this season, while running off two win streaks of five or more road wins. Only the Atlanta Braves have been able to match two win streaks of five or more on the road this season, while tonight's opponent, the Athletics, have the longest road win streak in MLB this season with seven (Apr. 8-21)

SACRAMENTO & ATHLETICS CONNECTIONS

Jacob Wilson's father, **Jack Wilson**, was selected by St. Louis in the 9th round of the 1998 MLB Draft and played parts of three minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization before being traded to the Pirates for LHP **Jason Christiansen** (July 29, 2000).

Cardinals broadcaster **Chip Caray's** son, **Chris Caray**, is an Athletics broadcaster.

Justin Bruhl was born in nearby Petaluma, Calif.

Joel Kuhnel made his MLB debut on Aug. 16, 2019 vs. St. Louis while pitching for Cincinnati.

Daniel Descalso was born in Redwood City, Calif...graduated from St. Francis High School in Mountain View in 2004...played college baseball at University of California, Davis (2005-07)...resides in Danville, Calif.

Cardinals Minor League Outfield Coordinator **Ryan Ludwick** was a 2nd round draft pick of the Athletics in 1999 and Cardinals Special Advisor & Pitching Instructor **Jason Isringhausen** pitched for the Athletics from 1999-2001 before he signed with St. Louis as a free agent in December 2001.

Cardinals Pitching Strategist **Dean Kiekhefer** pitched in four games for the Athletics during the 2018 season.

Athletics Hitting Coach **Mike Aldrete** was the Cardinals Asst. Hitting Coach (2008-11) and Bench Coach (2012-14)...member of the Cardinals 2011 World Championship team and 2013 NL pennant winner...his son, **Michael Aldrete**, was selected by St. Louis in the 39th round of the 2012 Draft.

Cardinals Video Coordinator **Chad Blair** previously served in a similar role with the Athletics from (1988-95)...is a native of nearby Santa Rosa, Calif.

Cardinals Hall of Famer and A's Special Assistant to Player Development **Mark McGwire** played parts of 12 seasons in Oakland (1986-97)...1987 AL Rookie of the Year...1989 World Series Champion & member of three AL pennant winners (1988-90)...eight-time AL All-Star (1987-92, '95-97)...won two Silver Sluggers (1992 & '96) and one Gold Glove (1990)...selected by Oakland in the 1st round (#10) in the 1984 MLB Draft...traded to St. Louis for **Eric Ludwick**, **T.J. Mathews** and **Blake Stein**.

Hall of Famer and A's Special Assistant to the President **Dennis Eckersley** pitched nine seasons with Oakland (1987-95) and two with St. Louis (1996-97)...converted 386 of his 390 career saves between the Athletics (320) and Cardinals (66).

Athletics Quality Control Coach **Marcus Jensen** played 16 games for St. Louis in 1999.

Athletics Roving Coach **Stephen Piscotty** was a Cardinals 2012 1st round draft pick and played in 323 games for St. Louis from 2015-17 before the A's acquired him on Dec. 14, 2017 in exchange for **Yairo Muñoz** and **Max Schrock**.

Cardinals Assistant Hitting Coach **Brandon Allen** played in 44 games for the A's from 2011-12 & was the A's Opening Day First Baseman in 2012.

Athletics Head Athletic Trainer **Jeff Collins** is a SIU Carbondale graduate.

Hall of Fame Manager **Tony La Russa** was a manager of the Athletics (1986-95) and Cardinals (1996-2011)...is only manager to win multiple pennants in both leagues and one of two (Sparky Anderson) to win a World Series in both...His 70 postseason victories (50 with St. Louis, 19 with Oakland, & 1 with Chicago) rank 2nd to Joe Torre (84)...La Russa piloted the A's to four division titles, three AL pennants, and the 1989 World Championship...is A's franchise wins leader (798)...also played parts of four seasons in Oakland (1968-71).

Mgr. of Baseball Info. & Media Services **Chris Tunno** was the clubhouse manager for the Athletics California League affiliate, Stockton Ports (A) at the beginning of the 2007 season under manager **Darren Bush**, current A's bench coach..

TONIGHT'S GAME:

- 26-year-old Opening Day southpaw starting pitcher makes his team-leading 9th start of the season tonight.
- Tonight's game marks his 129th career Major League appearance and his 62nd career start.
- Has departed with the lead in three of his last four starts. Sports a 2-1 record, but the Cardinals are 6-2 in his eight starts this season.
- The Cardinals are 15-15 in his 30 career starts at Busch Stadium, where he has gone 11-10 with a 3.93 ERA (151.0 IP/66 ER) with 10 quality starts.
- **Is 5.0 innings away from reaching 300.0 as a starting pitcher in his career.**
- Pitched 5.0 or more innings in seven of eight starts.
- Allowed one run in four starts and two runs or fewer in five starts.

LAST TIME OUT (Thursday, May 7 at Petco Park): W, 2-1; 6.0 IP, 3 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 3 BB, 6 SO, 0 HR, 81 pitches).

- Yielded a run in the first inning, then twirled 5.0 scoreless in a 2-1 win over the Padres in the Cardinal road trip opener at Petco Park. Held Padres batters to 0-for-12 (2 walks erased by GIDP) between hits in the 1st and 6th inning.
- Recorded his 2nd pick-off of the season (Bogaerts), his most in a single season.
- Induced two double plays giving him five on the season, tied with **Kyle Leahy (5)** and trailing **Dustin May (6)** for the team lead.
- Recorded his 300th career strikeout fanning **Nick Castellanos** in the 5th inning.
- Exited with the score tied at 1-1 as St. Louis pulled ahead in the top of the 7th on **Masyn Winn's** RBI triple.
- Matched season highs in innings pitched (6.0) for the 3rd time and strikeouts (6) for the 2nd.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

FRIAR FRYER: Earned his 2nd straight win holding the Padres (5/7) to one run over 6.0 innings in a 2-1 come-from-behind win at Petco Park.

HR DERBY: Surrendered a career-high 3 HR's in 3.1 IP vs. SEA (4/25) as the two teams combined for 33 hits and 8 HR's in 11-9 Mariners win.

SPACE DUST: Worked a season high 6.0 IP, allowing just one run on three hits, taking a ND in the Cardinals 7-5 extra inning win on 4/19 at HOU to complete the series sweep of the Astros.

FIRST TO 100: Threw a career high 105 pitches in 9-3 loss vs. CLE on 4/13 in 5.0 IP; He was the first Cardinals pitcher to reach the 100 pitch plateau.

NO FOOLING: Held the Mets to one run in his second start on April Fools Day, a day after **Andre Pallante** and company shut out New York. Retired the first 12 Mets batters (first time a Cardinal vs. NYM since 1968) and carried a no-hitter through 4.2 innings, longest of his career.

LIBBY'S LID-LIFTER: Made his 1st career Opening Day start and received a no decision vs. TB (3/26) despite pitching 5.0 innings and allowing just one run. Cardinals rallied for a 9-7 win (he exited with game tied 1-1).

LEFTY LIFT-OFFS: Made his 1st career Opening Day start on 3/26 vs. TB, becoming the 1st Cardinals lefty to start on Opening Day since **Donovan Osborne** (4/5/99) vs. MIL - the same year that Libby was born. He became one of just 16 LHP's to make the Opening Day start for the Cardinals since 1901 (MLB).

CAREER:

- Chose to switch to uniform No. 32 prior to 2026 season in honor of Hall of Fame left-handed pitcher **Sandy Koufax**, whom he grew up admiring.
- Was acquired by the Cardinals from the Rays in a four-player trade in 2020 that included Randy Arozarena, with a compensation pick that netted the Cardinals RHP **Tink Hence**.
- Is a career 15-22 with a 4.76 ERA (295.0 IP) in his 61 career starts opposed to 3-3 with a 3.89 ERA (81.0 IP) in 67 career relief appearances.
- Has limited left-handed batters to a .247/.306/.380 (93-376) with a .686 OPS average over his Major League career.
- 2021 Cardinals Minor League Pitcher of the Year, his first season of play in the Cardinals organization.

LIBERATORE vs. ATHLETICS:

- Making his 3rd career start (4th app.) vs. the Athletics. Is 1-1 with a 3.97 ERA (11.1 IP) and 12 strikeouts.
- Enters on a 7.0-inning scoreless streak vs. the A's dating back to April 17, 2024.
- His first start came at Busch Stadium (Aug. 16, 2023) allowing six runs (5 ER) over 4.1 innings in an 8-0 loss.
- Made a relief appearance at the Oakland Coliseum in the Cardinals final game in Oakland (April 17, 2025) pitching five scoreless outs.
- His lone win against an American League West team is against the Athletics: 1-4, 6.75 ERA, 12 app., 9 GS). Opponent BA is .326 over 199 total batters faced.
- Sutter Health Park becomes the 31st Major League stadium of Libby's career. Active stadiums where Libby has yet to pitch at includes Fenway Park and Chase Field.
