WITH THE GIANTS: Made his MLB debut on Aug. 22 at Philadel-
phia...was selected in the third round of the 2020 MLB Draft out of
De La Salle High School (Concord, CA).

TODAY'S GAME: Is slated to make his sixth-career start and his
first since he optioned to Triple-A Sacramento on Sept. 15...Har-
rison was recalled yesterday after **RHP Alex Cobb** and **RHP Keaton
Winn** both landed in the IL.

LAST OUTING: Took a no-decision in SF's 6-5, 10th inning walkoff
win vs. Cleveland on September 13...the southpaw worked 4.0
innings and allowed five runs (three earned) on seven hits (one
homer)...his earned runs came on a two-run homer to CLE's José
Ramírez and a one-run single to Josh Naylor...SF has won three of
the last four games Harrison's pitched in.

HOLD YOUR HORSES: Harrison had just six swing-and-misses out
of the 43 swings (14 percent) he generated against Cleveland,
which was his lowest percentage in any start this season, accord-
ing to *Sports Info Solutions*...his low swing-and-miss rate could
be due to his lack of getting ahead in counts, as his 55% first pitch
strike rate is down compared to the league average (66%).

THE PUNCHES.... Harrison's three strikeouts last time out brought
his season total to 29, which matched **Juan Marichal** in 1960 for the
fifth-most strikeouts through any Giants' first five games...the last
Giant with as many strikeouts in that span was Tim Lincecum's 33
strikeouts though his first five starts in 2007.

THE HOMERS....After allowing a 1st inning homer to CLE's José
Ramírez, Harrison has given up the most home runs (seven) in a
player's first five career games in franchise history...Harrison has
allowed 17 runs total at the big league level so far...11 of those 17
have been scored on homers (64.7%).

FUTURE DODGER KILLER?: Although Harrison is pitching in his
first-career game against Los Angeles-NL, he faced the Oklahoma
City Dodgers in Triple-A four times this season...Harrison had a
1.26 ERA (2er, 14.1ip) with 29 strikeouts and just three hits allowed
in those four starts...none of the players he faced in those starts
are on LA's current active roster.

THINGS LEFT TO LEARN?: Since his debut with SF, however, lefties
have given Harrison quite a bit of trouble...they've gone 12-for-24
(.500) off Harrison with five XBH (two doubles, three homers)...
furthermore, Harrison has yet to strike out a left-handed batter in
the Majors with all 29 of his punchouts coming to RHBs...righties
at the MLB-level are 14-for-74 (.189) vs. Harrison with seven XBH
(two doubles, one triple, four homers).

GRAB SOME PINE, MEAT: Harrison logged 14 strikeouts through
his first 30 career batters faced, the third-most by a starter since
1901 (other: WSH's Stephen Strasburg with 17 in 2010, MIL's Fred-
dy Peralta with 15 in 2018)...he also became the only left-handed
pitcher in the modern era to strike out 40% or more of the batters
he faced through his first two starts (*OptaSTATS*).

RAKING IN THE AWARDS: In addition to being the No. 1 ranked
player in the SF system on *MLB.com*, Harrison is the game's No.
20 overall prospect and top left-hander...he has earned 10 awards
on MiLB.com including two Triple-A Pitcher of the Week awards
this year.

TIME ON THE IL: After returning from a hamstring strain on
July 31, Harrison pitched in four Minor League games, three
for Triple-A Sacramento, posting a 3.86 ERA (4er, 9.1ip) with
13 strikeouts at Triple-A...he suffered a moderate hamstring
strain on July 5 while training in between starts and did not
pitch in the Futures Game.

JOINING THE PARTY: The lefty was the Giants' third draft
pick from the 2020 draft to make his debut, joining **C Patrick
Bailey** and **IF Casey Schmitt**.

HE'S NOT ALONE: Harrison became the 11th Giants player
to make their MLB debut this season, and fourth pitcher...he
also became the first Giants pitcher to start in his MLB debut
since **RHP Logan Webb** on August 17, 2019 at Arizona.

BAY AREA'S OWN: Harrison was born in San Jose and attend-
ed nearby De La Salle High School in Concord, California.

Pitch Arsenal: Sinker, Slider, Changeup

Last Game: 9/19 at ARI; 1.0ip, h, k (13 pitches)

- ▶ Hasn't allowed an earned run over his last four outings (4.1ip), with batters going 4-for-18...had allowed 12 runs (9.2ip) on 20 hits (.426 avg) over his previous 12 outings (11.17 ERA)
- ▶ Stranded 24 of his 30 inherited runners this season.
- ▶ Lefties are 16-for-76 (.211) off him with five XBH.
- ▶ His 14.9 strikeout rate is in the bottom 5% of MLB.
- ▶ Has struck out just 30 of the 201 batters he's faced this year.
- ▶ Alexander is 7-0 as a reliever in 2023...according to *Stats, LLC*, his record would tie for the most wins without a loss in a single season by a Giant out of the bullpen in the modern era.

#43 TRISTAN BECK ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Curveball, Changeup

Last Game: 9/4 at CHC; 1.1ip, 1h, 2h, 1bb (27 pitches)

- ▶ Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento today.
- ▶ This marks the fifth time he's been recalled this season.
- ▶ Last pitched Sunday vs. Sugar Land and threw 4.0 innings, allowing four runs on four hits in what was his sixth start for Sac this year.
- ▶ In his first MLB season...he's 3-3 with a 4.04 ERA in 31 games.

#59 JOHN BREBBIA ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Changeup

Last Game: 9/17 at COL; 0.2ip, h, 2r, er, hr (14 pitches)

- ▶ Returned from his rehab assignment and reinstated from the 60-day Injured List on Sept. 5 (right lat strain)...missed 69 games.
- ▶ Has worked in six games since being reinstated from the IL.
- ▶ Has bounced back and forth from the bullpen to being used as an "opener" this season.
- ▶ Has a 0.90 ERA (2er, 20.0ip) with 17 strikeouts in 19 career starts.

#75 CAMILO DOVAL ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Cutter, Sinker

Last Game: 9/17 at COL; 0.2ip, 3h, 4r, er, hb, k (35 pitches)

- ▶ His 37 SVs are most by a Giant since **Santiago Casilla** (38 in 2015).
- ▶ His 37 saves are tied for second-most in MLB behind CLE's Emmanuel Clase (41).
- ▶ Named to the NL All-Star team, his first career selection.
- ▶ Has struck out 83 batters over 64.0 innings of work (11.67 SO/9)...his 31.0% strikeout rate ranks in the top 8% of the league.
- ▶ Batters are 15-for-94 (.160) off his slider with 46 strikeouts.

#77 LUKE JACKSON ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Curveball

Last Game: 9/17 at COL; 1.0ip, h, 2k (11 pitches)

- ▶ Has struck out 40 batters in 30.2 innings of work (11.74 SO/9).
- ▶ 30 of his 40 strikeouts have come on his slider.
- ▶ Reinstated from the 60-day IL on May 30 and made his Giants debut on May 31...missed the entire 2022 season after undergoing TJ surgery.
- ▶ Also missed 21 games with a low back strain from June 25-July 22.

#34 JAKOB JUNIS ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker, Changeup, Four-Seam Fastball

Last Game: 9/16 at COL (G2); 4.0ip, 4h, 2r, er, bb, 5k (57 pitches)

- ▶ Has allowed seven runs (six ER) on 11 hits in 14.0 innings over his last five relief appearances.
- ▶ Has made 35 appearances out of SF's bullpen...served mainly as a long reliever with his season-high being 4.0ip.
- ▶ Also made four starts for SF and allowed just two runs (unearned) on five hits with 14 strikeouts (12.2ip).

#33 TAYLOR ROGERS ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker, Cutter

Last Game: 9/17 at COL; SV, 0.1ip (2 pitches)
