PARTING IS SUCH SWEET SORROW: The Detroit Tigers this afternoon conclude their 11-day, 10-game homestand, their longest of the season, on the heels of a doubleheader sweep of the Baltimore Orioles yesterday ... the Tigers have already assured themselves of a winning homestand by taking seven of the first nine games (3-1 vs. Kansas City, 2-1 vs. San Diego, 2-0 vs. Baltimore) ... after today, the Tigers embark on their longest road trip of the year, an 11-day, 10-game, three-city trek through Houston (3 games, tomorrow-Wednesday), the Angels (4 games, May 1-4) and Colorado (3 games, May 6-8) and do not return home until Friday, May 9, one dozen days from now.

- At 12-3, the Tigers have begun a season by winning 12 of their first 15 home games for the first time in 114 years when they started off 14-1 at Bennett Park in 1911.
- At 17-10 overall, the Tigers are off to their best 27-game start since 2015 (also 17-10).
- The Tigers have gone 17-7, a .708 winning percentage, in their last 24 games since enduring a three-game sweep to start the season at Dodger Stadium.
- The Tigers today continue their stretch of 23 games in 24 days through next Sunday, May 4.

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The Tigers have started a season by winning seven of their first nine series for the first time since 1984 when they went 8-0-1 through their first nine series.

- The Tigers have won their first five home series for the first time since 1942, though that run 83 years ago included a pair of one-game series victories.
- The Tigers aim for their first three-game sweep of the Orioles since May 13-15, 2022 in Detroit.

IT ALL MAKES A DIFFERENCE: At 17-10 (.630), the Tigers begin the day with the best record in the American League on the strength of a +35 run differential this year, also the best mark in the A.L. ... the Tigers are one of only five A.L. teams in positive run-differential territory, just ahead of the New York Yankees (+29) and well ahead of the Seattle Mariners (+14), Tampa Bay Rays (+12) and Houston Astros (+7) ... overall, Detroit's +35 run differential is third best in all of baseball.

HOME OWNER: Tigers ace and reigning unanimous Cy Young Award winner Tarik Skubal today makes his third start this year at Comerica Park, where he has gone 11-1 with a 1.96 ERA (25 ER/115.0 IP) in 18 starts since the start of 2024 ... his 11 home wins, 1.96 ERA and .917 win percentage are all best in the A.L. at home in that span and second-best in the majors (Philadelphia's Zack Wheeler has 12 wins; Atlanta's Reynaldo Lopez has a 1.78 ERA; Atlanta's Chris Sale is 10-0 at home).

THIS IS SOME HIGH-END TORK: Including two more extra-base hits yesterday, Spencer Torkelson enters the day tied with Boston's Alex Bregman for the A.L. lead with 16 extra-base hits ... Torkelson ranks seventh in the A.L. with a .950 OPS ... Torkelson and teammate Andy Ibáñez are tied for second in the A.L. with four game-winning RBI this season ... overall, Torkelson's 24 RBI are second in the A.L. (New York's Aaron Judge leads with 26) and tied for fifth most in the majors.

IT TAKES A VILLAGE: Tarik Skubal (2.83 ERA) is one of four Tigers starters with a sub-3.00 ERA so far this season, joining Casey Mize (2.12 ERA), Jack Flaherty (2.63 ERA) and Jackson Jobe (2.70 ERA).

- The Tigers are the only team in all of baseball to have four starting pitchers with sub-3.00 ERAs ... across the rest of baseball, only the New York Mets have as many as three starting pitchers with sub-3.00 ERAs this season.
- Collectively, Tigers starters lead the American League with a 3.01 ERA (49 ER/146.2 IP) this season, second in the majors behind only the New York Mets (2.28 ERA).
- The Tigers have 60 percent (three of the five) of the A.L. starting pitchers with sub-2.00 ERAs at home this year: Reese Olson (0.98 ERA), Casey Mize (1.47 ERA) and Jack Flaherty (1.59 ERA).

THE MIGHTY PEN: The Tigers bullpen has combined to post a 2.75 ERA (28 ER/91.2 IP) this season, the fifth-lowest mark in all of baseball and second-lowest in the American League behind only Houston (2.53 ERA from their bullpen) ... Tigers relievers have also combined to limit opponents to a .588 OPS, the sixth-lowest mark in the majors and third lowest in the A.L. ... Detroit's 91.2 relief innings pitched are the fourth fewest in the American League.

HOME, SWEET, HOME: Zach McKinstry leads the majors with a .488 batting average (20-for-41) at home this season, 31 points ahead of his next closest competitor in New York's Aaron Judge with his .457 home batting average ... McKinstry also has a .569 on-base percentage and a .732 slugging percentage at home with a 1.300 OPS, second in the majors behind only Judge (1.518 OPS).

IN THE BIG INNING...: The Tigers are averaging seeing 20.6 pitches in the first inning this season, the best mark in the A.L. and second-best in the majors behind only the Phillies ... Detroit has scored 19 first-inning runs, tied for fifth most in the A.L. and tied for 10th most in the majors ... the Tigers lead the majors with a .406 on-base percentage (16 points higher than the Yankees) and a .322 (37-for-115) batting average (one point ahead of the Yankees) in the first inning this year.

AND FINALLY: Riley Greene's game-winning three-run homer last night was just Detroit's sixth bomb with runners on base this year, as 21 of their 27 blasts have been solo shots.

- Named the Tigers Opening Day starter for the second consecutive season...went 2-0 with a 2.33 ERA (5ER/19.1IP) in five starts in Spring Training, striking out 24 batters compared to just one walk
- Was the unanimous AL Cy Young winner in 2024, becoming the fifth Tiger to win the award, the first since Max Scherzer in 2013, and the second LHP in franchise history to ever do so (other, Willie Hernandez in 1984).
- Started 31 games last year, posting an 18-4 record with a 2.39 ERA (51ER/192.0IP) and 228 strikeouts...his 18 victories were the most by a Tigers pitcher since Max Scherzer also won 18 in 2014.
- Won the American League Pitching Triple Crown, finishing first in wins (18), ERA (2.39) and strikeouts (228)...became the third pitcher in franchise history and the 22nd pitcher in Major League history to win the Triple Crown, joining Justin Verlander (2011) and Hal Newhouser (1945).
- From Sept. 3, 2023-May 17, 2024, Skubal had a 10-0 record with a 1.48 ERA (14ER/85.0IP), 12 walks, 109 strikeouts and four home runs allowed...according to the Elias Sports Bureau, Skubal is the third starting pitcher since 1913 to have a 14-start span with an ERA below 1.50, 100-or-more strikeouts, 12-or-fewer walks and four-or-fewer home runs, joining Clayton Kershaw (twice, 9/29/15-6/4/16 and 5/1/16-9/19/16) and Jacob deGrom (4/5/21-7/1/21) while being the only starter with such a stretch while also earning 10 wins.
- Started three games during the postseason, compiling a 1-1 record with a 2.37 ERA (5ER/19.0IP) and 20 strikeouts...started his playoff career by not allowing a run in 17.0 consecutive innings, tied for the fifth-longest streak in MLB history and longest since Ian Anderson started his postseason career with 17.2 straight scoreless innings in 2020.
- Became the fourth pitcher in franchise history to throw 6.0-or-more shutout innings in his first career playoff game (Oct. 1), joining Max Scherzer (2011) and Joe Coleman (1972)

- Earned a spot on his first career Opening Day roster after a standout spring camp, during which he didn't allow a single earned run over 10.2 innings (nine games) of relief...went 1-0, surrendering seven hits and three walks while striking out nine
