RECENT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals continue their six-game homestand tonight with the second game of a three-game weekend series against the division-rival Milwaukee Brewers. The Washington Nationals (81-65) visit Busch Stadium for three games beginning Monday. St. Louis recently split a six-game road trip through Pittsburgh (2-1) and Colorado (1-2). The Cardinals enter today in first place in the NL Central, 4.0 games ahead of Chicago (vs. Pittsburgh).

TIME TO FLY: After a five-game losing streak on a West Coast trip to Oakland and Los Angeles (NL), the Cardinals are 25-9 since August 9, holding the most wins in MLB over that period while boasting a MLB-best 2.77 ERA. SECOND HALF SHILDT: Since taking over the reigns as manager, Mike Shildt and Oakland's **Bob Melvin** co-lead MLB for most Post All-Star Break wins (79).

JACK ATTACK: Jack Flaherty's MLB-leading 0.76 ERA in 11 starts since the All-Star Break currently ranks as the 2nd-lowest post All-Star ERA all-time in MLB history, trailing 2015 Cubs right-hander Jake Arrieta (0.75 ERA 15 starts).

I LOVE GOOOOOOLD: Eight of Paul Goldschmidt's team-leading 31 homers have been hit against the Brewers this season, tying his single-season most vs. any opponent (8 vs. the Dodgers in 2015). Those eight home runs vs. Milwaukee tie Cincinnati's Eugenio Suarez (8) for most in MLB this season, tie Albert Pujols (8 in 2010) for the Cardinals single-season record, and trail only Sammy Sosa (12 in 1998) in MLB single-season history.

THE HUNT FOR A RED OCTOBER: The Cardinals' 15 remaining games are against teams with winning records in contention for playoff positions (.532 combined win pct.). Nine games come against the NL Central (CHI 7; MIL 2), where the Cardinals are a division-leading 41-26 (.612) in 2019, including a 26-9 $\,$ record since the All-Star Break.

A WINNING TRADITION: The Cardinals have clinched a winning record for the 12th consecutive season since current President of Baseball Operations John Mozeliak took the post of GM in 2008, representing their 2nd-longest winning stretch in franchise history behind 15-season winning span from 1939-53 (1382-926, .599) that culminated in three World Series Championships. Since 2008, St. Louis has compiled a 1,068-861 (.554) record (3rd in MLB), with the Cardinals and Yankees being the only MLB organizations without a losing season.

BEER WARS: Last night's victory clinched the season series (10-7) over Milwaukee for the first time since 2016 and sixth time since 2012. The Cardinals are 6-1 (.857) at home over the Brewers this season, matching the 2003 Cardinals (6-1 at Busch Std II) for best all-time vs. Milwaukee. St. Louis' most home wins over the Brewers in a season came in 2002 and 2016 (7-3, .700).

MAHALO: Kolten Wong and Paul DeJong have reached base safely in 16 straight games vs. Milwaukee this season, T2nd longest active streak in MLB, one behind **Cody Bellinger** (17). While slashing .444/.516/.685 (24-54) with three home runs and 15 RBI over his on-base-streak vs. the Brew Crew, Wong's 24 hits are his single-season career high vs. any opponent and rank T5th-most in Cards single-season in history vs. the Brewers. **Edgar Renteria** ranks 1st, going 30-for-61, (.492) vs. Milwaukee in 2003.

SHOUT OUT TO SHUTOUTS: Last night was St. Louis' 13th shutout of 2019 (2nd in NL) and 8th since **Yadier Molina** was activated from the Injured List on Aug. 13...Molina has now started and caught 154 shutouts in his career, three behind Carlton Fisk (157) for 3rd all-time in MLB history...Cardinals starting pitchers have thrown 29.0 consecutive scoreless innings at home (Sept. 2-present)...St. Louis has recorded back-to-back home shutouts and in three of their last four home games (Sept. 3-present)...The Cardinals scored double digits in a shutout win last night for the 5th time in Busch Stadium III history and the first time over Milwaukee since a 13-0 shutout victory on Sept. 18, 2003 at Busch Std. II.

Cardinals Hall of Famer, broadcaster and Special Assistant **Jim Edmonds** played in 73 games for Milwaukee in 2010.

Cardinals Director of Medical Operations/Head Athletic Trainer **Adam Olsen** is a native of Green Bay, Wisc...earned his Master's in Physical Therapy from The University of Wisconsin-Madison.

Cardinals Special Asst. to the GM, Player Procurement **Matt Slater** is a Marquette Univ. graduate... started in pro baseball as the Brewers' Scouting and Player Development Assistant (1991)

Cardinals Hall of Fame catcher **Ted Simmons** played 13 seasons with St. Louis (1968-80), where he was a six-time NL All-Star and won 1980 Silver Slugger Award...traded by St. Louis with pitchers Rollie Fingers and Pete Vuckovich to Milwaukee for outfielders David Green and Sixto Lezcano and pitchers Dave LaPoint and Lary Sorensen. played five seasons with the Brewers (1981-85) where he was a two-time AL All-Star and faced off against the Cardinals in the 1982 World Series.

Brewers broadcaster Bob Uecker played two seasons (1964-65) with St. Louis...won the 1964 World Series...originally traded by the Milwaukee Braves to St. Louis for catcher **Jimmie Coker** and outfielder Gary Kolb (April 9, 1964)

TONIGHT'S GAME

- Makes his 30th start of the season and his 63rd career start (64th appearance).
- Has established single-season career highs in wins (10), innings pitched (168.1), strikeouts (196), quality starts (16) and games started (29). Is seeking to become 1st Cardinals pitcher with 200 strikeouts in season since 2017 (C. Martinez, 217)
- Named N.L. Pitcher of the Month for August, becoming the first Cardinal to win the award since Adam Wainwright (Sept. 2014). Went 4-1 with 0.71 ERA in his six August starts.
- His 1.64 ERA (66.0 IP) in 11 day starts rank 4th-lowest in the National League.
- Has allowed just two earned runs in his last 56.0 innings (0.32 ERA). His current 18.0 scoreless innings streak (Aug. 28-present) is longest active streak in the majors.
- Logged 23.0 scoreless IP streak (7/26-8/13), which was longest by a Cardinals starting pitcher since Adam Wainwright's 25.0 scoreless innings in 2014.
- In his last 12 starts since July 7, is 6-2 with 0.80 ERA (7 ER/78.1 IP) and .146 opp. BA. Since ERA became an official stat in 1913, the only other pitchers in MLB history to have a sub-1.00 ERA and sub-.150 opp. BA over a 12-start span in a season are Jake Arrieta (2015) & Chris Sale (2018).
- Sports the lowest ERA (0.76) in Major League Baseball since the All-Star Break (11 GS).
 It's the majors 2nd lowest post All-Star ERA, trailing only Jake Arrieta (0.75) in 2015.
- Ranks 2nd among NL pitchers with 184 strikeouts Post All-Star Break over the last two seasons (2018-19) behind only Jacob deGrom (213).
- His 10 scoreless starts in 2019 are most by a Cardinal since A. Wainwright (12) in 2014.
- Has made 15 starts this season pitching 6.0 or more innings while holding his opposition to four hits or fewer, most in the NL. (Justin Verlander 19; Gerrit Cole 19).
- Allowed just four runs in a seven start span from July 7 to Aug. 13 covering 45.1 IP for a 0.79 ERA. It was the lowest ERA in seven start span by a Cardinals starter since Chris Carpenter in 2005 (0.45) and Bob Gibson in 1968 (0.43). Elias
