AROUND THE HORN

SIX NON-PROFITS SURPRISED WITH OVER \$1 MILLION THRU 2026 KEN KENDRICK GRAND SLAM AWARDS: Six Arizona-based nonprofits - Arizona Educational Foundation, Delivering Dreams Arizona, Foundation for Blind Children, Keys to Change, Phoenix Public Library Foundation and Southwest Human Development - were surprised with a combined \$1 million in grant funding through the Arizona Diamondbacks Foundation's 2026 Ken Kendrick Grand Slam Awards...established in 2002, this signature grant program has awarded more than \$13.8 million to organizations across Arizona, supporting transformative, large-scale projects that drive long-term change by improving operations and strengthening communities.

\$100 MILLION IN GIVING: The D-backs and Arizona Diamondbacks Foundation have earned a place among professional sports' most impactful philanthropic organizations in fewer than three decades, reaching a historic milestone of \$100 Million In Giving through their signature "D-backs Give Back" approach and investment in communities across Arizona...March 9 will forever be celebrated annually as "D-backs Give Back Day" as proclaimed by Arizona Governor Katie Hobbs ensuring the organization's longstanding statewide commitment will be recognized each year.

HERE'S THE STORY: Among NL teams, the D-backs rotation's 3.16 ERA (20 ER in 57.0 IP) ranks fourth best, behind the Braves (2.80), Cubs (2.80) and Reds (3.03).

- 20 earned runs are tied for the NL's third fewest (also: Braves and Reds), behind the Cubs (17) and Pirates (19).
- 1.82 earned runs per game average is tied for the NL's fourth lowest (also: Reds), behind the Cubs (1.55), Braves (1.67) and Pirates (1.73).
- **Geraldo Perdomo's** 38 consecutive plate appearances without a strikeout since March 27 @ Dodgers (third inning) is the longest active streak in the Majors, ahead of Chandler Simpson/TB (30).
- **Corbin Carroll** has reached base safely in 8 of his last 9 games, hitting .345 (10-for-29)/1.169 OPS with 1 double, 2 triples, 2 homers, 9 RBI and 6 walks.
- **Ildemaro Vargas** has hit safely in his first 5 games this season at a .438 clip (7-for-16)/1.283 OPS with 1 double, 1 triple, 1 homer, 4 RBI and 1 walk.
- **Ketel Marte** has reached base safely in 8 of his last 10 games (9 H, 4 BB)/.302 OBP with 2 doubles, 1 homer and 3 RBI.
- D-backs relievers, in their last 4 games, have a 2.30 ERA (6 R-4 ER in 15.2 IP), opponent .175 AVG/.485 OPS, 1 walk and 12 strikeouts.

LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 4-3 @ Mets in 10 innings yesterday and are now 1-1 in extra-inning games.

- **Zac Gallen** yielded 2 runs (1 ER) over 5.0 frames with 4 walks and 5 strikeouts in the no-decision.
- **Nolan Arenado** went 2-for-5 with 1 double and 1 RBI to record his first multi-hit effort as a D-back.
- **Adrian Del Castillo**, after successfully challenging a strike call, collected a game-tying 2-run single with the bases loaded and 2 outs in the fifth inning.
- **Gabriel Moreno** had a career-high-tying 4 times on base, going 2-for-3 with 1 double, 1 walk and 1 hit-by-pitch.
- **Ketel Marte** went 2-for-5 to record his second consecutive (third of the season) 2-hit game.
- 5 relievers - **Ryan Thompson**, **Juan Morillo**, **Jonathan Loaisiga**, **Kevin Ginkel** and **Paul Sewald** - combined to allow 1 earned run over 4.1 innings with 0 walks and 2 strikeouts.

A TOUGH K: D-back hitters' 79 strikeouts are the fewest in the Majors, ahead of the Marlins (84), Dodgers (89), Braves (90), Cardinals (90) and Phillies (90).

SAVING RUNS: The D-backs' 15 defensive runs saved (DRS) lead the Majors, ahead of the Pirates (12), Braves (11), Dodgers (11) and Mets (11).

- **Alek Thomas'** 4 DRS are tied for most in the Majors (also: Cole Young /SEA), while **Ketel Marte's** 3 DRS are tied for second (also: 12 others).
- The D-backs and Red Sox are the only teams with multiple players who have 3+ DRS.

500 FOR CARROLL: Corbin Carroll is slated today to play his 500th career game in the Majors.

- Among players to play their first 500 career regular-season games with the D-backs, ranks in runs (1st, 365, ahead of Paul Goldschmidt/318), triples (1st, 45, ahead of Stephen Drew/34), stolen bases (1st, 124, ahead of A.J. Pollock/88), extra-base hits (2nd, 223, behind Goldschmidt/236), home runs (3rd, 84, behind Goldschmidt/93) and RBI (4th, 257, behind Jake Lamb/272) [source: Elias Sports Bureau].

CARROLL CLIMBING THE RECORD BOOKS: Corbin Carroll is 1 stolen base from surpassing Paul Goldschmidt (124) for second on the club's all-time stolen base list, behind Tony Womack (182)...is 1 triple away from tying David Peralta (46) for second all-time, behind Stephen Drew (52).

VS. METS: The D-backs have won 4 of their last 6 games @ Mets since June 1, 2024.
