Bunting

Last night, Mike Yastrzemski dropped down a bunt-single in the fourth inning and became the first 35-year-old Brave with multiple bunt-hits in a season since David Ross in 2012. Just five total MLB players have recorded multiple such hits in a season at such an age since 2022.

Since his debut with San Francisco in 2019, Yastrzemski's 21 bunt-hits are tied for fifth in the NL regardless of age, only trailing T.J. Friedl (42), Victor Robles (29), Garrett Hampson (25) and Geraldo Perdomo (24).

TODAY'S GAME: The Atlanta Braves will play the New York Mets for a four-game wraparound series this weekend...New York took two-of-three from Atlanta at Citi Field in June...These teams will next see each other back in New York for three games from July 27-29.

A Atlanta suffered a comeback loss to St. Louis last night and dropped the series, two games-to-one... The Cardinals scored seven runs in the seventh to spoil Dominic Smith's three-RBI night.

A Atlanta played to an 8-5 record against New York last season, including a 4-2 mark here at Truist Park...Overall, the 2025 Braves went 30-22 against the National League East, but 46-64 against all other opponents.

A The Braves have taken the season series from the Mets for nine consecutive seasons, dating to 2018... The team is 77-51 (.602) against New York in that span.

A The Mets and Braves are set to play all of their matchups during the summer months, completing all 13 contests in a 53-game span...From the start of this series until August 12, 28% of Atlanta's games will be played against New York-NL.

A RHP Christian Scott has made one prior start against Atlanta...He took the loss here at Truist Park on May 11, 2024, after he allowed three earned runs across 6.0 innings, including eight strikeouts...The 6-foot-4, 215-pound right-hander owns a 6.00 ERA (6 ER/9.0) in his last two turns overall.

A RHP Grant Holmes takes the ball for Atlanta today having pitched to a 1.04 ERA (1 ER/8.2 IP) in his last two outings – one start and one relief appearance...The 6-foot-0, 226-pound native of Conway, SC, has faced the Mets just twice in his career, once each in 2024 and 2025...He's 0-1 with a 2.00 ERA (2 ER/9.0 IP) against New York with 13 strikeouts.

SLIDERS: As a pitching staff, the Braves have thrown the most sliders (3,085) in MLB this season, 203 more than the next-closest team (Toronto, 2,882)...The next-closest National League team is Los Angeles-NL, which has thrown 2,472 sliders.

A Atlanta's 264 strikeouts on sliders are also the most in Major League Baseball by a significant margin... The club leads the Blue Jays by 71 punchouts in that regard.

A Individually, Chris Sale and today's starter, Grant Holmes, have thrown the second- and sixth-most sliders in MLB, respectively...Among relievers specifically, Tyler Kinley and Dylan Lee have thrown the second-and seventh-most.

A According to Statcast, the Braves have posted a pitching run value of 14 on their sliders, which is tied for the fourth-highest total in MLB...Los Angeles-AL (24), Toronto (16) and Los Angeles-NL (15) are the only clubs ahead of them.

MAURICIO DUBÓN: Last night went 2-for-3 with a run, RBI and walk...His first hit was a line-drive single to center field with the bases loaded in the first inning – his seventh bases-loaded knock of the season.

A Dubón is 7-for-9 with the bases loaded this year... Among players with as many at-bats in such situations, his .778 batting average is the highest in MLB...Overall, Dubón's seven bases-loaded hits are tied for second in MLB behind Washington's Luis García Jr. (8).

A In 2025, three Braves recorded at least seven bases-loaded hits: Matt Olson (9), Drake Baldwin (8) and Michael Harris II (7)...Before they did so, the last Atlanta player to reach the mark was Nick Markakis (7) in 2018.

A Pacing for 13, Dubón is on pace to set the modern-era franchise record for most bases-loaded hits... Numerous Braves currently rank first with nine of them...In modern MLB history, only 12 players have recorded 13 such hits in a season...The MLB record is held by Hall of Famer Luke Appling, who had 17 bases-loaded hits for the Chicago White Sox in 1936.

A Since June 3, Dubón has hit in 21 of the 24 games he's played...In that time, only three players have hit in more contests: Bryan Reynolds (PIT, 23), Carter Jensen (KC, 22) and Pete Crow-Armstrong (CHC, 22)...Dubón's 29 hits in his last 24 games are his most in a 24-game span since August-September, 2023 while with the Houston Astros.

ROSTER MOVE: The Braves today recalled RHP Anthony Molina to Atlanta after optioning RHP James Karinchak to Triple-A Gwinnett following last night's game...The club also returned LHP Danny Young from his rehab assignment and reinstated him from the injured list, and designated RHP Ian Hamilton for assignment.

A Molina has appeared three times for the Braves this season and has pitched to a 5.40 ERA (3 ER/5.0 IP)...In 13 games (8 starts) for Gwinnett this year, he's 3-2 with a 4.14 ERA (21 ER/45.2 IP).

A In five appearances as part of his rehabilitation assignment, Young didn't allow an earned run across 5.1 innings...He struck out at least one batter in every appearance, logging eight in total...Has made 63 career MLB appearances, including nine with the Braves (0-0, 0.82) and 52 with the Mets (4-1, 4.50).

DOMINIC SMITH: Yesterday recorded his first extra-base hit since June 19, a bases-loaded, go-ahead, three-RBI double in the first inning...Smith has hit safely in seven of his last 11 games with an at-bat.

A Among players with fewer than 200 at-bats this season, Smith's 11 RBI with the bases loaded are tied for fourth most in the majors.

A Smith is one of three Braves with a batting average of .500-or-better with the bases loaded, along with Dubón (.778) and Ronald Acuña Jr. (.500).

Today's Game

Makes his 16th start of the season and the 44th of his career in the opener of a three-game series against New York (NL).

Has made two career starts against the Mets, going 0-1 with a 2.00 ERA (2 ER/9.0 IP)...Struck out seven over 4.0 scoreless innings in a no-decision September 30, 2024 at Truist Park in a 3-0 Atlanta win, then took the loss June 26, 2025 at Citi Field, allowing two runs on six hits over 5.0 innings in a 4-0 defeat.

Last pitched in relief June 27 at San Francisco, tossing 4.0 scoreless innings with four strikeouts and no walks on 47 pitches in a 5-0 loss...It was his first walk-free outing since March 31, 2025.

In 21 career relief appearances, is 1-1 with a 2.72 ERA (12 ER/39.2 IP) and 36 strikeouts, compared to 9-13 with a 4.07 ERA (100 ER/221.0 IP) and 226 strikeouts in 43 career starts.

Nineteen of his 21 relief outings came during his 2024 rookie season.

In his most recent start, took the loss June 22 at San Diego, allowing one run on three hits over 4.2 innings with five walks and four strikeouts on 91 pitches in a 1-0 defeat...Manny Machado's fourth-inning solo home run was the game's only run.

In 16 appearances (15 starts), is 4-4 with a 3.96 ERA (34 ER/77.1 IP) and 69 strikeouts, with five quality starts...Is holding opponents to a .233 average (68-for-292).

Has issued 37 walks and surrendered 14 home runs, equating to a 4.31 BB/9 and a 1.63 HR/9.

Has generated 48 of his 69 strikeouts this season with his slider, the third-most in the National League entering play.

Opponents are missing 41.3 percent of their swings against the pitch, the third-highest slider whiff rate among pitchers with at least 400 thrown.

Opponents are batting .202 (24-for-119) with a 2.76 ERA (10 ER/32.2 IP) against him the first time through the order this season.

The second time through, opposing hitters are batting .306 (34-for-111) with a 7.00 ERA (21 ER/27.0 IP).

Has held opponents 0-for-8 with the bases loaded in 2026.

His 43 career starts for the Braves are the most in Atlanta-franchise history by a South Carolina-born player.

2026

Tossed 4.0 scoreless innings of relief June 27 at San Francisco, allowing one hit with four strikeouts and no walks on 47 pitches in a 5-0 loss...It was his first walk-free appearance since March 31, 2025.

Took the loss June 22 at San Diego, allowing one run on three hits over 4.2 innings with five walks and four strikeouts in a 1-0 defeat...Machado's fourth-inning solo home run accounted for the game's only run.

Recorded his 250th career strikeout June 3 against Toronto, earning the win after allowing two runs on five hits over 6.0 innings in a 7-3 victory for his fifth quality start of the season.

Recorded the third 10-strikeout game of his career and his first of 2026 on May 23 against Washington, fanning the side in order in the first inning - the first such frame by a Braves pitcher since Bryce Elder on May 4, 2025.

Reached 200 career strikeouts April 3 at Chase Field in Arizona.

Went 1-0 with a 1.02 ERA in five spring appearances (four starts), fanning 20 over 17.2 innings with just one walk.

Career Recap

Awards: Midwest League Midseason All-Star (2015); Texas League Pitcher of the Week (July 30, 2017).

In his MLB debut season in 2024, went 2-1 with a 3.56 ERA (27 ER/68.1 IP) over 26 appearances (seven starts)...Was recalled by Atlanta from Triple-A Gwinnett on August 8, 2024.

In 2022, pitched for three different minor league teams throughout the Oakland and Atlanta organizations...Separately, went 1-2 with Triple-A Las Vegas before joining the Braves system.

Pitched the entire 2021 season for Triple-A Las Vegas and saw more relief appearances (29) than starts (7) for first time in career.

Set career highs and led the team in games (50) and saves (13) in 2023 with Triple-A Gwinnett...Led all Strippers relievers in strikeouts (74).

Named Gatorade Player of the Year in South Carolina following his senior year in 2014.

Selected by the Los Angeles Dodgers in the first round (22nd overall) of the 2014 June draft (Conway High School, SC).

On August 1, 2016, traded by the Dodgers to the Oakland Athletics along with RHP Frankie Montas and RHP Jharel Cotton for OF Josh Reddick and RHP Rich Hill.

Pitched 10 seasons in the minors before making his MLB debut.

Signed by the Atlanta Braves as a minor league free agent on August 13, 2022.
