Owen Caissie (CHC) had a 2-for-4 showing with a home run and double on Saturday, helping lead his Mesa Solar Sox to a 12-9 victory over the first-place Surprise Saguaros. Caissie recorded four RBI at Phoenix Municipal Stadium, doubling his AFL total.

Connor Thomas (STL) stands atop the AFL strikeout leaderboard (17) after three weeks of action. The left-hander returns to the mound this evening at Sloan Park after collecting 10 strikeouts in his last start (4 IP). Thomas has pitched a combined 12 2/3 AFL innings.

Zach Britton (TOR) is the current AFL leader in OPS (1.303), batting average (.500) and on-base percentage (.553) among gualified players. Going 9-for-13 in AFL Week 3 (.692/.733/1.154), Britton helped lead the Salt River Rafters to a 4-2 record in a six-day span.

After three complete weeks of AFL action, the Mesa Solar Sox lead the league in team OPS (.879), while the Glendale Desert Dogs lead in batting average (.275) and on-base percentage (.400). The Surprise Saguaros lead in team ERA (4.63) and pitching strikeouts (163).

Arizona Fall League Alumni Spotlight

Bryce Harper (Scottsdale Scorpions, 2010/2011) went 2-for-4 on Sunday in Game 5 of the National League Championship Series. His home run and two RBI proved decisive in a 4-3 victory over the San Diego Padres, leading the Philadelphia Phillies to the World Series for the first time since 2009. The first-overall selection in the 2010 MLB Draft, Harper was 17 years old when he first appeared in the Fall League. The outfielder made his MLB debut with the Washington Nationals in 2012 and has since received two National League MVP Awards (2015 and 2021) and seven All-Star selections.
