TODAY'S GAME: The Giants look to win the series with a victory in today's Colorado finale...SF is 7-2 in rubber games this season.

- ▶ The Giants are 2-3 vs. the Rockies this season, having gone 1-2 here in Colorado at the end of May, before splitting the first two games of this current series.
- ▶ The Giants are 61-21 vs. the Rockies since the start of the 2021 season...at Coors Field in that span, they are 28-15.
- ▶ The Giants have lost six of their last eight road games, getting outscored 48-28 in that span (started June 19 at MIA).

TODAY'S STARTER: RHP Tyler Mahle will close out the series looking for his first win since April 22 (vs. LAD)...he is 0-5 with a 5.93 ERA (27er, 41.0ip) over his last eight starts.

- ▶ In his last outing, June 29 at AZ, he allowed four runs on four hits (one homer) while striking out three across 4.1 innings.
- ▶ The righty is 2-1 with a 5.08 ERA (19er, 33.2ip), 27 strikeouts and a 1.43 WHIP in six career starts vs. the Rockies...in his last outing vs. Colorado (May 12, 2025 while with Texas), he allowed just one run on four hits and a walk across 6.1 innings.
- ▶ Mahle's best and most-used pitch this season has been his four-seam fastball (48.2% usage rate, +2 run value)...COL's .797 OPS vs. 4SFB this season is T-8th-best in MLB.

ALL ARRAEZ: IF Luis Arraez was named an NL All-Star yesterday...it's his fourth-career All-Star selection (also 2022 with Minnesota, 2023 with Miami and 2024 with San Diego).

- ▶ Arraez is the ninth Giants All-Star second baseman all-time, joining **Burgess Whitehead** (1937), **Bill Rigney** (1948), **Eddie Stanky** (1950), **Davey Williams** (1953), **Robby Thompson** (1988, 1993), **Jeff Kent** (1999-2001), **Marco Scutaro** (2013) and **Joe Panik** (2015).
- ▶ The first-year Giant currently ranks top-10 in the Majors in batting average (.330, 2nd), hits (109, 2nd), triples (seven, 2nd) and defensive outs above average (+11, T-4th).
- ▶ Arraez recorded his 10th game this season of three or more hits last night (T-3rd most in MLB this season)...his 107 games of three or more hits since his debut 2019 season are most in the Majors over that span (second is Freddie Freeman with 101 such games).

WEBB GEMS: RHP Logan Webb was also named an NL All-Star yesterday...the ace is coming off a June Pitcher of the Month award in which he led MLB for the month with a 0.71 ERA (3er, 38.0ip) and a .370 opposing OPS, while tying for the MLB lead with a 0.61 WHIP.

- ▶ This marks Webb's third career All-Star nod, having pitched in each of the last two games.
- ▶ Overall, Webb has a 3.66 ERA (38er, 93.1ip), 78 strikeouts and a 1.17 WHIP in 15 starts.

THE BRYCE IS RIGHT: IF Bryce Eldridge hit a 458-foot home run in the 3rd inning last night, which is the furthest homer hit by a Giants batter this season, and the furthest hit by a Giants batter age 22 or younger in the Statcast era (since 2015).

- ▶ Eldridge became the first Giants batter in the Statcast era to have multiple 450+ foot homers in a single season vs. Rockies.

LEE-DING THE WAY: OF Jung Hoo Lee has a hit in all 12 career games played at Coors Field...the 12-game streak is the longest by an SF batter at COL to start their career all-time (previous high: **Rich Aurilia** with eight from 1995-1998) per *Stats, LLC*.

- ▶ Lee's 12-game streak is tied for the sixth-longest for an SF batter all-time (chart to the right).

NO TROUBLE WITH THE DOUBLE: The Giants hit seven doubles in last night's game...they also had nine doubles at COL on May 31 earlier this season...they are the first visiting team in the history of Coors Field to have multiple games of seven or more doubles in a single season (Colorado has done it in just five seasons).

WHAT'S ON DECK?: The Giants will hit the road postgame and return home for what is their final homestand before the All-Star break...SF will first welcome the reigning AL Champion Toronto Blue Jays to Oracle Park for a three-game series Monday-Wednesday before a four-game set Thursday-Sunday vs. the Rockies to close out the first half.

FIRST YEAR GIANT: Is in his 10th season in the Majors and his first in a Giants uniform...the 31-year-old inked a one-year deal with SF on January 5 and is making his 14th start of the season today.

LAST TIME OUT: Took his third loss against the Diamondbacks of the season, pitching 4.1 innings and allowing four earned runs on four hits and three walks while striking out three...three of his four earned runs scored after he was removed from the game with one out and the bases loaded in the 5th inning due to a pitch count limit of 85 (he recently returned from a strained left hamstring that landed him on the 15-day injured list).

AGAINST COLORADO: Is making his seventh career appearance (all starts) against the Rockies, and first this season... is 2-1 with a lifetime ERA of 5.08 (19er, 33.2ip) in matchups with Colorado...tossed 7.0 innings and allowed just two earned runs in his most recent start at Coors Field (May 15, 2021 w/ CIN).

HOMEBODY: Has been pitching much better at home this season... in seven starts at Oracle Park, the righty has a 3.32 ERA (14er, 38.0ip), a .213 BAA and a .662 opponents' OPS...in six starts on the road, he is 0-5 with a 8.79 ERA (28er, 28.2ip), a .342 opposing average and a .983 OPS...last season, Mahle had a 0.84 ERA in 10 starts at home and 4.36 ERA in six road starts.

HAPPY DAYS: Mahle has been better in his daytime starts this season, as he holds a 4.21 ERA (12er, 25.2ip) in five day game starts versus a 6.59 ERA (30er, 41.0ip) in eight starts at night.

FAST AND FURIOUS: Over his last seven starts, opponents are 11-for-57 (.193) with 15 strikeouts in at-bats ending with his four-seamer...overall this season, Mahle is throwing his four-seam fastball 48.2% of the time this year, averaging 92.4 mph with batters hitting .250 off the pitch...it leads all of his pitches with a +2 run value.

SPLIT ON THE UP?: Opponents are 0x14 over Mahle's last two starts off of his main secondary pitch, his split finger...prior to those outings, batters were hitting .284 (19x67) with four doubles and three homers off his split, which Mahle has thrown 25.4% of the time this season...last year, Mahle's splitter was his most valuable pitch, accumulating a +5 run value and a .196 BAA.

PUT IT IN REVERSE: Has been putting up reverse splits this season, with right-handed batters slashing .339/.423/.525 (.949 OPS) off him while lefties are .215/.270/.415 (.685 OPS)...among right-handed pitchers, his .339 BAA and .949 OPS versus right-handed hitters are both highest in the Majors (min. .65.0ip).

FIRST THINGS FIRST: Is throwing the first pitch of an at-bat for a strike 56.1% of the time, almost 9% lower than his 65.0% mark last season.
